To whom it may concern,

The EIS Council requests the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) provide Long-Term Confidentiality of all internal photographs of the following product: FCC ID: 2AVVL0BSXR1BNETV001 herein referred to as the Bnet-V.

The Bnet-V is an advanced Electro-Magnetic Pulse (EMP) protected Software Defined Radio (SDR) being adapted from military use, to use by non-military government and critical infrastructure as well. As an advanced EMP protected SDR radio, the Bnet-V will provide survivable emergency communications for non-military government and critical infrastructure disaster response.

In order to prevent the internal photographs and internal circuitry from becoming public or being disclosed to unauthorized personnel, the EIS Council contemplates taking the following steps.

1. Equipment sales will not be made to the general public through third-party distribution channels, but limited to direct sales to customers engaged in the providing of critical infrastructure functions and non-military government agencies.
2. All sales will be secured with an NDA which outlines the customer's responsibilities in securing and safeguarding the equipment internal circuitry from disclosure.
3. Tamper resistant tags will be used to identify unauthorized access to internal circuitry.
4. Labels will be affixed to the equipment warning against unauthorized access.
5. All repairs requiring access to the internal circuitry will be conducted by Rafael Advanced System Ltd. (manufacturer) or by professional trained and certified by EIS Council and limited by an NDA.

EIS Council has spent substantial effort in developing this product and it is one of the first of its kind in industry. Having the subject information easily available to "competition" would negate the advantage they have achieved by developing this product. Not protecting the details of the design will result in financial hardship.
