

## Remoter control instucitons

### Control Method:

Adopt RF remoter to control the LED controller, which has 21 buttons, the function of each button as the table below:

ON	Jump	OFF	
Fade 8 COLOUR	Flash white 8 COLOUR	Chase 8 COLOUR	
STEADY ONE COLOUR	FADE ONE COLOUR	FLASH ONE COLOUR	
FLASH OUT ONE COLOUR	CHASE ONE COLOUR	WAVE ONE COLOUR	
Static red	Static Green	Static blude	
Static yellow	Static purple	Static cyan	
Static white	Random colour	Auto change	

1. “ON” “OFF”, control power on or power off.
2. Buttons in pink cyan, “JUMP” “FADE” “FLASH WHITE” “CHASE”, can auto change different colour for different effect.
3. Buttons in pink area, “STEADY”“FADE”“FLASH WHITE”“FLASH OUT”“CHASE” “WAVE” are function keys, the other keys are colour keys. Please select function key first, then color key.
4. “AUTO” can auto change different effects.
