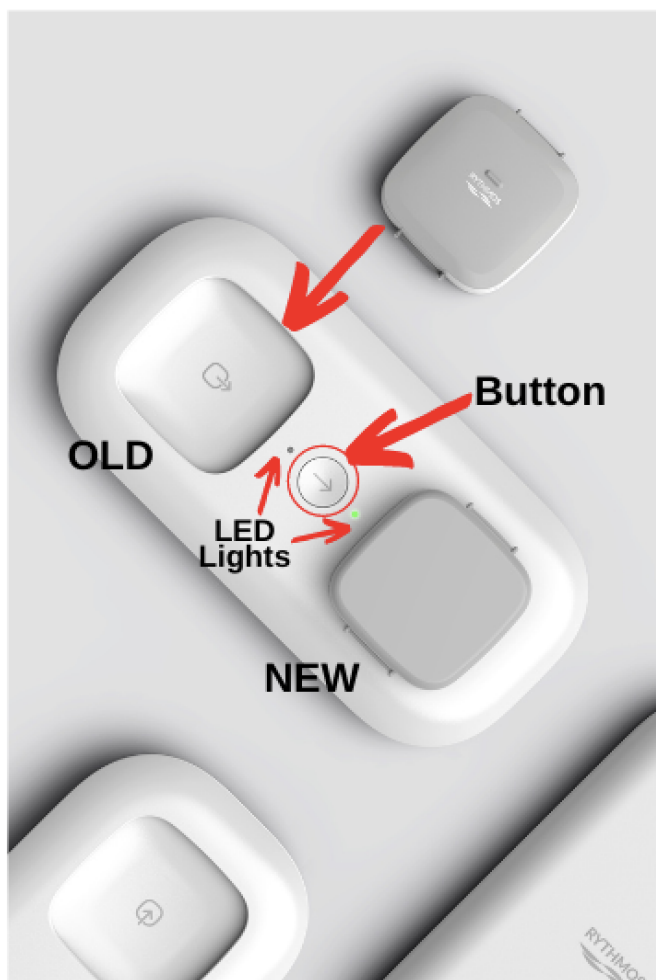


# Swap Pad



## How to Use the Swap Pad...

- 1** Read the instructions on the back of the Swap Pad.
- 2** Place the old and new wearable on the appropriate pad, button side down.
  - The LED's will turn blue when both wearables are correctly placed.
- 3** Press the center button.
  - The LED's will begin flashing in an alternating pattern to indicate a swap is in progress.
- 4** The LED's will blink green to indicate a successful swap, or red to indicate a failure.
  - If they blink red, check Rythmos. It may be a false negative.
  - Swap may take 1-2 minutes to complete.
