



After booting, the system will automatically focus until the projected image is clear. If the image is not clear, press the focus button of the remote control and the system will display the focus map. At this time, press the left or right button to adjust the image to the clearest state. (Press the focus button and the system will automatically call up the focus map). Note: The best projection distance is 0.5m~3m

Adjusting Focus


Power on and Off

Power on: when the unit is off, press and hold the [power switch] button for about 3 seconds to turn it on. Power off: when the unit is on, long press the power button on the remote controller or [power switch] on the machine for more than 3 seconds, and the system will automatically display the shutdown animation [shutdown] Restore factory Settings: when the unit is on, go to the system settings, select restore factory setting, confirm your choice to restore factory setting. [Restore factory Setting] Forced shutdown: when the unit is on, press and hold the [power switch] on the machine till the device forced off.
