# 1.2 important tips for notebook use, please be sure to read

- 1. Maintenance of LCD display:

# A new battery:

The new battery needs to be used first, the power will be exhausted, can do the action of charging.

# **Battery life:**

Improper use and maintenance can shorten battery life.

To improve battery life and battery function, eachThe battery

Should be completely discharged and recharged to saturation every 30 days.

# Battery, counter:

A meter is built into the battery to calculate battery power. Battery meter relies on battery [memory] (memory) to determine how much to stop charging and discharging.

But if you often do [incomplete] charging or [incomplete] Discharge, the battery [memory] will be messed up.

To improve the accuracy of the battery meter, you must every 30 days or after 20 [incomplete] discharges, Do at least one full discharge and recharging until full

Due to the characteristics of the battery itself, the battery will be gradually reduced in the process of use, the use time will be shortened in the battery protection During the repair period, the battery may not be able to be fully filled to 100%, but it will not affect the normal use, which is a normal phenomenon.

#### Save battery power:

#### A advanced power management:

Your laptop has advanced power management features that slow down the processor and peripheral parts. make Using these features will help save battery power.

#### B brightness of LCD:

LCDS use a lot of power, so if you turn down the brightness, you can save power.

#### C software and peripherals:

Different software and peripherals consume power even if they are not programs or devices in use. To save battery energy, we recommend the following:

- if you are not using a wireless card or other communication program, turn those programs off.
- remove the unused PC card from the computer slot.

  Even in pause mode, the PC card quickly drains the battery.
- unplug unwanted peripherals from the computer socket.

# How to fully discharge the battery?

Let the computer run on battery power until the computer shuts down automatically because the power is too low. Even among you

You should never read a message on your computer screen saying the power is too low or hear a beep warning you that the power is too low

Turn off the computer by yourself. Keep the computer running until it runs out of battery power and shuts down automatically.

# How to fully charge?

When the battery is recharged, it usually waits until the battery light on the computer shows that the battery has been charged. For details, please refer to the power status indicator in this manual

# How to maintain the battery?

After at least every 30 days or every 20 [incomplete] discharges, You have to do a full discharge and charge.

#### Special note:

This battery can only be used in this laptop.

There is a risk of explosion if the wrong battery type is replaced.

Only the same type of original battery can be used

Or the battery type of the same level approved by the original factory shall be replaced.

Please do not disassemble the battery.

Do not expose the battery to fire or water.

To prevent fire, combustion, or battery damage, do not allow the battery to touch metal objects at either end of the battery. Take special care when handling damaged or leaking batteries. If you accidentally

touch the battery fluid, Please rinse immediately with soap and water. If it touches your eyes, Please rinse your eyes with water for 15 minutes and go to the hospital as soon as possible.

Do not charge if ambient temperature is high.

Do not expose the battery to high temperature during storage.

#### (remind)

When working or playing on your computer, adjust your environment and arrange your computer equipment,

Keep your body in a comfortable, flexible state.

The following Suggestions can help you get a more comfortable environment.

#### 1. Support your back:

Choose a chair that supports the lower back.

Adjust the height of the face and the chair,

Make it appear a comfortable and natural posture.

#### 2. Promote comfortable leg posture:

Remove objects from under the table to make leg positioning and movement more comfortable.

If your feet cannot rest comfortably on the floor, use a footstool.

#### 3. Reduce neck bend and twist:

Put the LCD display in the middle of your front. If you view documents more frequently than the screen, Consider placing the document directly in front of you, with the screen slightly to the side.

Consider using a document rack and holding the document close to eye level.

Place the top of the screen near eye level. People with astigmatism may need to lower the screen a little bit,

Or talk to a qualified health professional about glasses suitable for computer work.

# 4. Reduce eye strain:

Sit comfortably in front of the screen at arm's length.

Avoid glare. The display should be placed away from the source of glare,

Or use curtains to control light intensity.

Remember to clean the screen; Clean your glasses if you wear them.
