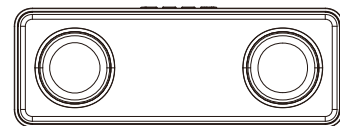

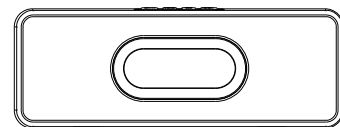

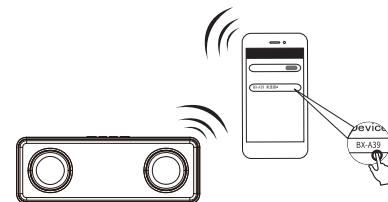
Operation manual

1. Power on/off: long press the on/off button for 2 seconds (power on/off beep);
2. Music play/pause: short press the on/off button once (under the music playing status); and
3. Music volume: long press the next key to increase the volume, long press the previous key to decrease the volume (under the music playing state);
4. Music switching: short press the next key to switch to the next song, short press the previous key to switch to the previous song (under the music playing state);

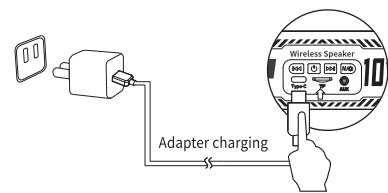
5. Coupling: double-click the next song key to automatically couple (under the wireless mode not connected state);
6. Lighting: short press M key to switch lighting;
7. Mode switching: long press M key to switch mode.

Pairing with devices

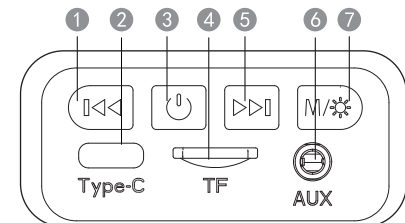


USB interface:

- ① Previous song key: can switch to the previous song, volume down
- ② DC: insert the charging cable to the speaker charging port
- ③ Switch: turn on and off the speaker, music play/pause
- ④ TF: insert TF card to recognize and play music
- ⑤ Next key: you can switch the next song, volume up, double-click couplet mode
- ⑥ AUX: insert AUX cable to enter AUX mode
- ⑦ Mode: mode conversion, switch the lighting mode

Troubleshooting

If the following "actions" do not solve your problem, please stop using this product and contact the dealer who purchased the product.

1. What should I do if the speaker cannot be connected?
Please check if your speaker audio source (mobile phone or computer etc.) has a built-in blue Wireless functionality, if so, please turn the wireless mode on and search for a wireless speaker connection or restart the wireless speaker.
2. What should I do if the machine operation does not respond?
Please make sure that the wireless speaker is charged, if not please charge it in time.

Precautions

- Do not drop, crush, disassemble or pierce this product.

- Do not charge the battery higher than the rating.
- The maximum temperature during charging cannot exceed 45°C.
