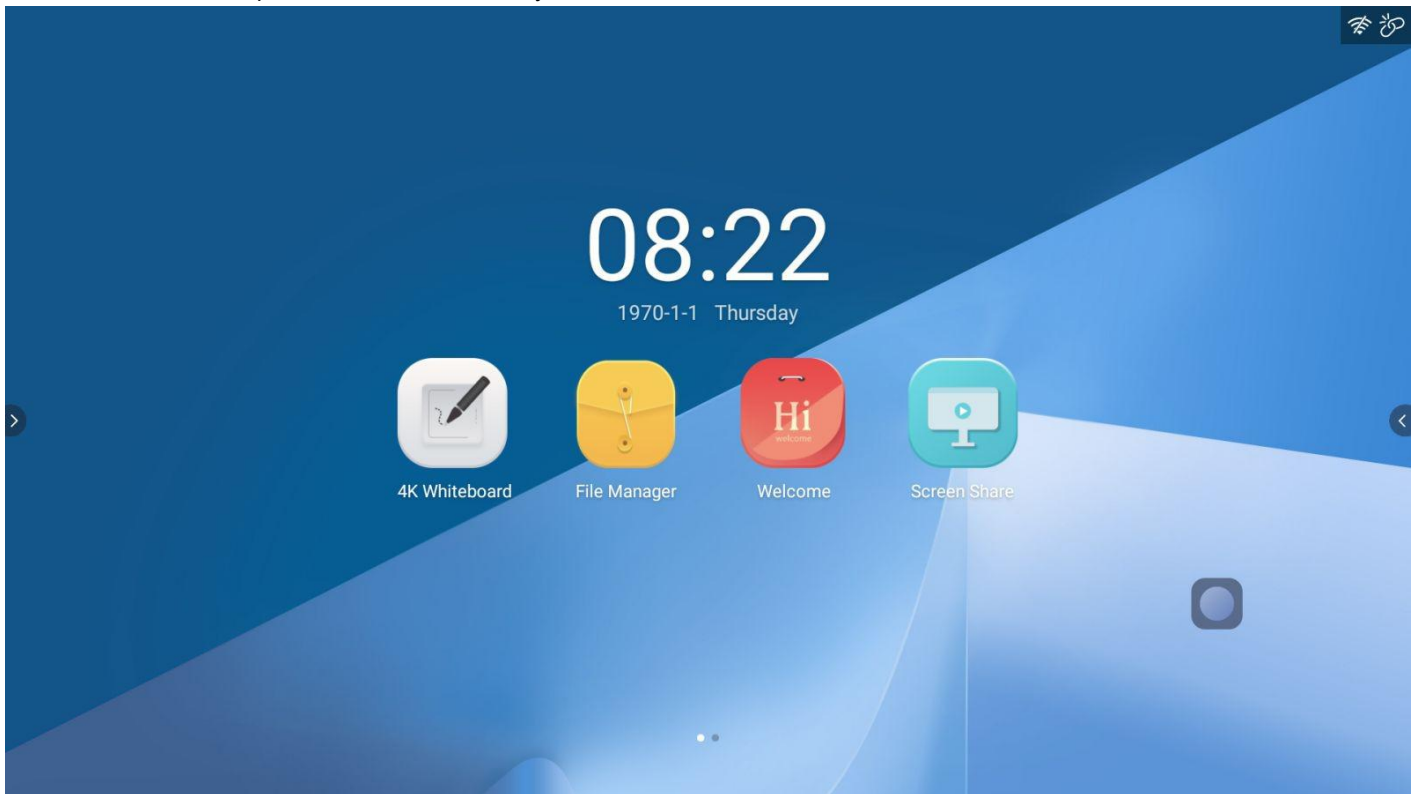


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1. Launcher

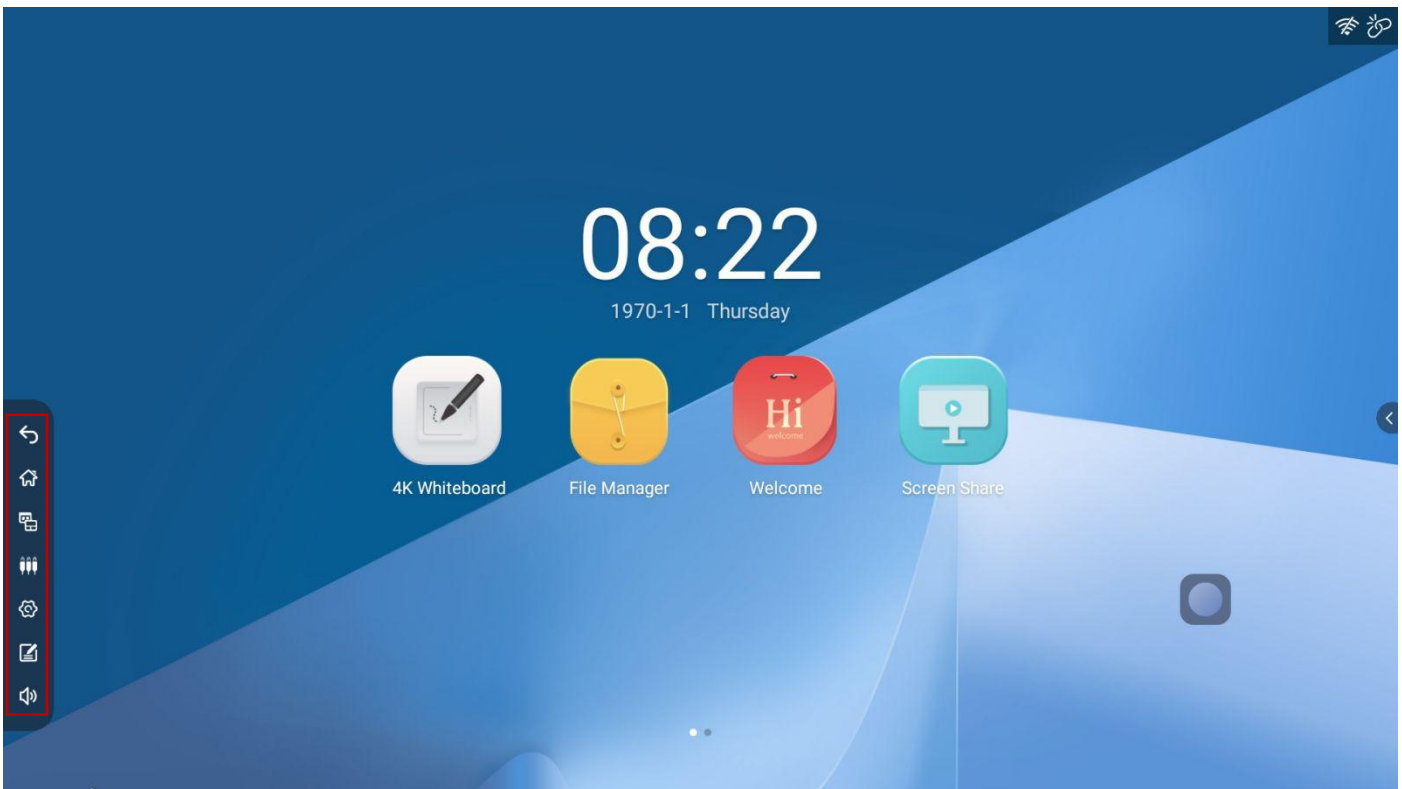
Power on the product , it will show the system launcher as default

Fuction


Side bars are located at the right side and left side of the screen , click the icon  (left side) and  (right side), we can open the side bar tool , it will contain following function: Return  , Home  , Task Manager  , Input  , Note  , Settings  . Click the screen, side bar will fold as the icon  (left side) and  (right side) .




2.1 Return

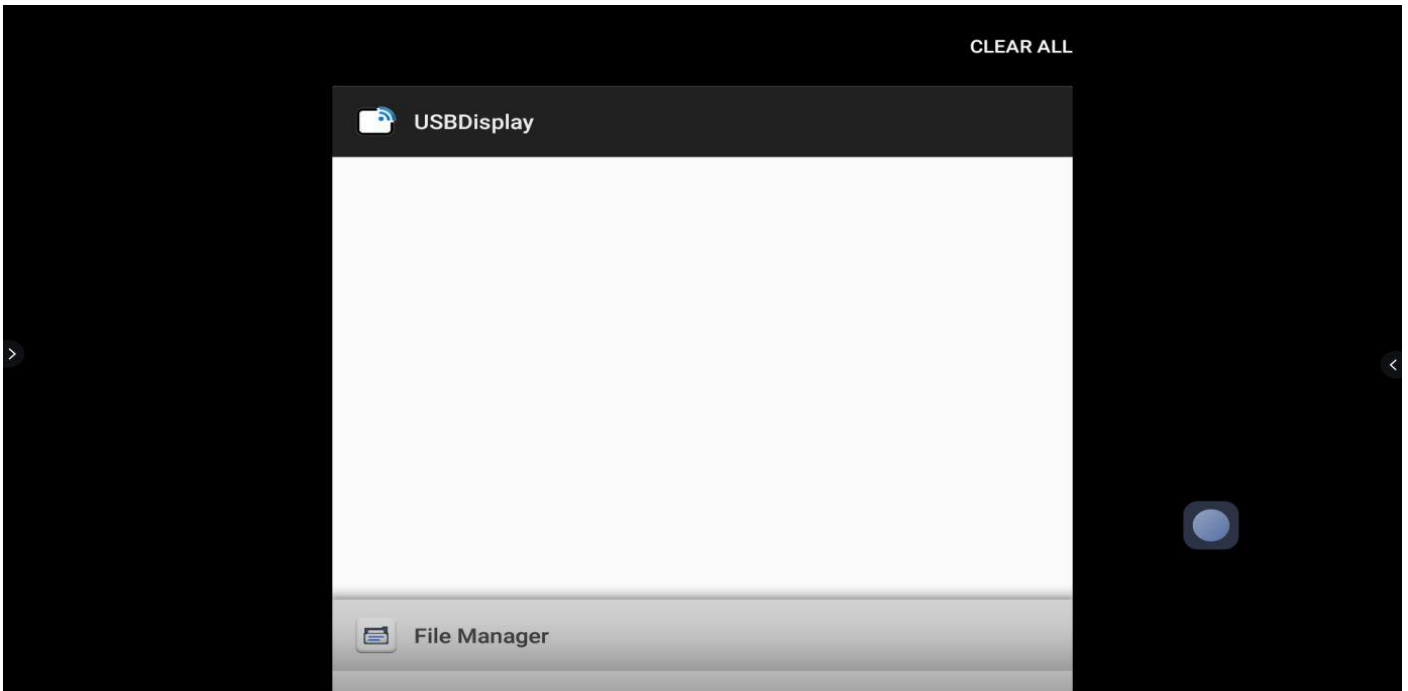
Click Return icon  , it will return previous page or quit current application.

Click Home icon  , it will go back to the system launcher.

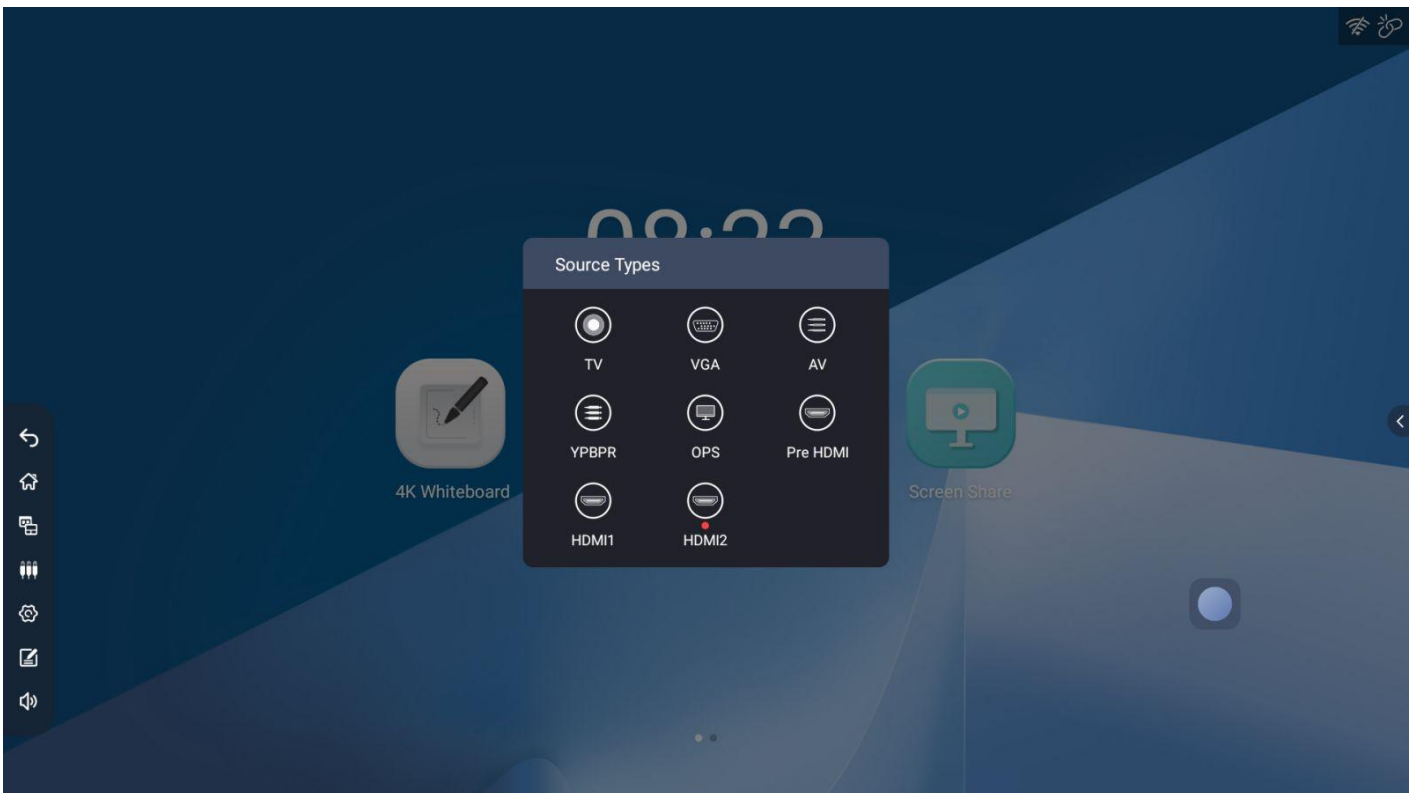
2.3 Task Manager

- (3) Slide the task or application thumbnail left or right out of the list area to close the task or application.




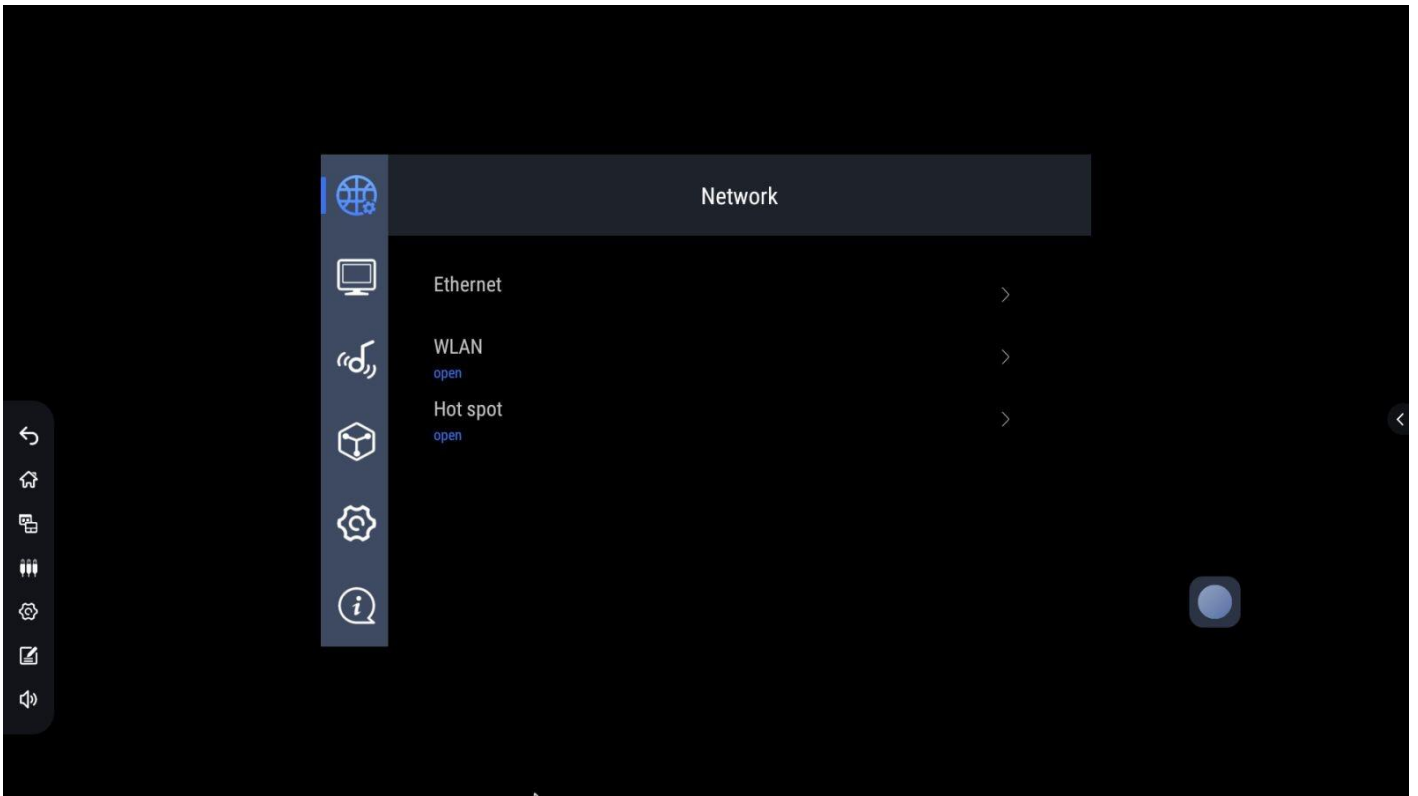
2.4 Input Source

Click the Input Source icon , open the input source list page and click the source icon to open the selected input device. If no device connected, it will show “no signal” on the screen.




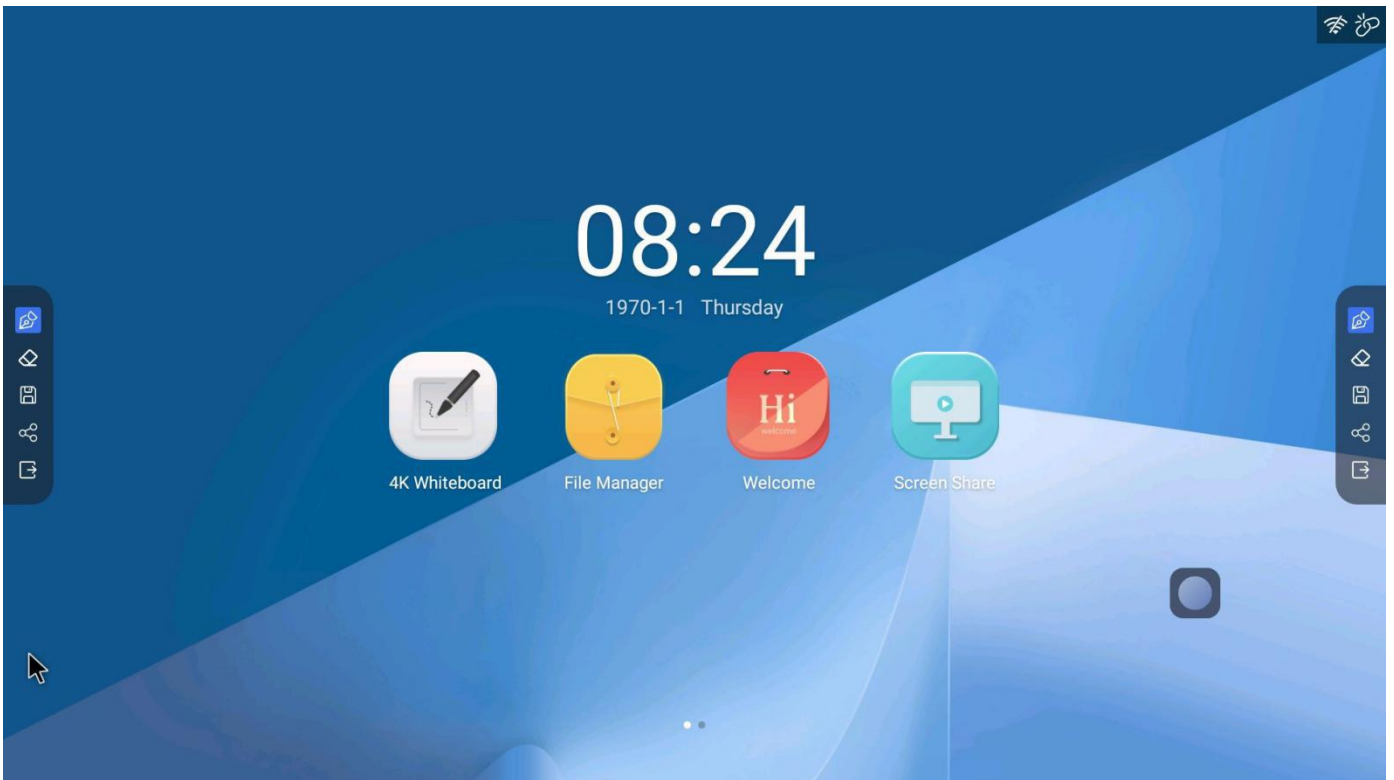
2.5 Setting menu

Click the Setting icon , it will open the setting menu as below:




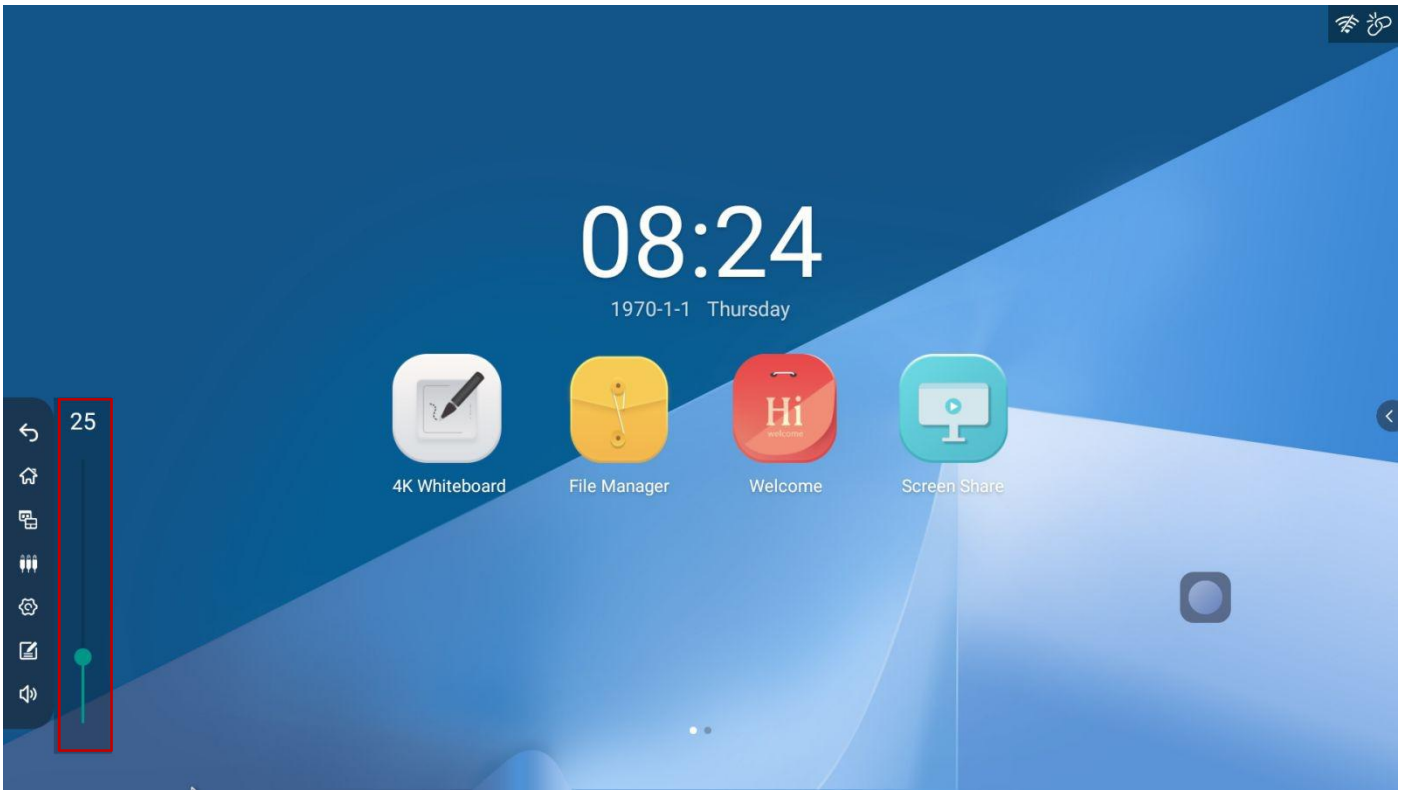
2.6 Note

2.7 Volume

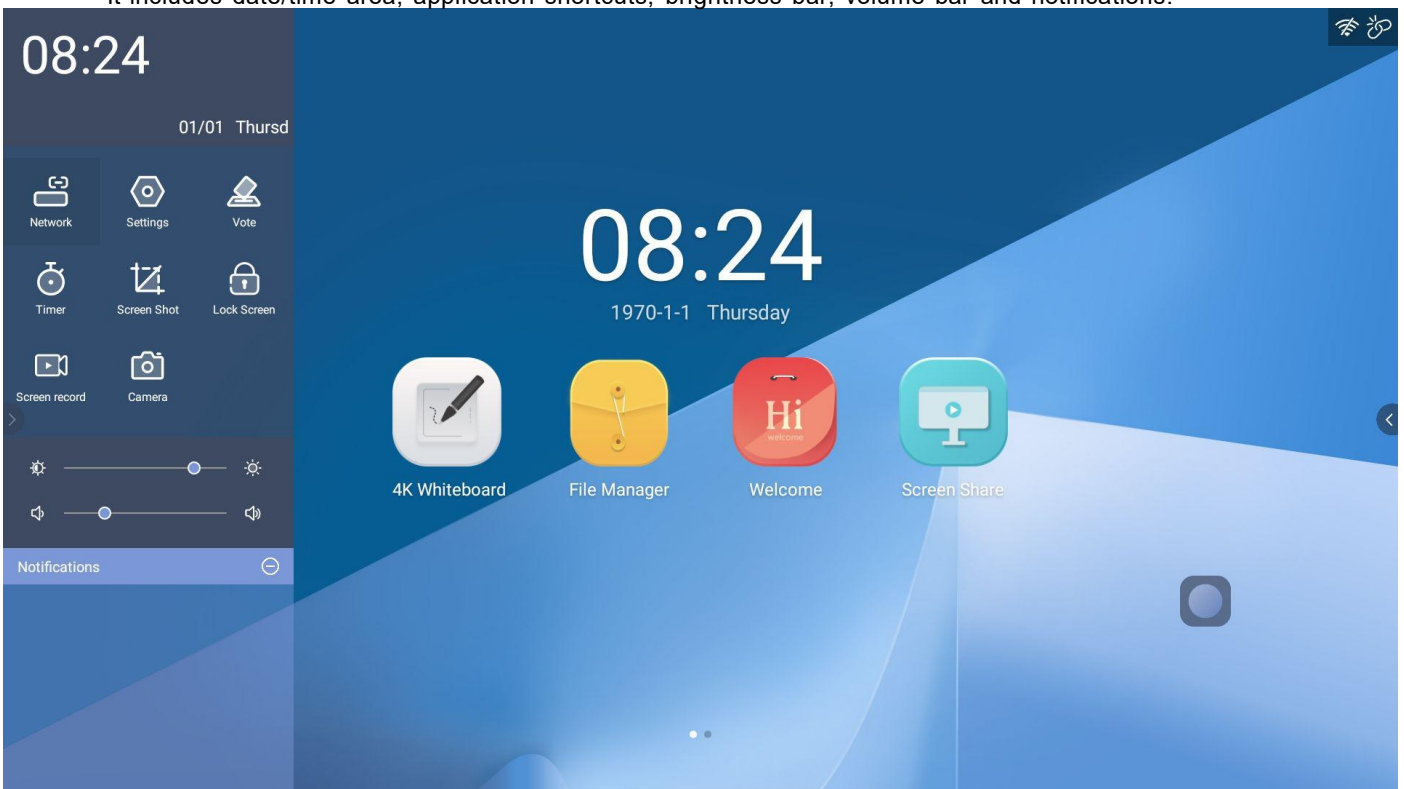
Click the icon  and slide or click the volume bar to change the sound level.





3. Notification Panel







Slide from the left or right side of panel to the center to open the notification panel as below:

It includes date/time area, application shortcuts, brightness bar, volume bar and notifications.



3.1 Default Shoutcuts

- Network, Click icon  , start network settings. (See Section 4.1)
- Setting, Click icon  , start system settings (See Section 4)

- Vote, Click icon  , start Vote application.
- Timer, Click icon  , start countdown or stopwatch.
- Lock Screen, Click icon  , to lock the screen, and touch, keyboard and remote will be no response, except the unlock button on the screen.
- Screen shot, click icon  to shot the screen, we can shot any area of the screen, include full screenshot.
- Screen record, click icon  to start screen recording , the recording file will save to the internal storage automatically.
- Camera, click icon  to start the camera application (need USB camera connected or build-in camera module)

3.2 Brightness and Volume

- (1) Brightness: click or slide the brightness bar to change the screen brightness.




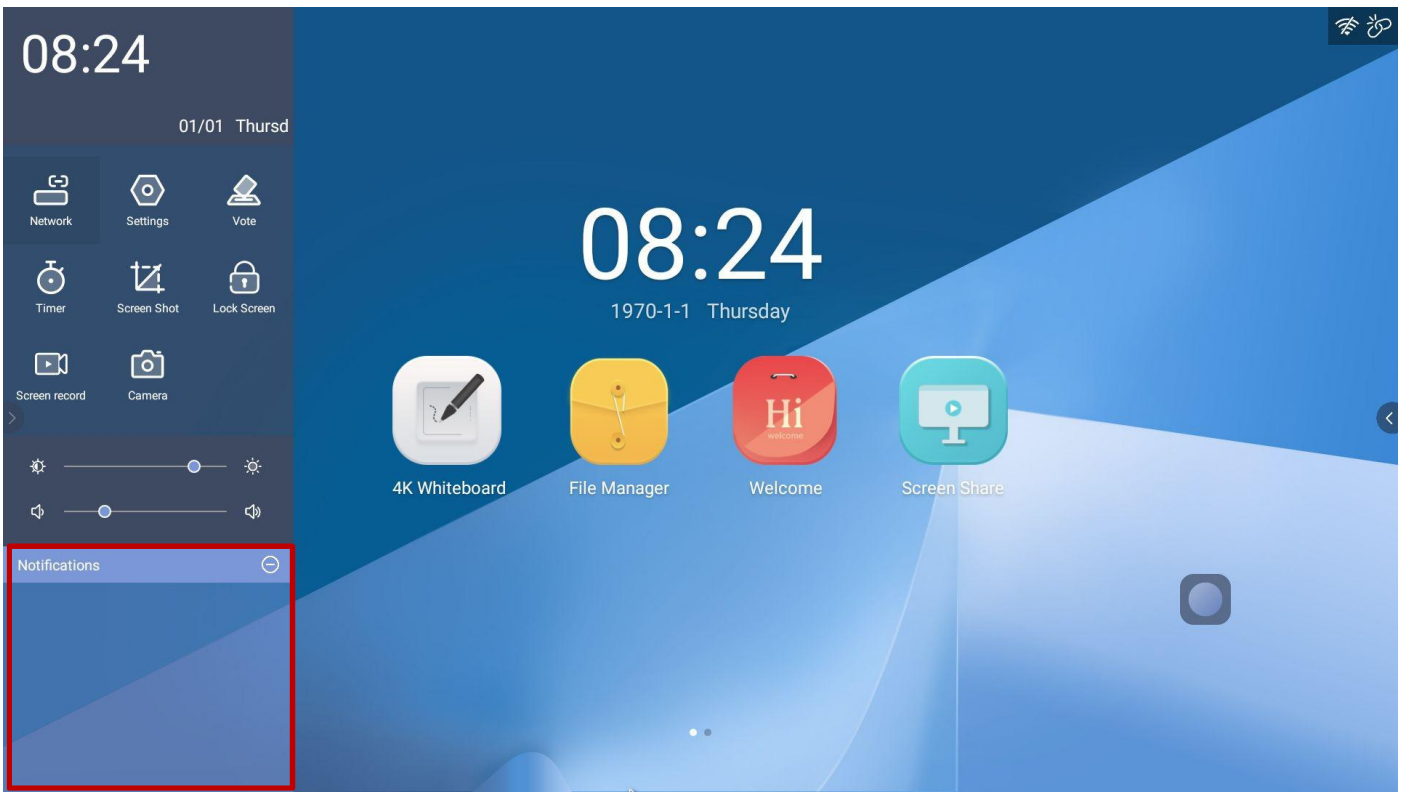
- (2) Volume: click or slide the volume bar to change the sound level.

- Click icon  to clear all the notice

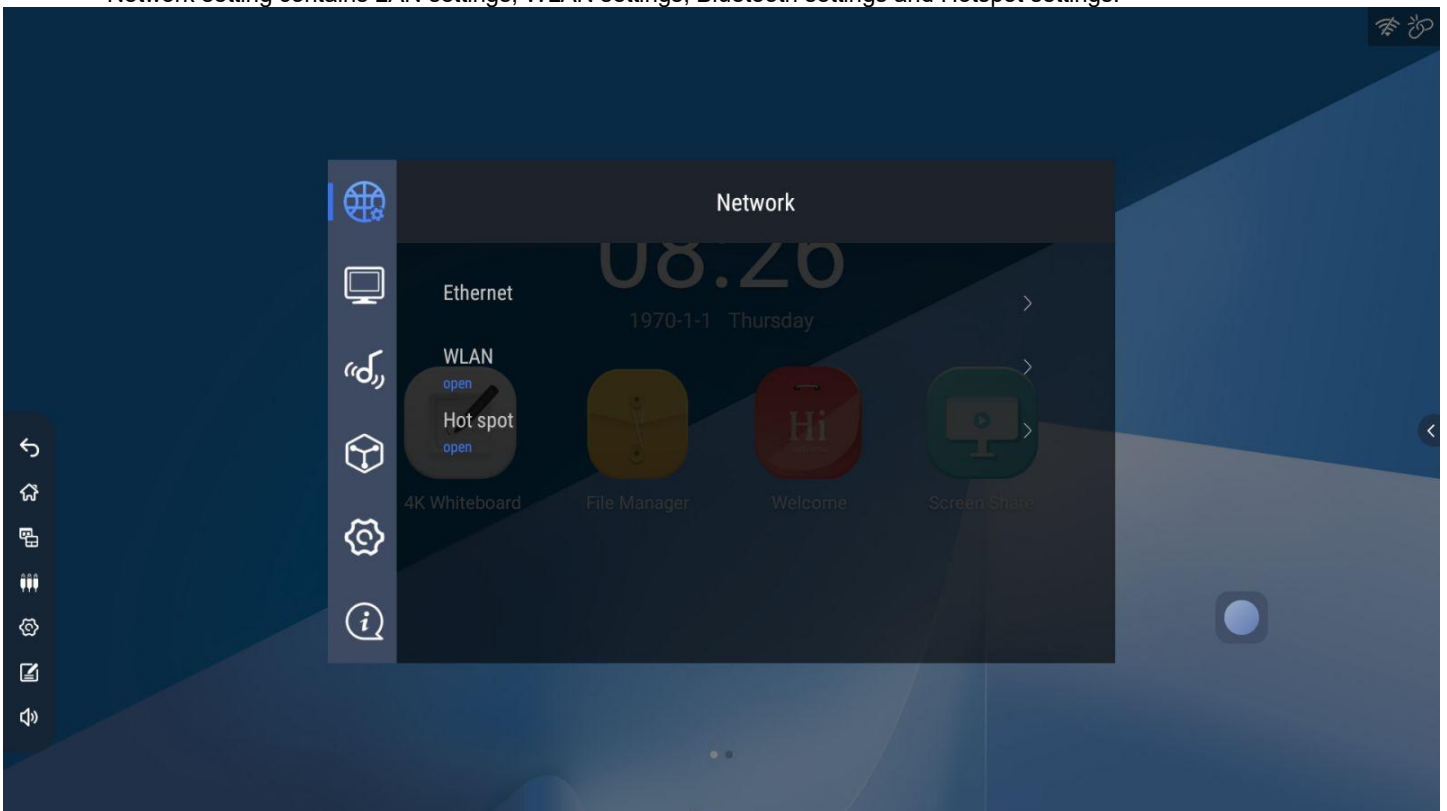


4. Settings

Setting menu include network settings  , display settings  , sound settings  , applications manager  , other settings  and system information .

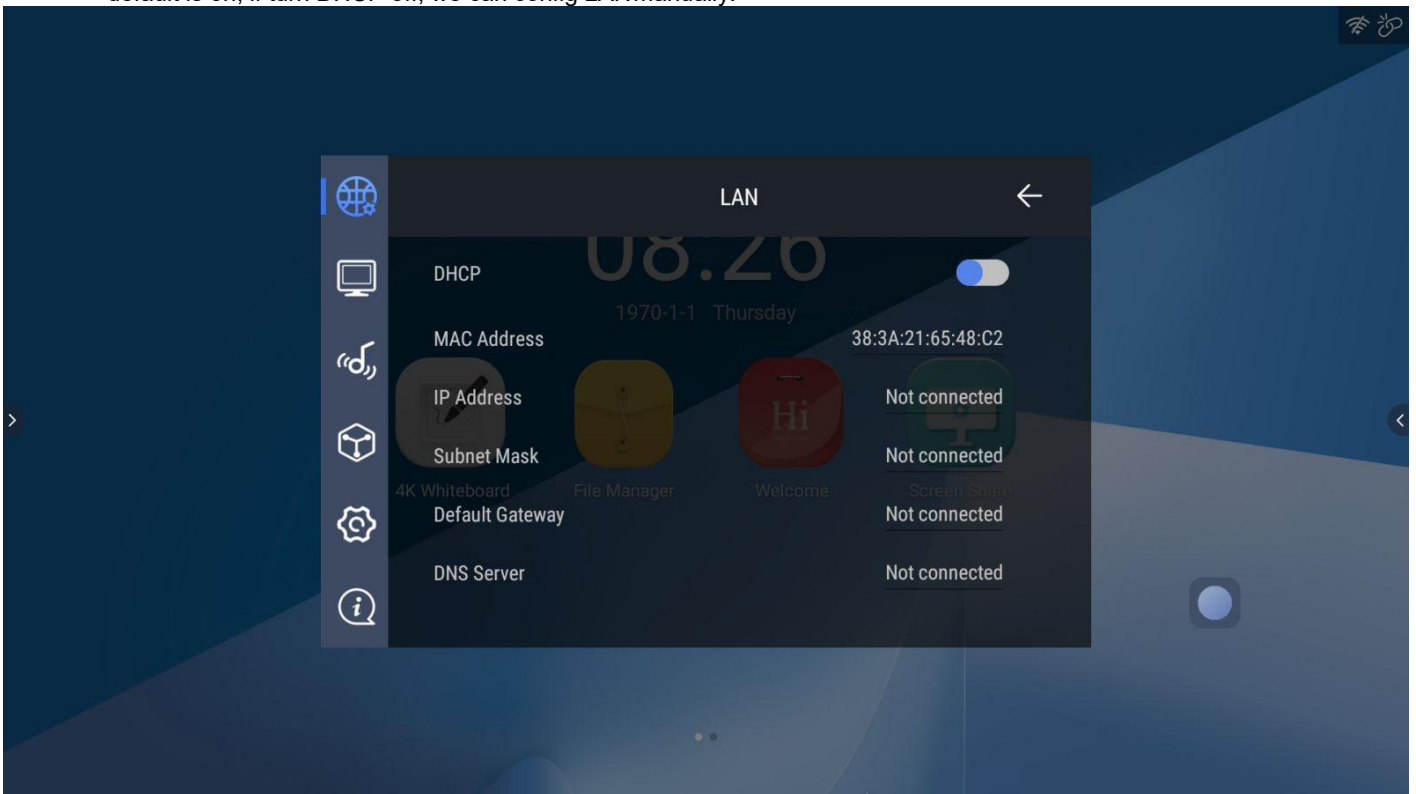
4.1 Network

Network setting contains LAN settings, WLAN settings, Bluetooth settings and Hotspot settings.



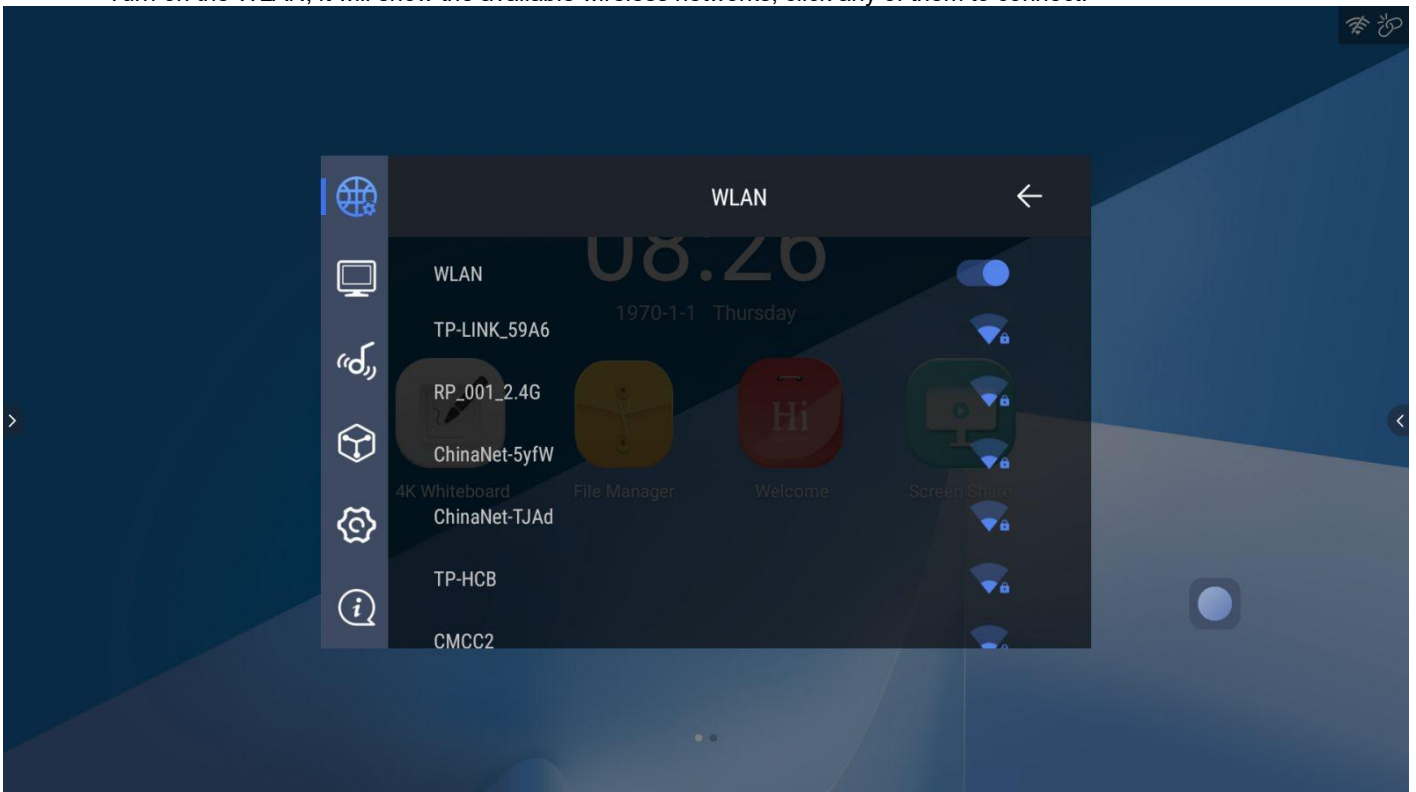
4.1.1 LAN Settings

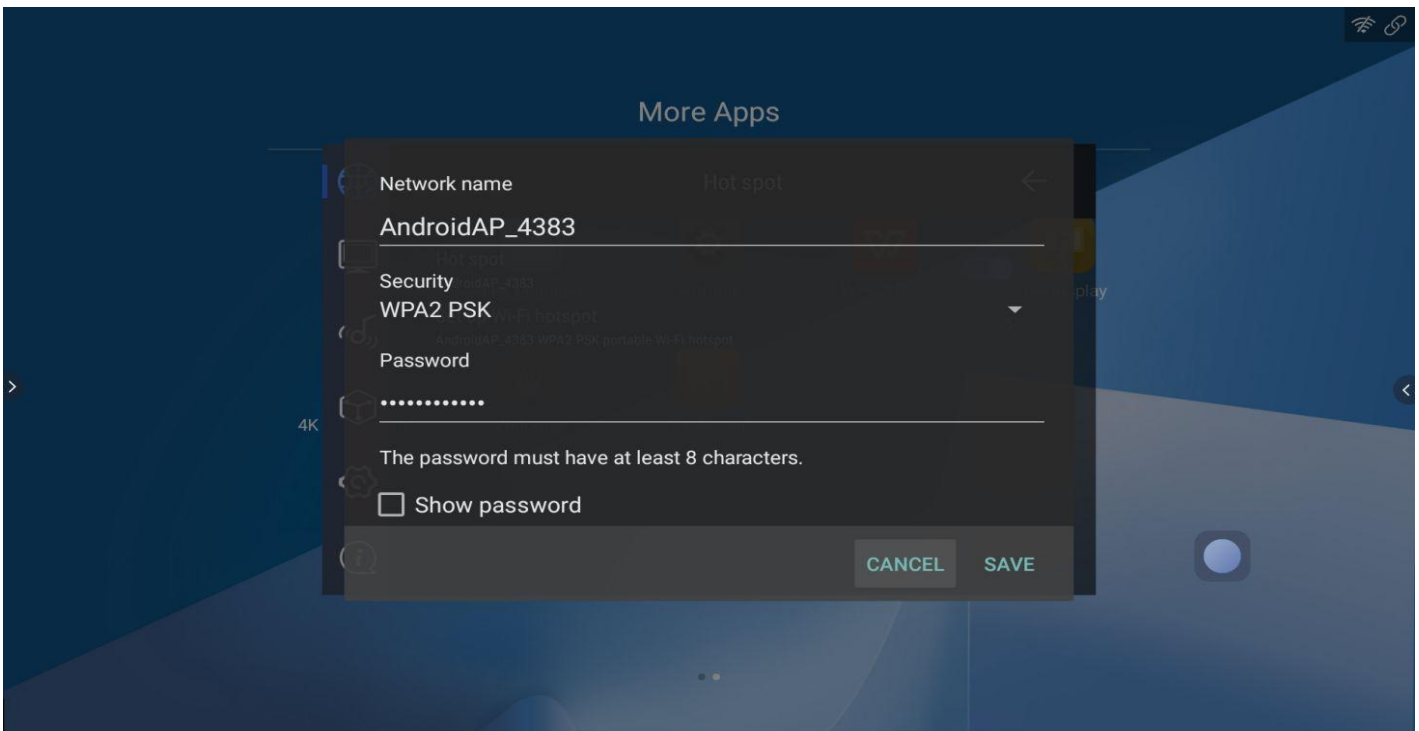
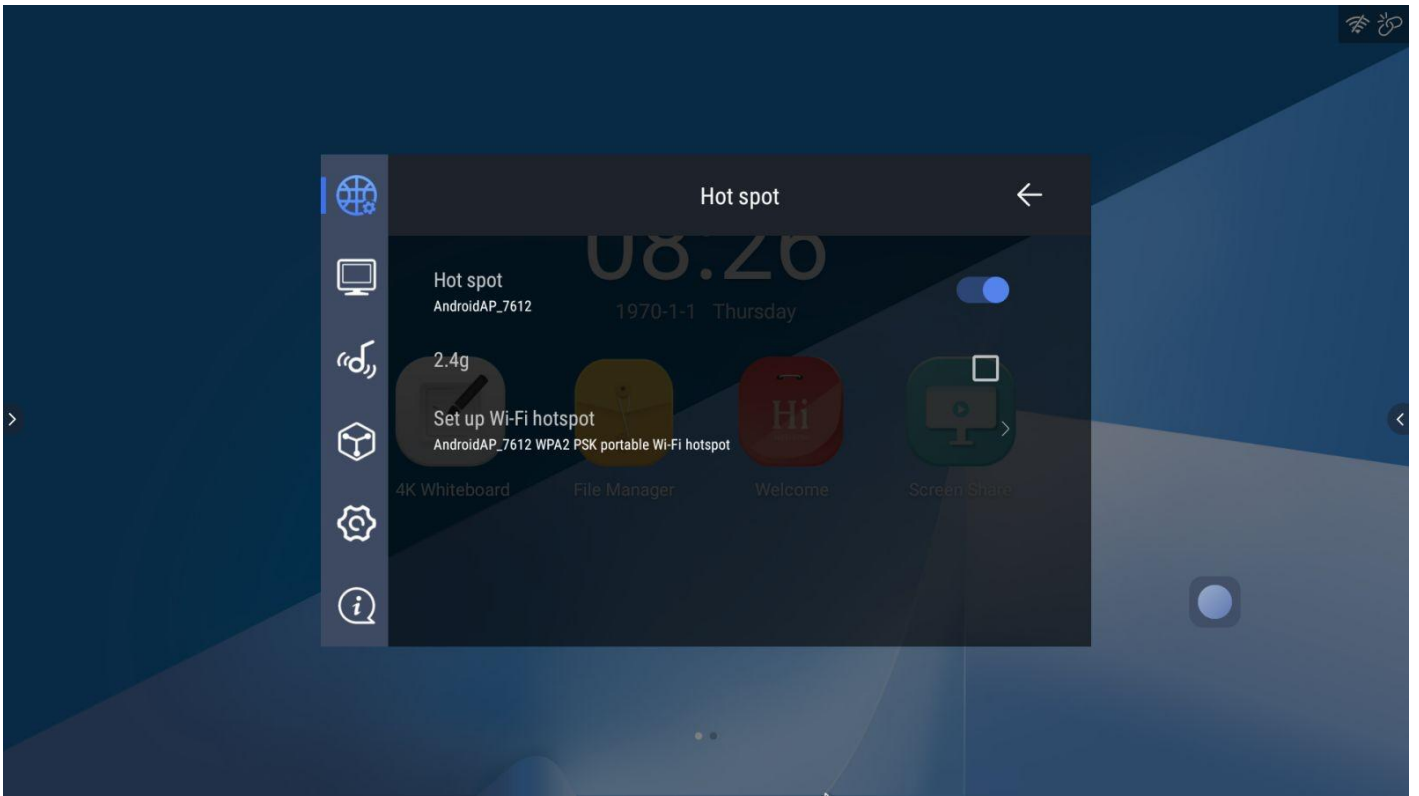
4. 1. 2 WLAN

Turn on the WLAN, it will show the available wireless networks, click any of them to connect.



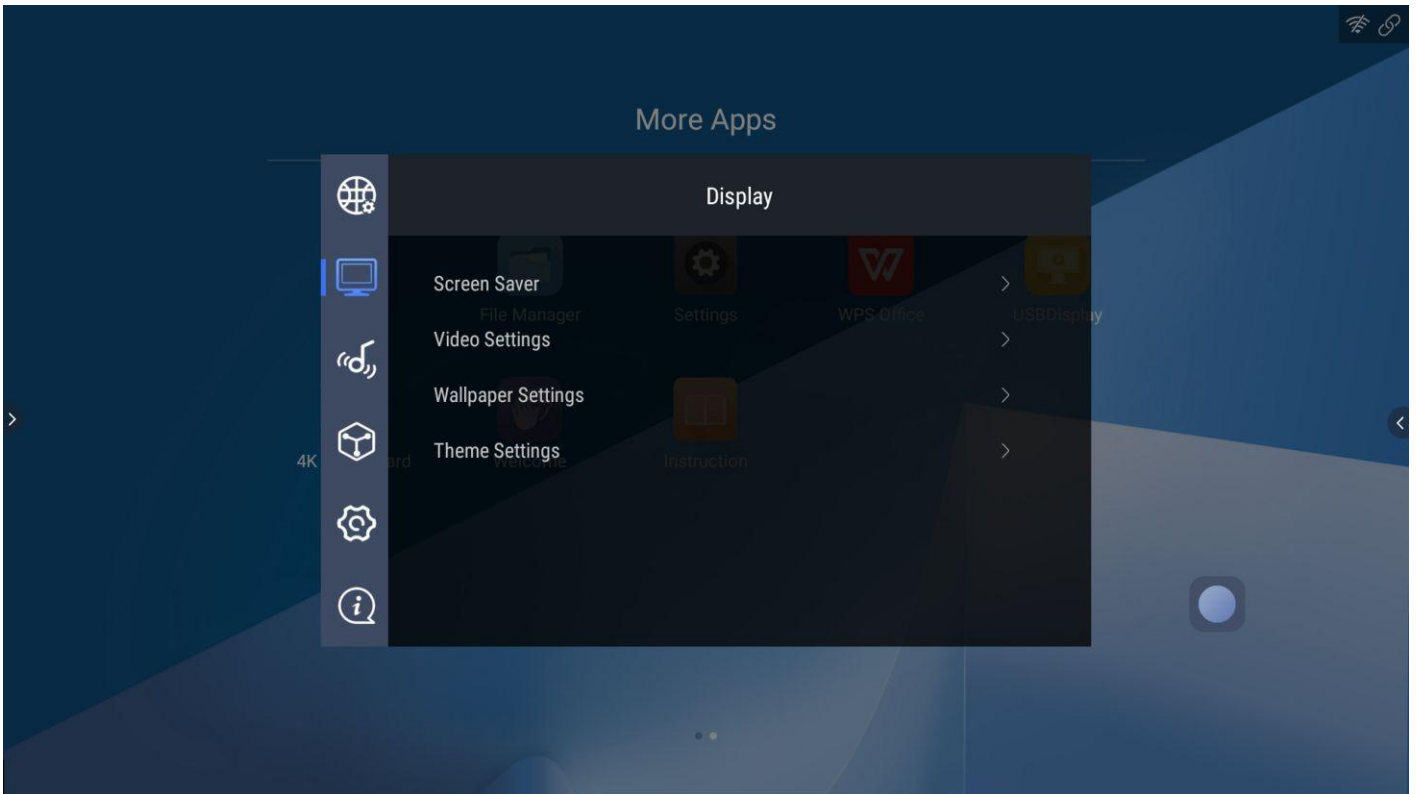
4. 1. 3 Hotspot (Screen share)

Display setting contains screen saver settings, video settings, wallpaper and theme settings.



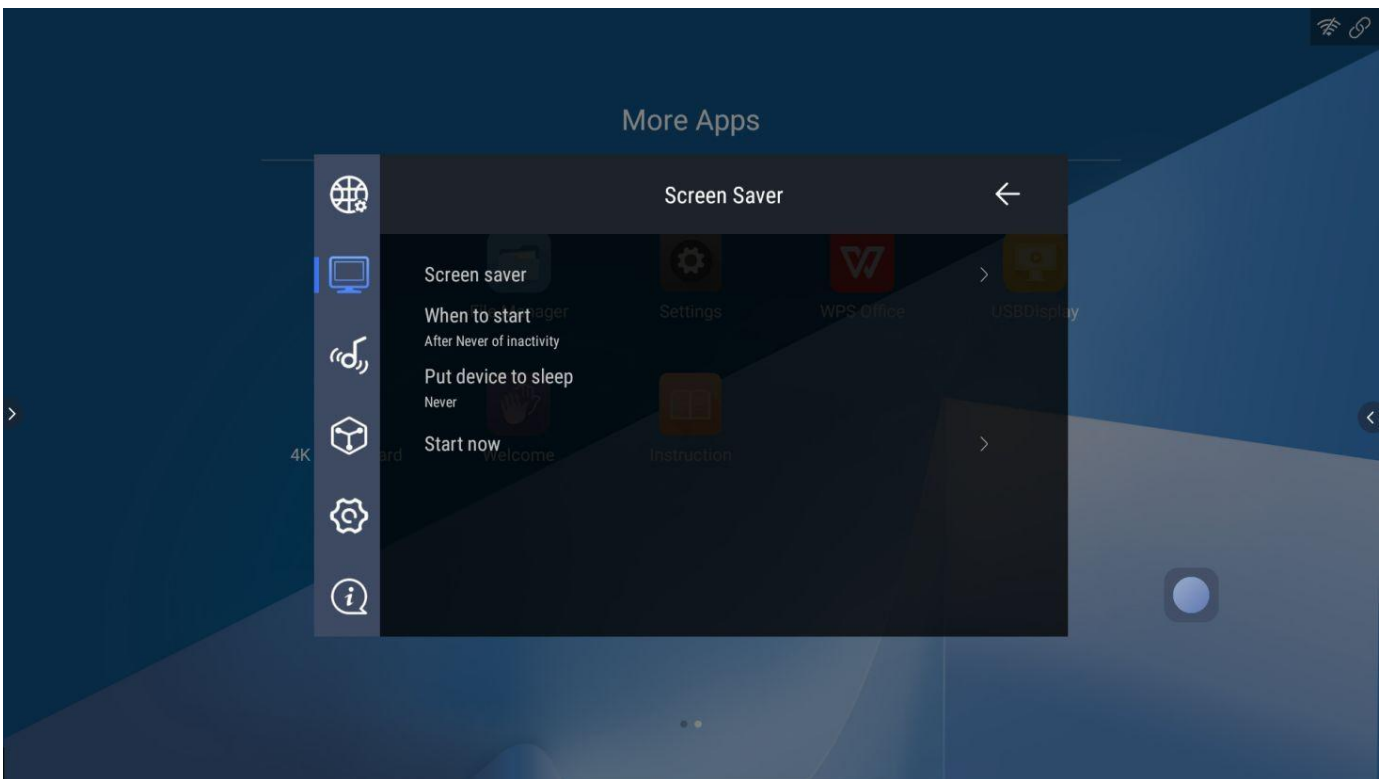
4. 2. 1 Screen saver settings

When to start: how long time without any operation, the system will show screen saver pattern.

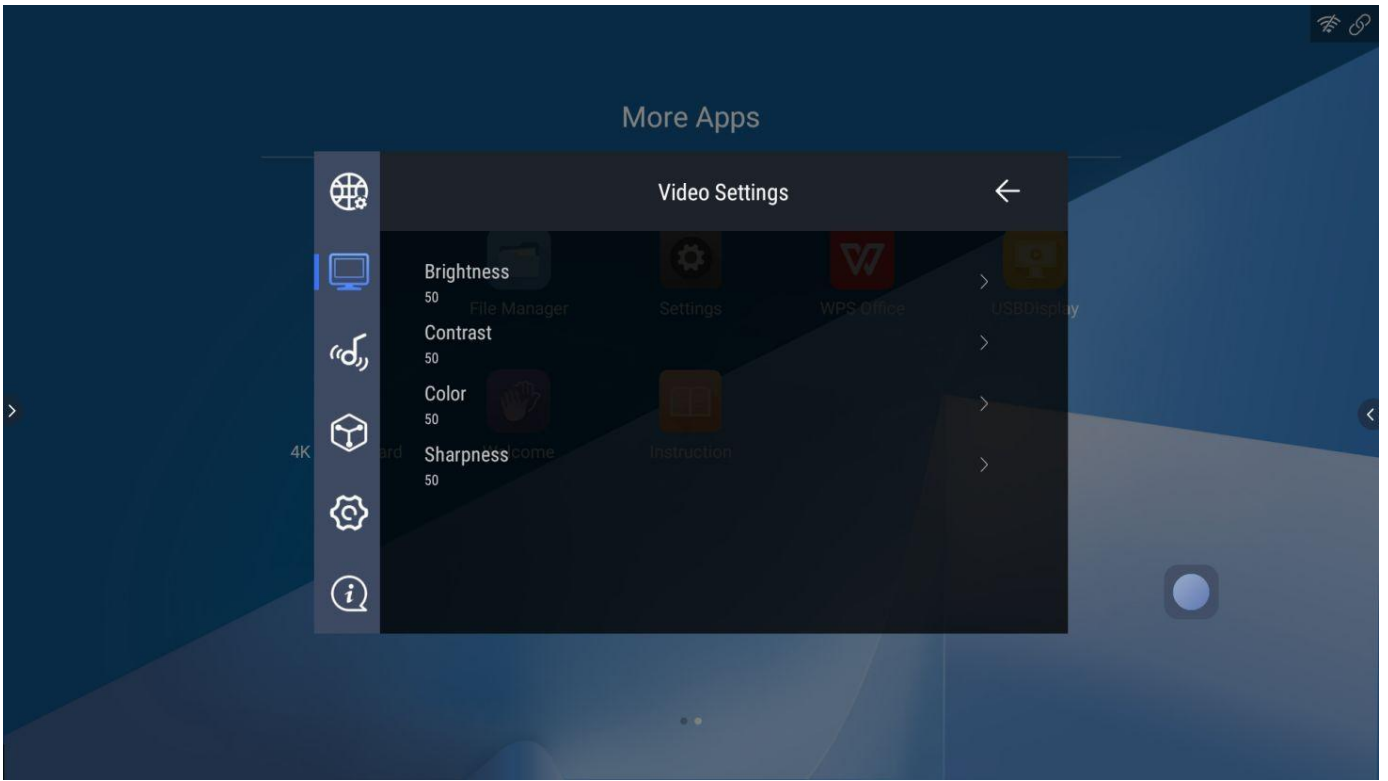
Put device to sleep: how long time without an operation, the system will go into sleep mode.

Start now: preview the screen saver pattern

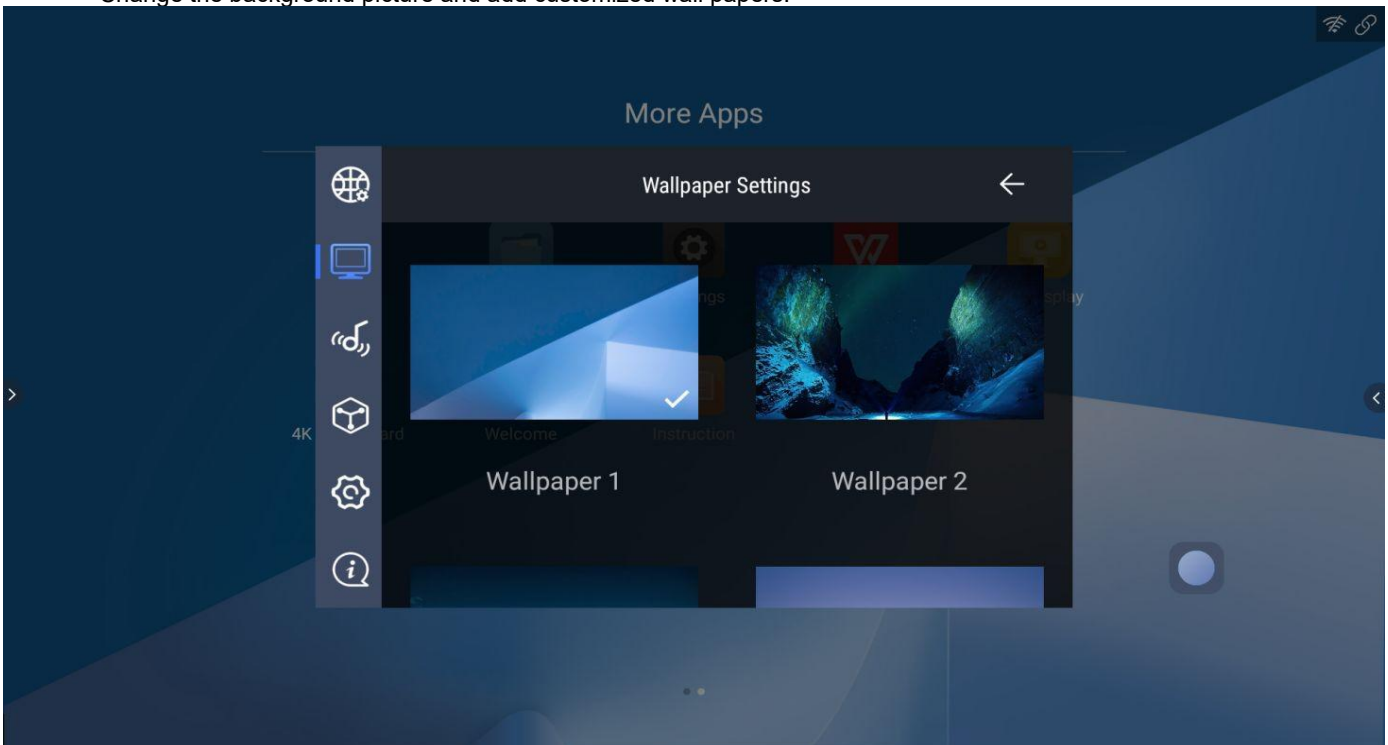


4. 2. 2 Video settings

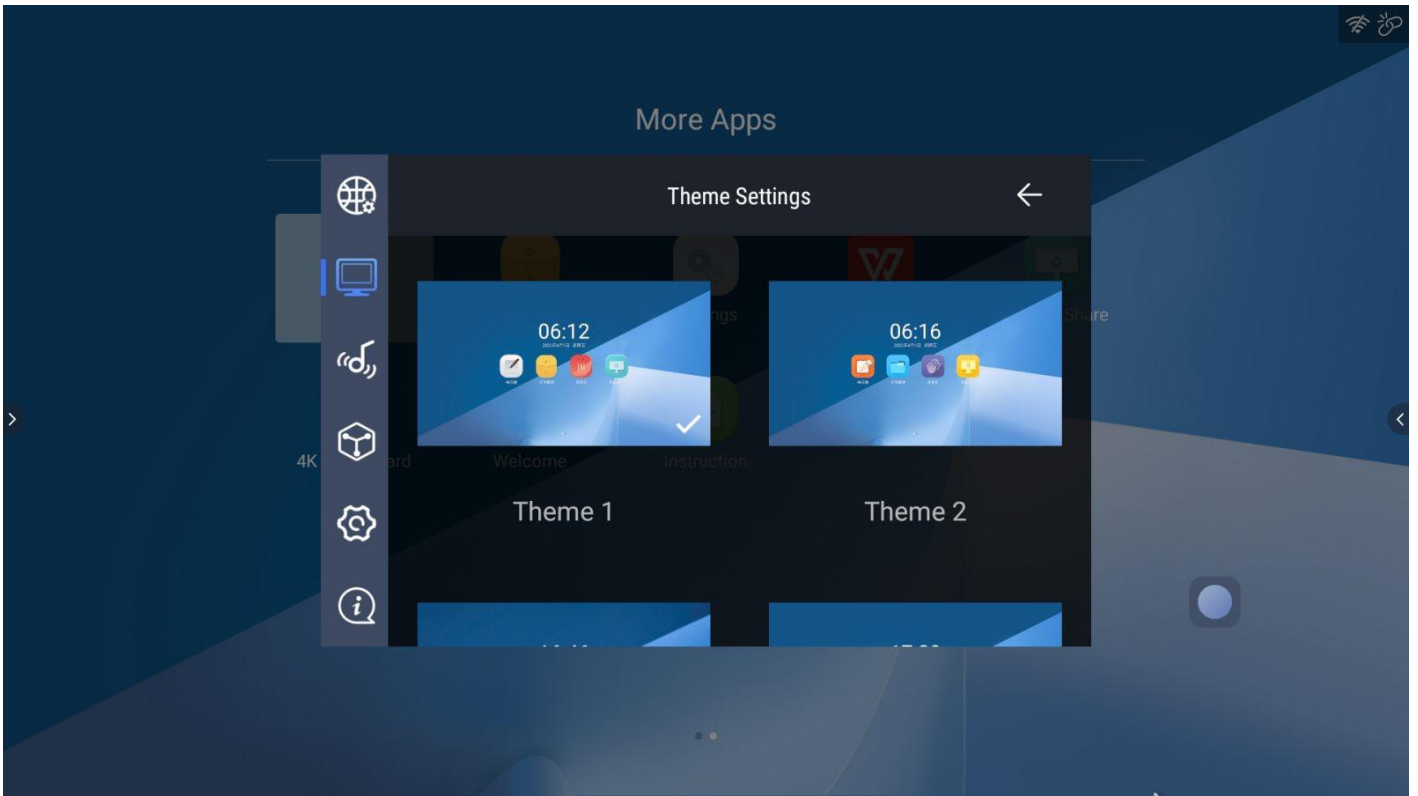
Video settings page contains brightness, contrast, color, sharpness setting.

Change the background picture and add customized wall papers.

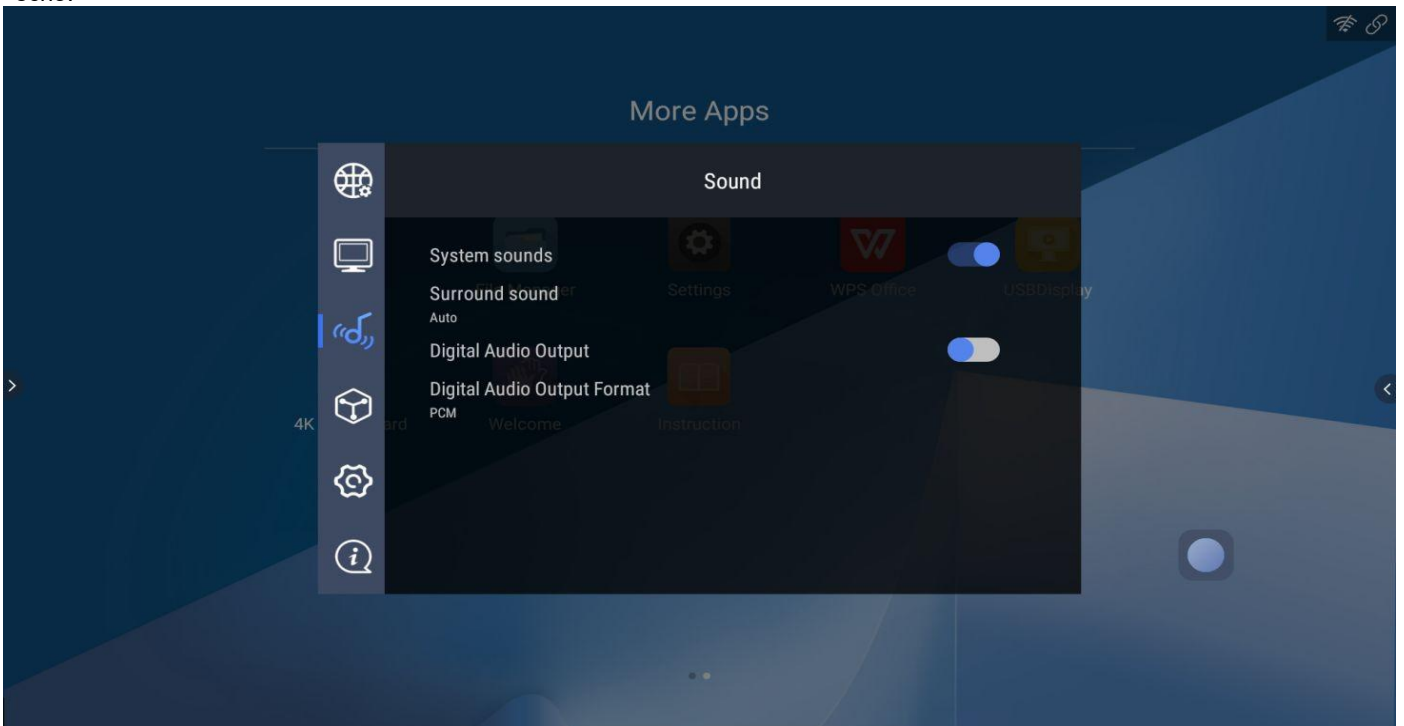


4. 2. 4 Theme settings

4.3 Sound

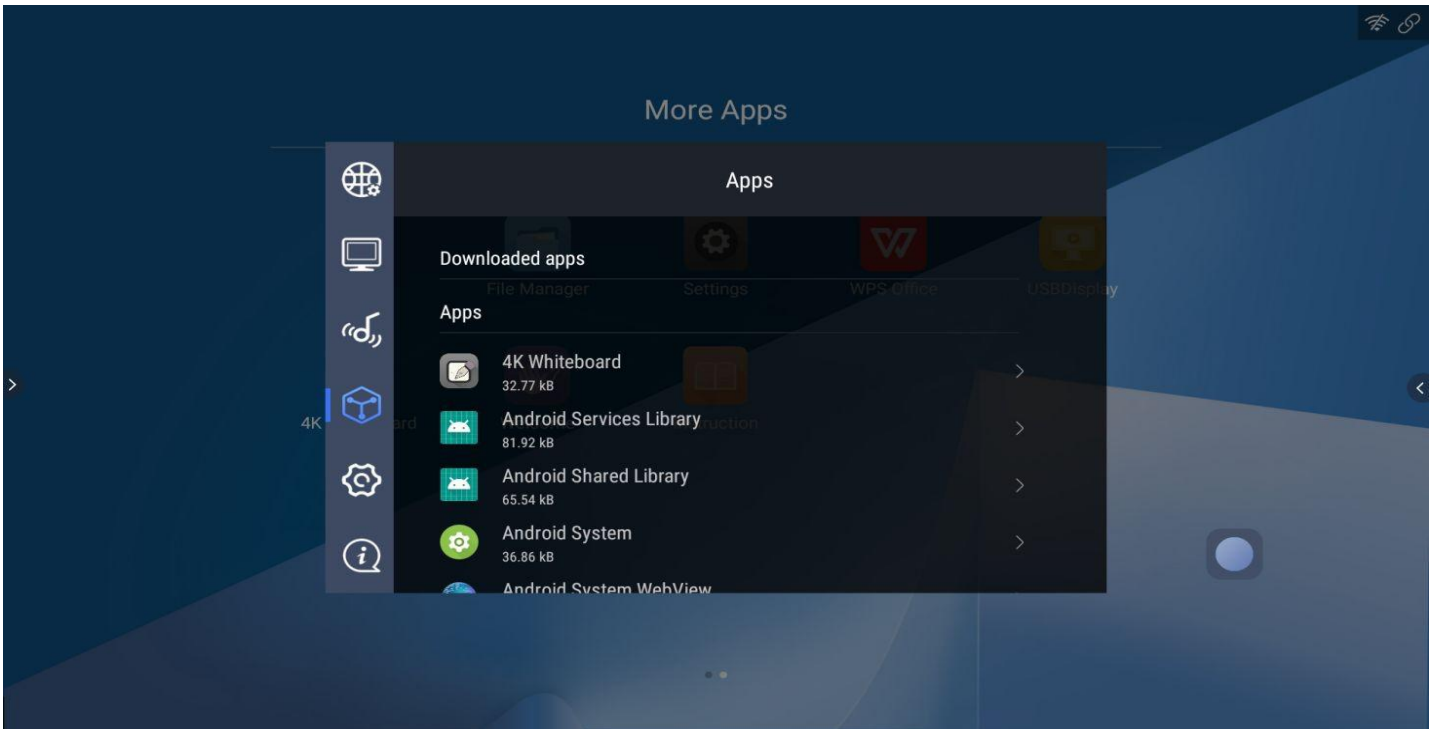
Sound settings page contains the system sound on/off, surround sound on/off and digital audio out on/off, Mic volume and Mic echo.



4.4 Application Manager

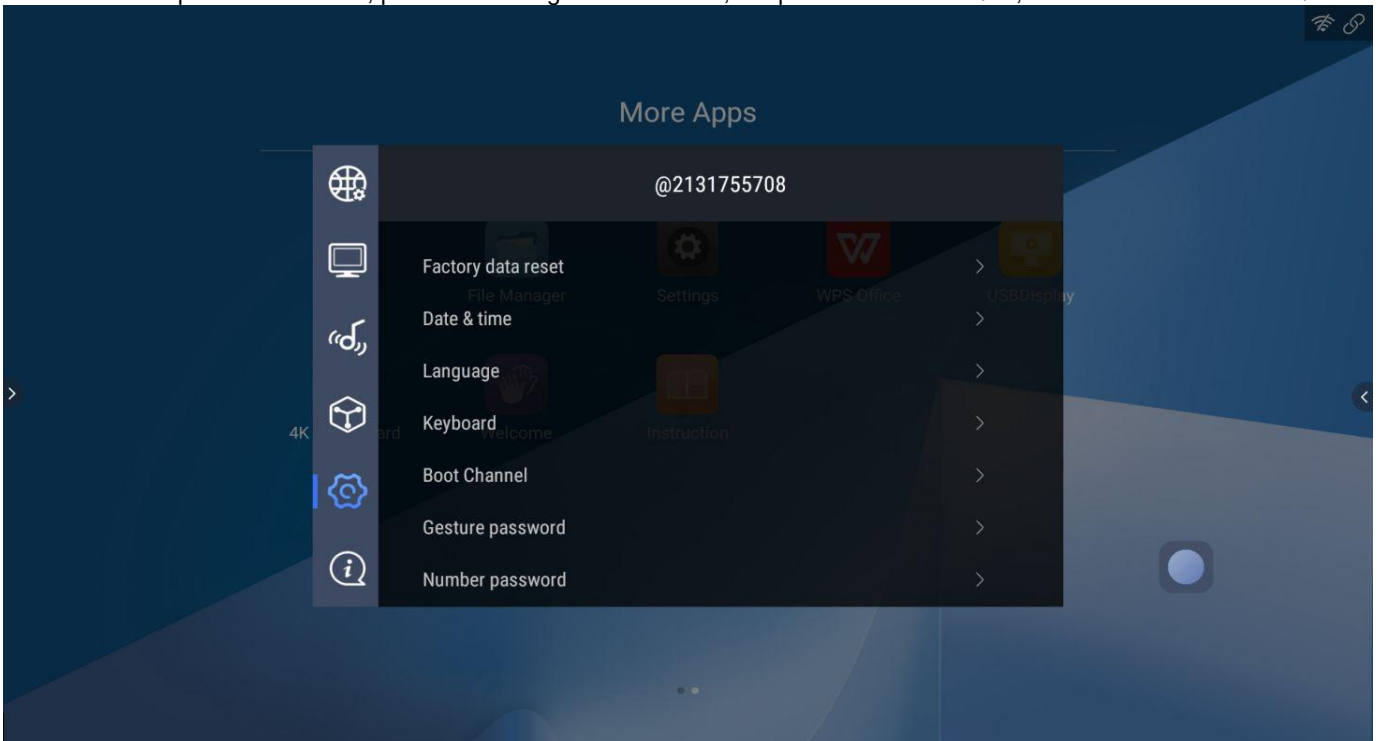
Application manager page contains application authority management, system applications list and installed application list.

Click installed applications to show the application information. Click the uninstall to uninstall the application.



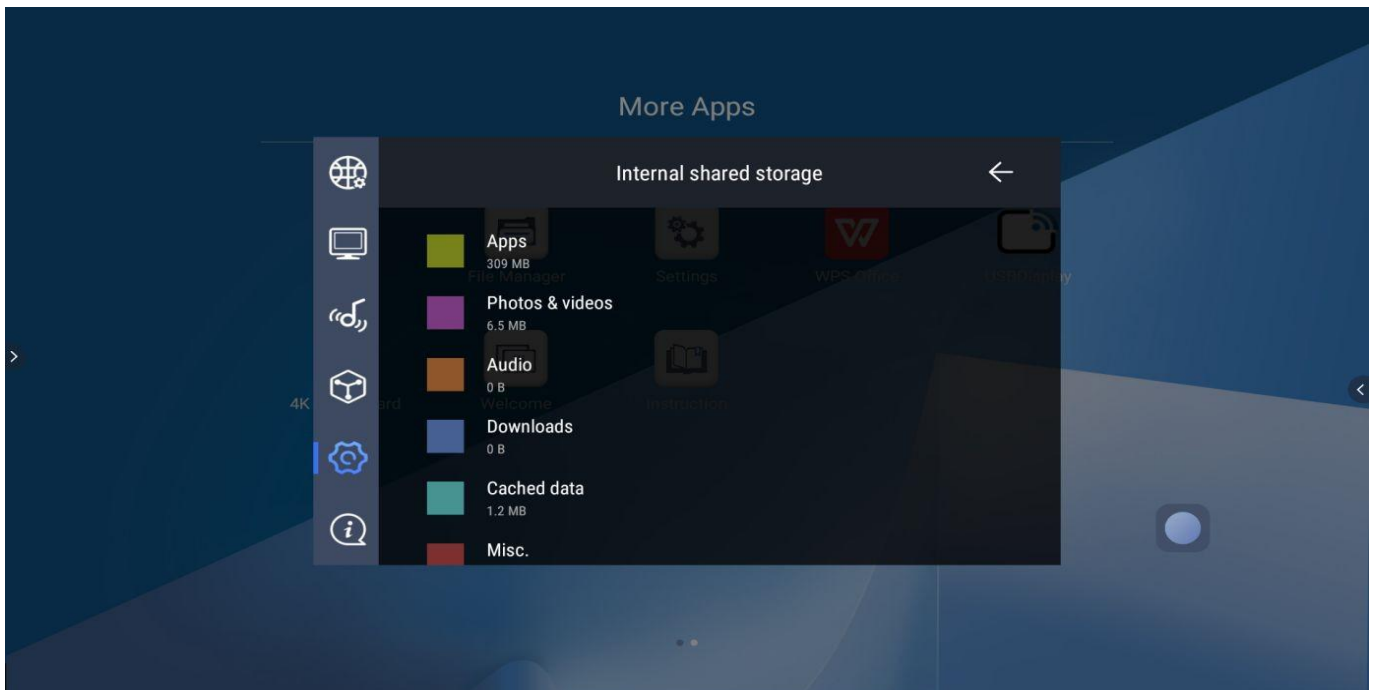
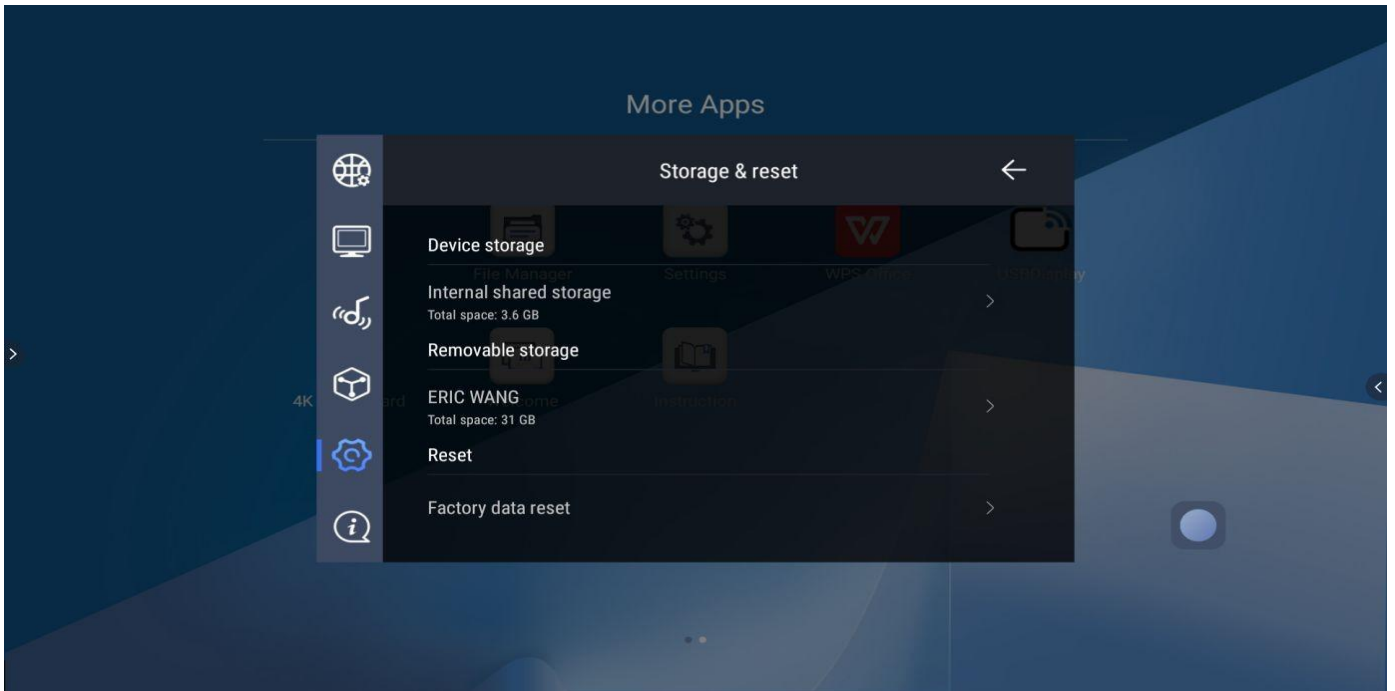
4.5 Other Settings

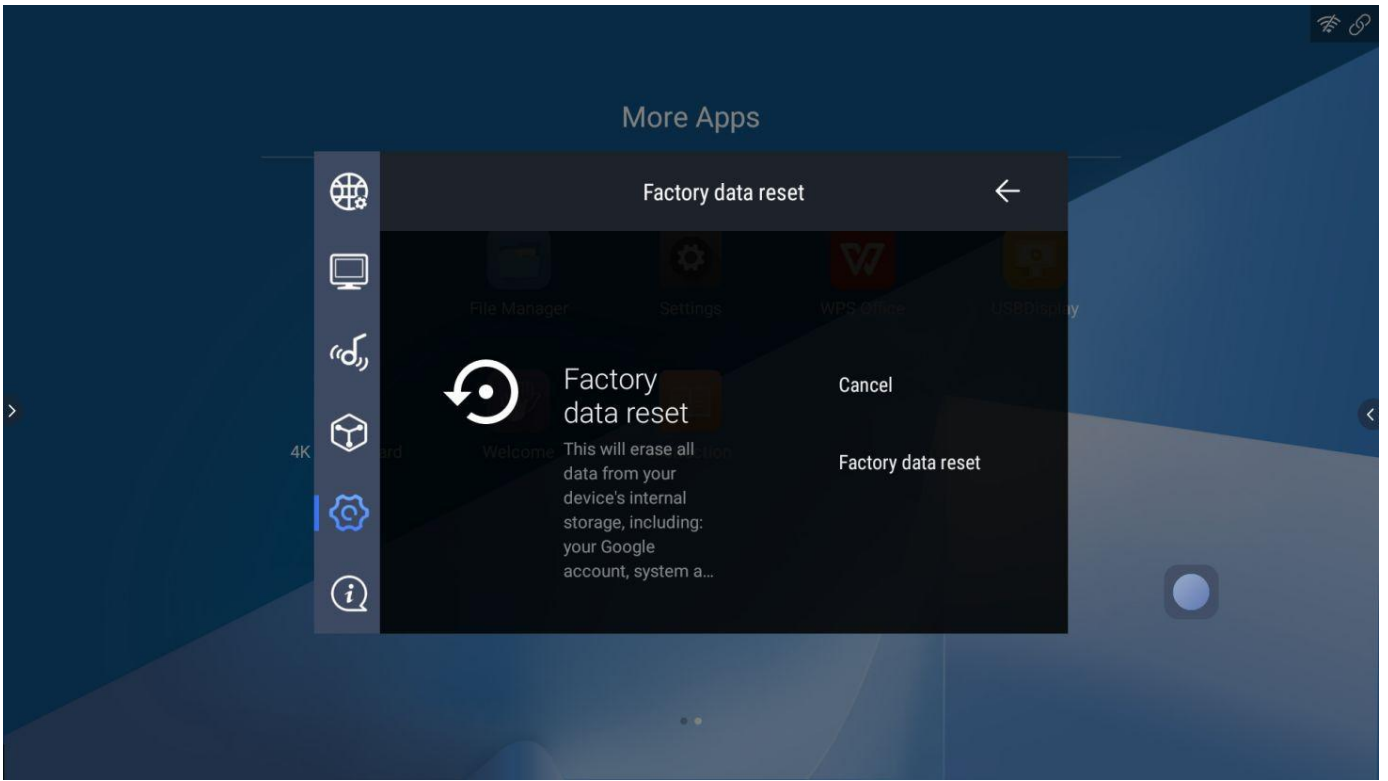


4.5.1 Storage and factory reset

Storage page shows the internal storage usage.

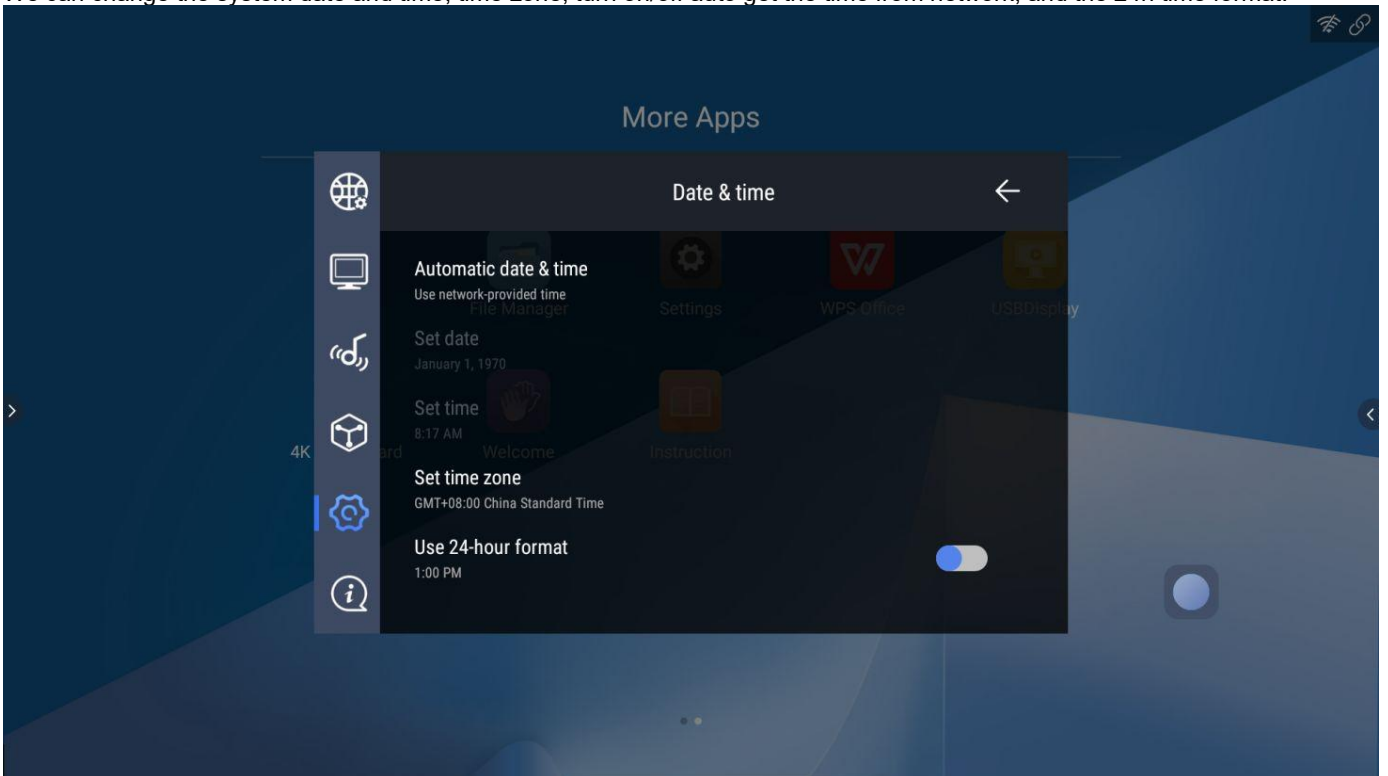


Factory reset to clear all the user information and data, include applications and storage.



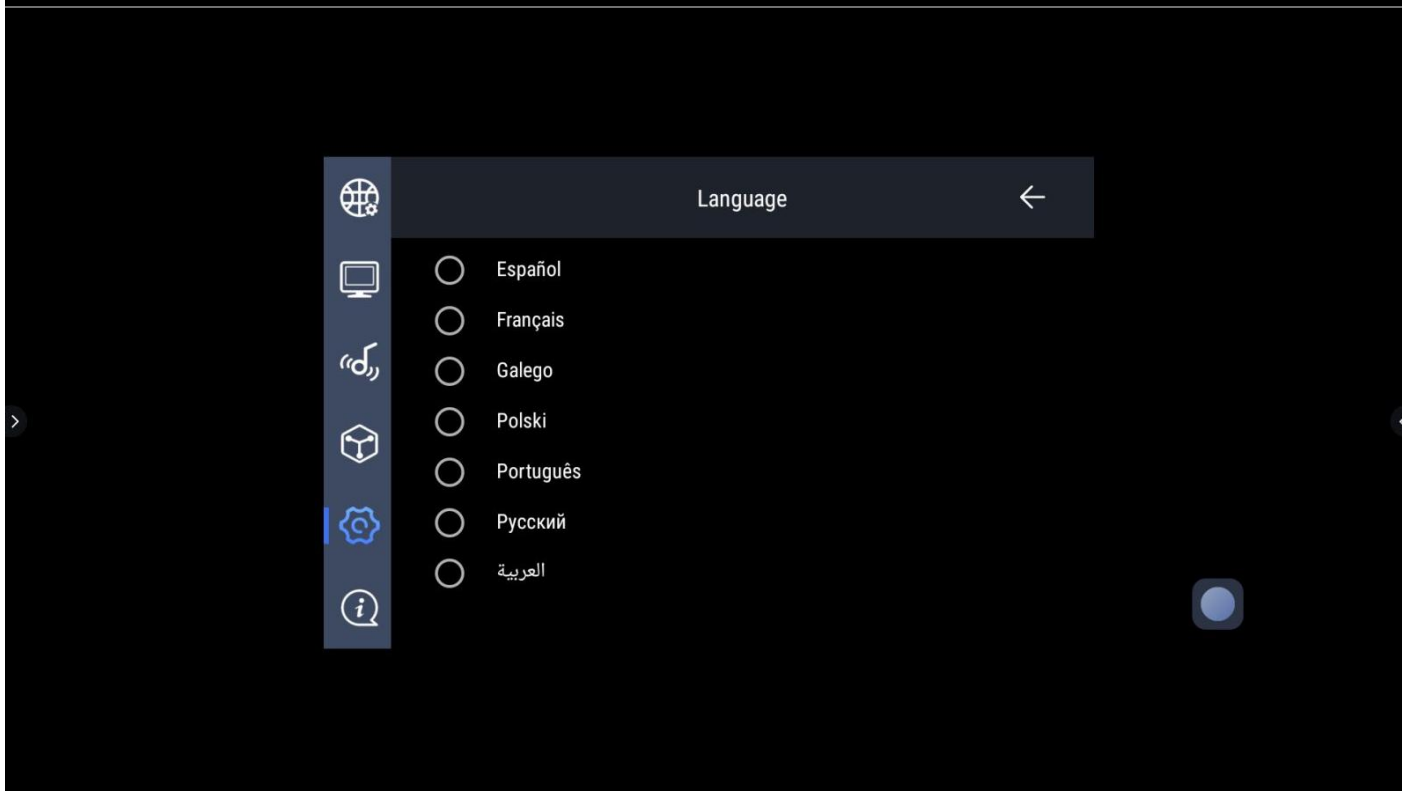
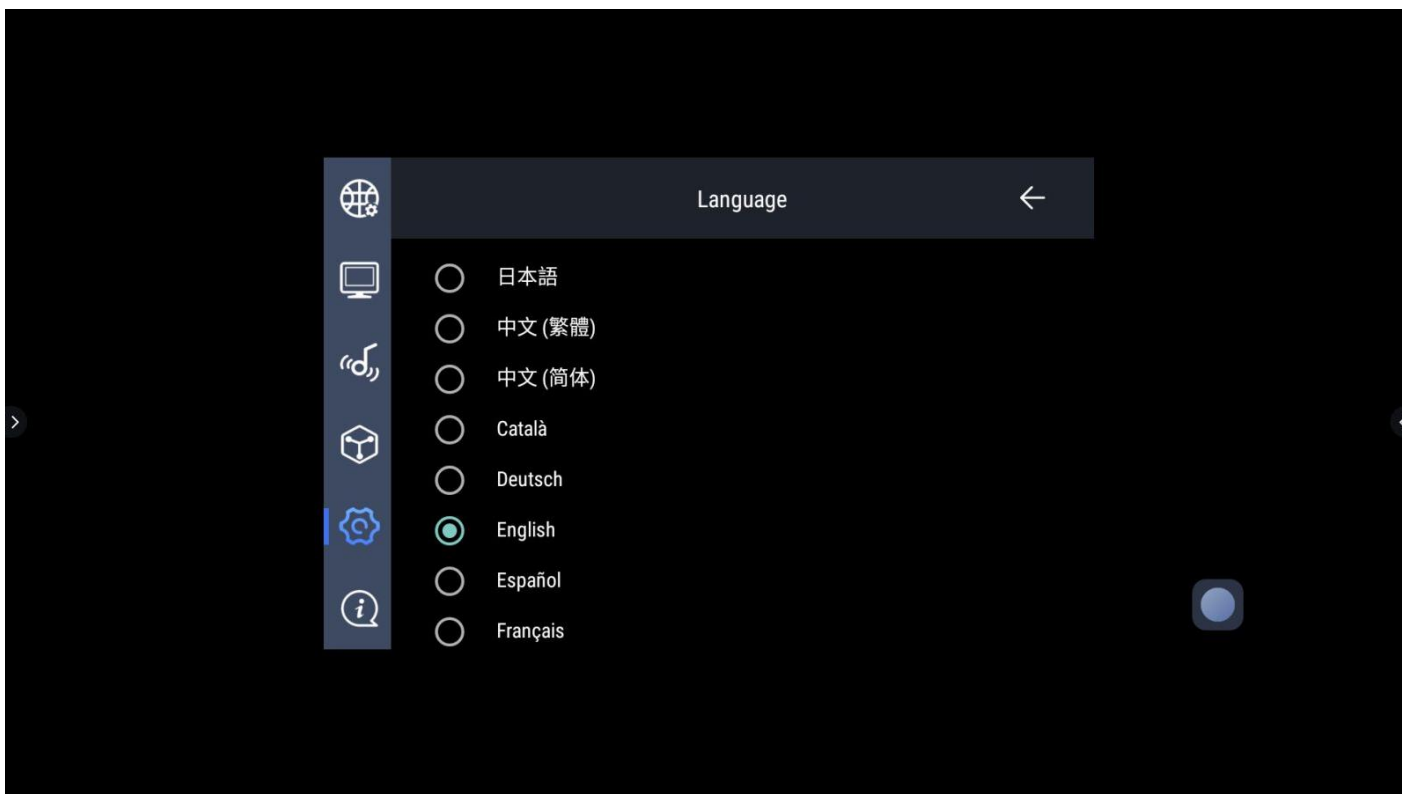
4.5.2 Date and time

We can change the system date and time, time zone, turn on/off auto get the time from network, and the 24h time format.



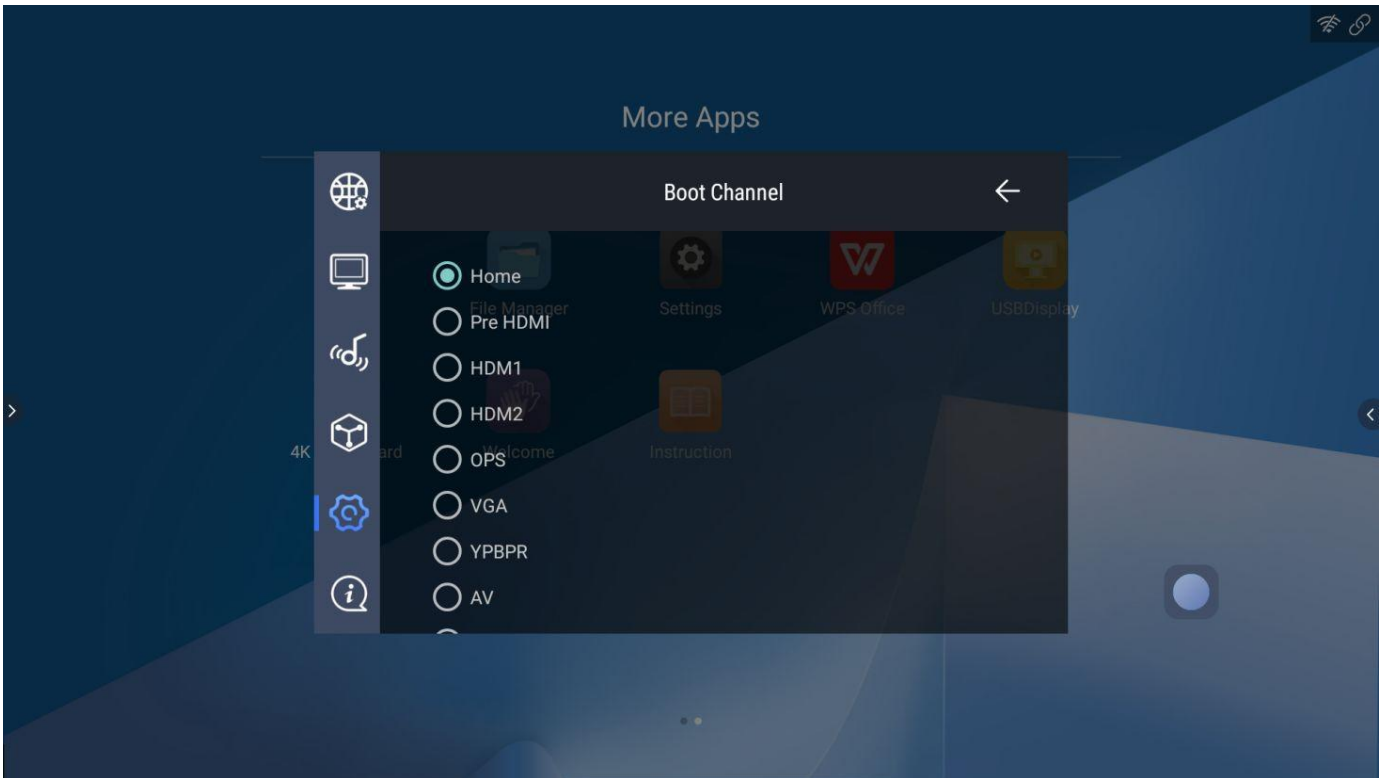
4.5.3 Language

4.5.4 Boot Channel

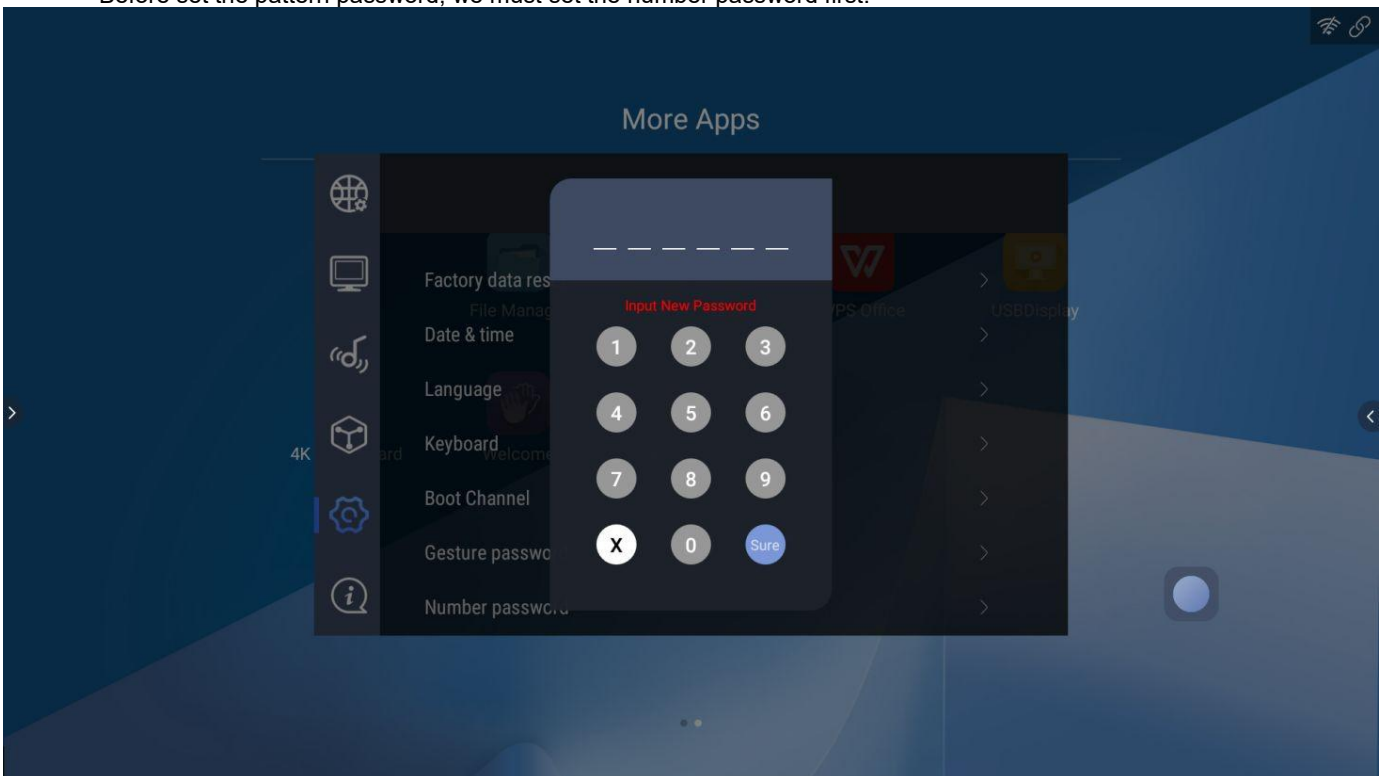

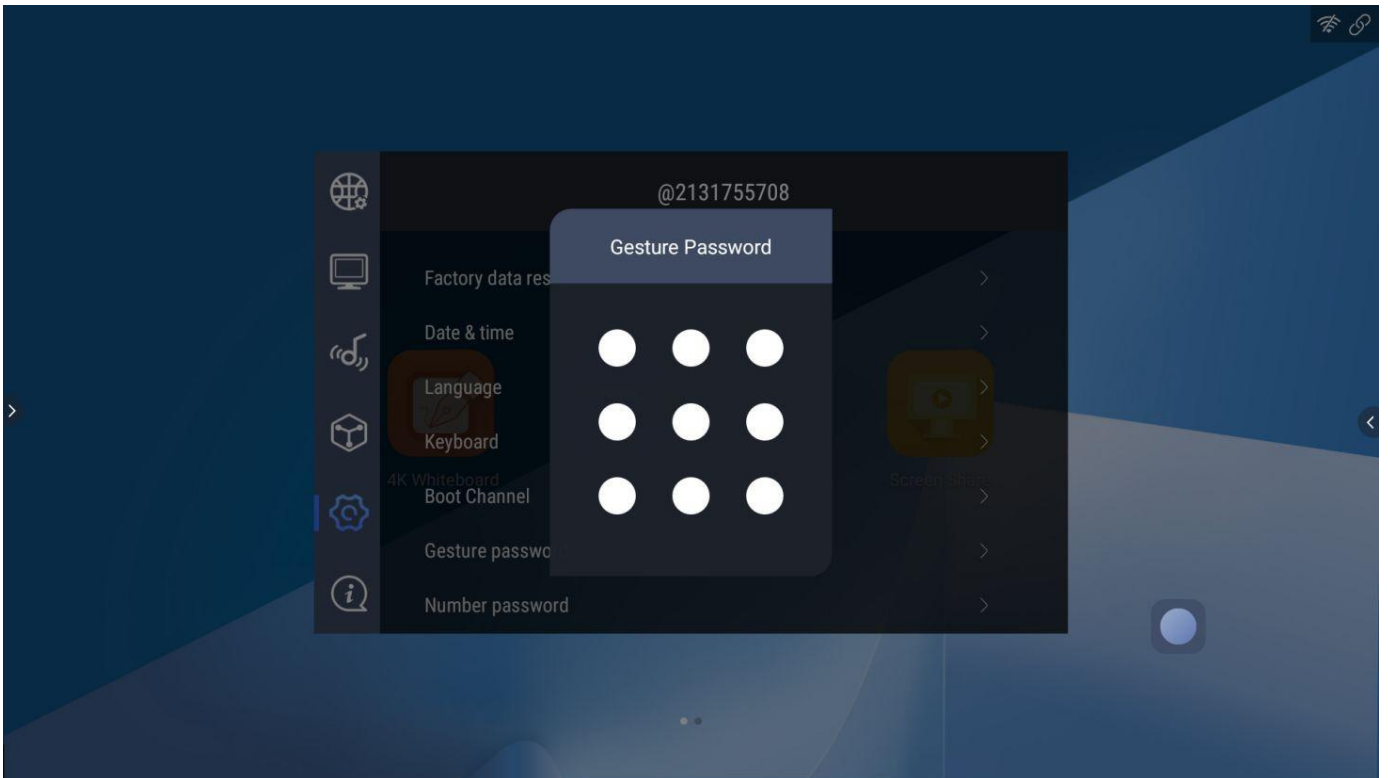


4. 5. 5 Password

This device support 2 kinds of password, pattern password and number password. These pass word is for unlocking the screen. Both kinds of password need to input twice to ensure the consistency.

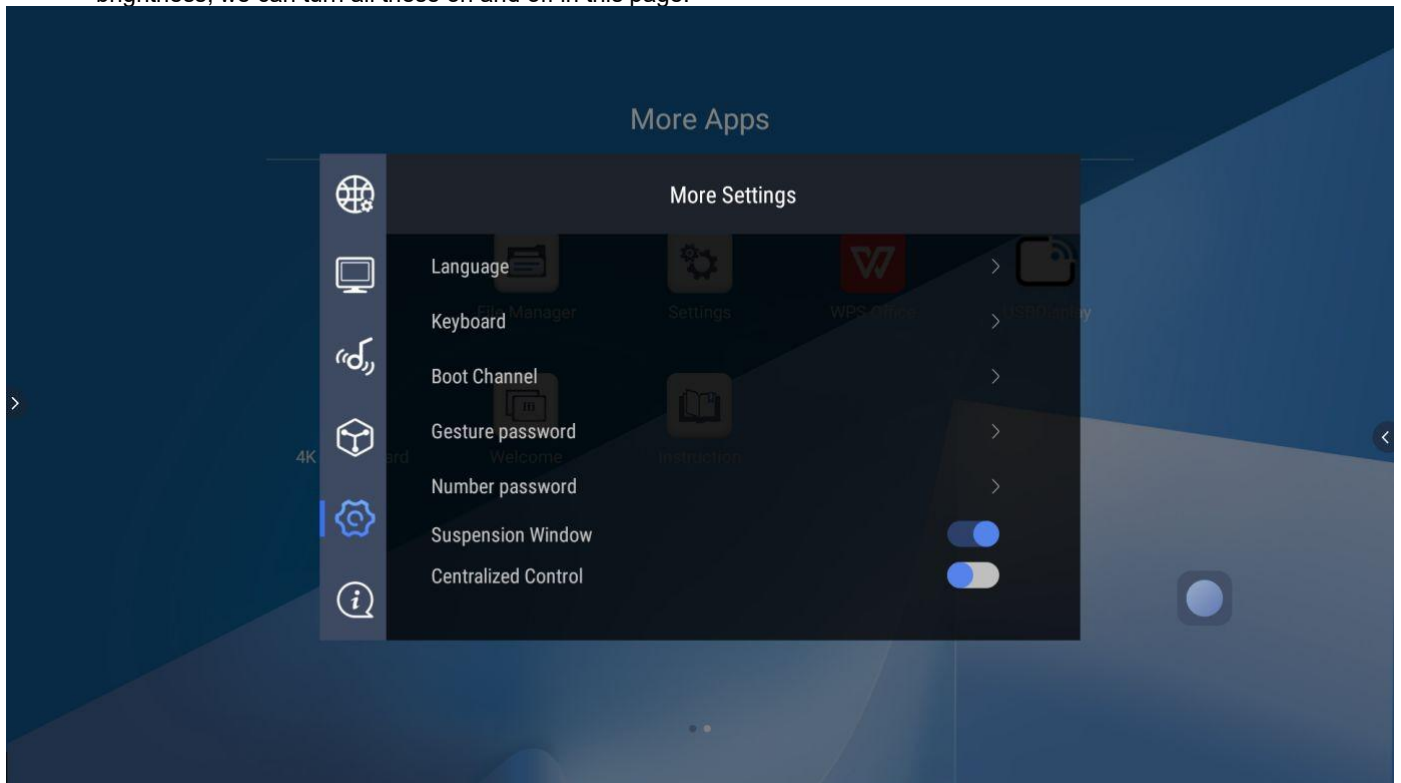
Before set the pattern password, we must set the number password first.





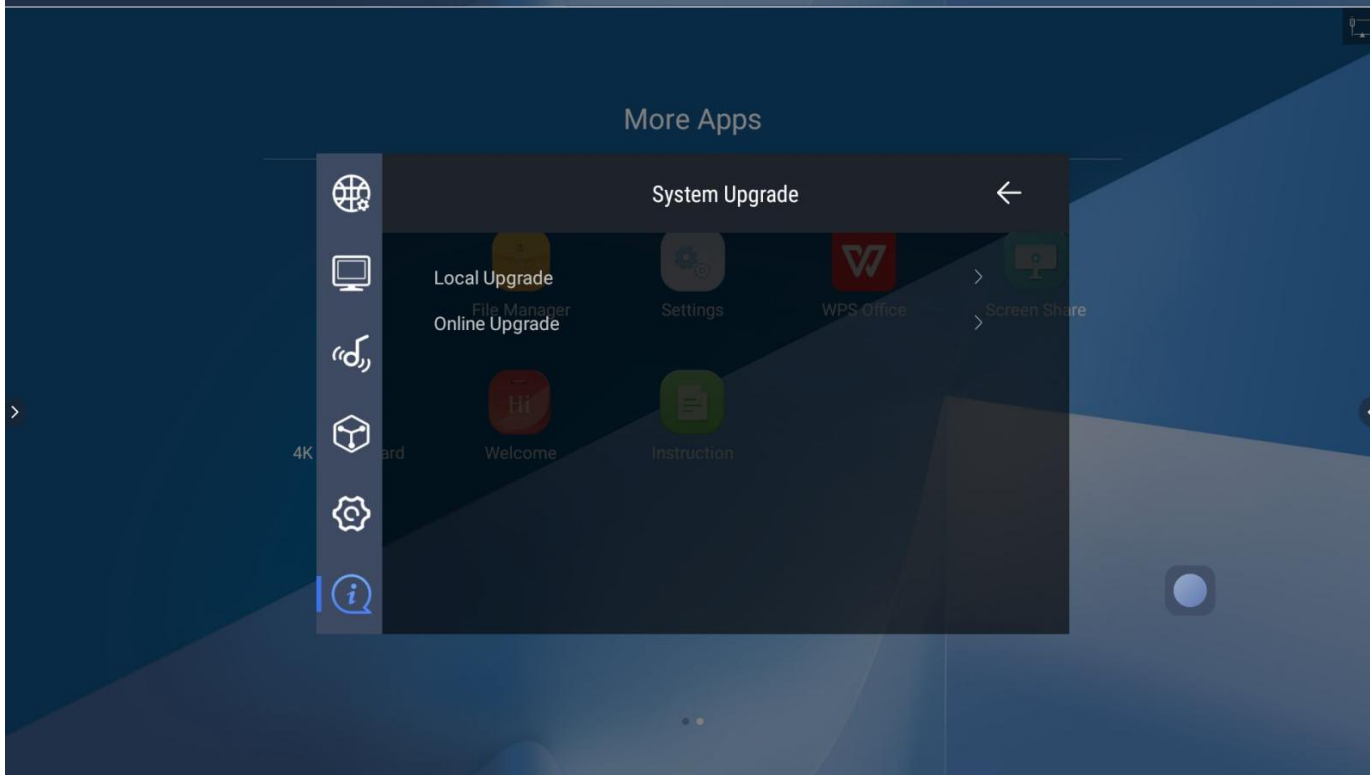
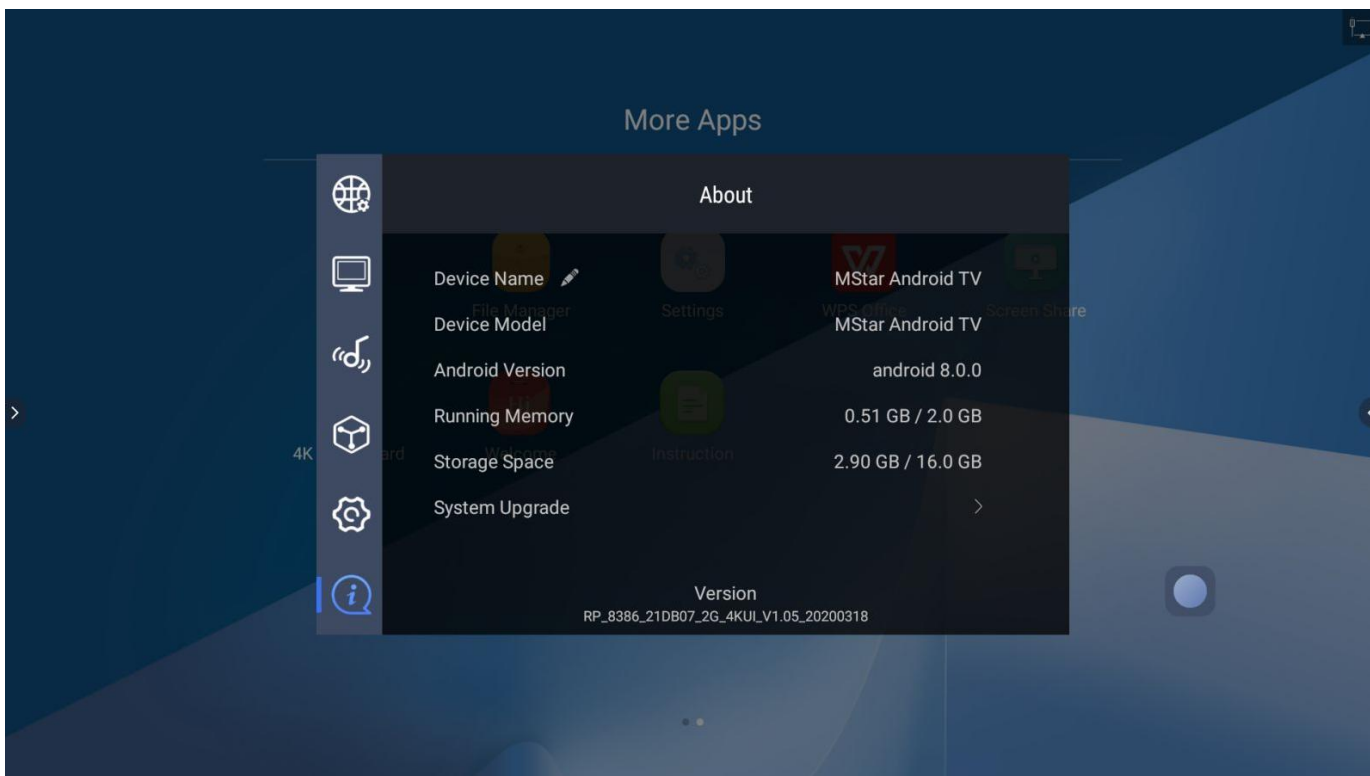
4. 5. 6 ON/OFF control

This device supports the Suspension window, centralized control and ambient light sensor to change the screen brightness, we can turn all these on and off in this page.

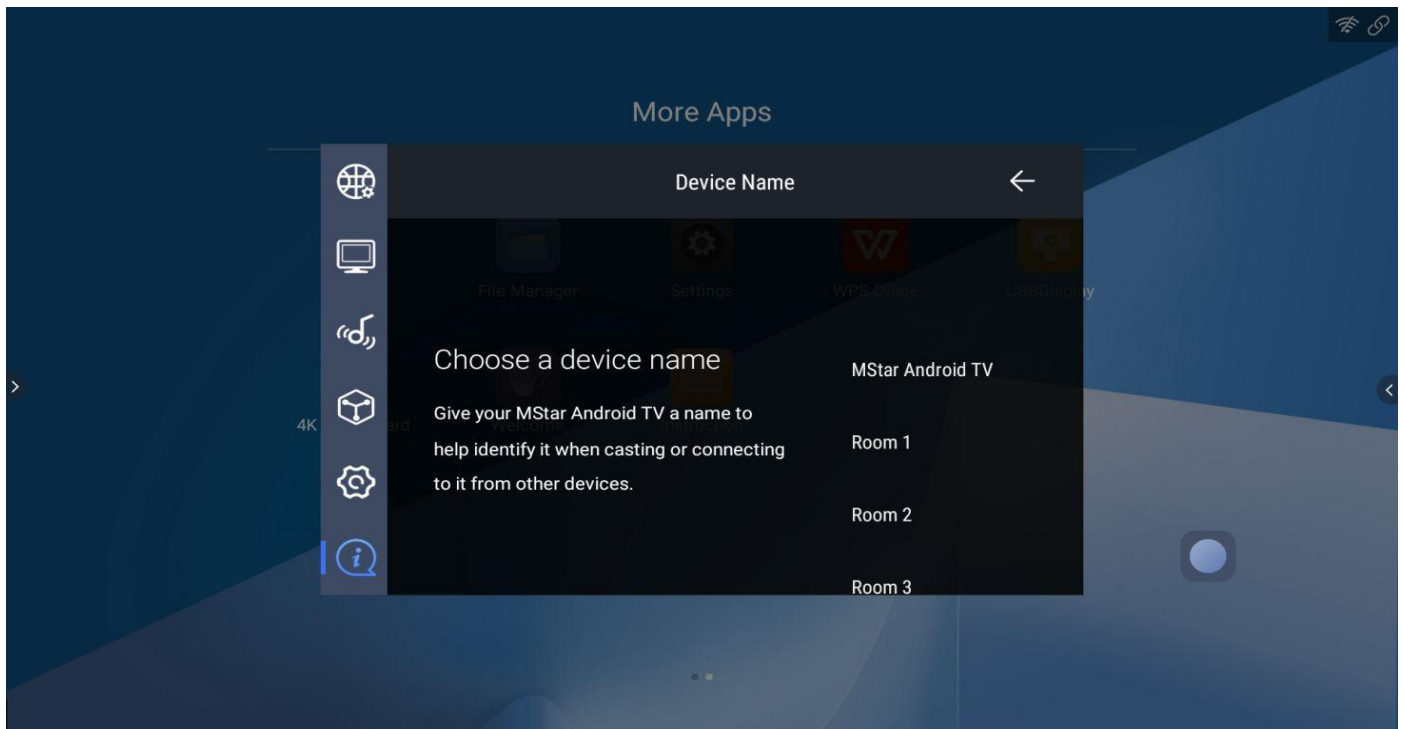


4. 6 System information

 Click the local upgrade to upgrade the software package in USB device. File name is RP_USB_UPGRADE.bin.

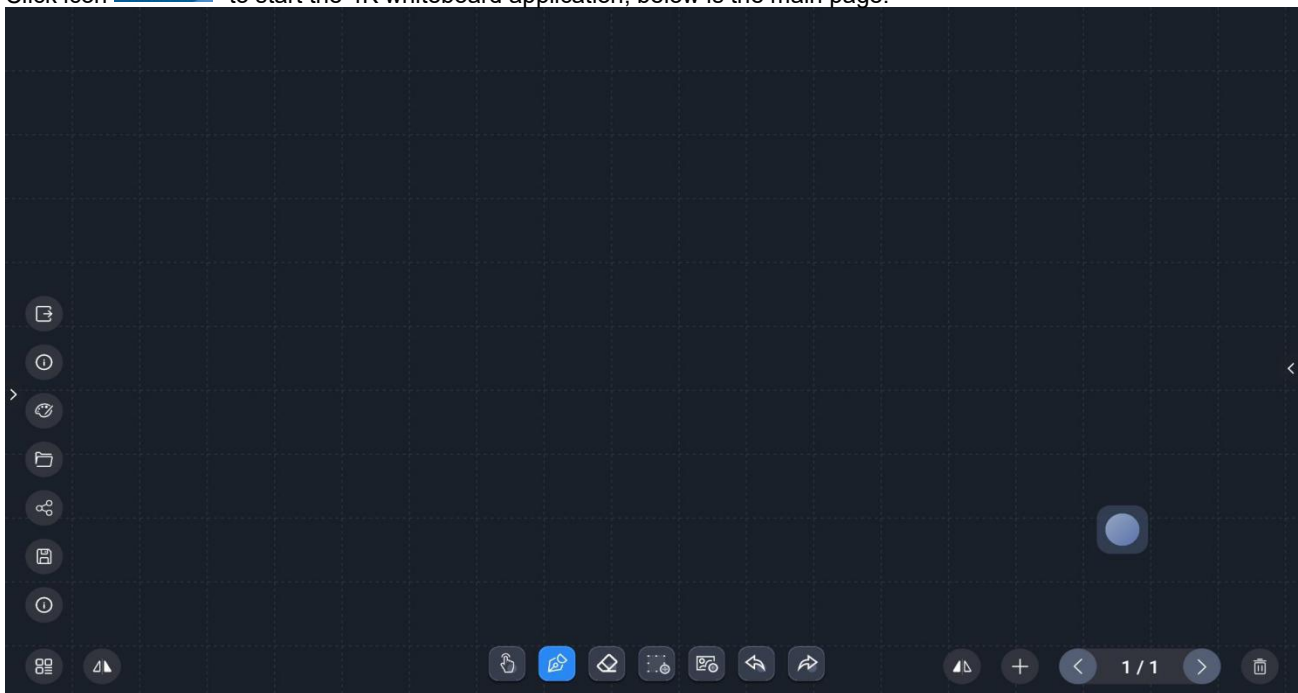

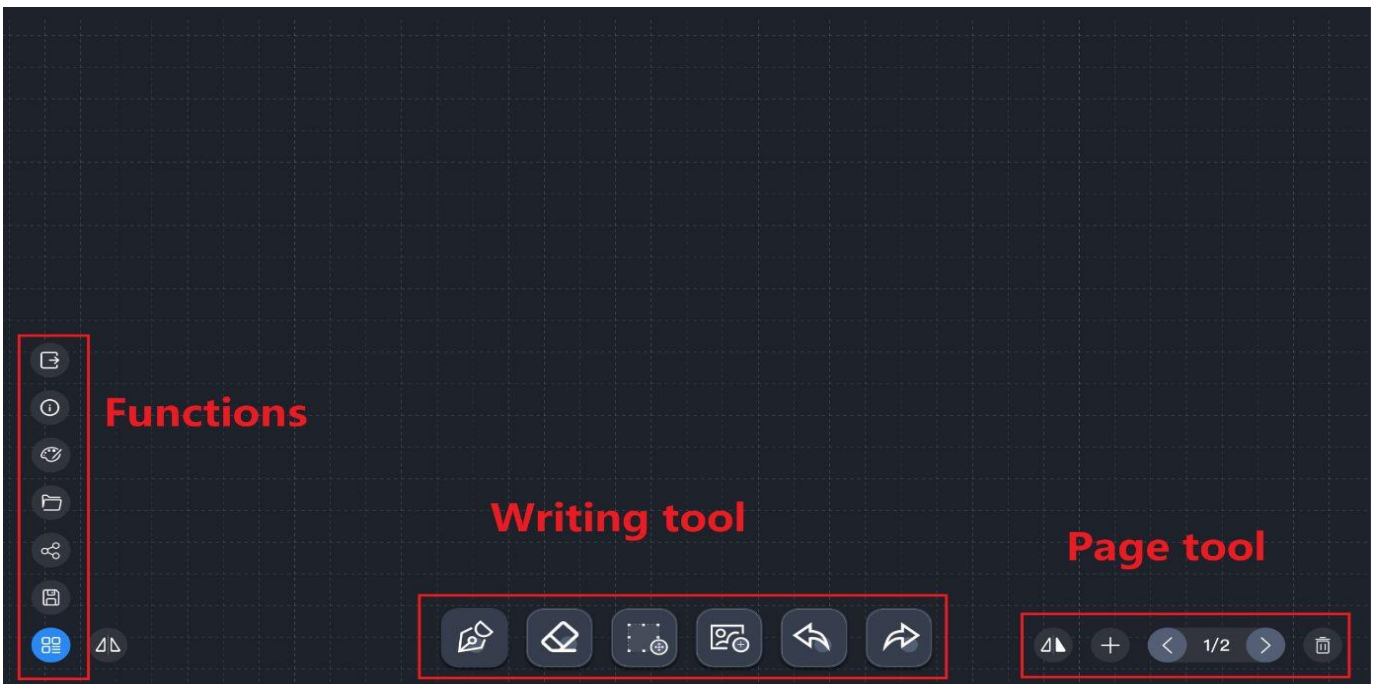
5. 1 Main page

5. 2 Function introduction

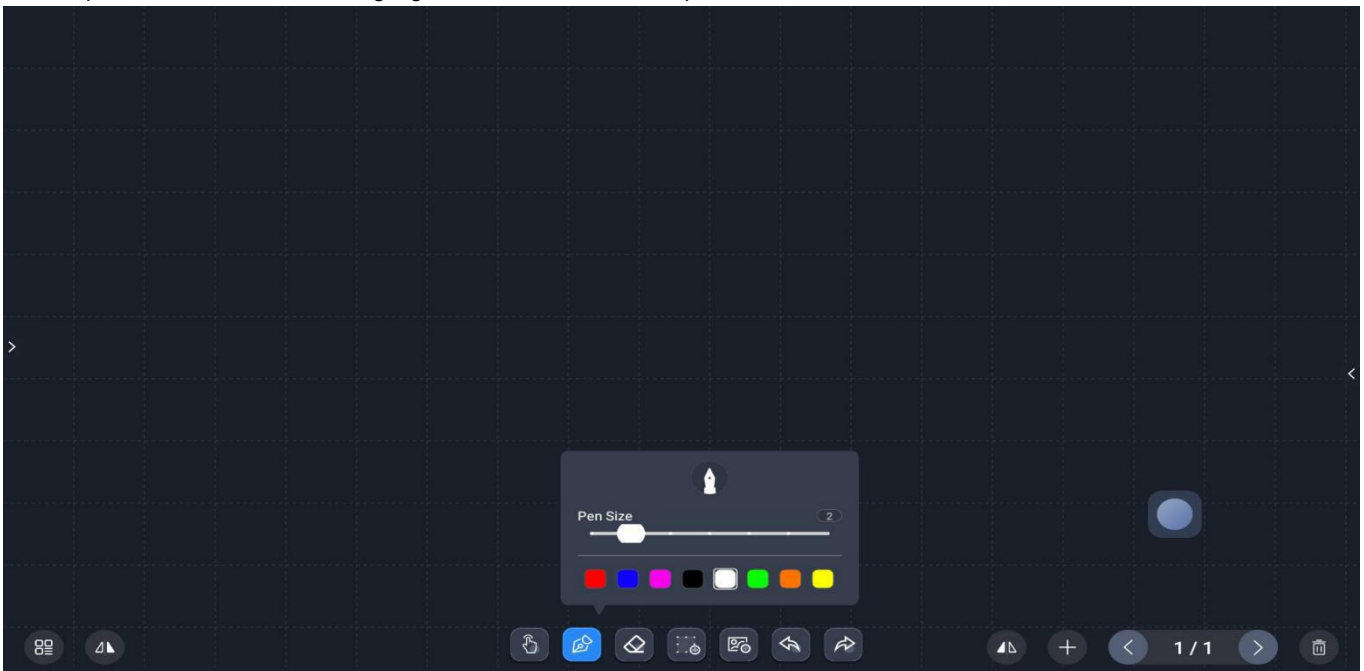



5.2.1 Writing

- Open whiteboard application, user can write directly with single point writing as default.
- In single point writing mode, multi finger touch is for zoom, back of hand or palm touch is for eraser.


- Click icon  or  to choose single point writing and multi point writing. Icon  means multi point writing , icon  means single point writing.

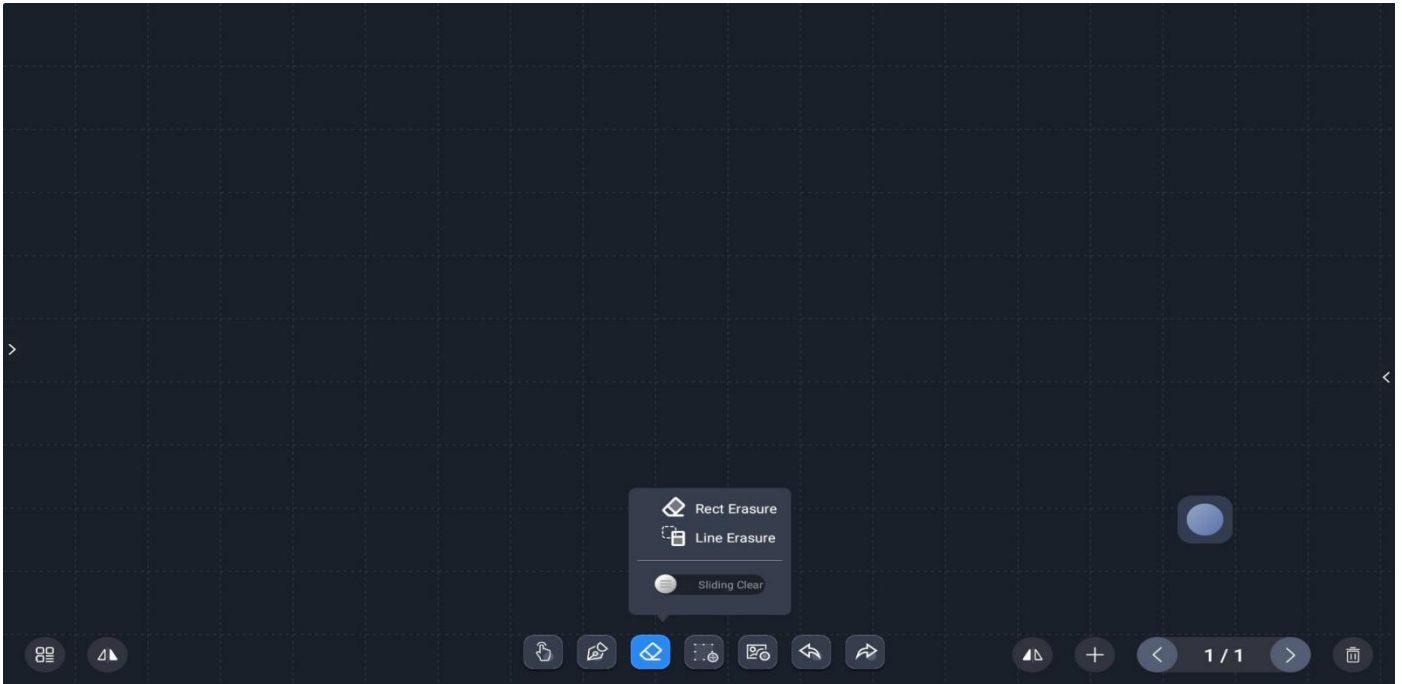

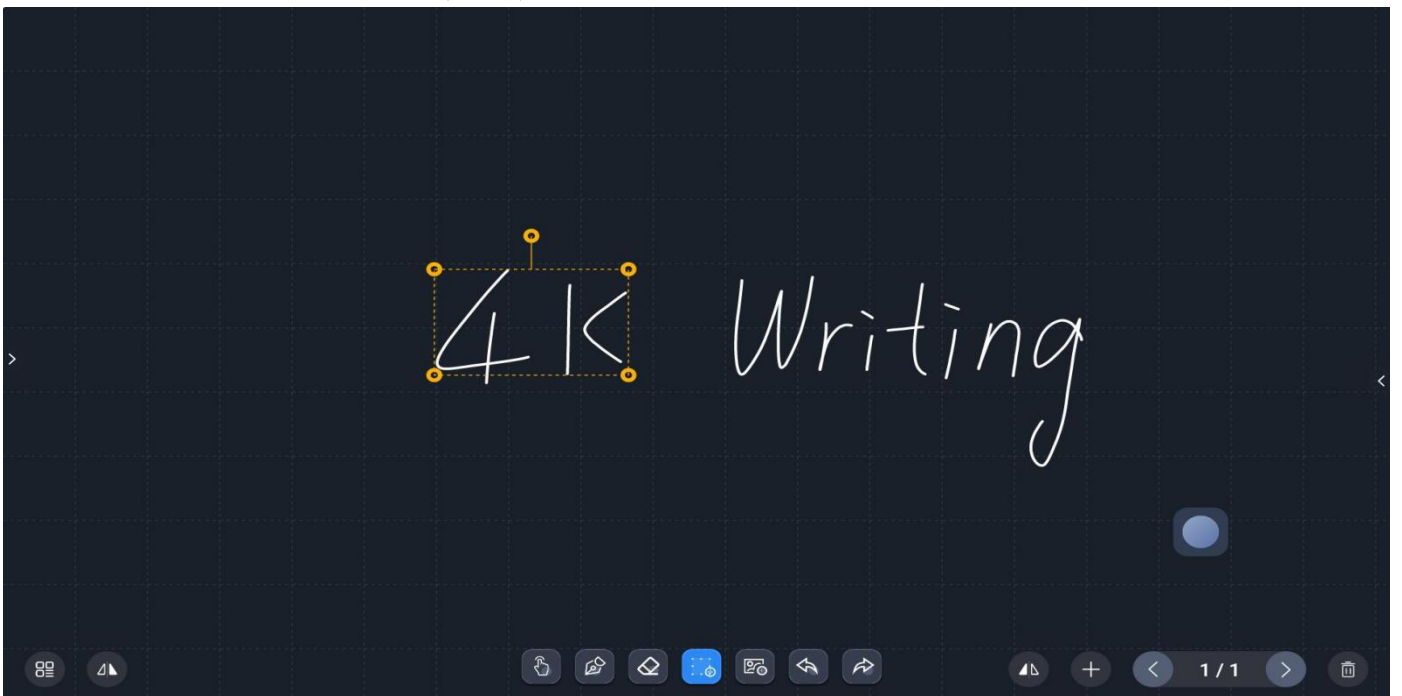
-  is eraser tools , include area wipe, trace wipe and clear screen.


Default is area wipe tool.

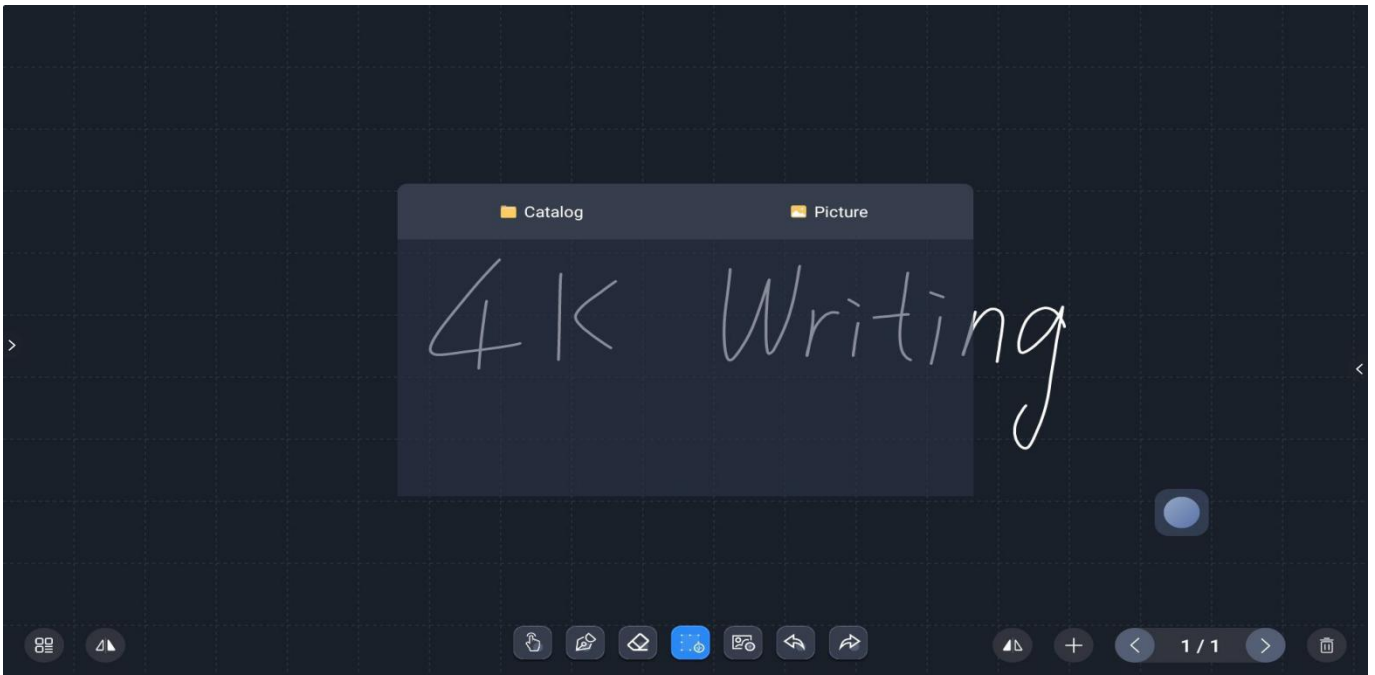
Slide  to the end of the bar to clear the screen.



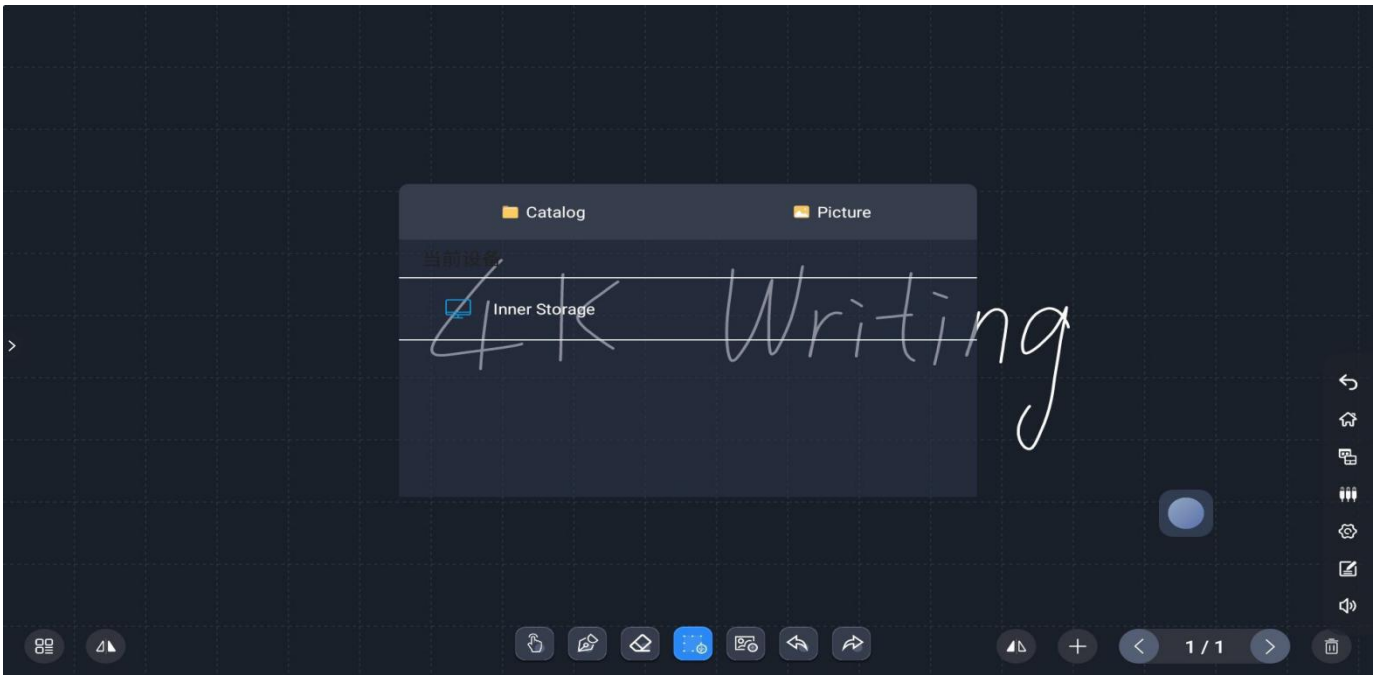
-  is select tool , user can move, zoom, rotate the selected area



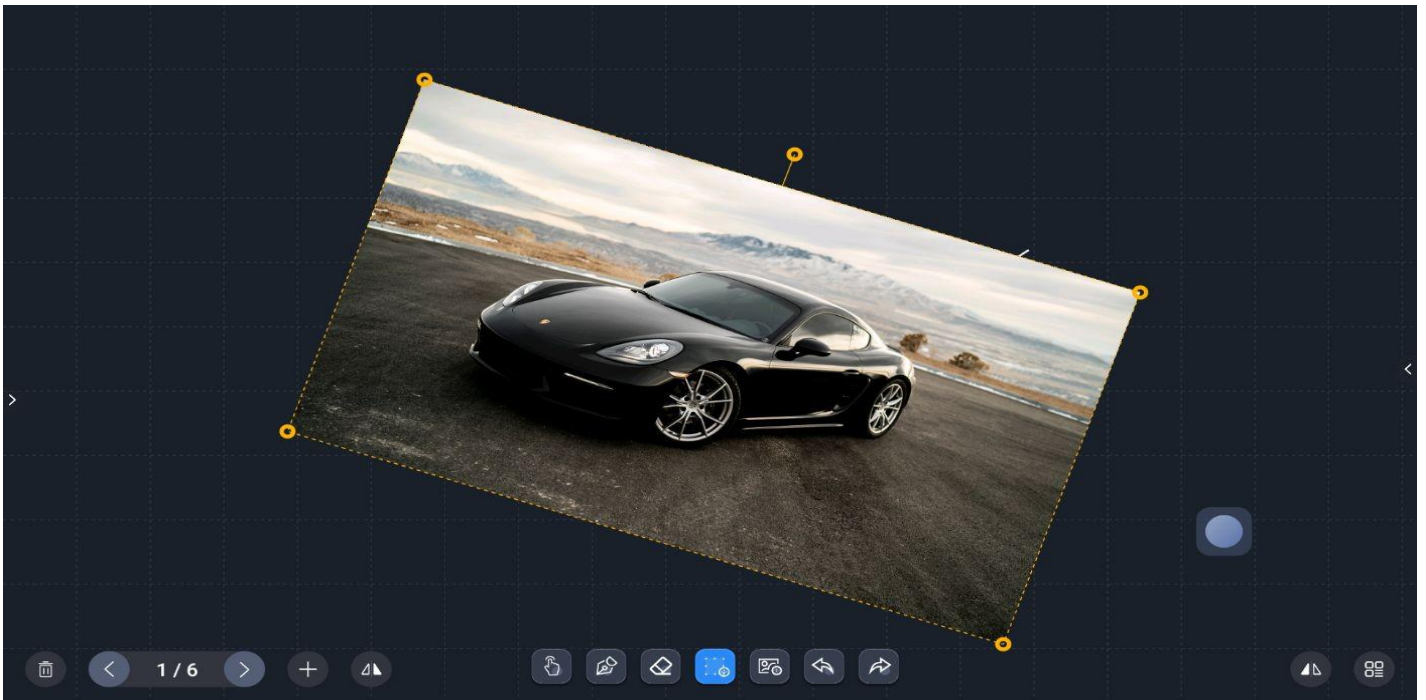
-  is picture insert tool , user can select the pictures in internal storage or US drive, and support zoom, move and rotate the picture





Click contents to change the storage drive :









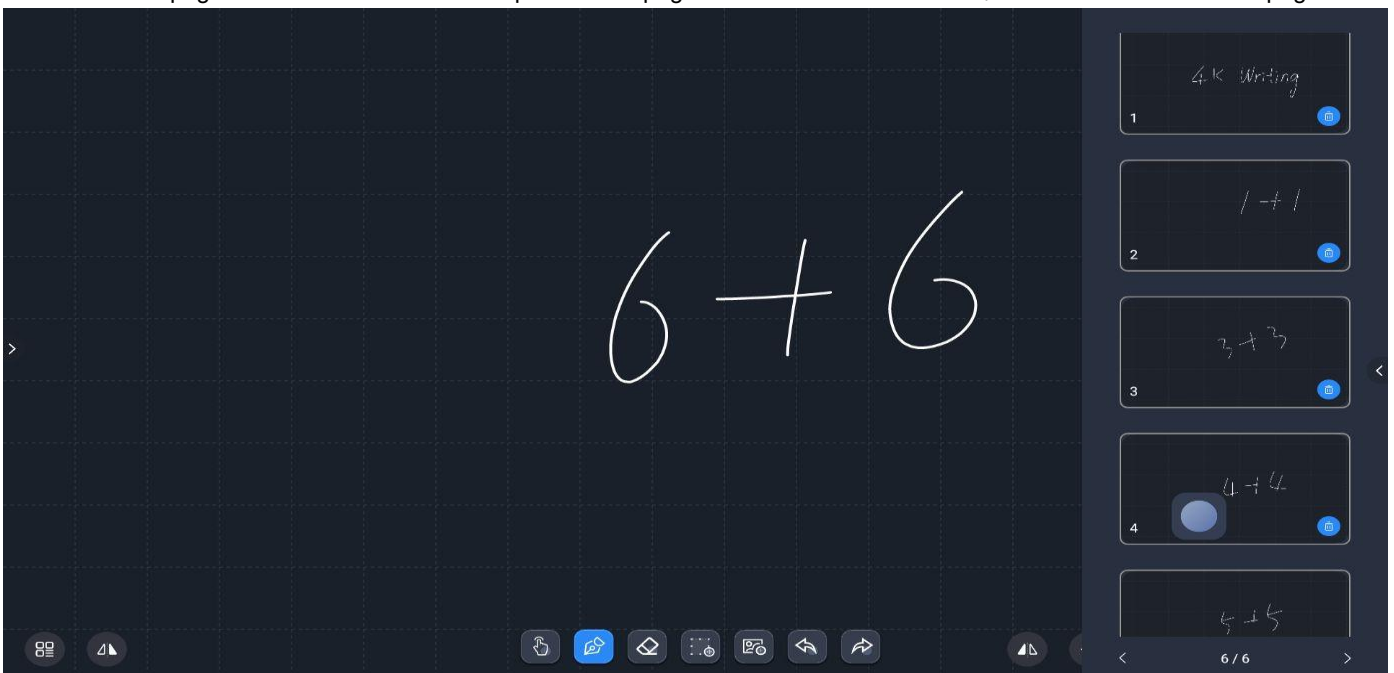

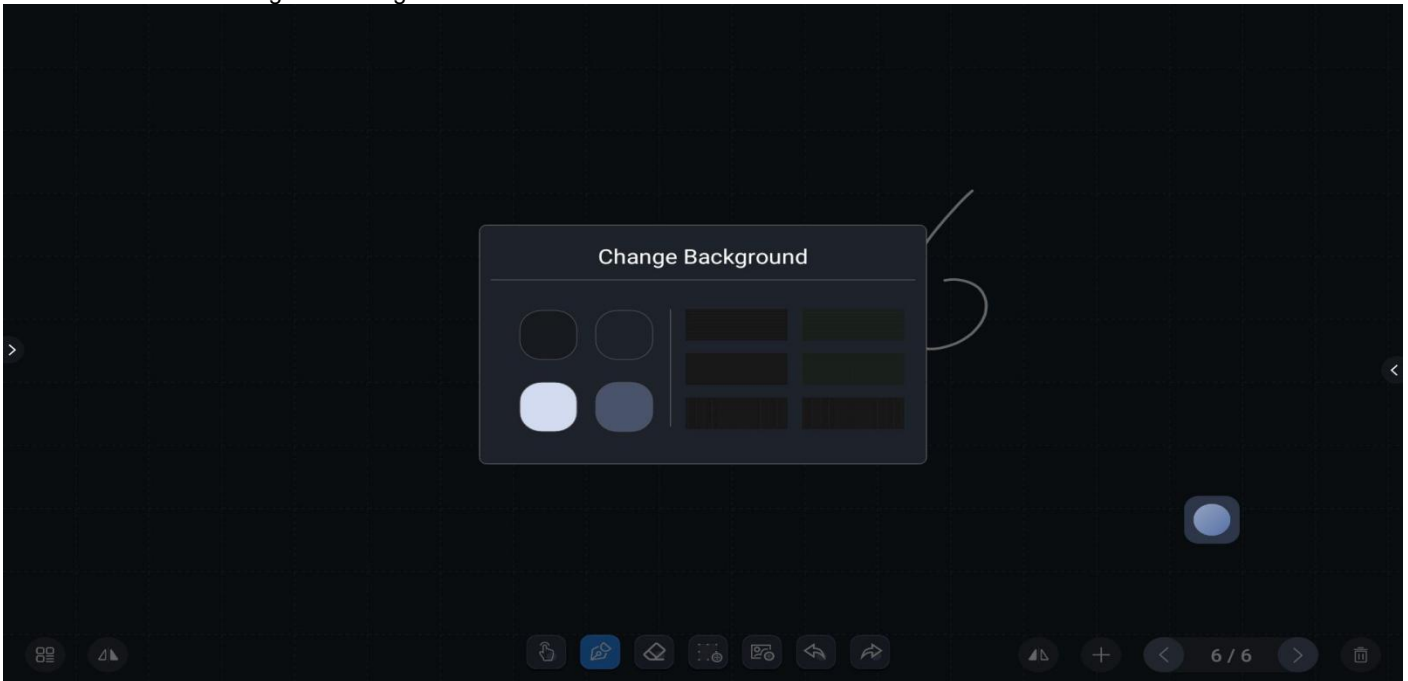
5. 2. 2 Page management

- Click the page number area  to preview the pages in current whiteboard file , user can select or delete page :

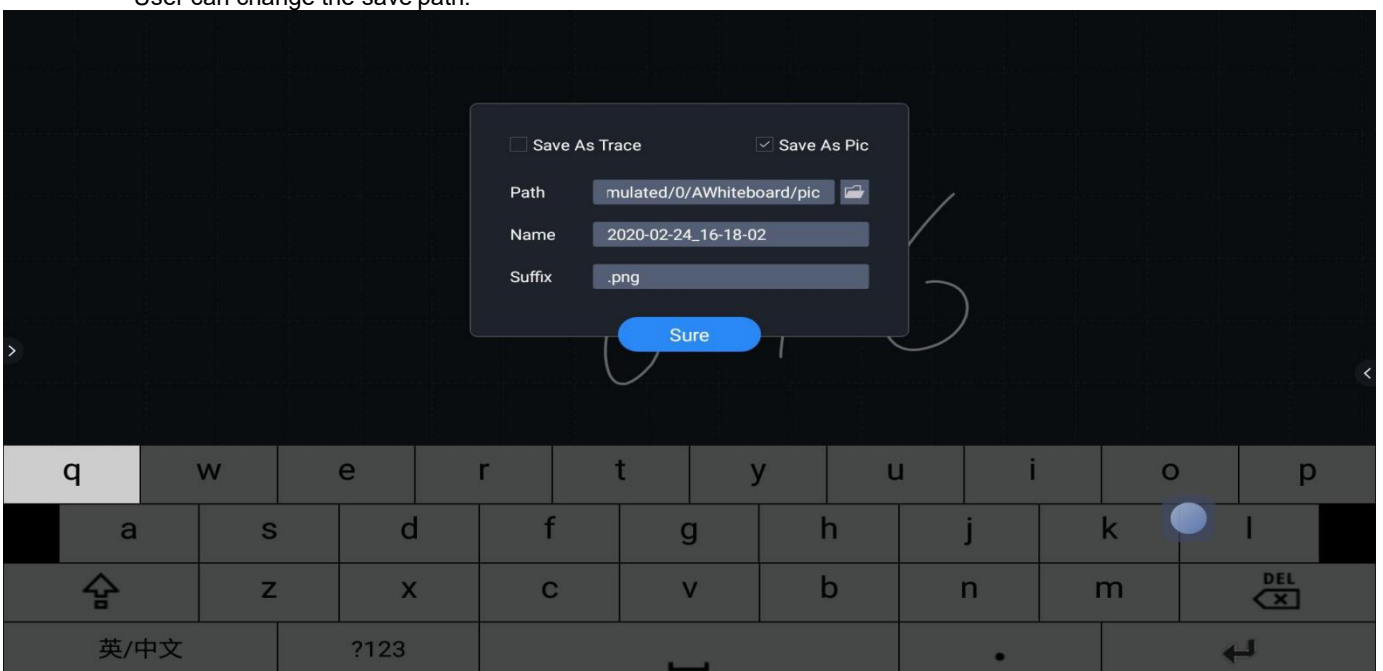



5.2.3 Others

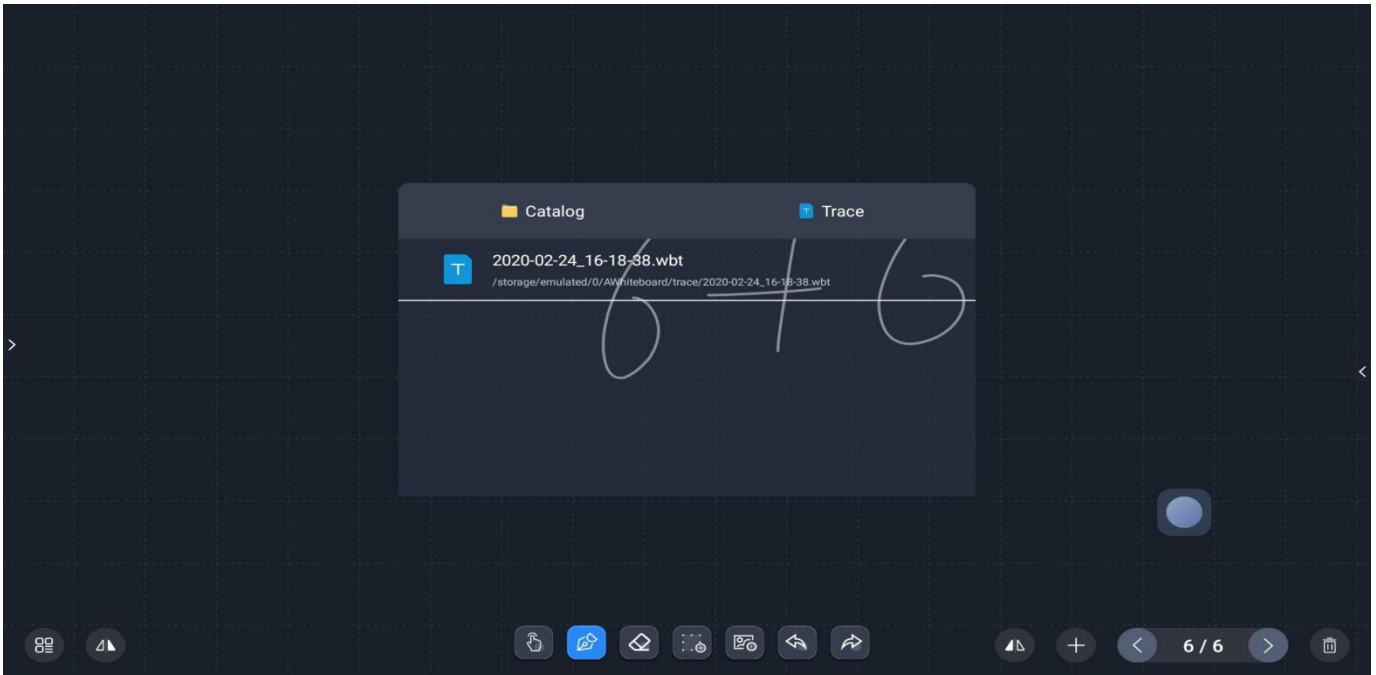
-  is function menu button:

- Click  to change the background of the whiteboard




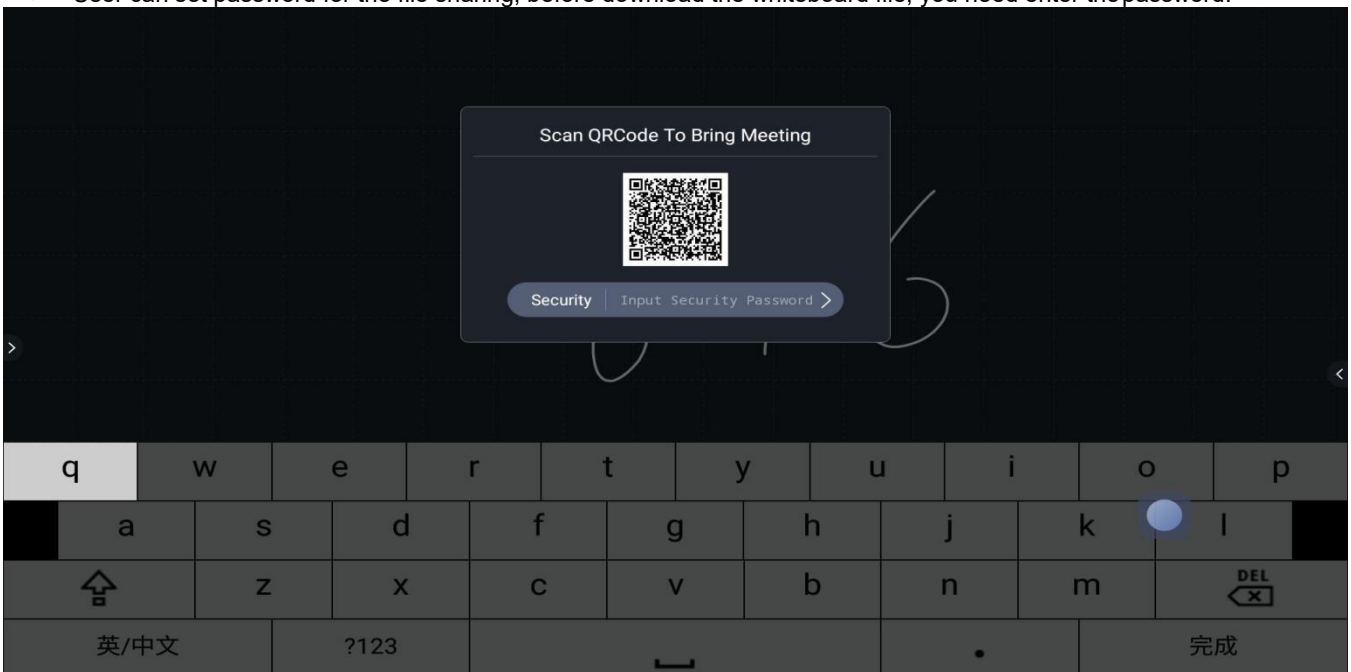
- Click  to save current whiteboard as trace(.wbt) or picture(.png).

- User can set password for the file sharing, before download the whiteboard file, you need enter the password.

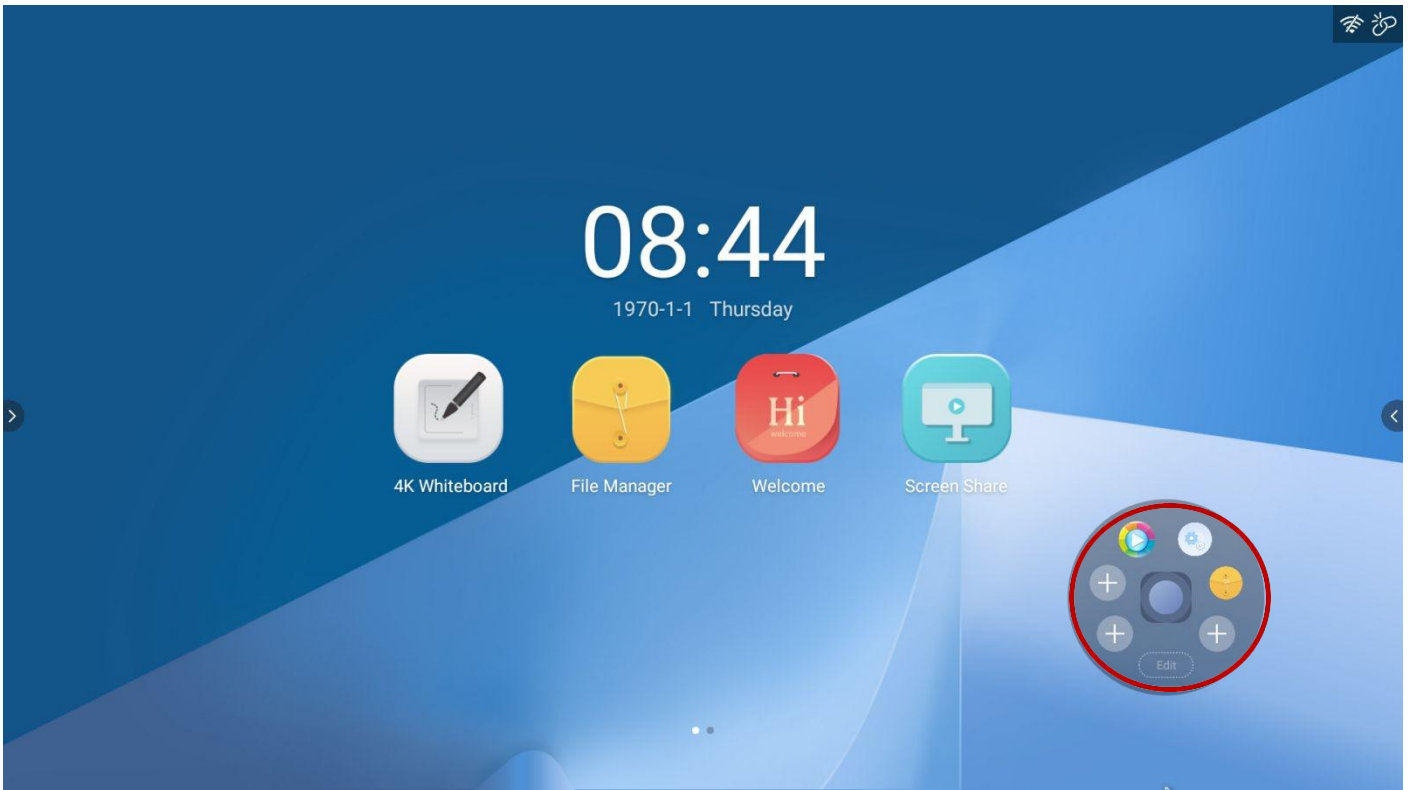



6. Suspension window

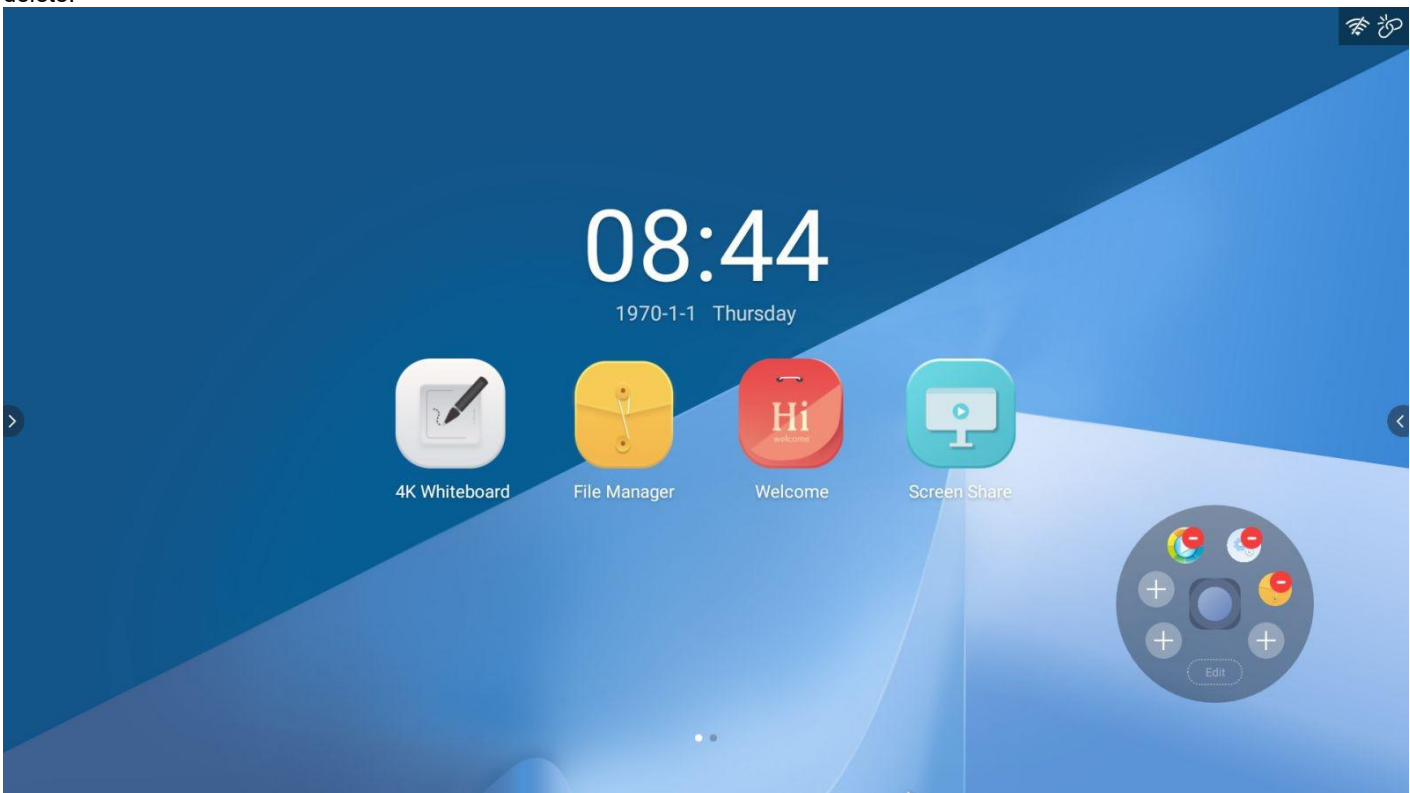
It's an accessible tool for shortcuts of the applications, support system applications and installed applications.
Icon as below:




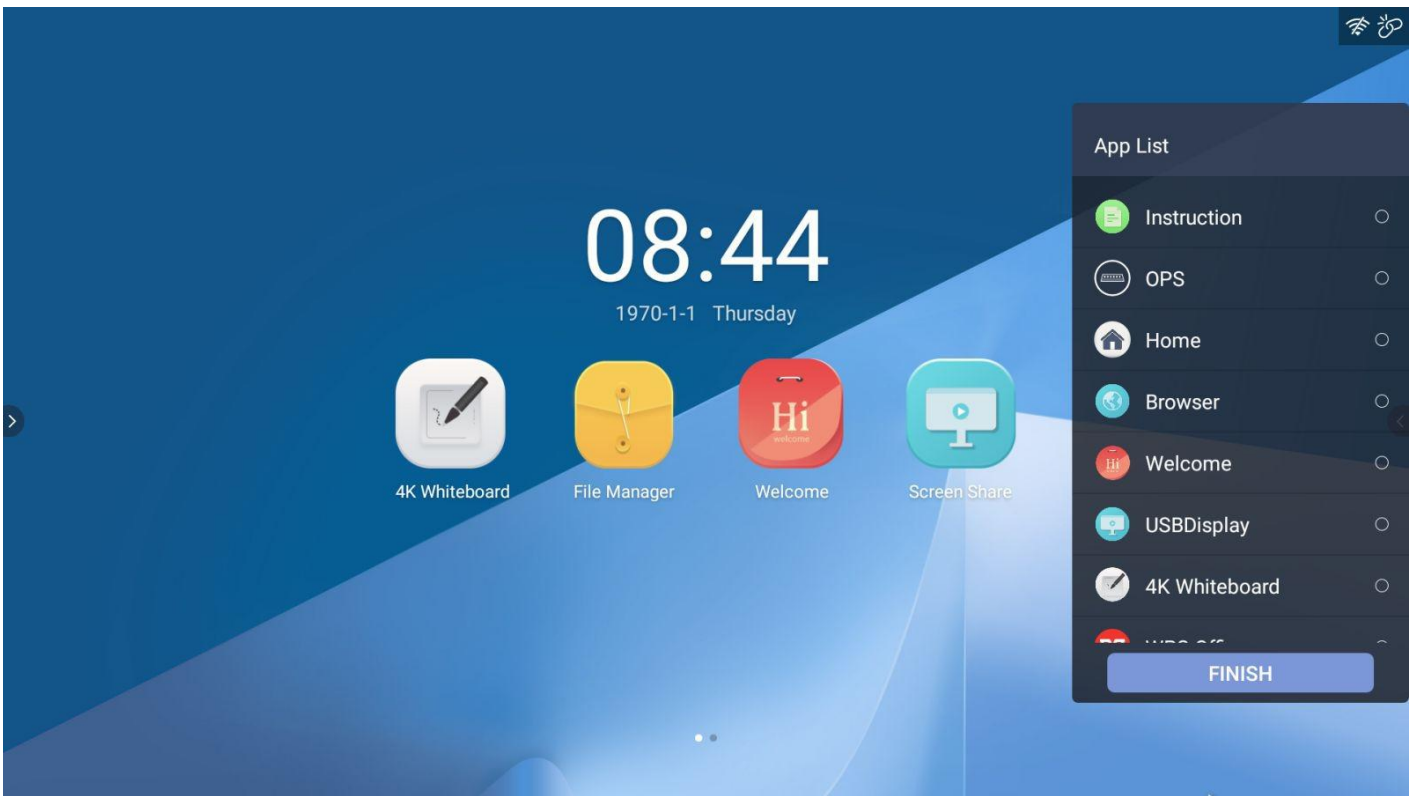
Suspension window active status :




Press the edit button to add or delete the shortcuts, press  on the shortcuts to delete.

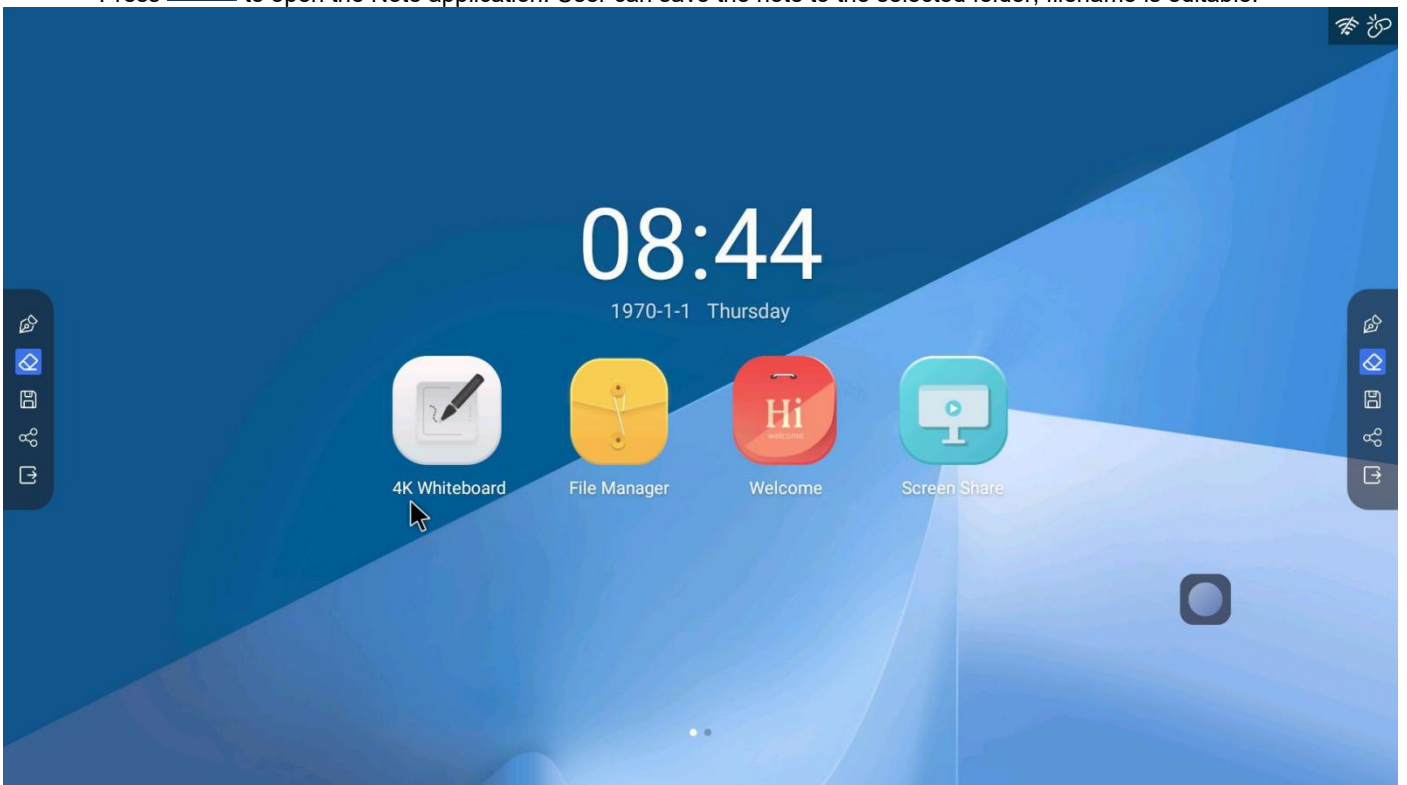




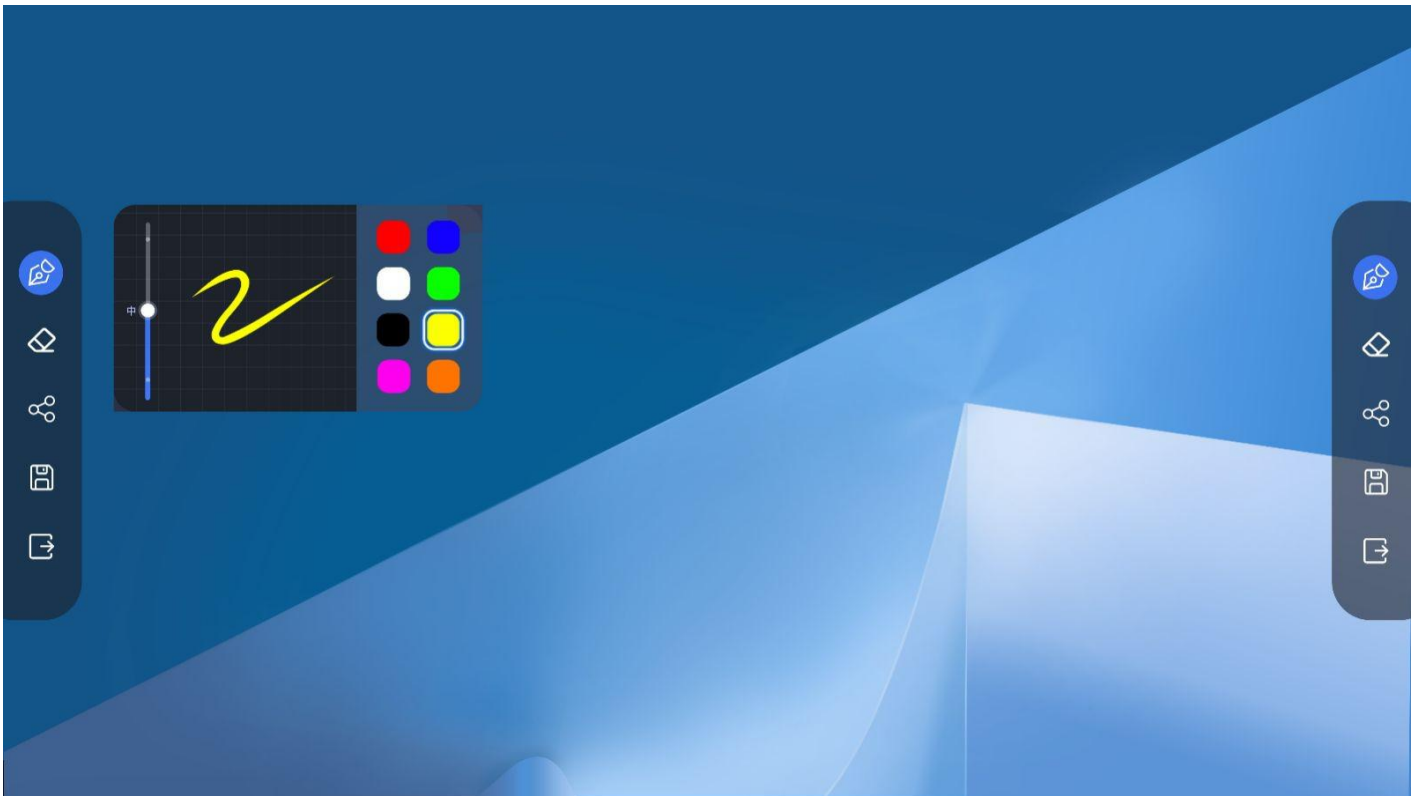


7. Note


Press  to open the Note application. User can save the note to the selected folder, filename is editable.

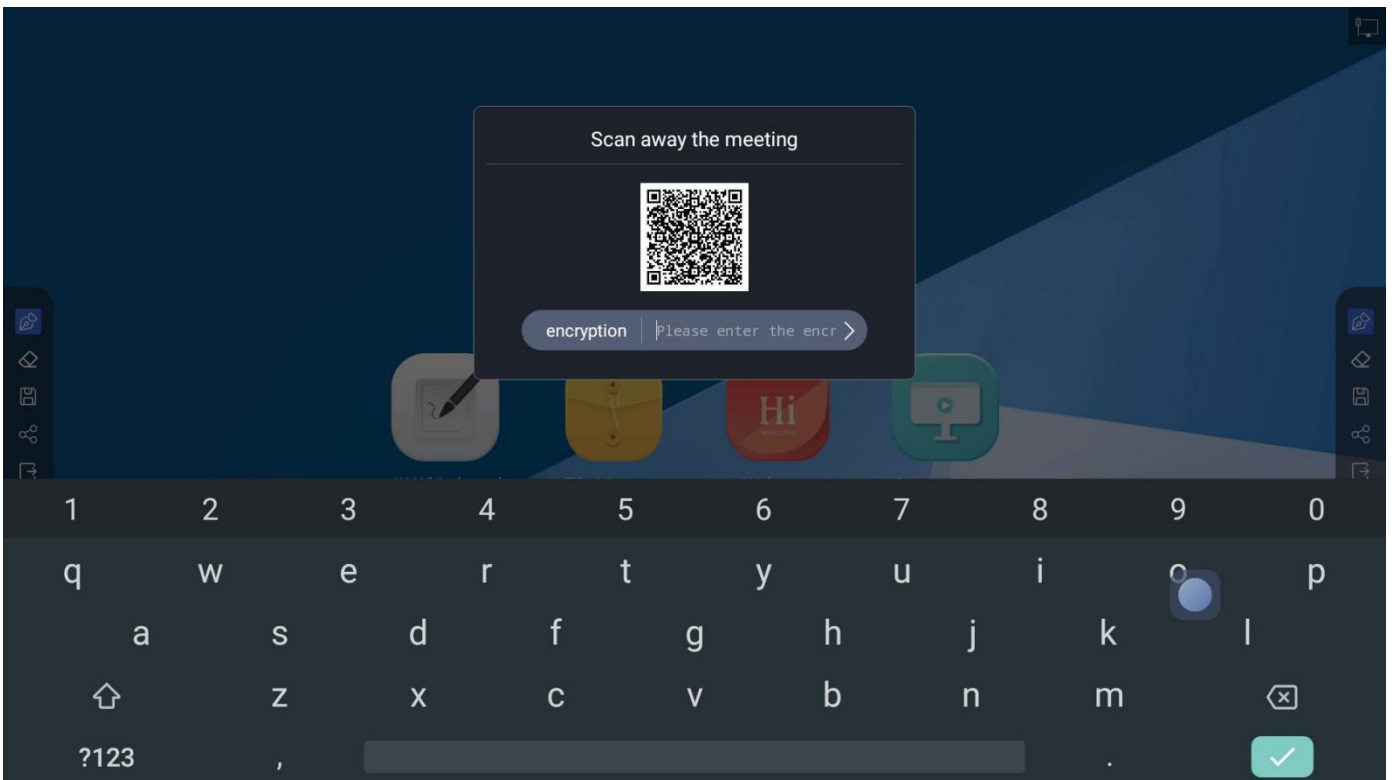



- (1) Press  to activate the pencil to start writing , in the pencil setting menu, user can set the pencil color and size.

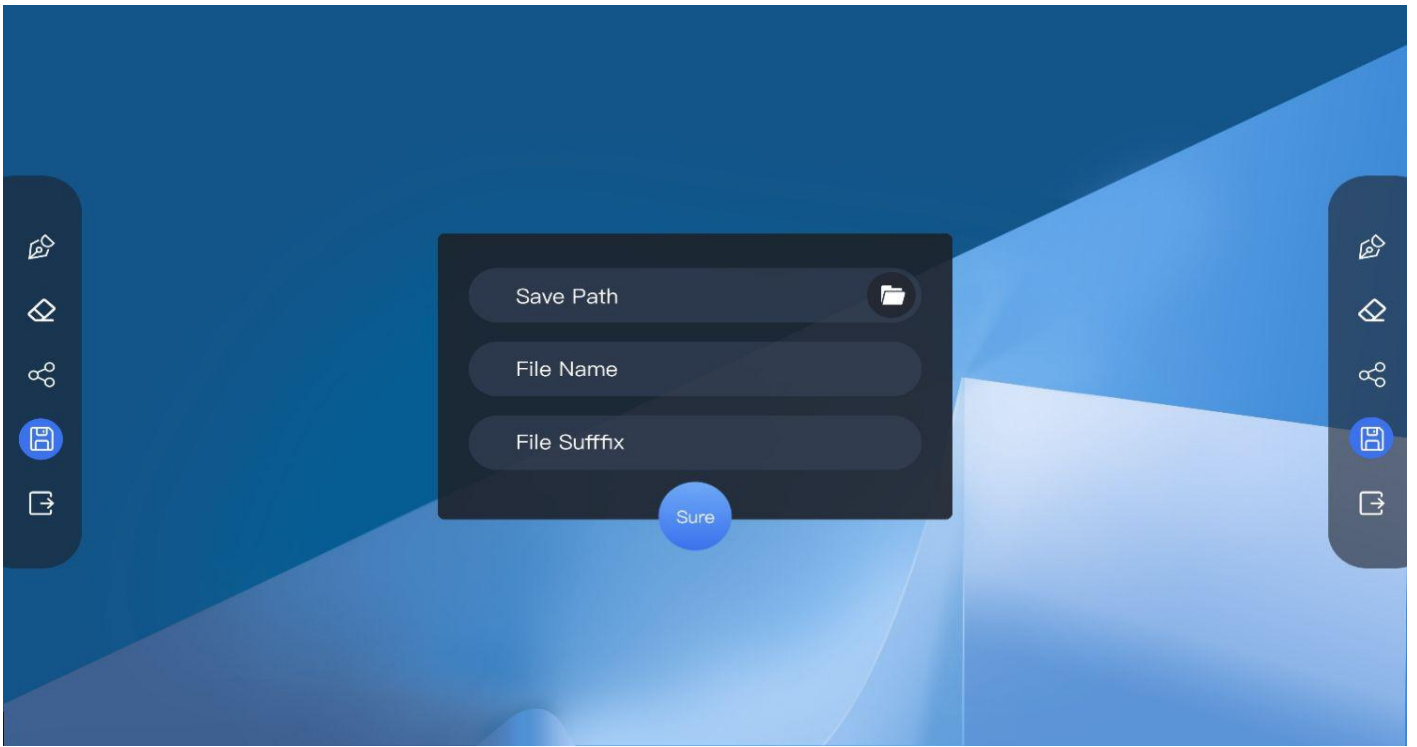


(2) Press  to activate the eraser tool.

(3) Press  to share the note via QR code or email. ? ?

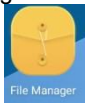

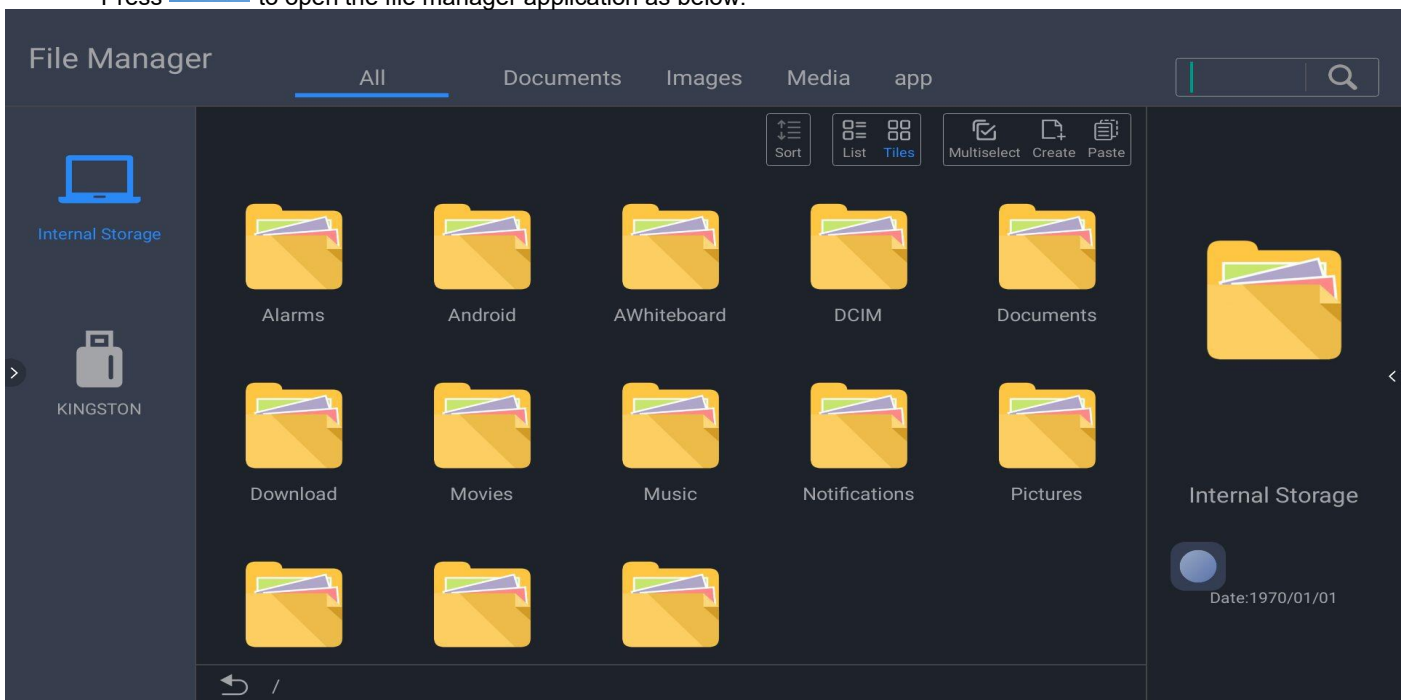

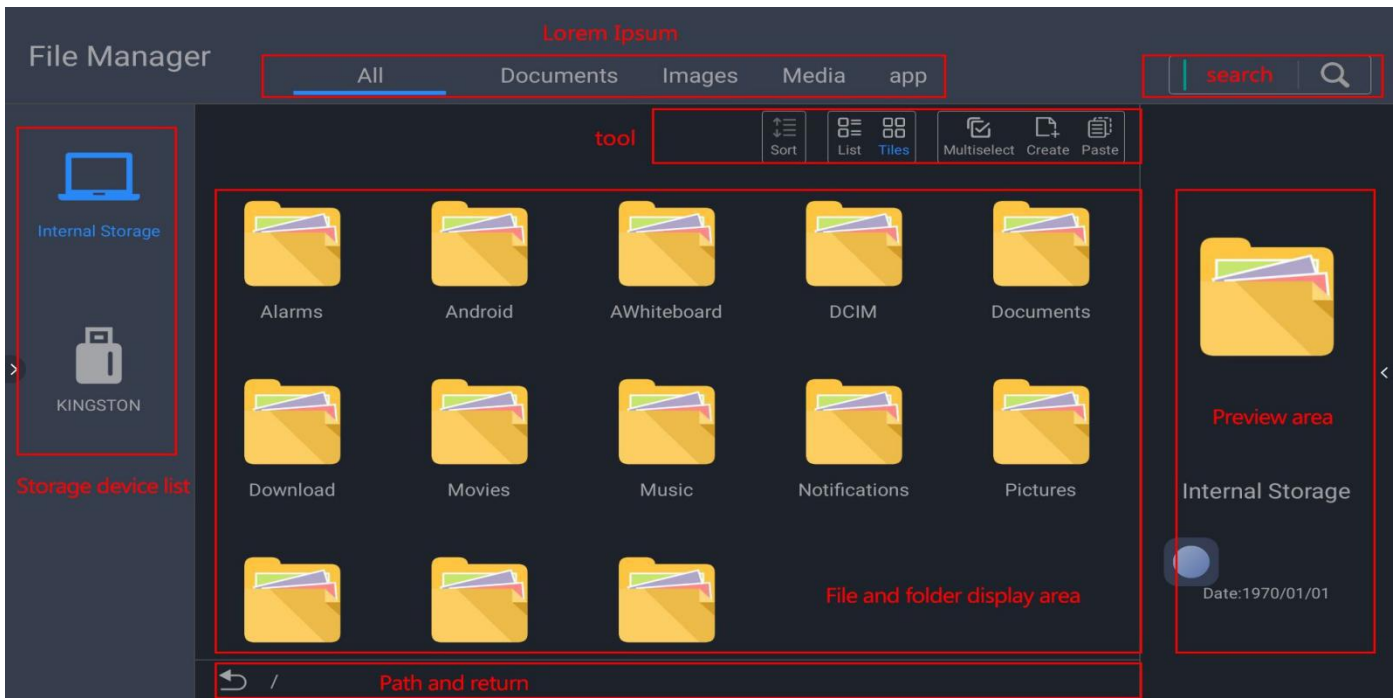

Show all the available storage devices, include internal and external. User can select to explore the files and folders in the selected device.

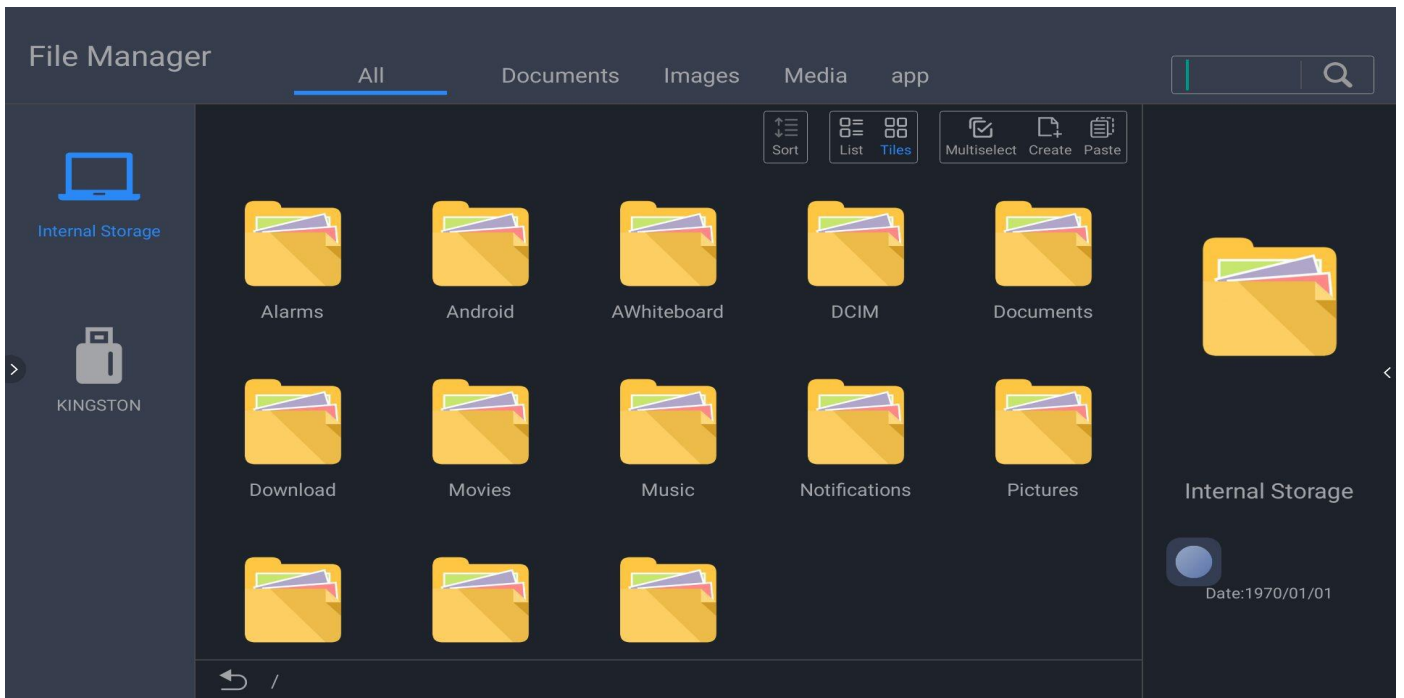
8.5 Back button


Press  to return the previous folder.

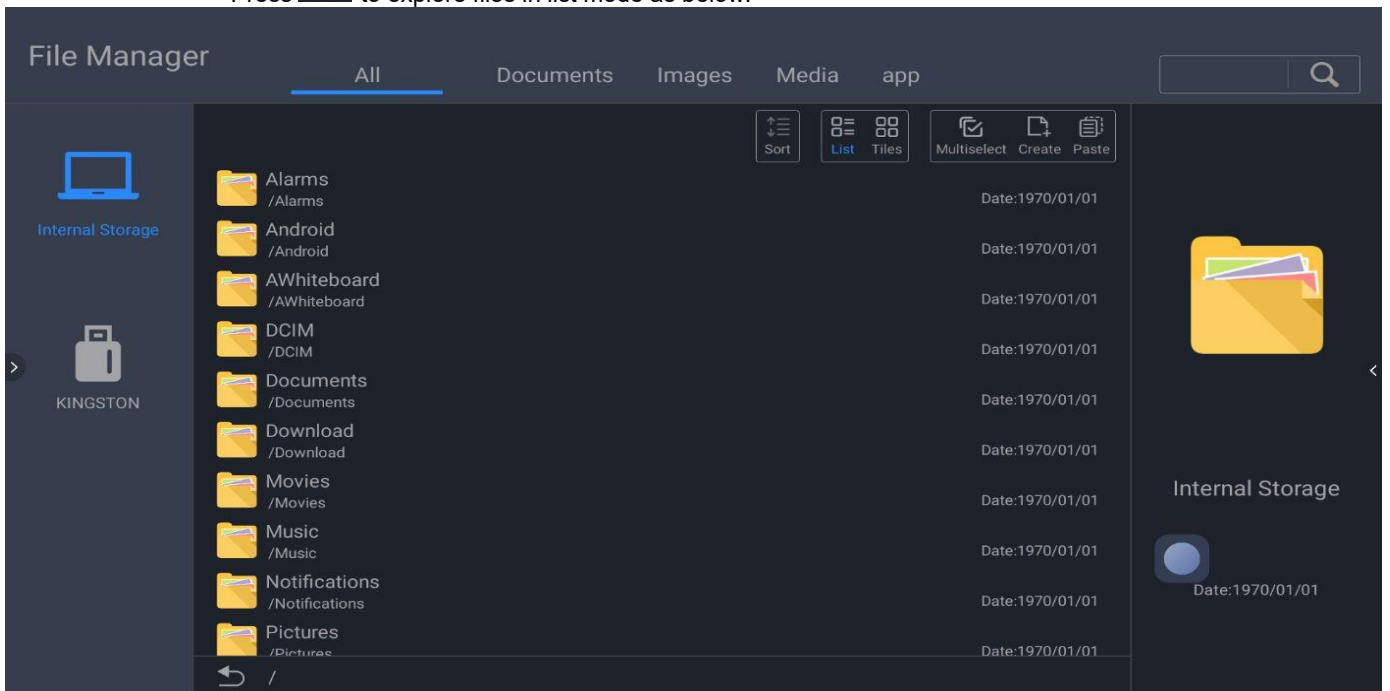

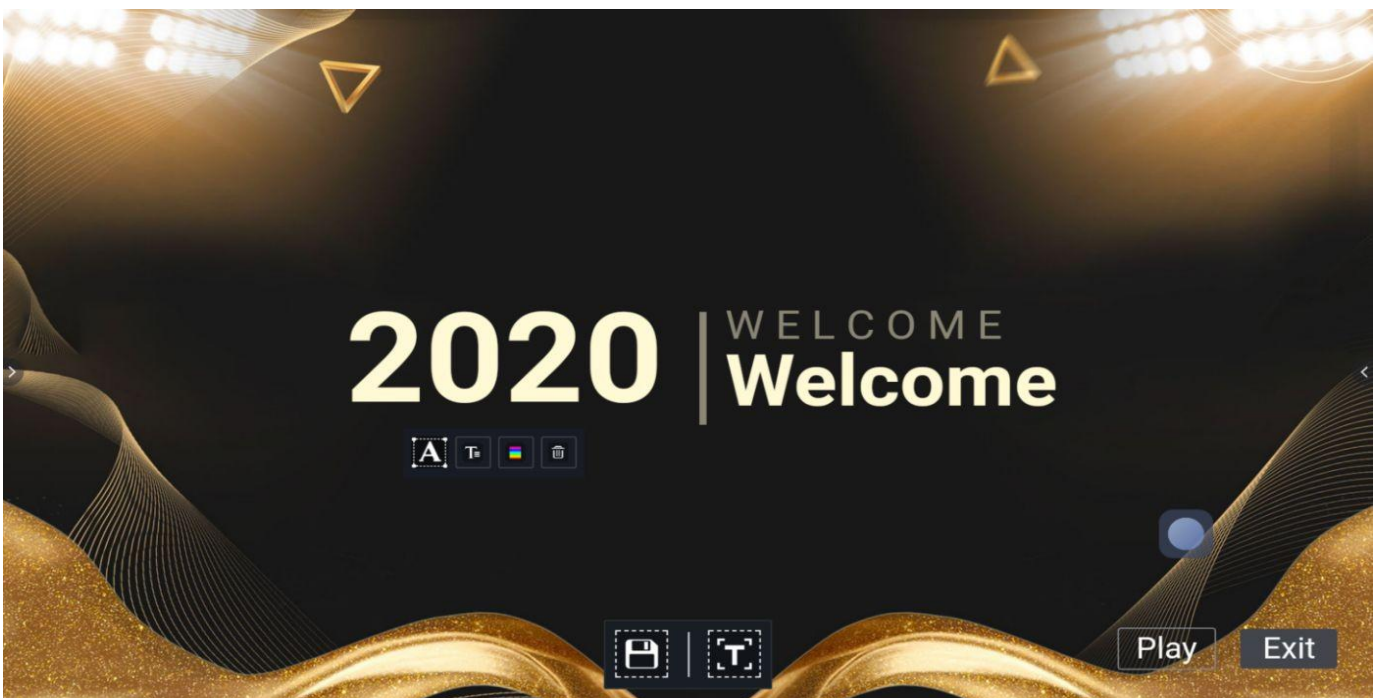

Press  to save the page as image file.

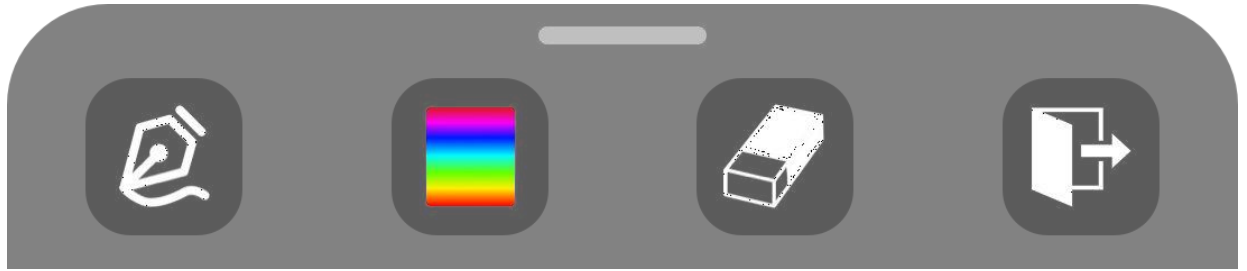
9. 2. 2 Signature mode


In play mode, press sign button, user can sign on the welcome picture as below:

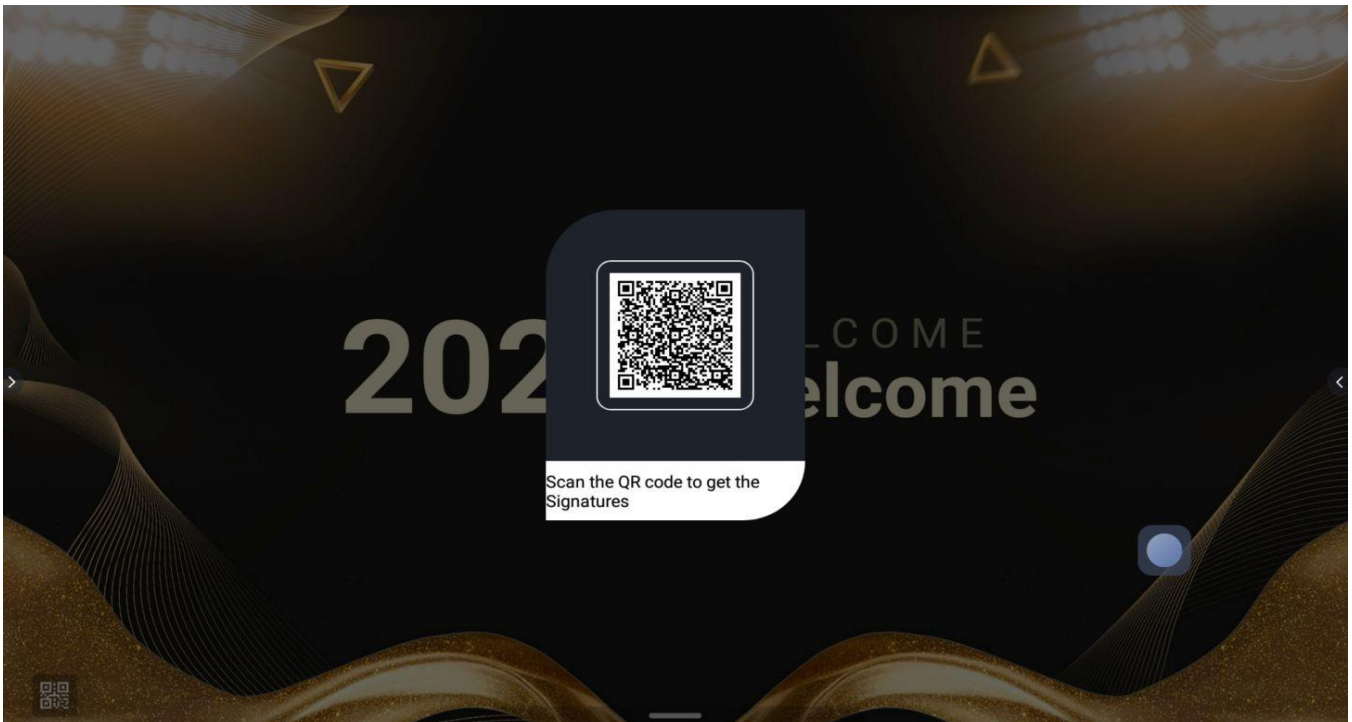


Press below button on the bottom of the screen , show the tools bar, user can select the pencil, or eraser tool , also can change pencil color or quite signature mode.

Press the left bottom QR code icon  to share the signature



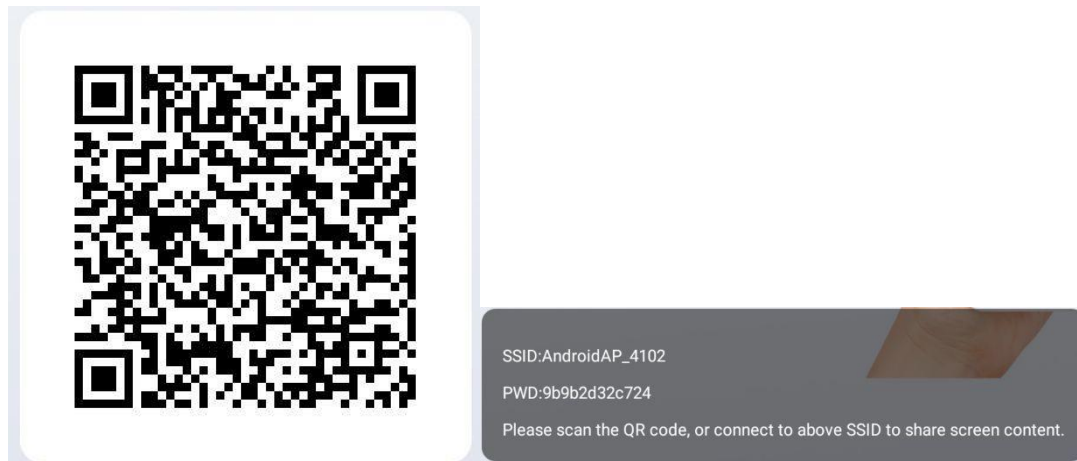

10.2 Android phone screen share

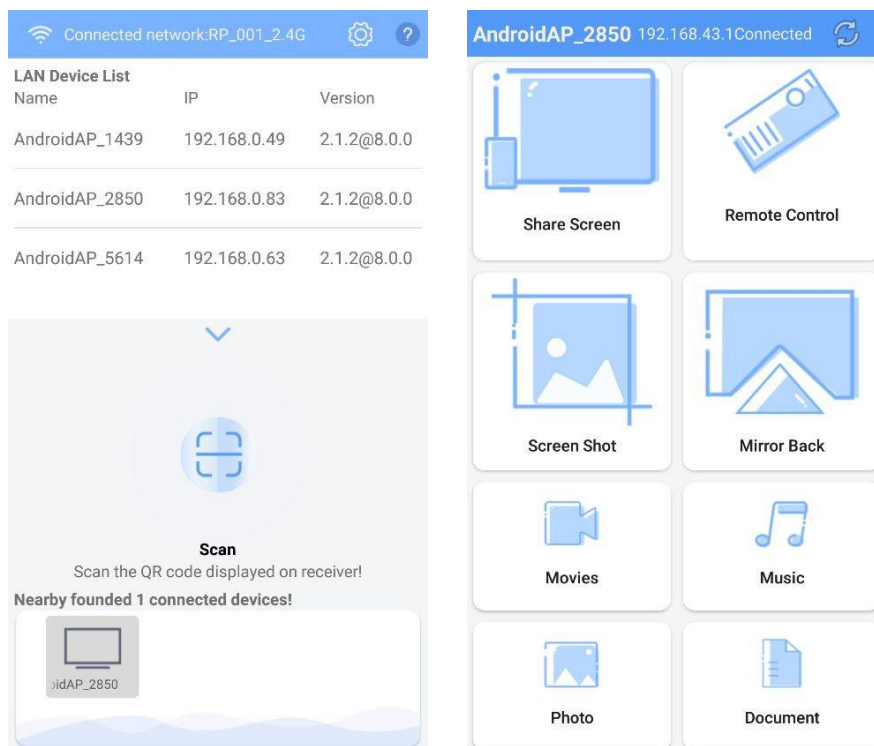
- Scan the QR code on the screen to download and install the screen share app to the androidphone.

- In screen mirroring list select the device.



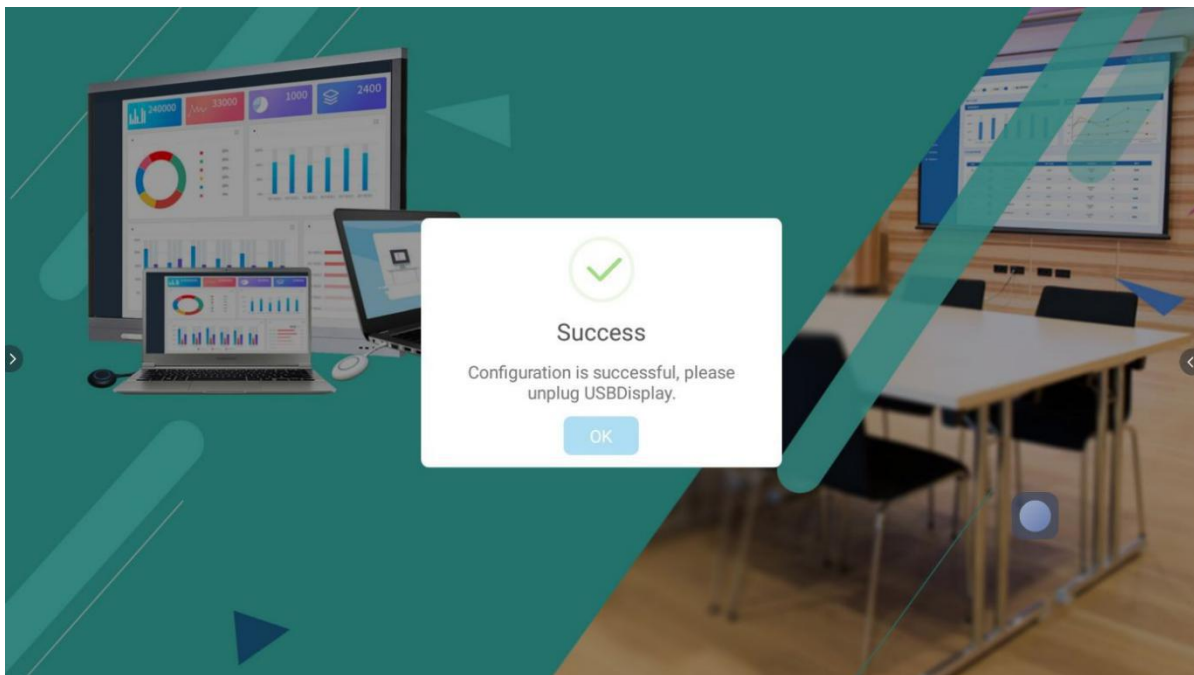
10.4 PC screen share

10.4.1 Dongle pair with the device

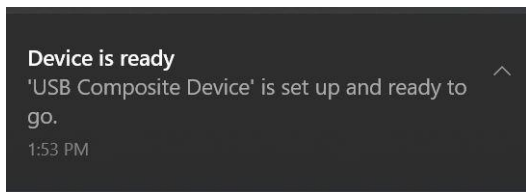
Insert the dongle to the device USB port, it will pair automatically. When the pair process is finished, the screen will show as below:

Connect the dongle to the PC USB port

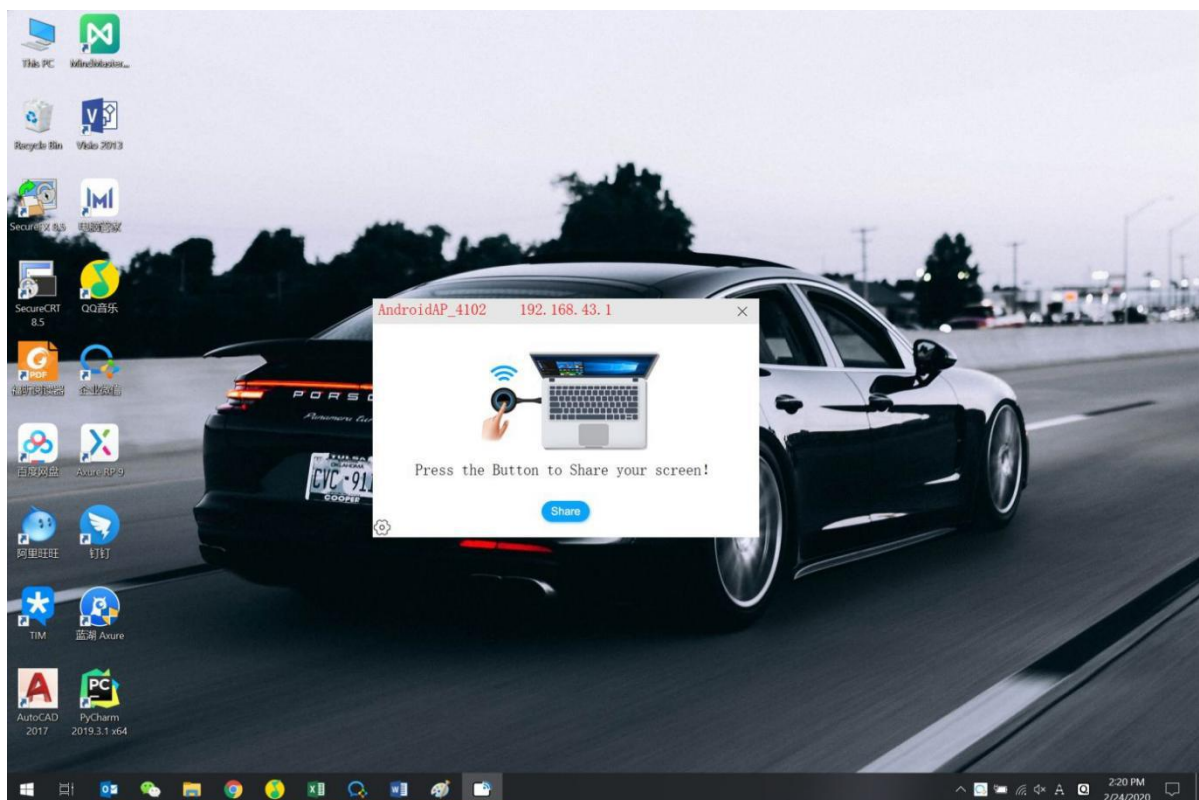
- Driver will installed automatically, after the driver is ready, it will show below information on the PC screen:
