




BATTERY INSTALLATION

Installation and charging of lithium battery for Remote control car:

Install the remote control car battery: Connect the attached 3.7V 500mah battery, as shown






*How to charge the remote car battery:

Connect one end of the USB port to the battery and plug the other end into any computer USB port or compatible adapter.


Remote control battery installation method:Open the cover of the battery box and insert the 2 1.5V AA battery according to the polarity indicated.



REMOTE CONTROL BUTTON OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS



1. Power switch: press to turn on the power, and press for 1 second to turn off the power. 2.Indicator description: Turn on the power, and the indicator of the remote control blinks, when the frequency is adjusted successfully, and the indicator of the remote controller is off.

HOW TO PLAY

1.Please charge the toy fully before using it. when charging the USB light comes on. 2. Run the car according to the buttons on the remote control instruction. 3. Tap the spray button, the remote car will spray, and press again the spray will stop.

Adjust to go straight

- 1. If the remote control car does not go straight when driving forward, turn the steering adjustment button at the bottom of the remote control car. The L mark indicates "fine left", fine left until the remote control car can go straight.
- 2. If the remote control car does not go straight when moving forward, turn the steering adjustment button at the bottom of the remote control car. The R sign means "fine to the right", fine to the remote control car can go straight.

TIPS

- 1. Do not touch the four wheels of the remote control car when the car is moving to avoid injury or damage to the remote control car.
- 2.Don't play on the road or in dangerous places in case of accidents. Don't play with your remote control car in dirty water, dirt or sand.
