


## DBOARD R2 Label locations


The following document describes where the compulsory labeling requirements are fulfilled in the DBOARD R2.

## 2. Label details

### 2.1.- FCC Part 15 Statement



FCC ID, IC number and following disclaimer has been included as a sticker:

*“This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undesired operation”.*

The disclaimer is also included in the user manual.

### 2.2.- Commercial Brand and Manufacturer Info



Commercial brand (PVH) is included, along as official address of the company. The name of the equipment (DBOARD R2) is also included along with input power supply. Additional information regarding documentation can be found in this part of the marking.

## 2.3.- Marking and Serial Numbers
