

NOTE: Bluetooth settings may vary by device.
3. Then click on the newfound device named "Powerlocus Moonfly".
4. For wired connection, Use the included audio cable to connect.

Charging

Wired Charging: Please plug in the USB-C into headphones charging port and connect the other side with USB wall charging adapter or computer. The LED indicator turns red while charging, and turns off when fully charged. When the battery power is below 10%, the Bluetooth headset will remind you with a beeping sound every 15 minutes.

Product Maintenance

1. Do not use non-original accessories, because it may result in performance degradation, damage, safety issues, and void the warranty.
2. Do not immerse the headset by yourself, because it may cause damage and void the warranty.
3. Do not place the Bluetooth headphones in a dusty environment.
4. Do not allow children under 3 years to play with the Bluetooth headset unsupervised.
5. Do not place the product in an overheated or super-cooled environment otherwise, it may not properly either temporarily or permanently.
6. Always clean the Bluetooth headphones with a clean, soft and dry cloth.

7. Place the Bluetooth headphones in the original package or keep it carefully when it is not in use.

Battery Maintenance

1. Go to a qualified repair center if you need to remove or replace the battery. (Rechargeable batteries will last for a long time if maintained carefully).
2. The charging temperature of the rechargeable battery is from 5 - 50 degrees Celsius.
3. Ensure to charge the Bluetooth headphones at least once a month if not used for a long time.
4. Battery usage time and standby time are related to specific conditions.
Usage time and standby time are provided for reference only.

Notes

1. Other than the manufacturer's automatic save the Bluetooth headset after a first-time connection. If you cannot connect again, please delete the Powerlocus Moonfly information (remove the paired device or ignore the connected device), then you can search and reconnect to Powerlocus Moonfly again.
2. When the Bluetooth headphones fail to power on, it might be a result of low battery power. Please charge the Bluetooth headset.
3. Select the desired volume and be cautious of the playing time.

4. Do not disassemble the bluetooth headphones by yourself.
5. Do not place heavy objects on the product to prevent damage.

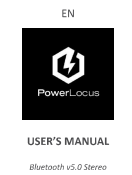

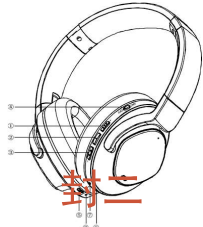

Key Functions



No.	Name	Introduction
①	Volume / Play / Track	Press to increase volume (press and hold to skip to the next track).

No.	Name	Introduction
②	MBF (Multi-function Button)	Pause/Play: Press once to pause / play music. Google Assistant activation: Press 2 times to activate Siri / Google Assistant. Phone Call Control: Press once to answer. During phone call, press once to hang up. Press and hold to decline calls.
③	Volume (Previous Track)	Press to reduce volume (press and hold to play the previous track).
④	Power On/Off button	Slide the On/Off button to power on the headphones. Press to switch off the Bluetooth headphones (power off). Pressing with the power button applied with the power button can be used to prevent the headphones from being powered on. Press and hold the power button of the charging cable to the USB socket of the headset; connect the other plug to the USB socket of your computer or other charging devices.
⑤	USB-C port	After inserting the charging cable properly and the charging status light turns red, the headset is being charged. When the Bluetooth headset is full, the charging status light turns off. Suggestion: Do not use headphones without charging.
⑥	Charging light

⑦	LED indicator	When powering up/paring, the LED indicator on the Bluetooth headset flashes 3 times, blue and red light flashes alternately. When connected, the blue light flashes once every 3 seconds.
⑧	3.5mm Earphone Jack	When an extra earphone is plugged, the Bluetooth turns off automatically.
Troubleshooting		Remedy
The indicator blinks red (battery interference, 2s) or continuously?		It means the battery is low. Please charge the headphones as soon as possible.
Bluetooth headphones do not work?		This may be a result of low battery power. Please charge the headphones before using. 1. Make sure the Bluetooth headphones are fully charged. 2. Make sure the headphones are properly connected to the device. 3. Make sure the Bluetooth headphones have been paired and connected to the device successfully. 4. Make sure the distance between the device and the headphones and try to be in no more than 10 meters/32.8 ft apart. 5. Make sure your phone/device is within the range of signal and without external interference. 6. Make sure your phone/device is not connected to other devices.
Bluetooth headphones are without sound?		Remedy
		1. Make sure you insert the 3.5mm audio cable into its port properly. Note that the bottom and microphone of the headphones will not function during a wired connection. 2. Bluetooth connection is not successful.	How to connect? 1. To connect Bluetooth devices, activate the MFB for 2 seconds. 2. Press the power on and enter pairing mode automatically. The LED indicator flashes blue and red alternately. (The Bluetooth headphones powers off after 5 minutes if Bluetooth is not connected and there is no activity). 3. To connect: Activate Bluetooth on your phone (or other devices) and set it to search for new devices. iPhone Settings > Bluetooth > On > Scan for devices. Android Settings > Bluetooth > On > Scan for devices.
