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1 PRECAUTION BEFORE USE



This product is supplied with a charging adapter and recommends using this one. There is a risk of electric shock, fire or product failure if use unauthorized adapter.

5 POWER ON

Press the power key to turn on the power.

When the power is on uccessfully, the screen of the device appears.



6 POWER OFF

Press the power key while the product is powered on. Select Power Off on the screen then the screen turns off.



7 CHARGING WITH USB CABLE

- 1. Connect the sync cable to the SLED sync cable connector.
- 2. Connect the USB part of the sync cable to USB adaptor or PC.



8 CHARGING WITH CRADLE

- 1. Insert the charging adapter into the charging cradle.
- 2. Plug the charging adapter into a power outlet.
- 3. Insert the product into the charging cradle to charge.



* When the product is completely discharged, PDA powers on automatically after a certain time when charging started.

9 CHARGING GUN BATTERY WITH CRADLE

- 1. Insert the charging adapter into the charging cradle.
- 2. Plug the charging adapter into a power outlet.
- 3. Insert the battery into the charging cradle to charge. (If charging is successful, the LED of the cradle will light. Make sure that the LED lights when charging.)



* The gun handle battery is dedicated to SLED and is used separetely from PDA power. To charge the PDA, need to charge it via cradle or sync cable.

10 HOW TO REPLACE THE BATTERY

- 1. Remove the battery to be replaced by pressing down on both sides of the bottom of the gun handle and pulling it down as shown in the following illustration.
- 2. Replace the battery by inserting a new battery upwards as follows.
