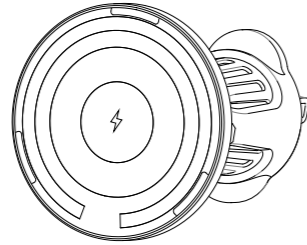


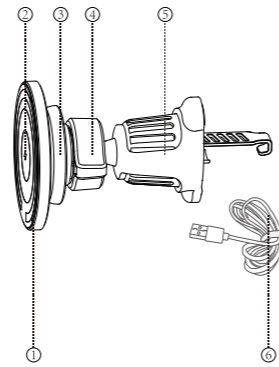

Magnetic Wireless Charging Phone Mount

Parts

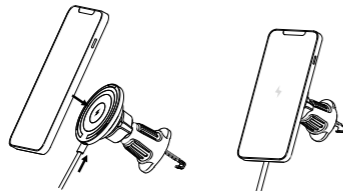


- ① Anti-slip Silicon Pad
- ② Coil Induction Area
- ③ Ball Socket
- ④ Ball-Nut
- ⑤ Airvent Hook
- ⑥ Cable

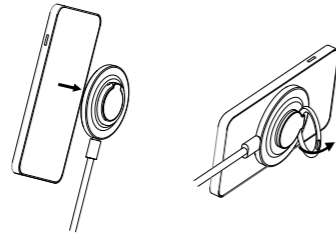
Installation

- ① Insert the ball-nut through the ball socket of the airvent hook component part
 - ② Attach the ball and socket joint together
 - ③ Turn locking knob anti-clockwise to tighten and attach the joint components
 - ④ Gently place the desktop ring phone holder over the assembled component parts and it will magnetically attach to each other
 - ⑤ Insert the hook into the vehicle airvent and hook it onto the grille
 - ⑥ Turn knob clockwise to tighten hook and lock onto the grille, fix support
- Turn knob counterclockwise to extend hook

Instructions



Plug-in the cable, then place the center of the mobile phone in alignment with the center of the magnetic phone mount to start automatic wireless charging immediately.



The magnetic phone mount can be detached from the installation part attached to the vehicle. When the phone mount is removed it could be used as a desktop ring phone holder. Keep the magnetic phone mount connected to the cable for wireless charging feature
