

AIRDOPES 141

Get ready to immerse yourself in musical bliss with your very own pair of boAt Airdopes 141. Please consider this manual as your guiding map towards the unparalleled shores of musical bliss.

Knowledge of Bluetooth and device connectivity is essential for steering this boat and therefore we strongly recommend thorough reading of this manual; also, you may refer to the same at times when you face any sort of difficulty in future.

POWER ON (First Time User)

Step 1: To switch the earbuds on (Smart Power On) simply open the lid of the charging case (when earbuds are inside). Courtesy our IWP™ technology, the earbuds power on automatically, get connected and enter into the connection mode

Long touch the CTC on both earbuds for 8 seconds to manually power on the earbuds

Step 2: After powering on, the earbuds enter into the Connection Mode, indicated by red and white LED

CONNECTION MODE

Step 3: Turn on the Bluetooth functionality on your none/media device and scan Step 4: Search for 'Airdopes 141' and pair

accordingly. Congratulations! Your earbuds are now connected

successfully via Bluetooth

· Pairing mode lasts for 3 minutes. If the pairing time is missed then you will need to reconnect the ear-buds and follow the above mentioned procedure

Airdopes 141 remembers previously connected devices; once switched on, the ear-buds automatically reconnect to the previously connected devices

SINGLE EARBUD USAGE

Step 1: Please note that both the earbuds can be used in mono mode. Use Smart / Manual Power On for switching on the desired earbud

Step 2: The selected earbud will automatically enter the connection mode indicated by red and white LFD flashes

Step 3: Turn on Bluetooth on your phone/media device and search for 'Airdopes 141'

To switch to Stereo mode, simply take out the other earbud from the case.
It will automatically power on and pair with the previously selected earbud, hence enablina Stereo usage

· You cannot skip tracks or return to the previous tracks in Mono mode

QUICK GUIDE ON FUNCTIONALITIES

Long touch either CTC for 3 seconds to activate voice assistant

Long touch both CTCs for 8 seconds to manually power on

Long touch both CTCs for 5 seconds to manually power off



HARGING THE EARBUDS

Step 1: Please insert the earbuds back inside the charging case in correct orientation Step 2: A solid red LED on earbuds indicates that the earbuds are being charged. Once fully charged the LED turns off

tep 3: Once the earbuds are fully charged, the charging case automatically switches

Step: To charge the case, plug one end of the provided cable into the case and connect the other end to a computer/ wall adapter/ powerbank, etc.

White LED flashes while the case is on charging. When the charge gets full, it gets ndicated by solid white LED.



BASIC FUNCTIONS

- Voice Assistant: Long touch the CTC on either earbud for 3 seconds to activate
- Answer: Single tap the CTC on either earbud to answer an incoming call Hang Up / Reject Call: Double tap the CTC on either earbud to end or reject
- /Pause Music: Single tap on either earbud's CTC to play or pause music Next Track: When playing music, double tap the right CTC to skip to the next
- n playing music, double tap the left CTC to return to the
- BEAST Mode: Triple tap on either earbud's CTC to activate/deactivate the BEAST Mode for Low Latency



VOICE ASSISTANT

Step 1: Long touch the CTC on either earbud for 3 seconds to activate the smart voice

Step 2: The respective voice assistant screen pops up and you may place your commands at ease

Tips: You may try out the following commands,

· What is the weather?

· Play a song Set a reminder

Step 1: After usage, remove both the earbuds from your ears

Step 2: Place the earbuds back into the charging case in correct orientation and close the lid

The earbuds automatically switch off (and enter into charging mode).





MANUAL POWER OFF

Step 1: Long touch both CTCs for 5 seconds to manually power off Step 2: Once the earbuds get turned off, place them back inside the case and close the





MANUAL FACTORY RESET

form the Factory Reset in case you face any difficulty while operating your Airdopes *Note: Before performing reset, clear " Airdopes 141" from pairing device history by forgetting device

Step 1: Take both earbuds out from the charging case

Step 2: While in pairing mode (White and Red LED Flashes on earbuds). Tap 5 times on both earbuds CTC area, Red and White LED flash to indicate the same then Red LED flash before Turning OFF

Step 3: Keep both earbuds inside the charging case

Step 4: Once you open charging case lid, they automatically restart.

AUTO - RESET

irdopes 141 comes equipped with our cutting edge IWP™ technology along with the uto-Reset feature, which means that you would not require to do the factory reset anually. Now, every time while the earbuds are kept inside the case and the lid gets
