

## Wireless Earbud User Manual

### Bluetooth Headset Parameters:

1. Bluetooth Version: BT5.3
  2. Bluetooth Protocol: HSP1.2, HFP1.6, A2DP1.3, AVCP1.5
  3. Rated Voltage: 3.7V
  4. Frequency: 2.4G

### Button Description

#### The Keyboard

1. Start Up: Open The Charging Compartment And Take Out The Headset. The Headset Will Start Up Automatically, Or Long Press The Button For 3 Seconds To Start Up
2. Shutdown: The Headset Will Automatically Shut Down When Put Into The Charging Compartment, Or Long Press The Button For 5 Seconds To Shut Down
3. Play/pause: Click One Of The Headset Buttons To Pause The Play And Then Click To Play Again
4. Answer/hang Up The Phone: When A Call Comes In, Click One Of The Headphone Keys To Answer The Call. To End The Call, Click One Of The Headphone Keys To End The Call
5. Last Song: Double-click The Left Earphone Button
6. Next Song: Double-click The Right Earphone Button
7. Volume Up: Hit The Left Earphone Button Three Times
8. Volume Reduction: Hit The Right Earphone Button Three Times
9. Wake Up Siri: Hold Down The Button For 3 Seconds While The Headset Is Connected To Your Phone
10. After Connecting The Phone With The Headset, Four Clicks On One Of The Headset Buttons Can Switch The Game Mode Or Music Mode

### Pair Connection

1. Open The Charging Compartment And Take Out The Earphone. When The Earphone Has Been Connected With The Mobile Phone, It Will Automatically Pair With The Mobile Phone, And The Indicator Light Will Go Out After The Connection
2. When The Headset Is Powered Off, Long Press The Two Headset Buttons To Power On. After The Headphones Are Paired, The Indicator Of The Main Headset Will Be On
3. After The Headset Is Successfully Paired For The First Time, The Headset Will Be Automatically Paired And Connected To The Device That Has Been Connected

### Headphone Indicator Description

1. Power On: The Blue Indicator Blinks For 2 Seconds And Goes Off
2. Shutdown: The Red Light Blinks For 2 Seconds And Goes Off. The Red Light Will Be On When It Is Put Into The Warehouse For Charging
3. The Left And Right Headphones Are Paired Successfully: The Blue Indicator Of The Left Headset Is On
4. The Headset Is Successfully Connected To The Mobile Phone: The Red And Blue Lights Are Off
5. The Earphone Is Disconnected From The Mobile Phone: The Blue Light Of The Left Earphone Is On
6. Left And Right Earphones Are Not Paired: Red And Blue Lights Flash Quickly

### Charging Bin Function Description

1. Use A 5v/1a Power Adapter To Charge The Charging Box
2. Use The Charging Cable Of The Corresponding Port To Charge. When Charging, The Charging Box Displays Charging Or The Charging Indicator Is On
3. The Headset Will Charge Automatically When Placed In The Charging Case
4. The Charging Case Will Display 100 When Fully Charged, Or The Charging Indicator Will Change Color
