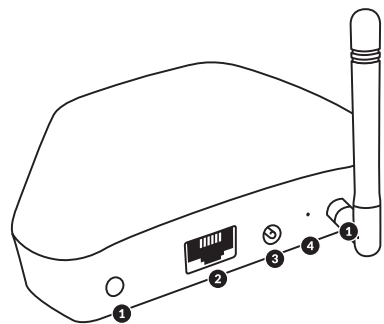

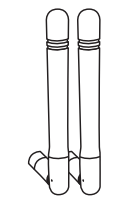

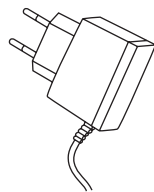

Setup

1. ADD BUTLER IN THE CMS

Go to devices and add Butler in your viewneo account.

2. CONNECT BUTLER

Connect Butler with the power supply and if needed, the LAN cable. Wait until the blue light appears to indicate that it is successfully connected.

3. SETUP HOTSPOT

The Butler will automatically create a hotspot: **viewneo_butler_**. Use your cell phone/PC to connect to the hotspot and then go to: **<http://192.168.2.5>**

4. SETUP ASSISTANT

Follow the instructions on your screen to complete the setup process.

1. BUTLER IM CMS ANLEGEN

Butler im viewneo Account unter der Rubrik „Geräte“ hinzufügen.

2. BUTLER ANSCHLIESSEN

Butler an die Stromversorgung anschließen und bei Bedarf LAN Kabel verbinden. Warten bis Butler blau leuchtet.

3. HOTSPOT VERBINDEN

Der Butler erstellt einen Hotspot: **viewneo_butler_**. Über Handy/PC verbinden und folgende Adresse im Browser aufrufen: **<http://192.168.2.5>**

4. SETUP ASSISTENT

Folge nun den Anweisungen auf dem Bildschirm, um die Einrichtung vollständig abzuschließen.
