#### QUICK START (PAIRING) 1. Charge the headphones until the blue light remains on (indicating full charge).

- Charging cable is a USB-C USB cable found in the headphone packaging.
- 2. Turn the headphones on by sliding the power button from "off" to "or Headphones will automatically enter "discoverable" mode, indicated by blue and red alternating flashes.
- 3. Bring the headphones within 1 meter (3 ft.) of the source device and follow the source device instructions for pairing a Bluetooth device. You will hear a voice prompt indicating that the headphones are paired.
  - a. For Apple source devices Go into "settings" -> Bluetooth, Make sure Bluetooth functionality is on. JuniorJams-PLUS will show up as a discovered device, select JuniorJams-PLUS.
