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
1. INTRODUCTION

Pd = power density in mW/cm²

Pout = output power to antenna in mW

G = gain of antenna in linear scale

Pi = 3.1416

r = distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm

Pd is the limit of MPE, 1mW/cm². If we know the maximum gain of the antenna and the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance r where the MPE limit is reached.

CONCLUSION:

WLAN 2.4GHz Band AND WLAN 5GHz can transmit simultaneously.

The max Power Density at R $(20.7 \text{ cm}) = 0.4035 \text{mW/cm}^2 + 0.5941 \text{mW/cm}^2 = 0.9976 \text{ mW/cm}^2 < 1 \text{mW/cm}^2$.

So the compliance distance is 20.7cm for device installed without any other radio equipment.
