

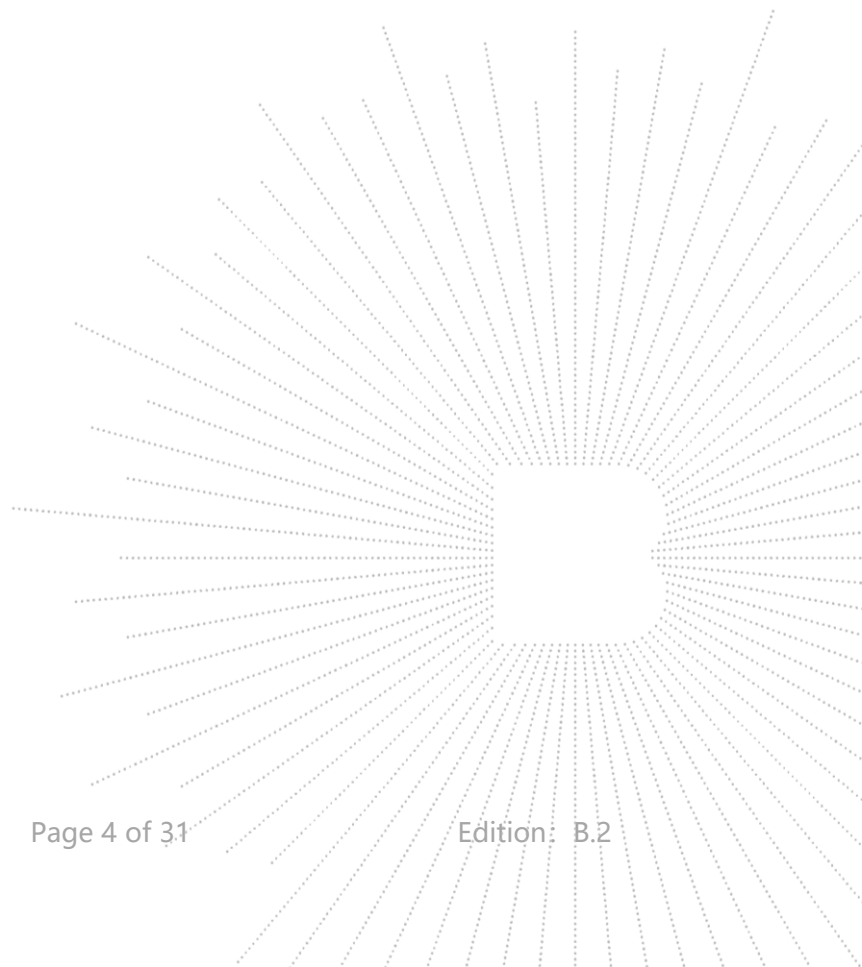

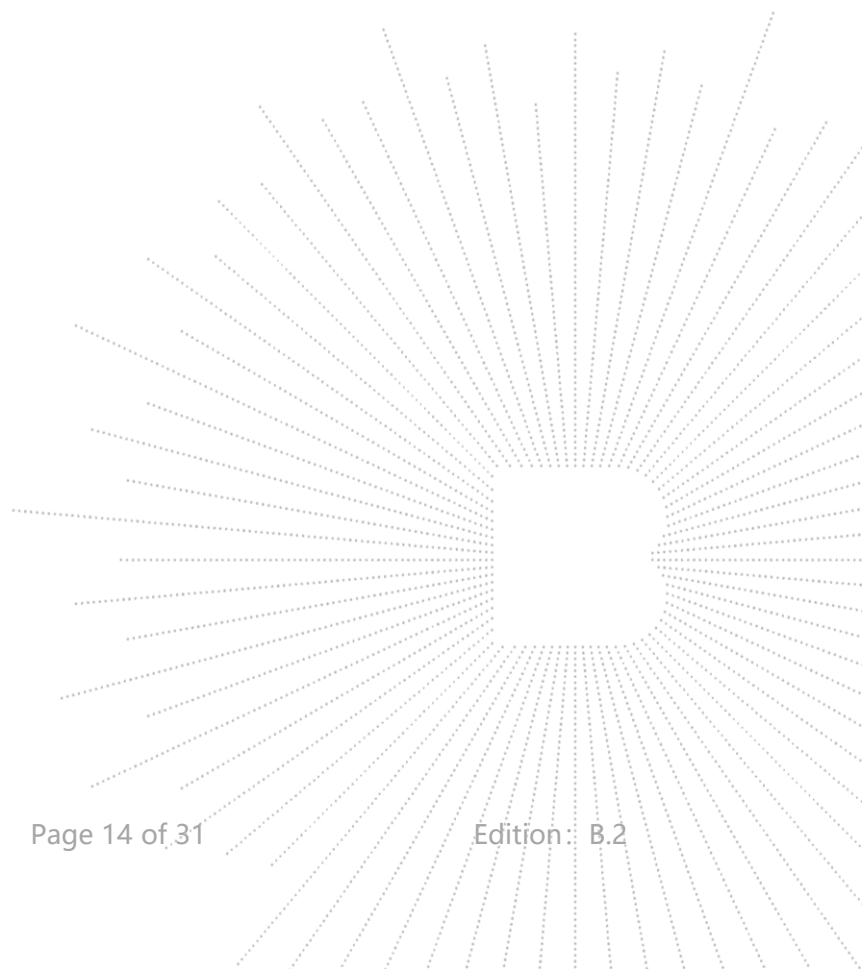

4.6 Measurement Results Explanation Example

For all conducted test items:

The offset level is set in the spectrum analyzer to compensate the RF cable loss and attenuator factor between RF conducted output port and spectrum analyzer. With the offset compensation, the spectrum analyzer reading level will be exactly the RF output level. The spectrum analyzer offset is derived from RF cable loss and attenuator factor. Offset = RF cable loss + attenuator factor.

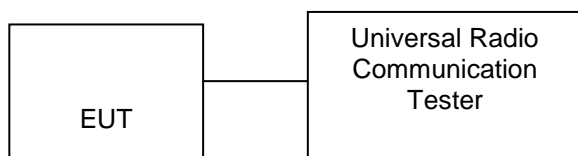

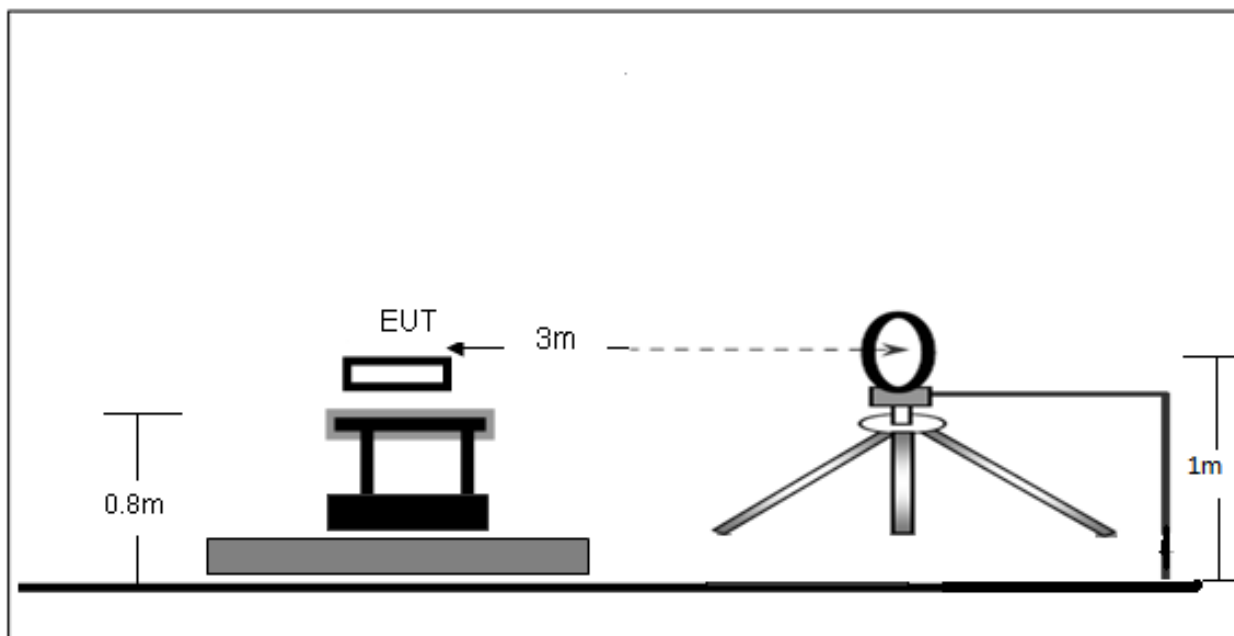
6.1 Block Diagram Of Test Setup

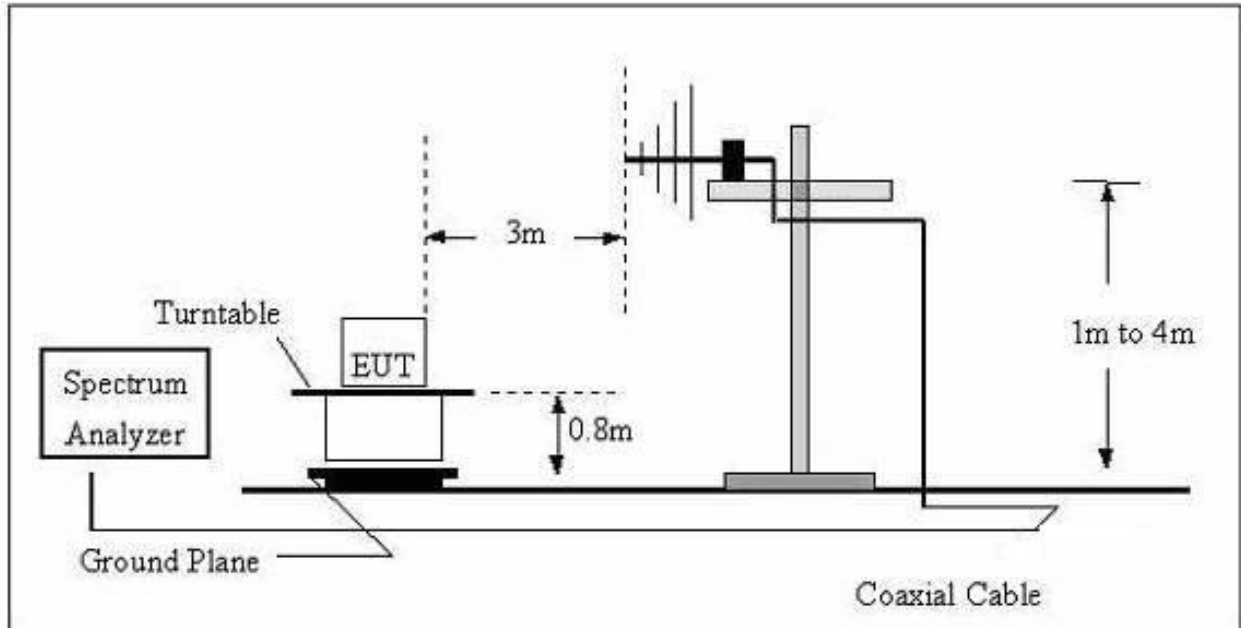


Radiated power test method:

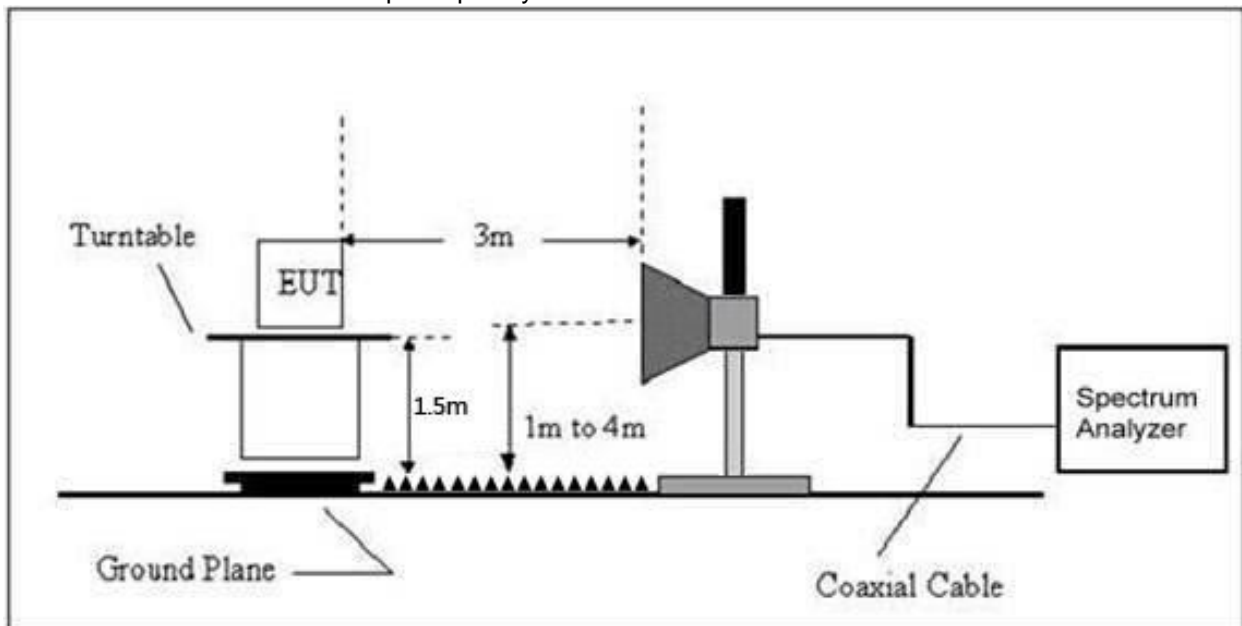
(A) Radiated Emission Test-Up Frequency Below 30MHz

6.2 Limit

According to §22.913(a)(2), The ERP of mobile and portable stations transmitters and auxiliary test transmitters must not exceed 7 Watts.

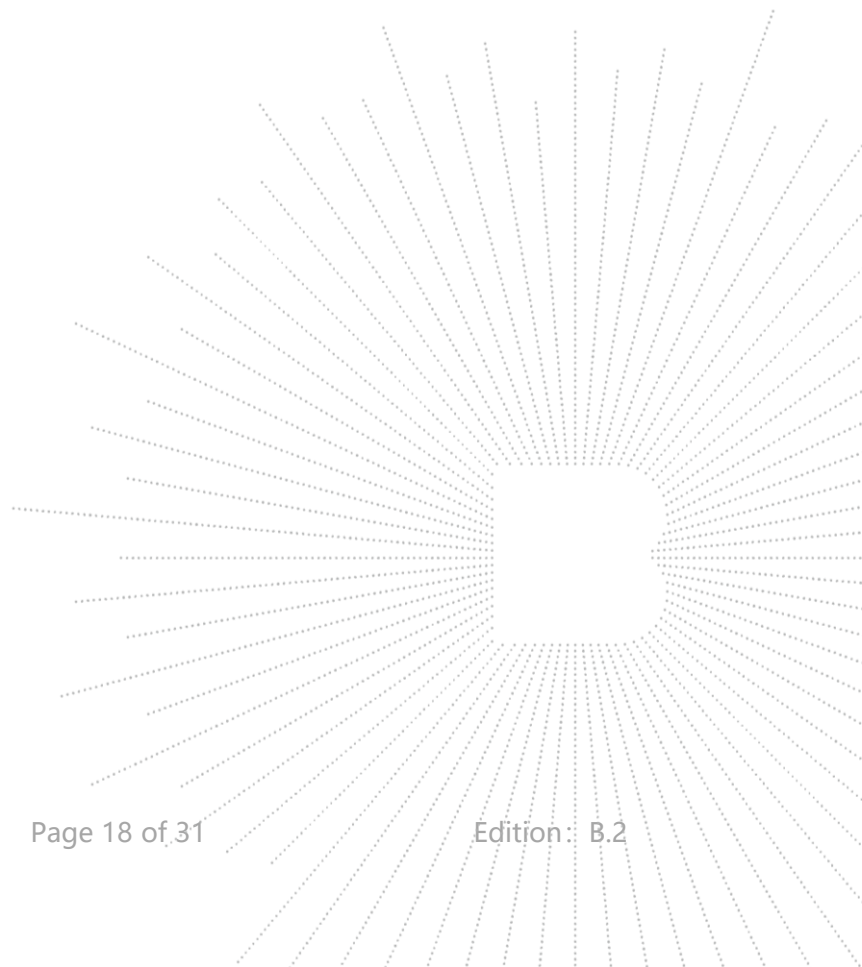
According to §24.232 (c), Mobile and portable stations are limited to 2 watts EIRP and the equipment must employ a means for limiting power to the minimum necessary for successful communications.

According to §27.50(d)(4), Fixed, mobile, and portable (hand-held) stations operating in the 1710-1755 MHz band and mobile and portable stations operating in the 1695-1710 MHz and 1755-1780 MHz bands are limited to 1 watt EIRP.

6.3 Test procedure

Radiated power test method:

1. The setup of EUT is according with per ANSI/TIA Standard 603D and ANSI C63.4-2014 measurement procedure.
2. The measurement antenna was placed at a distance of 3 meters from the EUT. During the tests, the antenna height and polarization as well as EUT azimuth were varied in order to identify the maximum level of emissions from the EUT. The test was performed by placing the EUT on 3-orthogonal axis.
3. The frequency range up to tenth harmonic of the fundamental frequency was investigated.
4. Remove the EUT and replace it with substitution antenna. A signal generator was connected to the substitution antenna by a non-radiating cable. The absolute levels of the spurious emissions were measured by the substitution.

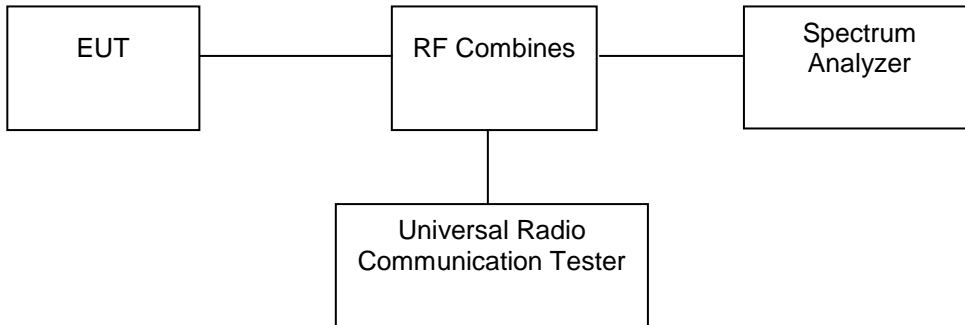

7. Peak-To-Average Ratio(PAR) Of Transmitter

7.1 Block Diagram Of Test Setup



7.2 Limit

According to §24.232(d), Power measurements for transmissions by stations authorized under this section may be made either in accordance with a Commission-approved average power technique or in compliance with paragraph (e) of this section. In both instances, equipment employed must be authorized in accordance with the provisions of §24.51. In measuring transmissions in this band using an average power technique, the peak-to-average ratio (PAR) of the transmission may not exceed 13 dB.

According to §27.50(B), the peak-to-average power ratio (PAPR) of the transmitter output power must not exceed 13 dB. The PAPR measurements should be made using either an instrument with complementary cumulative distribution function (CCDF) capabilities to determine that PAPR will not exceed 13 dB for more than 0.1 percent of the time or other Commission approved procedure. The measurement must be performed using a signal corresponding to the highest PAPR expected during periods of continuous transmission.

7.3 Test procedure

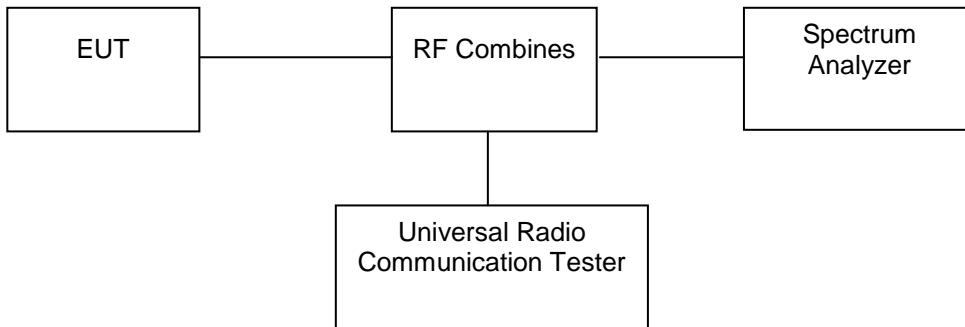
The RF output terminal of the transmitter was connected to the input of the spectrum analyzer via a suitable attenuation. The RBW of the spectrum analyzer was set to 30kHz and the peak-to-average ratio (PAR) of the transmission was recorded. Record the maximum PAPR level associated with a probability of 0.1%.

8.2 Standard Applicable

According to §22.917(b), The emission bandwidth is defined as the width of the signal between two points, one below the carrier center frequency and one above the carrier center frequency, outside of which all emissions are attenuated at least 26 dB below the transmitter power.

According to §24.238(b), The emission bandwidth is defined as the width of the signal between two points, one below the carrier center frequency and one above the carrier center frequency, outside of which all emissions are attenuated at least 26 dB below the transmitter power.

According to §27.53, The emission bandwidth is defined as the width of the signal between two points, one below the carrier center frequency and one above the carrier center frequency, outside of which all emissions are attenuated at least 26 dB below the transmitter power.

8.3 Test procedure

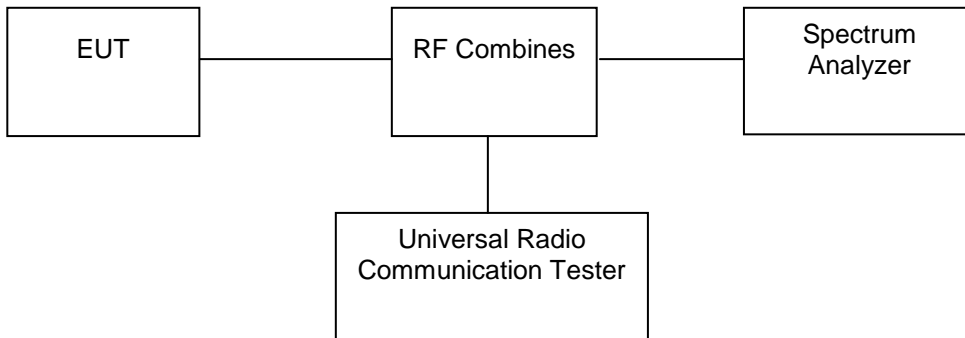
1. The testing follows FCC KDB 971168 D01v03 Section 4.2.
2. The EUT was connected to the spectrum analyzer and system simulator via a power divider.
3. The RF output of the EUT was connected to the spectrum analyzer by RF cable and attenuator. The path loss was compensated to the results for each measurement.

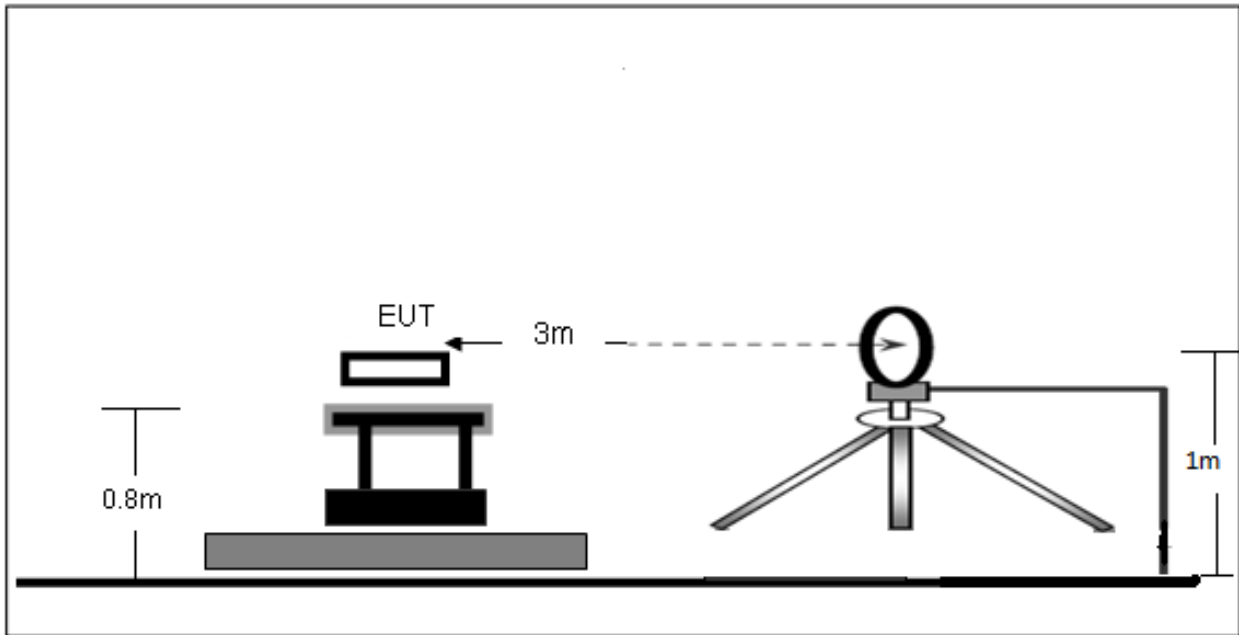

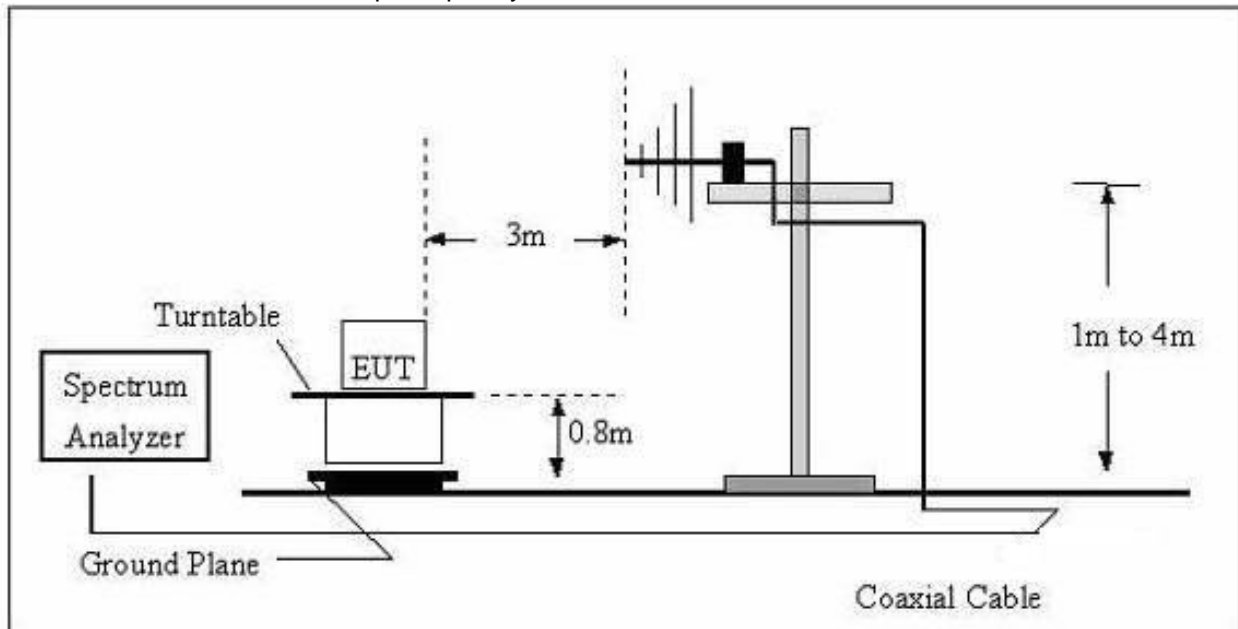

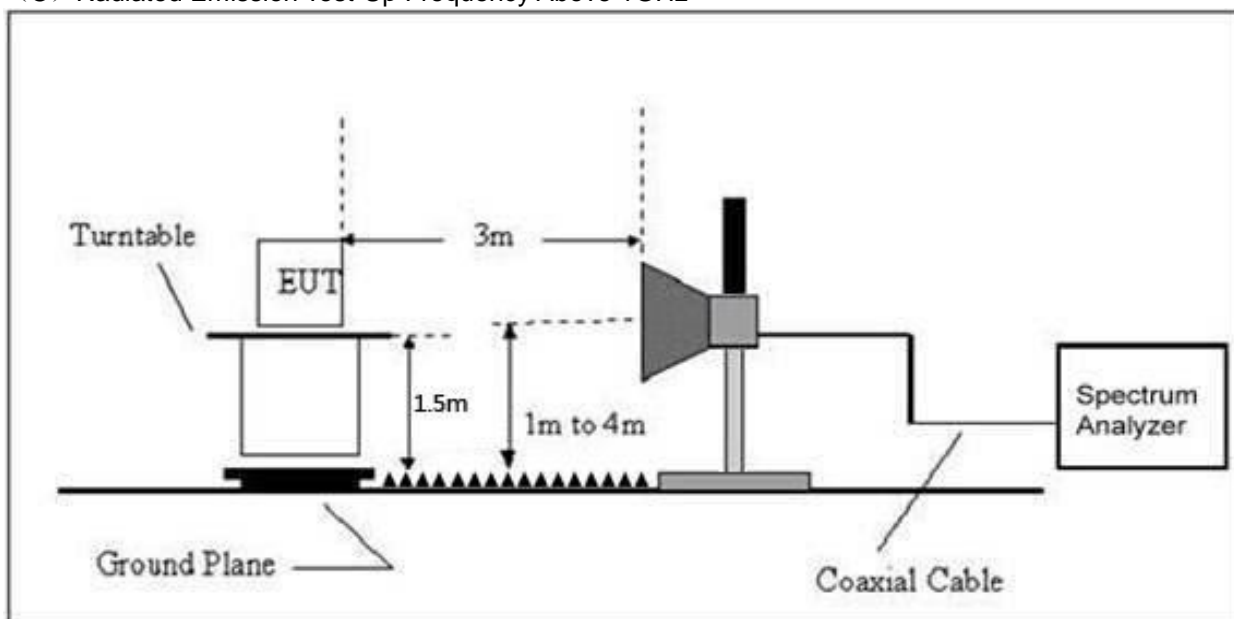
(A) Radiated Emission Test-Up Frequency Below 30MHz

1. The setup of EUT is according with per ANSI/TIA Standard 603D and ANSI C63.4-2014 measurement procedure.
 2. The measurement antenna was placed at a distance of 3 meters from the EUT. During the tests, the antenna height and polarization as well as EUT azimuth were varied in order to identify the maximum level of emissions from the EUT. The test was performed by placing the EUT on 3-orthogonal axis.
 3. The frequency range up to tenth harmonic of the fundamental frequency was investigated.
 4. Remove the EUT and replace it with substitution antenna. A signal generator was connected to the substitution antenna by a non-radiating cable. The absolute levels of the spurious emissions were measured by the substitution.

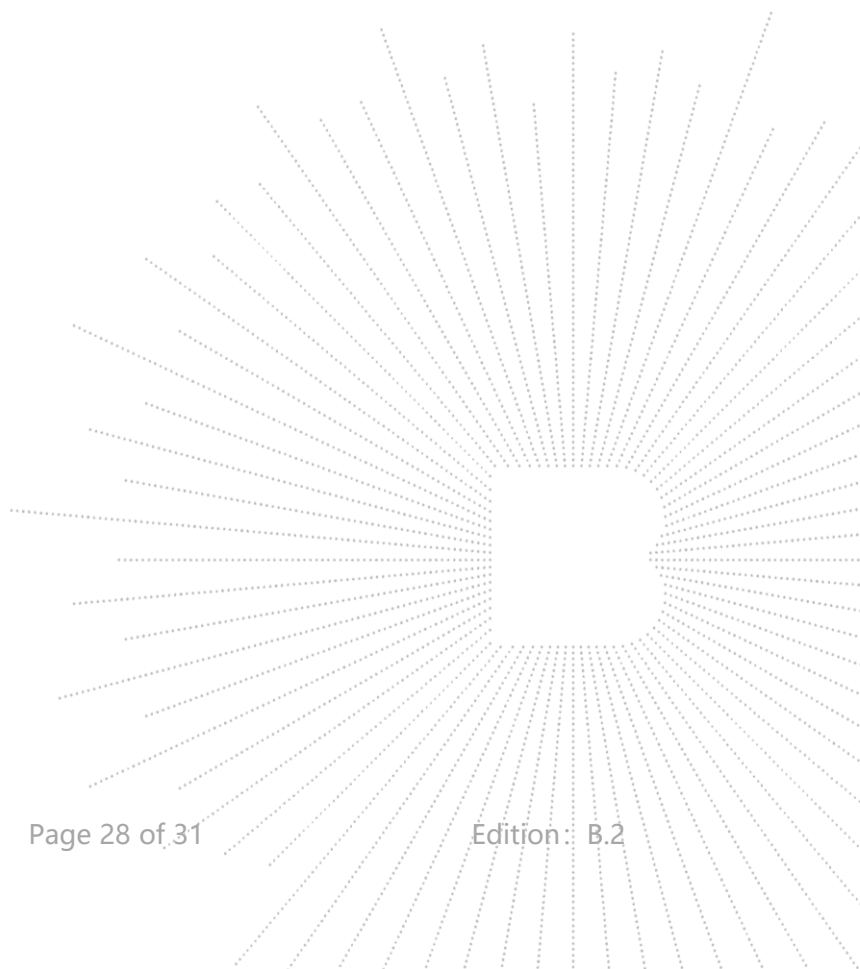

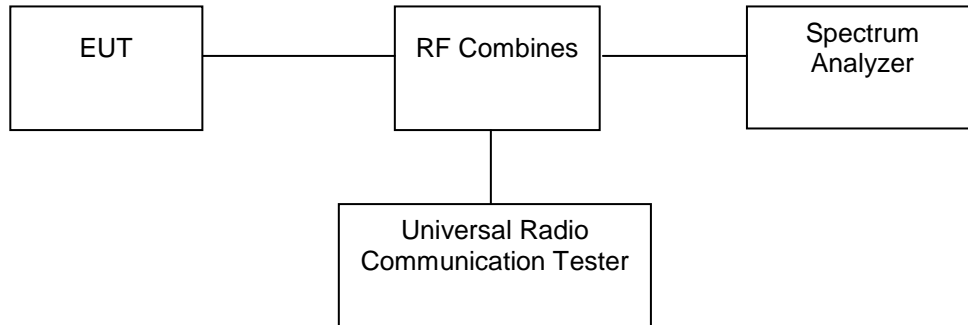

11.3 Test procedure

Test Procedures for Temperature Variation

1. The testing follows FCC KDB 971168 D01v03 Section 9.0.
2. The EUT was set up in the thermal chamber and connected with the system simulator.
3. With power OFF, the temperature was decreased to -30°C and the EUT was stabilized before testing. Power was applied and the maximum change in frequency was recorded within one minute.
4. With power OFF, the temperature was raised in 10°C steps up to 50°C. The EUT was stabilized at each step for at least half an hour. Power was applied and the maximum frequency change was recorded within one minute.

Test Procedures for Voltage Variation

1. The testing follows FCC KDB 971168 D01v03 Section 9.0.
2. The EUT was placed in a temperature chamber at 25±5° C and connected with the system simulator.
3. The power supply voltage to the EUT was varied from BEP to 115% of the nominal value measured at the input to the EUT.
4. The variation in frequency was measured for the worst case.
5. The worst case(worst bandwidth) for frequency stability reported in the Test Data.

The worst bandwidth is as follow:

- 1.4M is for LTE Band 2, 1.4M is for LTE Band 4,
- 1.4M is for LTE Band 5, 1.4M is for LTE Band 12,
- 5M is for LTE Band 13, 1.4M is for LTE Band 66, 5M is for LTE Band 71
