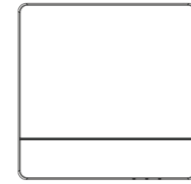

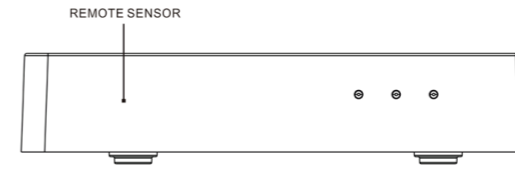

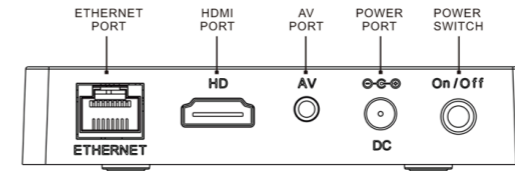


1. **POWER** - Switch on or switch off receiver
2. **MUTE** - Switch on or switch off receiver's sound.
3. **FIND** - Search channel, program or application.
4. **0-9** - Numerical key.
5. **Subtitle** - Display Subtitle information of channel.
6. **FAV** - A shortcut to the favorite channel list.
7. **Group** - A shortcut to channel group list.
8. **▲/▼** - Page up/down.
9. **🔊** - Adjust receiver's volume.
10. **EPG** - Display Electronic program Guide information.
11. **INFO** - Display detailed information of channel, program or application.
12. **◀/▶** - Moving the highlight to left/right.
13. **▲/▼** - Moving the highlight to up/down.
14. **OK** - Confirm the selection.
15. **MENU** - The entry of application's functions.
16. **BACK** - Back to the previous menu.
17. **COLORIZED KEYS** - Entries of application's key functions.
18. **RECORDED KEYS** - Record program to local storage such as USB stick.
19. **PLAY** - Start to play media.
20. **PAUSE** - Pause the playing of media.
21. **STOP** - Exit the playing of media.
22. **Live** - Shortcut to live channel.
23. **VOD** - Shortcut to VOD.
24. **Series** - Shortcut to SERIES.
25. **Radio** - Shortcut to Radio.

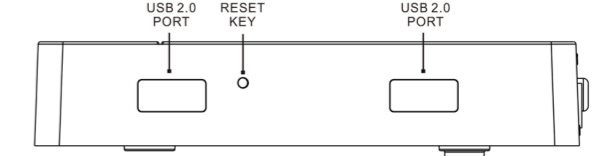
Front Panel



Rear Panel

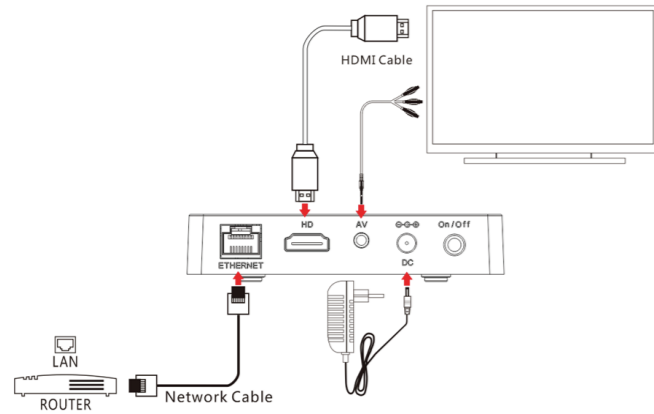


Side Panel



Preparation

1. **Connecting Internet cable**
Connect Ethernet cable to the 'Ethernet' Port of the rear panel of the box.
 2. **Connecting the TV**
Connecting TV via HDMI cable.
 3. **Power ON/OFF**
There are several ways to turn the box ON or OFF.
- **Complete Power Shutdown**
Remove the power supply, it takes a longer time to boot the system if you turned it off by this way.
 - **Standby Mode**
Press the **POWER** button to turn the box on or off.
The box includes a standby mode for lower power consumption which locates at **[Setting > System Options > Real standby]**.
If **Real standby** set to **OFF**, the system is not completely shutdown and thus it takes a few seconds to restart.

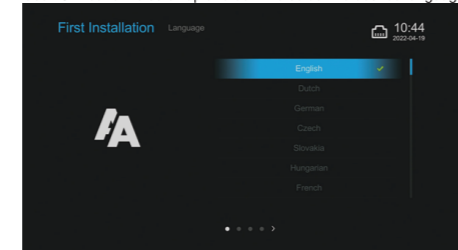


First Time installation

When you switch the box on for the first time, the easy installation starts automatically with the language selection.

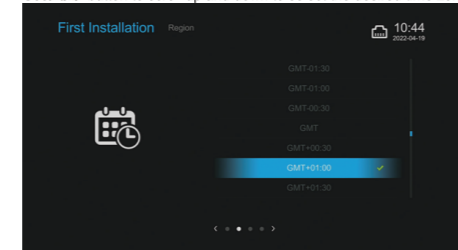
1. Language Selection

Use **▲/▼** button to scroll up and down to select the desired language and confirm with **OK** button.



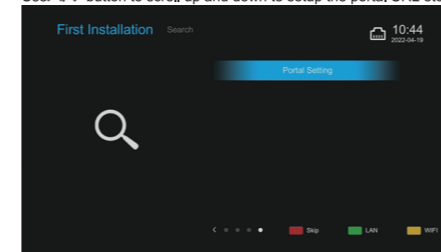
2. Press ► button to go to next region setting.

Use **▲/▼** button to scroll up and down to select the desired time zone and confirm with **OK** button.



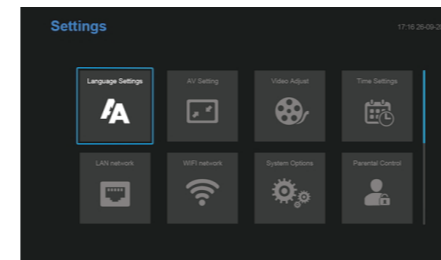
3. Press ► button to go to next search setting.

Trouble shooting

Before you contact your local service center, please read the following tips carefully.

1. **No video on TV**
 - Check first if the product is powered on and in operational mode.
 - Check if the video cable is properly connected between TV and the box.
 - Check if the internet cable is properly connected between Router and the box.
2. **Problem with audio quality**
 - Check if your audio cable is connected correctly.
 - Check the volume level of your TV and the box.
 - Check if the box or TV is on mute.
 - Check the audio option if it is correctly selected for the program that you are currently watching.
3. **Poor audio and video quality**
 - Check if the internet cable is properly connected between Router and the box and the internet bandwidth is enough.
4. **Remote control problem**
 - Check if the battery is low power.
 - Point the remote control directly toward the box.
 - Make sure that nothing blocks the front panel display.
5. **Recording problem**
 - Check if the HDD has a sufficient space for recording.
 - Check if there is a conflict between recordings.
