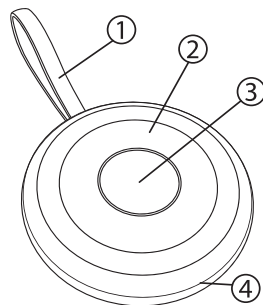

1. Built-in Type-C Input Cable
2. Wireless Charging Surface
3. iWatch Wireless Charging Surface
4. LED Indicator

What's included:

- 1 x Wireless Charging Pad

Tech Specifications

- Type-C Input: 5V/3A; 9V/3A
- Wireless Output: 15W Max

Instructions:

1. Wireless Charging Mobile phones and other electronic devices:

- Connect the built-in Type-C cable(1) to a power source. To achieve best performance, quick-charge power adapter is recommended.
- LED indicator (4) will glow RED when the device is in wireless charging standby.
- Place the wireless charging supported device on the wireless charging surface(2).
- LED will glow BLUE when device is charging.

- Phone will begin to charge automatically.
- ** Once fully charged remove the device.

Note: When wireless charging, if the LED indicator flashes the device is either NOT a wireless charging device or there is an object between the device and charging surface interfering with the charging process.

2. Wireless Charging a iWatch:

- Be sure the wireless charging pad is connected to a power source.
- Place the iwatch on the wireless charging surface(3) in the center groove of the wireless charging pad.
- The watch will begin to charge automatically, the wireless charging LED(4) will glow BLUE when charging.
- Once fully charged remove the device.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

- WARNING-When using this product, basic precautions should always be followed:

1. Read all the instructions before use.
2. Never store or use this product in temperatures below 32°F(0°C) or above 115°F(45°C).
3. Do not overcharge your phone. The unit may become hot under excessive use. Remove your phone once it is fully charged. Never charge your phone for more than 7 hours at a time.

4. To reduce the risk of injury, close supervision is required when the product is used near children.

5. Do not expose the device to moisture.
6. Do not use the device in excess of its output rating. Overload outputs above the rating may result in a risk of fire or injury

7. Do not use the device if damaged or modified.

8. Damaged or modified batteries may exhibit unpredictable behaviour resulting in fire, explosion or risk of injury.
