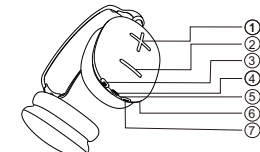

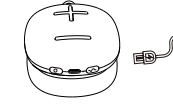
A Quick Look



- ① :VOL+/Next Track
- ② :VOL-/Previous Track
- ③ :Power
- ④ :USB-C Charging Port
- ⑤ :Indicator light
- ⑥ :Pause/play/Answer
- ⑦ :Microphone hole

Charging

1. Insert the included charging cable's USB-C end into the charging port.



2. Insert the charging cable's standard USB end into the USB port of a computer or suitable wall adapter (not included).

3. The red LED Charging Indicator light will be on while the unit is charging and will be off when fully charged.

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Press and hold the power button for about 5 seconds to turn on your headphones. Once your headphones are turned on they will go into Bluetooth pairing mode. The red and blue indicator light start to flash.



2. On your phone, go to the Bluetooth page in the Settings app. Make sure Bluetooth is on before connecting to the available device "v80021 Headphones".

3. The blue light indicators will start to flash slowly after Bluetooth pairing is successful.

Music Controls



Press to Play/Pause your track.
Press to pick up/end a call.
Press and hold to reject a call.



Press to switch between



Press to lower the volume.
Press and hold to go to the previous track.



Press to raise the volume.
Press and hold to go to the next track.
