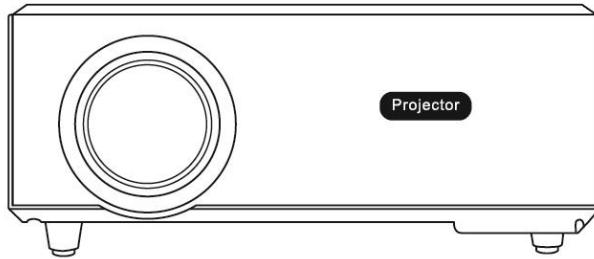

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**Precautions:**

- Please read this manual thoroughly before operating this projector.
- Please use the correct power cord for the country you are located.
- Do not look straight into the projector lens while on, as it may cause serious eye damage.
- Do not block any ventilation openings as it may lead the overheating. It is normal for the projector to generate heat when in use.
- Do not expose the projector to rain or moisture to reduce the risk of electric shock.
- To prevent risk of overheating, place the projector in an area that does not block ventilation, such as an enclosure or cabinet that might restrict airflow.
- Do not block the light coming out of the lens. The light will heat the object and may cause burns, cause it to melt or catch fire.
- In order to mount projector on a ceiling or wall, it should be installed by using the mounting hardware to guarantee stability and safety.
- If the projector is defective, please contact the professional technician or local distributor for after service.

**Tips:**

Please turn off the projector after using it and store the projector safely.

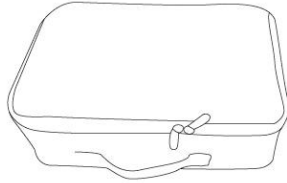
- Press the ON/OFF button in top case of projector or remote controller to power off the projector.

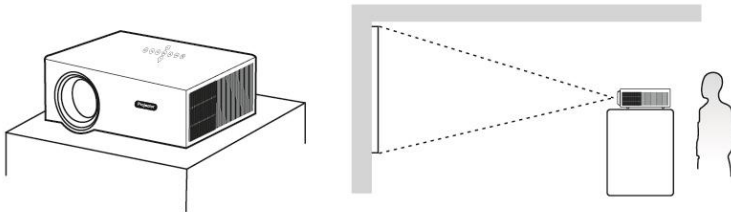


## Projector Installation

### 1. Installation and Debugging

#### 1) Front Table

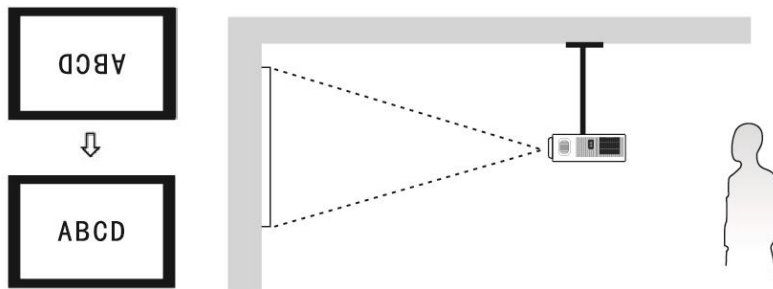
The projector must be placed horizontally in front of wall/screen, and the image will be directly projected to the wall/screen

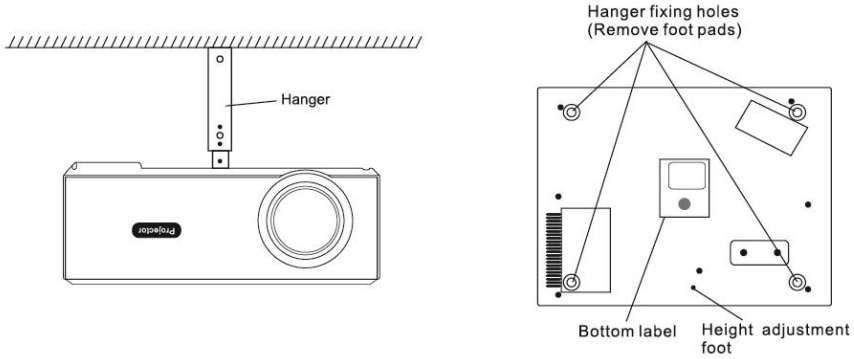


#### 2) Front Ceiling

- When the projector is installed in ceiling or wall, please use the hanger and screw of sufficient strength to avoid projector falling accident.
- When the projector is suspended from the ceiling or in a rear projection system, please change the projection direction in the settings.

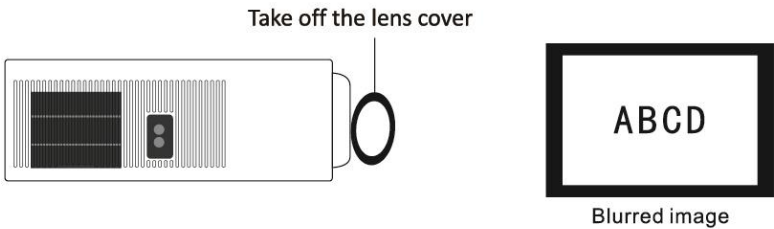
Setting Path: Projection Setting --> Projection Mode --> Front Ceiling / Rearing Ceiling



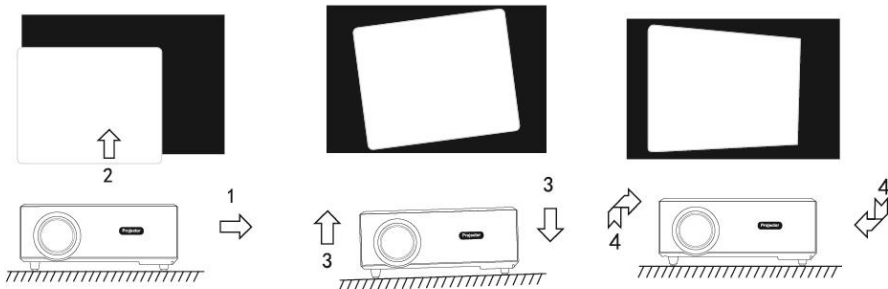


### 3) Projection Adjustment (available for non auto-focus version)

By adjusting lens focus dial wheel to realize the fantastic image. If there is blurred image, please adjust focus dial wheel to improve the image clarity. If blurred image were not improved, please move the projector forward or backward to improve the image quality.

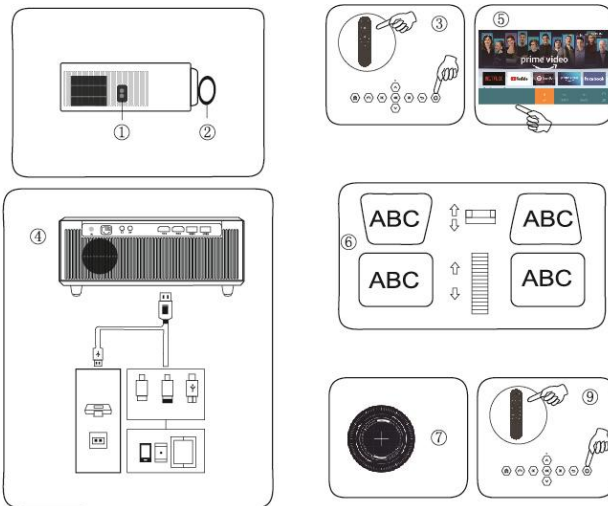


## 2. Projection Adjustment



- 1) If the screen is offset to the left or the right, please move the projector to the opposite direction till the center of the screen/wall to aim of projector lens center.
- 2) If the screen is vertical offset, please move the projector up and down till screen returns correct view.
- 3) If the screen is angular offset, please put the projector on a horizontal place.
- 4) If the projector does not face the screen directly, please turn the projector to face the screen.

### 3. Quick Start



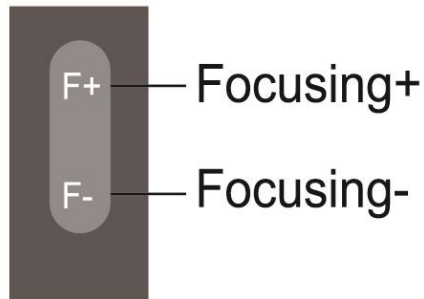
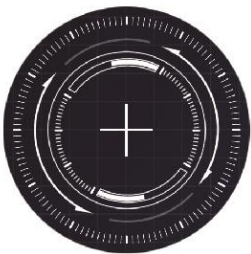
- 1) Plug the power cord into outlet.
- 2) Take off the lens cover.
- 3) Turn on the projector by press the power button on the projector panel or the remote controller.

- 4) Connect your device to the projector correctly by wired or wireless connection.
- 5) Choose the right type of file to play.
- 6) Adjust the kickstand accordingly.
- 7) After power on, the projector will be automatically focused. If the image is not perfectly clear, press “F+” or “F-” on remote controller to fine tune the clarity.
- 8) Find the menu “Projection Setting - Geometric Correction - Screen Rotate” to quick perform keystone correction.
- 9) Turn off the projector by press the power button on the projector panel or the remote controller.

#### **Automatic Focusing (available for auto-focus version projector)**

The projector will automatically adjust the “Focus” when running the interface.

1. If the clarity is not perfect, press “F+” or “F-” on remote controller to fine tune manually.





### Tips:

- If don't use "Auto-Focus", you can turn off this function  
Settings --> Projection Settings --> Auto Focus --> Off
- It is normal for the screen to be blurry when starting up, and then, the projector will automatically proceed auto focusing mode.
- Do not look into the lens during the projector is operating to avoid hurting your eyes.
- Keep the projector stably during the operating.

### Keystone Correction

1. Press and hold the menu button, and select Keystone. Press the up and down button to select 4D keystone and use the direction arrow keys to correct the keystone distortions, you can also perform keystone correction point by point.



2. The projector support automatic keystone correction, you can activate this Mode as below steps.

Homepage --> Setting Button --> Projection Setting --> Auto Keystone --> On.

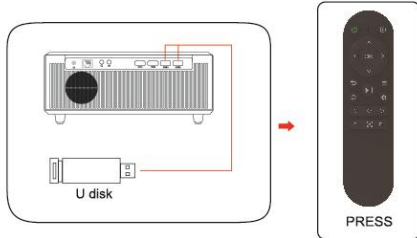


**Tips:**

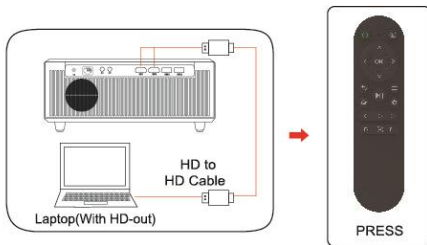
The calculation of the automatic keystone correction is based on the relative position between the projector and the projection screen. If the direction of the projector deviates too much, the “automatic keystone correction” may not achieve the good effect, and then, the electronic keystone correction is recommended.

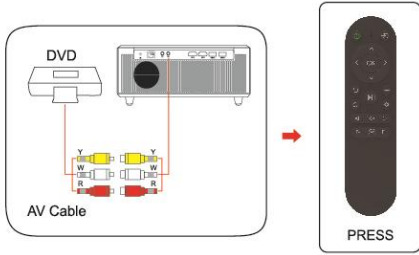

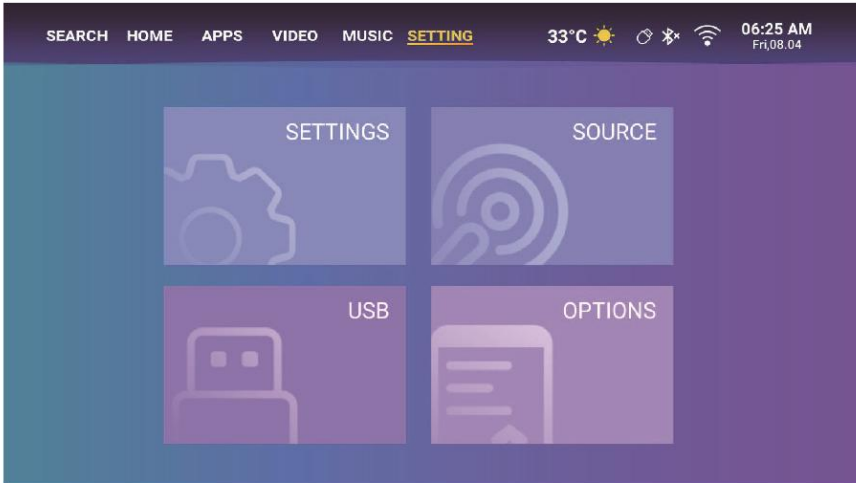

## Movie/Music/Photo/Doc Playing



1. Connect USB device with projector correctly
2. Select preferred Movie/Photo/Music/Doc accordingly
3. Press “OK” button to open multimedia file via projector or remote controller
4. Click the file folder to select the Movie/Photo/Music/Doc you would like to play
5. Press “Play” button of the projector or remote controller to play the selected file.

1) Streaming media casting mode:

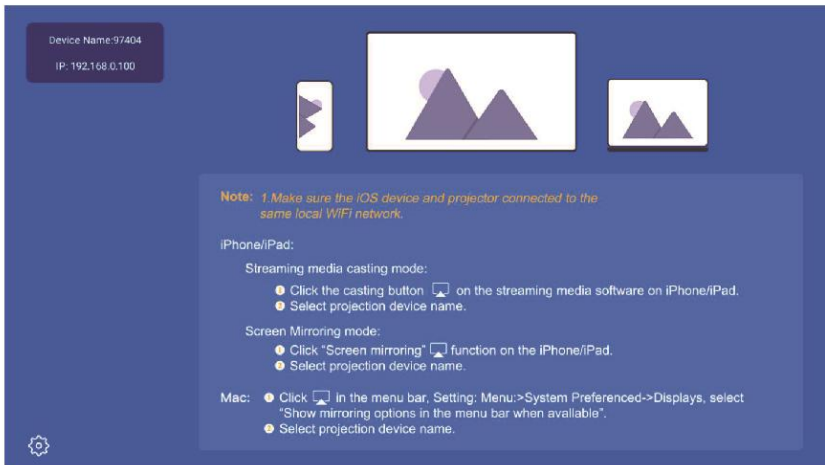
- Click the casting button  on the steaming media software on iPhone/iPad.

- Select projection device name.



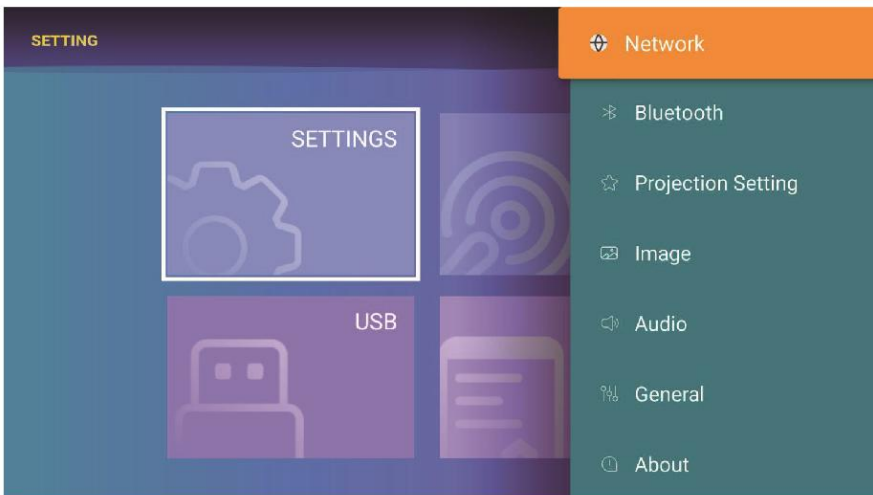
## 2. Android CAST

## Projector Settings



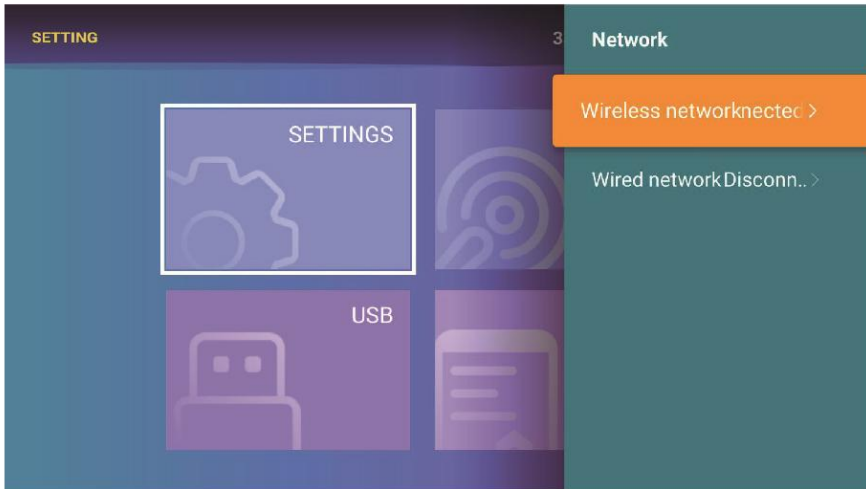
- 1) Press "SETTING" on top of homepage to enter menu as sequence: Network - Bluetooth - Projection Setting - Image - Audio - General - About.
- 2) Press UP/DOWN button to the menu you want to set up, and then, hold "OK" button

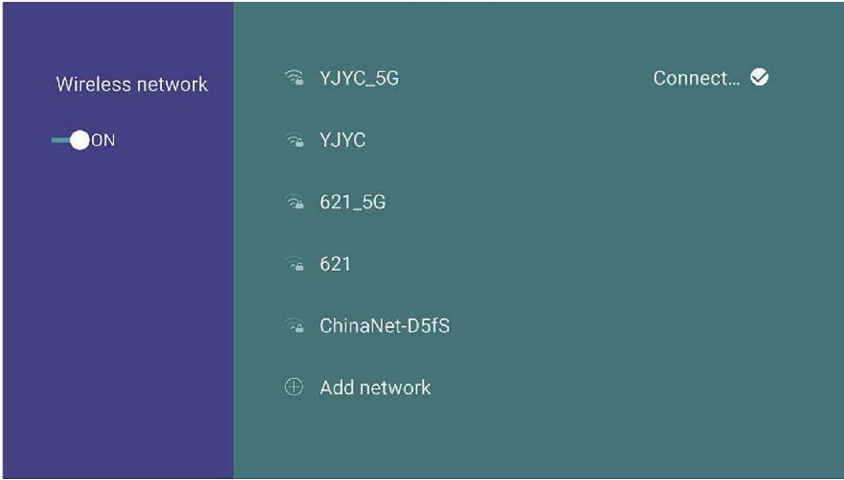
to activate sub-menu, after that, you can set the projector as you preferred performance.

3) When you finish the setting, press the “OK” button for confirmation, and press the return button to the previous menu, and press the return button again to exit and turn back the starting interface.

Note: Ensure your Bluetooth speaker is powered on , not be connected with other device.

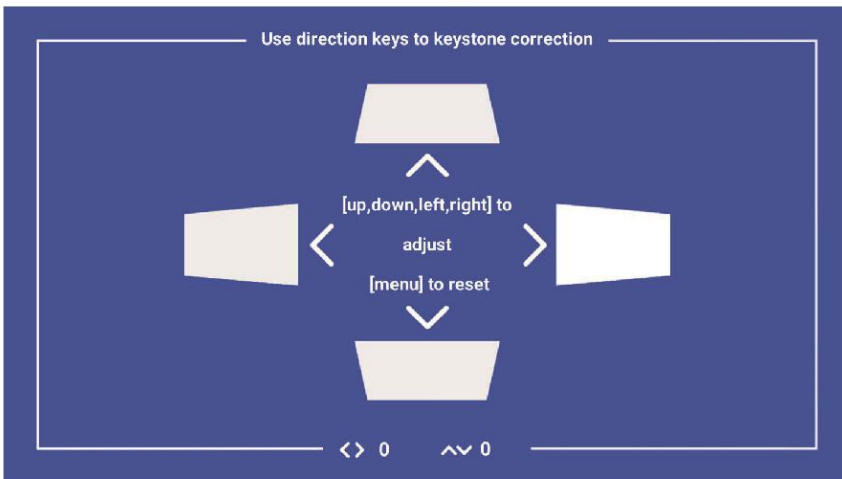
## 3. Projection Setting

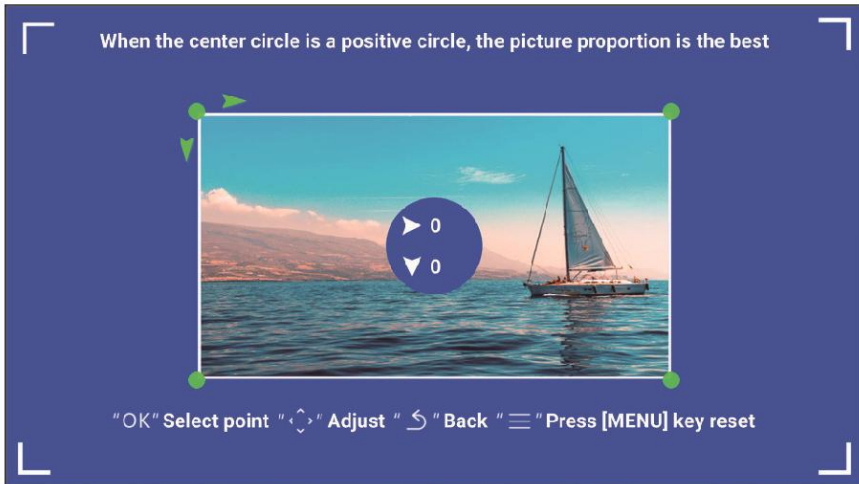


1) Keystone: Press Keystone sub-menu to activate the the correction on keystone

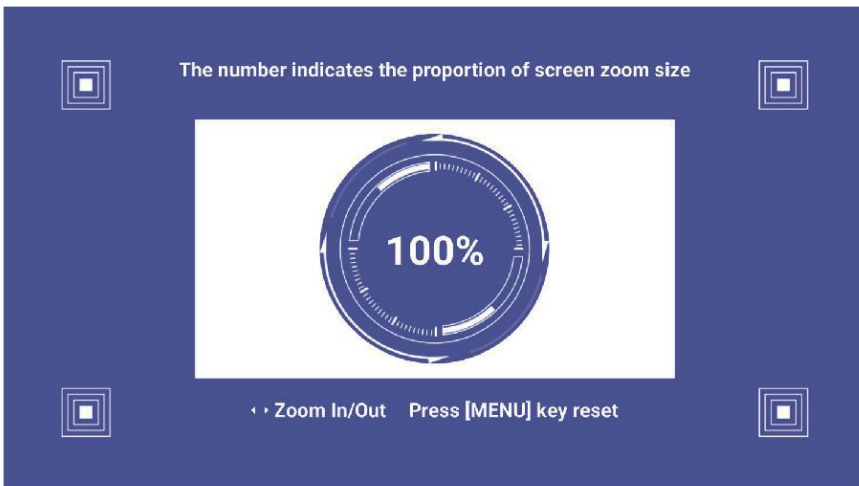

distortions. Move the UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT arrow key to the point locates in each corner of the square, and press the OK button to activate corrections by increasing or decreasing the parameters to correct the keystone distortions, you can also perform keystone correction point by point.





2) Zoom In/Out: By holding the LEFT/RIGHT button to achieve your preferred image proportion.



3) Projection mode: you can shift the projection modes among Front-Projection, Rear-Desktop, Front-Ceiling and Rear-Ceiling for various projections.

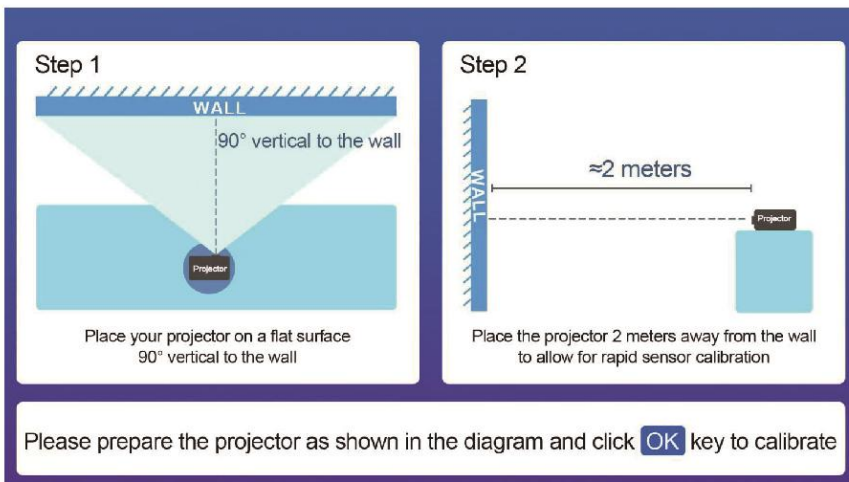




4) Calibration zero: you can calibrate the projector setting as following steps:

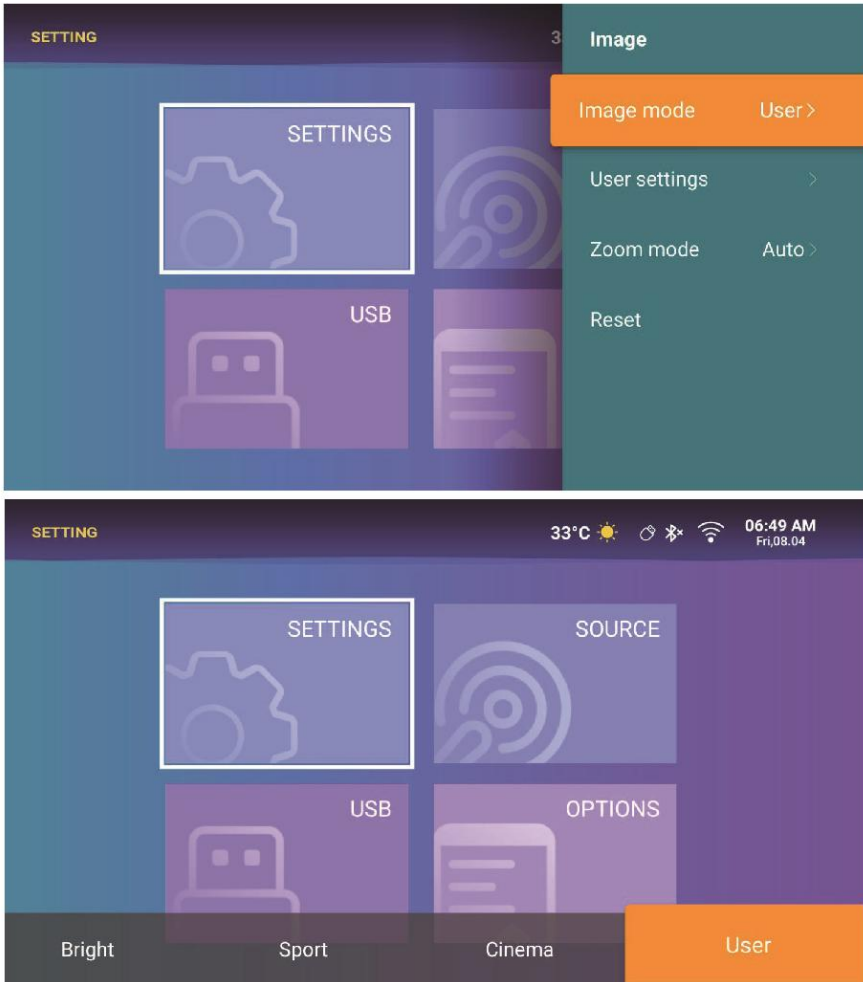
Step 1: Place your projector on a flat surface 90° vertical to the wall

Step 2: Place the projector 2 meters away from the wall to allow for rapid sensor calibration.

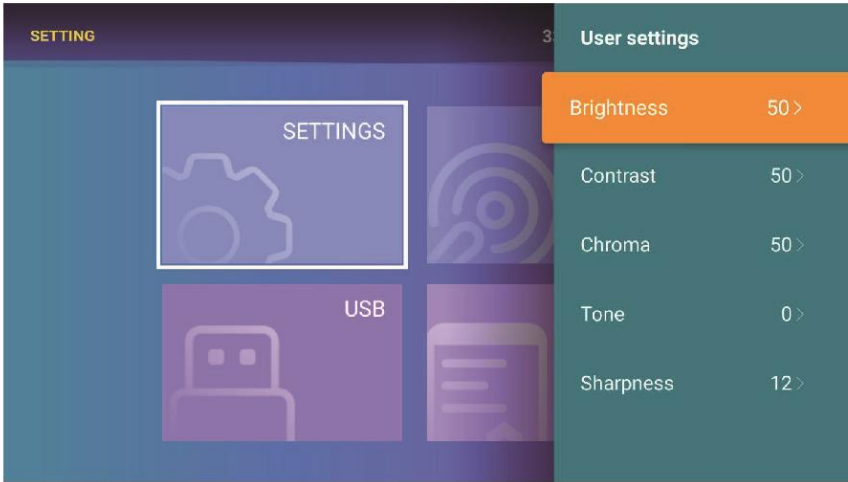


#### 4. Image

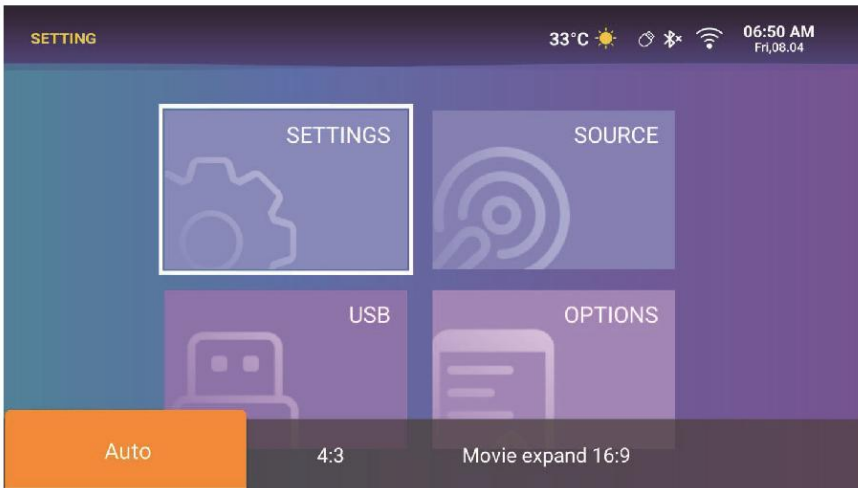
1) Image mode: shifts among the Bright, Sport, Cinema and User for different projected contents.



Note: The User setting mode is only valid once the image under the user mode, and then, the user can adjust the parameters of Brightness, Contrast, Chroma, Tone and Sharpness.



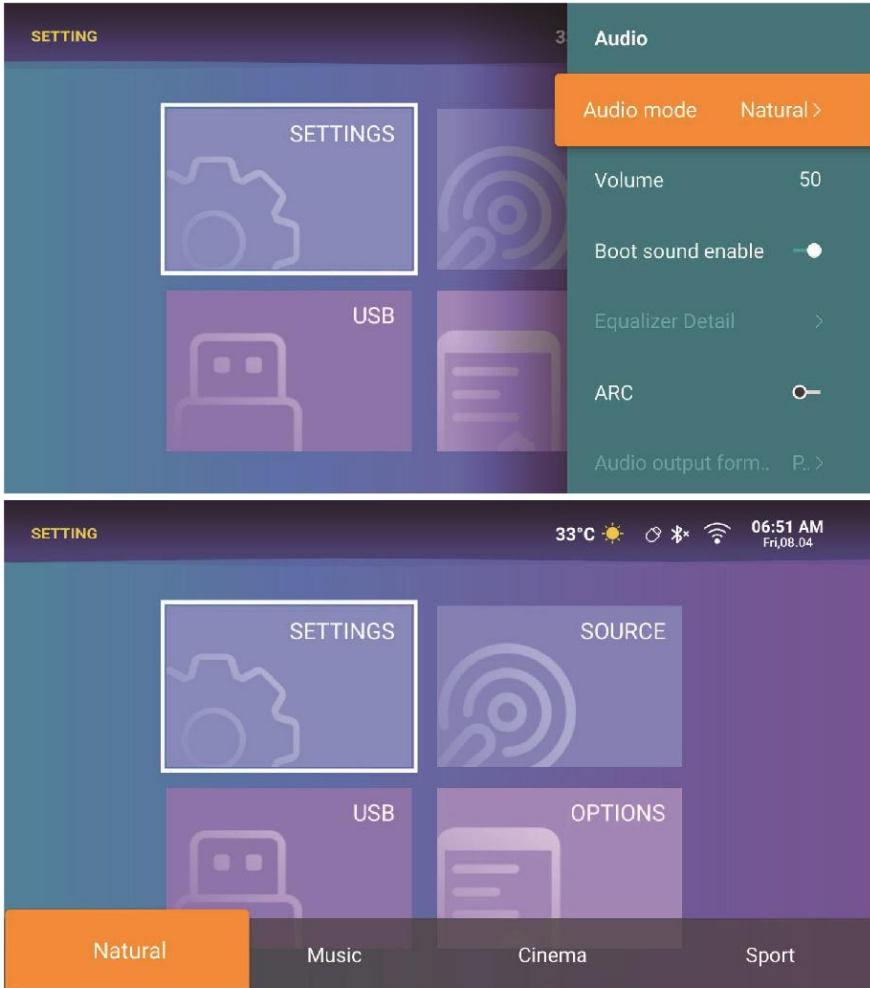
2) Zoom mode: Press the Zoom mode sub-menu to enter the zoom adjustment on image's width and height as Auto, 4:3 and Movie expand 16:9.



3) Reset: Press the Reset to return the default settings.

## 5. Audio

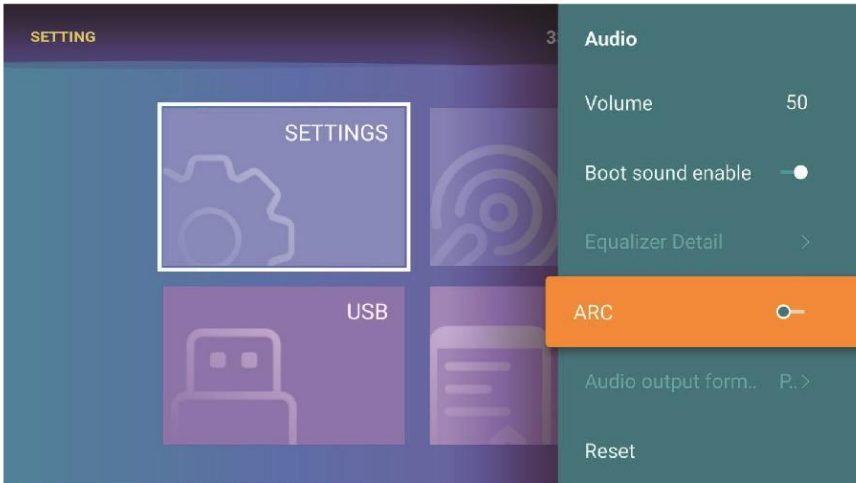
1) Audio mode: sets up the different sound pattern as Nature, Music, Cinema, Sports and User.



2) Volume: Press the sub-menu to increase or decrease the volume of sound.

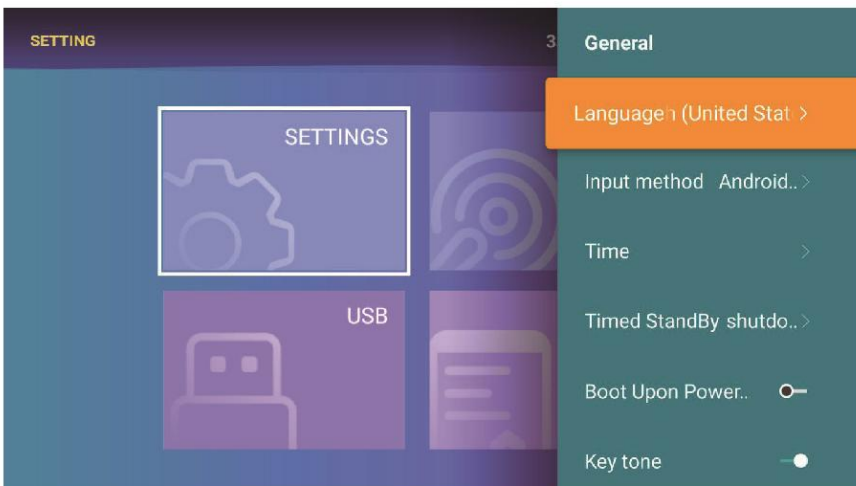
3) ARC: Press ARC to active or inactive this mode.

4) Reset: Press Reset to return the default settings.



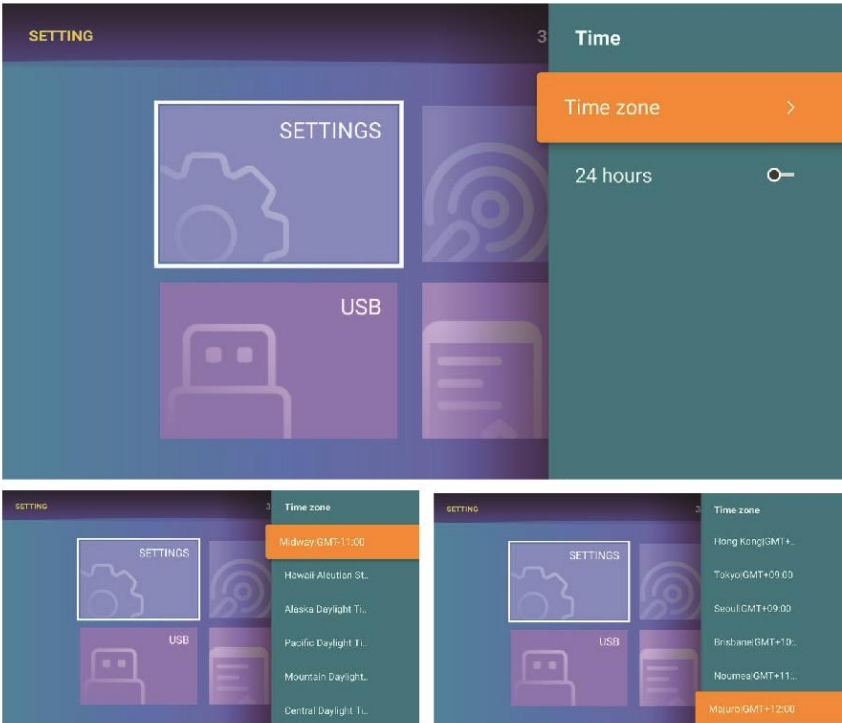
## 6. General

1) Language: Press OK button to set your preferred languages (multilingual options)

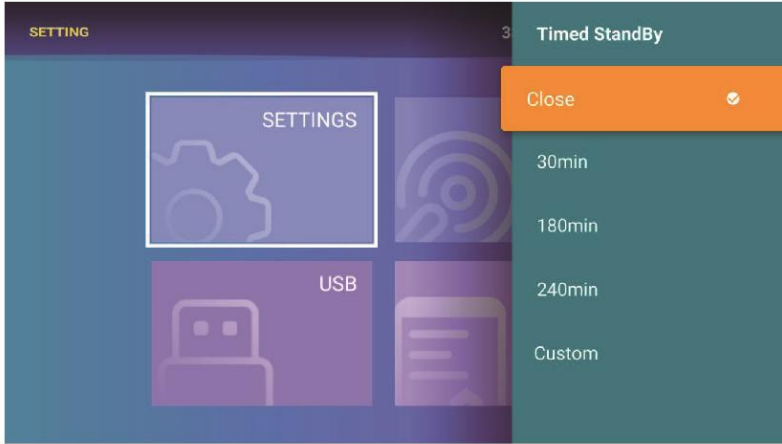




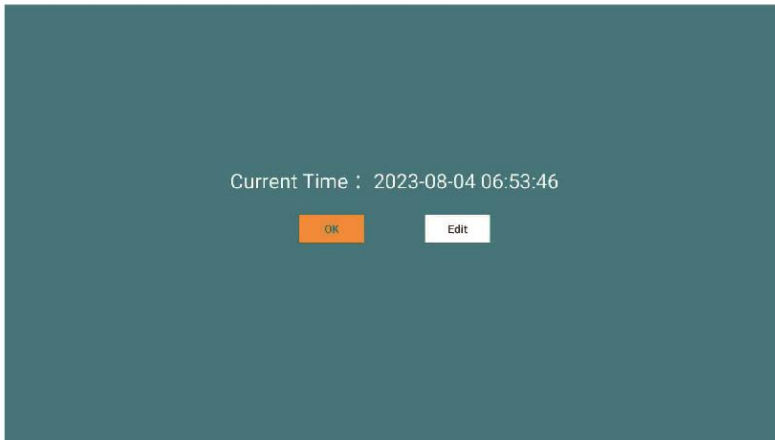
2) Time: Press OK button to set the time zone



3) Time Standby: Press OK button to set the projector standby time

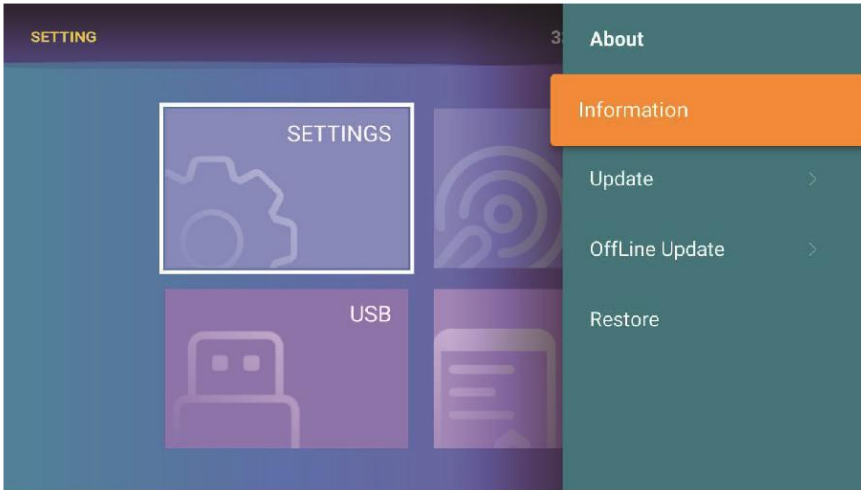


4) Network Clock: Press Network color to edit time the projector shows

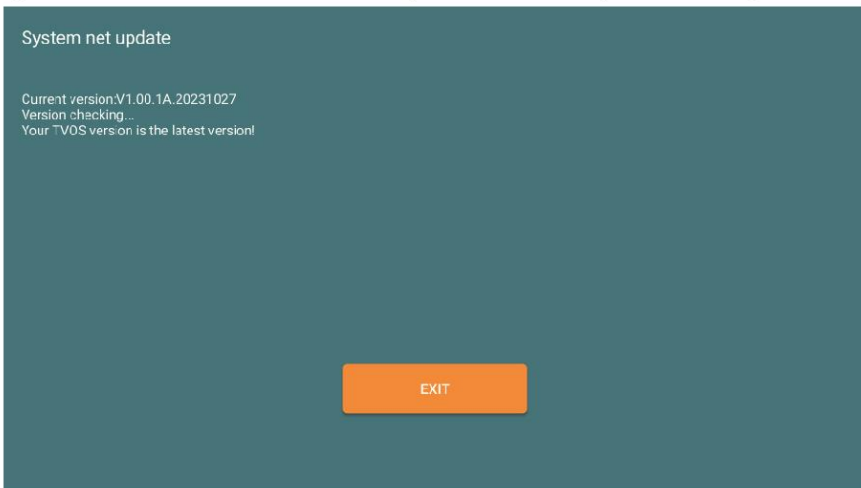


## 7. About

## Maintenance and Cleaning

### Tips:

- Before you start cleaning the projector, please make sure the power plug is unplugged



from the power outlet.

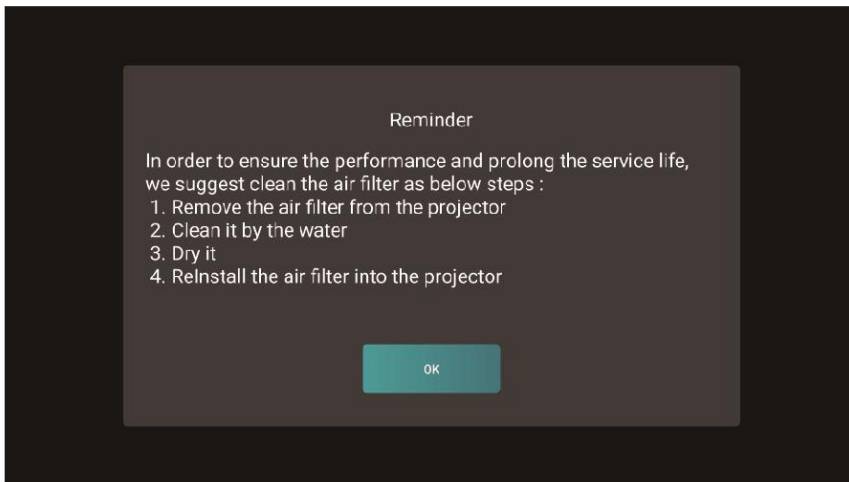
- Do not use pesticides or other volatile chemicals on the projector or lens.

### 1. Cleaning the projector

Wipe the projector with a soft and dry cotton cloth. When the projector is extremely dirty, the projector can be wiped with a soft cloth, diluted with a neutral detergent. After using the diluted cloth, dry the projector with a clean cloth. When cleaning the lens, please use a professional blower or a special glass cleaning paper to remove the dust on the lens.

### 2. Cleaning the air filter

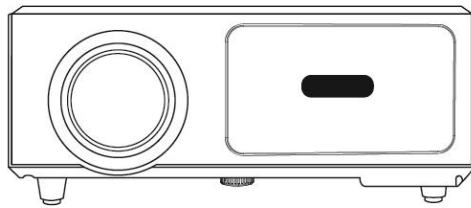
In order to ensure the performance and prolong the service life, we suggest to clean the air filter inside of cooling vent.
