

Pursuant to KDB 680106 of the HONOTO TECHNOLOGY CO., LTD hereby declare our product which is an inductive wireless power transfer applications that meet all of the following requirements are not required to submit a KDB inquiry for devices approved using a PAG for equipment approved using certification to address RF exposure compliance.

- 1) Power transfer frequency is 0.110-0.205MHz which is less than 1 MHz
- 2) Output power from each primary coil is equal to 15 watts max
- 3) The system may consist of more than one source primary coils, charging one or more clients. If more than one primary coil is present, the coil pairs may be powered on at the same time.
- 4) Client device is placed directly in contact with the transmitter
- 5) The EUT is a mobile device.
- 6) The aggregate H-field strengths at 15 cm surrounding the device and 20 cm above the top surface from all simultaneous transmitting coils are demonstrated to be less than 50% of the MPE limit.
