- ✗ Not compatible with **leather** or **vinyle** dashboard



Re-Usable Suction Cup




Restore stickiness with warm water and let it air dry to use




Option 1: For iPhone 12/13 Series



Option 2: For Official Magsafe Case




Option 3: For Non-Official Phone Case




Stick the metal ring **on the center** of back of the phone case
