

- 1. For WIFI function, the engineering test program was provided and enabled to make EUT continuous transmit/receive.
- 2.According to ANSI C63.10 standards, the test results are both the "worst case" and "worst setup" 1Mbps for 802.11b, 6Mbps for 802.11g, 6.5Mbps for 802.11n(H20), 13.5Mbps for 802.11(H40). Duty cycle setting during the transmission is 98.5% with maximum power setting for all modulations.






