- 1. Power on: Press and hold the camera button for 3 seconds.
- 2. Bluetooth selfie and phone connection steps:
- (1). Press and hold the Bluetooth selfie camera button for 3 seconds to turn on, the LED indicator light flashes, and the Bluetooth selfie starts pairing with the phone.



(2) On the Bluetooth page of your phone, click on "KJ remote" in the "Available Devices" section




(3). Press and hold the Bluetooth selfie camera button for 3 seconds to turn on, the LED indicator light flashes, and the Bluetooth selfie starts pairing with the phone.



(4) The "Paired Devices" page displays "KJ remote connected", and the Bluetooth selfie is successfully connected to the phone.

- 2. Bluetooth name: RS2607110
- 4. Connection distance: At least 10 meters.
- 5. After successfully pairing the Bluetooth selfie, press the photo button once, the LED indicator light will flash, and the phone can take photos.
- 6. After 3 minutes of booting up, the pairing was not successful, and the LED indicator light flashed twice before turning off. The Bluetooth selfie entered sleep mode.

- 7. After the Bluetooth selfie is successfully connected, there is no operation for 5 minutes, and the LED indicator light flashes twice before turning off. The Bluetooth selfie is disconnected from the phone and enters sleep mode. After restarting, there is no need to match Bluetooth again to automatically connect.
- 8. Shutdown: Press and hold the camera button for 3 seconds, the LED indicator light will flash quickly twice and then turn off, and the Bluetooth selfie and phone will be disconnected.
