










Connection Lost

When speaker loses connection, voice prompt: "disconnected". Blue LED stays on until auto connection or auto shut down occurs.

PAIRING TO DEVICE

Hi-Jack Mode

POWER BANK FEATURES



TO CHARGE YOUR DEVICES

- 1. Connect the USB-C cable to the Range's output port.
- 2. Connect the other port to your device.
- 3. Your device should automatically start charging.
- 4. When the your device is fully charged, disconnect the Range

LISTEN



The Range is built to go anywhere, but for optimal sound quality follow the steps below:

- · Make sure the Range is resting on its base and facing upwards.
- When connected wirelessly via Bluetooth, it's best to turn the volume on your phone/device fully up and when you use the volume control (-/+) on the Range


