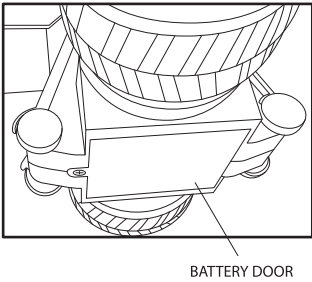
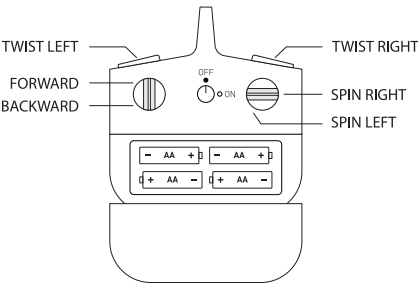

Battery Installation

The vehicle requires 4 AA 1.5V batteries (not included) and the remote requires 4 AA 1.5V batteries (not included).

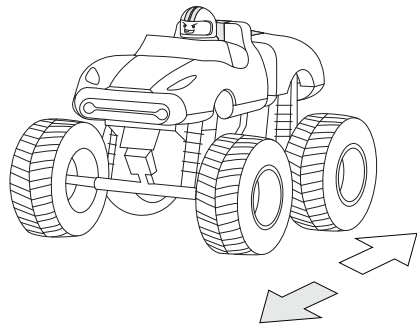
Use a Phillips head or Cross screwdriver to loosen the screw securing the battery cover on the bottom of the vehicle and remote. Insert the batteries, ensuring the correct polarity. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw.



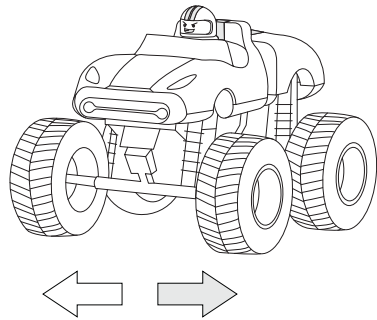
PLAY

1. Turn the power knob on the remote clockwise and flip the power switch on the vehicle to I (ON). The remote pair light will pulse. It will turn solid when paired.
2. Control the vehicle using the remote-control sticks. The left stick drives forward and backward, and the right stick spins the vehicle right or left.
3. Split Twister can transform using the 2 large buttons on the top of the remote. To transform, press either the top left or right button to rotate the body of the vehicle. The vehicle can only transform 180 degrees by pressing one of TWIST buttons. Try the other button if it cannot transform further.
4. Once transformed, try driving or spinning to performs stunts.

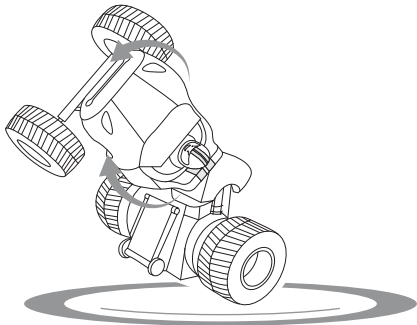
Forward and Backward
