How To Use:

- Power on: Press the power key "▶ı/o" 2 seconds when it is off. The blue LED light will be on, and a voice will prompt, this indicates the BT Speaker is in pairing mode.
- Pairing: Activate the bluetooth function on your phone within range and select "Gaming_Spkr" from the list shown. When the blue LED light stops flashing, it has paired successfully and you will hear a tone. The blue LED will flash slowly when

- Volume up: Hold down ">+" to increase the volume.
- Volume down: Hold down "-ा-«" to decrease the volume.
- Previous song: Press the "→⊷ " once to play the previous song.
- Next song: Press the ">+" once to play the next song.
- Power off: When the speaker is standby or operating, press and hold the speaker key "▶I/o" 3 seconds to shut down the speaker.
- Light up: Toggle the light switch to turn the multi-color changing LEDs off/on.


