




Installation instructions:



1. Install the lampshade on the lamp base




2. Lock the lamp cap nut



3. Install the bulb into the base

(Don't tighten the bulb too hard, or the bulb will be poorly contacted, just feel slight resistance)



Introduction of keys:

- 1. Touch switch: touch to turn on, hold on to touch to turn off
- 2. Power key: function mode
- 3. Time set/Bluetooth playback pause
- 4. - key
- 5. + key
- 6. VOL - key
- 7. VOL + key

Product Function Introduction:

1. Touch switch: three levels brightness (low, medium and high) can be adjusted
2. Dual alarm clocks: three alarm times available (Mon to Fri, Sat to Sun, Mon to Sun)
3. Bluetooth supported: connected with playback devices
4. Dual output port: USB + USB-C
5. LED display: two levels brightness (Exit Bluetooth mode, hold on to press 1 to adjust)
6. Twelve-hour clock (AM/PM): automatically calibrates the time when bluetooth connected

Warm Tips

When you set clock and alarm clock, pls exit bluetooth mode.

When the alarm clock rings, bluetooth will exit automatically, pls connect again after alarm clock ends.

When the table lamp is unplugged or power cut, it will factory reset, pls set again.

Bluetooth Setting

Enter Mode	Press ① to enter bluetooth mode, "BT" will flash on the display screen, there will be voice prompt after connected CA0503BT
Function Selection	Press ▶ to play/pause music, press ◀ to play the last song, press ▶ to play the next song
Vol Setting	Press or hold on to press ◀ to reduce vol, press or hold on to press ▶ to increase vol

Clock Setting

Pls press ① to exit bluetooth mode before set clock time, "BT" off	
Enter Mode	Hold on to press ▶ , enter the time set mode
Manual Setting	Press ◀ to adjust hour, press ▶ to adjust minute, wait the digits stop flashing, save automatically
Auto Setting	Time will be automatically synchronized when bluetooth connected (PS: Time automatically updates with iOS system; Time can be only updated after information authorized with Android system)

Alarm Clock Setting

AL1 Setting (Pls press ① to exit bluetooth mode before set AL1, "BT" off)	
AL1 State	Press ◀ to turn on or turn off AL1, AL1 state shows on the display screen
Enter Mode	Hold on to press ◀ until the digits flash to enter the AL1 setting.
Setting Steps	Press ◀ to adjust hour, press ▶ to adjust minute → press ◀ to enter AL1 time selection, press ▶ or ◀ to select AL1 time(1-5, 6-7, 1-7) → wait the digits stop flashing, save automatically (default ringtone, the volume will gradually increase)
Ditch the Alarm Clock	Press ◀ or ① to turn off when AL1 rings
AL2 Setting (Pls press ① to exit bluetooth mode before set AL2, "BT" off)	
AL2 State	Press ◀ to turn on or turn off AL2, AL2 state shows on the display screen.
Enter Mode	Hold on to press ◀ until the digits flash to enter the AL2 setting.
Setting Steps	Press ◀ to adjust hour, press ▶ to adjust minute → press ◀ to enter AL2 time selection, press ▶ or ◀ to select AL2 time(1-5, 6-7, 1-7) → wait the digits stop flashing, save automatically (default ringtone, the volume will gradually increase)
Ditch the Alarm Clock	Press ◀ or ① to turn off when AL2 rings
