INSTRUCTIONS

Operation

Speaker automatically detects the external device to identify Bluetooth/AUX-N mode. Inserting SD card automatically recognizes the player, SD card is priority over Bluetooth.

Button Instructions

- **1.POWER:** press this button for 3 seconds to turn it on, press this button for 3 seconds again to turn it off. Press this button one time to play the music, press it again to pause.
- 2.[-]: Previous song/Volume down keep pressing the button to adjust the volume down; short press this button to play the previous track
- 3.[+]: Next song/Volume keep pressing this button to adjust the volume up; short press this button, play the next track
- 4.[M]: press this button to switch between the functions: Bluetooth, AUX-IN, SD card.
- 5.[LIGHT]: press this button to turn on or off the light or switch between multiple color & light modes.
- 6.[AUX-IN]: AUX jack
- 7.[TF]: Insert SD card to play MP3 music

Connecting via Bluetooth

- 1.If the speaker is on and there is no AUX-IN or SD card, it will enter Bluetooth mode and the blue light will flash while Bluetooth is waiting for connection. Once connected, the blue light will flash 3 times, then remain on.
- 2.Turn on the Bluetooth function of mobile devices (cell phones, computers, etc..), search for Bluetooth devices, "Bandit Sports Speaker", then you can complete device pairing.
