


MULTIFUNCTION CONTROLLER BLUETOOTH OPERATION

- 1) Press the (8) *PLAY/PAUSE* once to start playing music or press the *PLAY* button from vour devices touchscreen 2) To skip songs or advance, short press the (6) **NEXT TRACK** button
- 3) To select the previous song, short press the (7) **PREVIOUS TRACK** button


VOLUME CONTROL
