
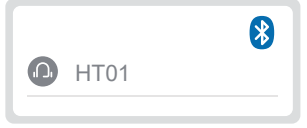


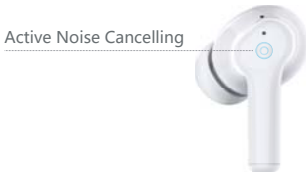




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| <p><b>HT01</b> <small>Wireless Headphones</small></p> <p>Operation Instruction</p>   | <p><b>1 Starting up</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Opening the charging case</li> <li>Pressing the charging case for 3 seconds then automatically pair with the phone.</li> </ol>   | <p><b>2 Bluetooth Pairing</b></p> <p>Start up phone bluetooth,click "HT01" then follow the tips to pair.</p>     | <p><b>3 Headphones Control</b></p> <p>(When in your ears)<br/>Double click the right one to answer the phone once again double click to hang up. Usually,pull out of ears,sound will automatically swift to the phone.Pull in the ears,sound will automatically swift to the earbuds.</p>    | <p><b>4 Active Noise Cancelling</b></p> <p>(When in your ears)<br/>Double click the left one to the noise cancelling mode,once again double click to the ambient mode(environmental voice)</p> <p>Note:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Noise cancelling is turned off by default</li> <li>One ear wearing mode couldn't start up noise cancelling mode</li> <li>When in noise cancelling mode,pull out one ear will turn off noise cancelling,pull in will turn it on.</li> </ol>  |
