Usage Method - Steps to start S4G Pro

1. Press the Power Button, and the screen lights up. After the first boot interface shows up, follow the prompts to operate. Two internet access modes are available for this device.

2. Wireless Network Connection: Click the wireless network you want to connect to on the wireless interface and enter the password (if any) to connect;

3. Wired network connection: you can connect to the network through the network cable after plugging it into the network port.
