Connecting with a 3.5 mm AUX Cable

Plug one connector of a 3.5 mm auxiliary cable (*not included*) into the 3.5 mm aux input port on the bottom of the right earcup. Plug the other connector into the audio output port on your media-playing device.

- In auxiliary mode, all playback and volume will be adjusted with the controls on your connected device.
- The headphones will automatically power OFF when a 3.5 mm AUX cable is inserted.

TF Card Input

Insert a micro SD/TF card into the TF card input port.

If the headphones do not automatically switch to the correct mode, change input modes until you enter TF card mode. A voice will be heard indicating the mode, and the speaker will automatically begin playing music off the device.

In TF mode, playback and volume adjustment will be controlled with controls on the headphones.

- Press the button to pause and resume playback.
- Press the and buttons to skip tracks.
- *Press and hold* the and buttons to adjust volume.

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power the headphones ON. A voice will be heard, and the LED indicator will flash BLUE and RED.
2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. Select BSNCH102 from the list of found devices.
3. After a successful pairing, a voice will be heard and the LED indicator will flash BLUE every 5 seconds while playing music.

In Bluetooth mode, playback and volume can be adjusted with the on-ear controls, or with your paired device.

- Press the **⏸** button to pause and resume playback.
- Press the **V+ ▶▶** and **◀◀ V-** buttons to skip tracks.
- Press and hold the **V+ ▶▶** and **◀◀ V-** buttons to adjust volume.

Phone Calls

To use the phone functions on the headphones, you must be connected to a Bluetooth-enabled device.

- Press the **⏸** button to answer and end phone calls. Playback will automatically pause and resume.
- 2x press the **⏸** button to dial the last outgoing phone number.
- Press and hold the **⏸** button for 2 seconds to reject an incoming call.

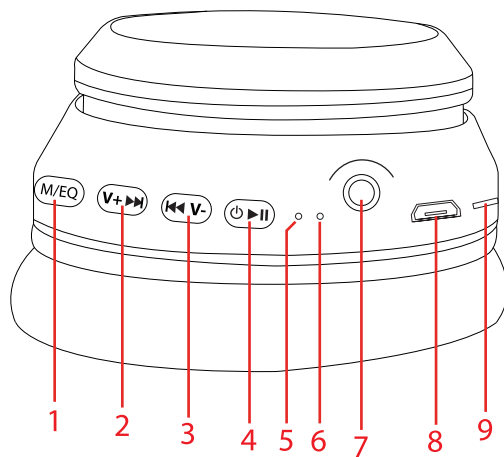

Location of Controls



1. M/EQ Button:
Press: Change EQ mode
Press+ hold: Change input mode
2. V+ ▶▶ Button:
Press: Skip to next track
Press + hold: Increase volume
3. ◀◀ V- Button:
Press: Skip to previous track
Press + hold: Decrease volume
4. ⏸ Button:
Press: Pause and resume playback, Answer and end phone call
Press + hold (3s): Power ON/OFF
5. LED Indicator
6. Microphone
7. AUX Port
8. USB Type-C Charging Port
9. TF Card Slot

Charging the Headphones

Plug the small connector of the included charging cable into the charging port on the bottom of the headphones' earcup. Plug the large connector into a USB power source, such as the USB port on a computer, or a 5V USB wall adapter (*not included*).

The LED indicator on the headphones will turn RED while charging and turn OFF when finished charging.

Powering ON/OFF

- Press and hold the **⏸** button for 3 seconds to power the headphones ON.
- Press and hold the **⏸** button for 5 seconds to power the headphones OFF.
- When powered on, the headphones may automatically reconnect to a nearby previously-paired device with Bluetooth enabled.

Changing Input Mode

- Press + hold the M/EQ button to change the input mode.
- A TF/Micro SD card must be inserted or AUX cable plugged in order to switch to these modes.

Changing EQ Mode

- Press the M/EQ button to change the EQ mode (normal, pop, rock, jazz, country, heavy bass).
