Q1. Why did I fail to add my T Guard to the VOCOlinc app? 1. If the screen shows "Couldn't find the accessory" after scanning the setup code: (1) Make sure your accessory is powered on and nearby.

(2) Make sure to turn on Bluetooth for your iOS device.

- 2. Make sure the setup code is entered correctly. Select the accessory shown on screen in manual mode, then input the setup code (XXX-XXX) which can be found on the interior cover or quick start quide.
- 3. If the app prompts "Couldn't add VOCOlinc-XXX-XXXXXXX" after scanning the setup code: (1) Close the app (2) Reboot the phone
