



1.1 Introduction




ISWARD is an advanced robotic mowing system that uses a virtual boundary, eliminating the need for complicated perimeter wiring. Easy to operate and manage, iSward gives you more free time to do the things you love and an effortlessly impeccable lawn with every use.

iSward contains a robotic lawnmower, a charging station, and a RTK (Real - time kinematic) signal beacon. The robotic lawnmower and RTK signal beacon simultaneously receive positioning signals from satellites to locate the lawnmower and the work area. The charging station charges the lawnmower and transmits the satellite positioning signal received by the RTK signal beacon to the lawnmower to improve the positioning accuracy of the lawnmower.

The Lawnmower

The robotic lawnmower is powered by a lithium battery and can automatically cut grass in a defined work area. The work area can be defined by controlling the lawnmower through the iSward app as needed. When mowing, the lawnmower's driving path is automatically planned by the algorithm according to the shape of the work area to achieve the highest mowing efficiency. If the entire lawn cannot be completed at one time, the lawnmower will automatically return to the charging station to charge. When the lawnmower is charged, the mowing resumes from the position where it stopped.





iSward app

The iSward app is an important part of the iSward system. You can follow the interactive guidance shown via the app to complete the installation and set up the work area. You can also use the app to adjust the settings of the lawnmower, manage the work area, view the work status of the lawnmower, control the lawnmower, etc. You can also get the latest and most comprehensive official Help and Support content through the app.

1.2 Safety Warnings

IMPORTANT

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE USE

KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

- 1) Be sure to install and operate the lawnmower and the charging station according to the instructions. Go to https://www.isward-tech.com/ for the complete User Manual and the latest user materials.
- 2) The product can be used both by consumers and for professional purposes. Using the lawnmower for purposes other than mowing can bring serious injury. To avoid risks of injuries, please read and understand all the warnings and cautions. Please understand that you can reduce the risk by following the instructions and warnings in this manual, but you cannot eliminate all risks.
- 3) The operator or user is responsible for accidents or hazards occurring to other people on their property.
- 4) iSward has many built-in safety sensors, however, safety risks still exist. Set a mowing time when there are no people or pets on the lawn. Inform the neighbors of the risks for accidents or hazards. When using the lawnmower on a public lawn, or when your lawn is open to your neighbor or street, protect or fence the lawn, or put up a warning sign around the working area that says: WARNING! Automatic lawn lawnmower! Keep away from the machine! Supervise children!
- 5) DO NOT modify the lawnmower by yourself. Modifications could interfere with lawnmower operations, result in serious injury and/or damage, or void the Limited Warranty. Use only iSward approved parts and accessories.
- 6) The manufacturer recommends the user to be 18-70 years old. Be sure to get the necessary training before operating the machine.

WARNING

Never allow children, person with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge or people unfamiliar with these instructions to use the machine. Local regulations may restrict the age of the operator.

Before Mowing:

- Regularly check that all parts of the lawnmower can function normally.
- For the best mowing result, it is recommended to mow in dry weather. Mowing in the rain can make the grass stick on the product and the lawnmower may slip. DO NOT mow in bad weather, such as heavy rain, thunderstorms or snow.
- Periodically inspect the area where the machine is used and remove all stones, sticks, wires, bones and other foreign objects. The Limited Warranty does not cover damages caused by objects left on the lawn.
- To avoid possible damage, keep the operating lawnmower at least 1 m (3 feet) away from sprinkler heads. The lawnmower and sprinklers should NOT work simultaneously. Time the lawnmower so that it works at a different time from sprinklers.
- NEVER allow children to touch the power supply unit, charging station, blades, the battery compartment, or any parts with gaps such as the wheels.

WARNING


Never operate the machine and/or its peripherals with defective guards or shields, or if the cord is damaged or worn.

When Mowing:

- Keep away from the rotating blades! DO NOT put hands or feet under or near the rotating blades.
- Watch out for projectile objects! Keep a safe distance from the lawnmower when operating.
- DO NOT leave the machine to operate unattended if you know that there are pets, children or people in the vicinity.
- DO NOT overreach. Keep your balance at all times and always be sure of the footing on slopes. Walk, never run while operating the machine or its peripherals.

WARNING

- DO NOT allow children to be in the vicinity or play with the machine when it is operating.
- DO NOT lift the lawnmower in operation. DO NOT ride on the lawnmower.
- DO NOT mow on areas with slopes steeper than the maximum incline inside the working area (57%), as well as the boundary (10%).
- If the lawnmower makes an abnormal sound or signals an alarm, press the STOP button immediately.
- If there are abnormal vibrations, turn off the lawnmower, place it on level ground for about 30 seconds and then restart. If the issue persists, contact authorized after-sales service.
- DO NOT touch moving hazardous parts before they have come to a complete stop.



Safe Usage:


- DO NOT operate the lawnmower outside the temperature limit: -10 °C ~+60 °C (14-140° F), because low/high temperatures can decrease lawnmower performance and even lead to accidents.
- DO NOT place anything on the lawnmower or the charging station.
- It is recommended to conduct regular maintenance of the lawnmower by an adult.
- Regularly check the warning devices to ensure they are effective. These devices include the LED light on the charging station, and the buzzer, the indicator light on the lawnmower.
- Before charging, please read How to Charge in Chapter 2.3. Improper use may cause electric shock, overheating, or leakage of corrosive liquid.
- If the cord on the power supply or the extension cable becomes damaged or entangled during use, disconnect the power supply from the power socket and then untangle. To avoid a hazard, pull the body of the plug rather than the cord when separating the power supply from the power socket. Contact after-sales service and have a professional technician to repair or replace the cord.

WARNING for button cell or coin battery:

- a) Remove and immediately recycle or dispose of used batteries according to local
- b) regulations and keep away from children. Do NOT dispose of batteries in household trash or incinerate.
- c) Even used batteries may cause severe injury or death.




1.4 Parts and Functions

Top view



- **The indicator light**: iSward will have specific lighting effects to remind you to pay attention to the state of the lawnmower.
- **Stop button**: Stops the lawnmower and the blade immediately.
- **Control panel**: The buttons on the control panel can be used for the basic operations of the lawnmower: start mowing, return to the charging station, enter the PIN code to unlock the lawnmower, etc.
- Rain sensor: For raindrop detection.
- **Bumper**: When the bumper hits an obstacle and triggers the internal sensor, the lawnmower will go backward and avoid the obstacle.
- **Visual sensor**: Our models are equipped with Visual sensors, which could detect obstacles and avoid collision.
- **Floodlight**: When the outside light is weak, the lighting will provide illumination for the vision sensor.
- Charging port: The charging position of the machine.

Bottom view




- **Blade:** The blades can rotate freely after being attached to the blade disc. When mowing, the spinning blade disc will generate centrifugal force to keep the blades pointing outside so that the blades can cut grass. When hitting an obstacle, the blade will turn inside.
- **Blade disc:** Blade disc height adjustment through iSward App.
- Lifting handle: Helps you lift the lawnmower when necessary.
- Start button: Switch the lawnmower on and off.

NOTE:

Never submerge the lawnmower in water, otherwise, the components may damage and the Limited Warranty will be voided.

Charging station and the RTK signal beacon



- **RTK signal beacon:** Receives satellite signals to improve the positioning accuracy of the lawnmower.
- LED indicator: Indicate different states with various colors.

NOTE: If the RTK signal beacon has poor signal due to surrounding buildings or trees, the lawnmower will not work properly. You need to find a better spot for the station.

1.5 Symbols and Decals

Please study the symbols on the product and labels carefully and understand their meaning:





1.6 How the PINS Works

PINS (Precise Integrated Navigation System) is iSward's unique high-precision fusion technology. Based on satellite positioning, PINS technology integrates various sensor data to improve positioning accuracy and fault tolerance through algorithm fusion.



The lawnmower can locate itself through satellite signals, which can also be picked up by the beacon. By comparing the satellite signals from the beacon and the lawnmower, errors in the transmission of the signal (such as the offset of the satellite signal as it travels through the ionosphere) can be minimized, improving satellite positioning accuracy to the centimeter level.

In addition, the data collected by the gyroscope, accelerometer, etc can also be integrated into this system through iSward's data fusion algorithms, further improving the applicability of iSward to various environments.

With PINS technology, iSward can draw a precise work area in complex outdoor environments without laying boundary wires, and optimize the mowing path through algorithms in the work area to achieve planned mowing results and maximize the lawnmower's work efficiency.

Multi-sensor data fusion improves the applicability of PINS to complex environments, but serious satellite signal issues will still greatly affect the normal operation of iSward. Below are major cases of satellite signal issues:

Blocking

If there are any obstacles on or surrounding the beacon and/or the lawnmower, the signal will be weakened or blocked.

Solution: DO NOT install the charging station and beacon under a roof, tree or anywhere that may block the signal.


• Signal Interference

Signals from the satellite are transmitted to the beacon after being reflected by the wall, instead of directly from the sky. This is called Multipath Effect.


Suggest: It is recommended not to use the lawnmower in a scenario with walls that have long and flat surfaces or that are made of glass or metal. The long and flat surface/glass and metal surface will interfere with the signal, hence the lawnmower may bump into the walls. The map should not be built between two high walls, because the walls will block the signal and the lawnmower will not be able to work in this area.

Some environments that cannot be installed:


• The lawn has a long and narrow area with high walls on both sides.




• There is a large area of a glass/metal wall or a wall with a long and flat surface.



• There are tall trees (usually above 5 m) with big tree crowns.



• The density of the trees is thick.



2.1 Before You Start



Prepare the lawn

Remove debris, piles of leaves, toys, wires, stones and other obstacles. Make sure children and pets are off the lawn. Please cut your lawn to a height of no more than 6 cm.



2.2 Install the Charging Station and the beacon

Step 1: Find a good spot

Install the charging station on a soft and flat surface.

When placed outside, the charging station and the lawn should be kept at the same level.

In order to ensure that the beacon can receive good satellite signals, please choose a suitable location to install the charging station and the beacon:

1. Remain a certain distance away (greater than 2 m) from houses, trees and walls.


2. Install the charging station and beacon in an open space with nothing blocking the signal (for example, the tree canopy or the sunshade umbrella), where the beacon has a clear sky view that at least 110° of the sky is unobstructed.

3. Please place the charging station on a flat non-hardened ground with the beacon upright. Do not install the beacon at an angle.

4. To ensure smooth docking, leave a minimum of 10 cm at the back of the charging station and 1 m at the front.

5. Stay away from sprinkler heads, fountains or other outdoor water systems.

6. Stay away from substations, generators, water pump stations and air conditioners.






Please choose the location carefully. Once the map is saved, if the location of the RTK signal beacon is changed, you need to create a new map.

Step 2: Assembly and Install the charging station


1. Insert the charging station panel into the installation position of the charging station base plate.




2. Place the charging station upside down on the soft ground.



3. Use a Phillips screwdriver to secure the charging station panel and base plate.




4. Fix the charging station

The side of the charging station panel with the indicator light should face to the lawn work area.


Step 3: Power the charging station


The indicator light will turn red when the charging station is powered.

Step 4: Install the RTK signal beacon




Caution: The illustrations in this user manual are for your reference only. The beacon assembly metal tube is installed next to the charging station.

1. Rotate the RTK signal beacon on the tube.




3. Thread the extension cable through the side hole of the other extension tube and out the other end along the tube-B. 2. Thread the wire of RTK signal beacon through the side hole of the tube-A and out the other end along the tube-A.




4. Connect the extension cable and the wire of the RTK signal beacon.





- 5. Rotate the tube-A and the tube-B.
- 6. Unfold the base fork and insert it into the ground.






To make sure that the RTK signal beacon can be stably connected to the charging station once the installation is completed, please fully insert the base fork into the ground.


7. Rotate the tube-B onto the base fork.

8. Connect the RTK signal beacon to the charging station.



NOTE:

- Secure the nuts tightly to prevent water from entering them. •
- Align the notch on the extension cable (A) with the groove on the power supply connector (B).
- Tie up the excess strands with cable ties. 9.



To ensure satellite signal, DO NOT put anything on the beacon.

Step 5: Check the satellite signal


To avoid performance degradation, always keep the connectors, accessories, connection part of the charging station and beacon away from any dirt or mud. Never allow water to get into the connectors or any parts and connection points.

2.3 Charge and Activate the Lawnmower

How to charge

How to charge for the first time:

A new lawnmower may have a low battery after long storage. Fully charge the lawnmower before the first use. Place the lawnmower in the charging station. Make sure the charging strip on the lawnmower and the contact strip on the charging station are in good contact.





Automatic charging:

After setting up the virtual boundary, the lawnmower will return to the charging station automatically when the mowing task is completed, or when the battery is low. During the mowing session, you can press the HOME and then OK button to command the lawnmower to go back to the charging station.

Where to place the power supply:

- Protection from direct sunlight and rain
- Indoors with good ventilation
- Keep it at least 30 cm (12 in) above the floor to avoid possible damages caused by water.




WARNING

- DO NOT charge if the lawnmower, the power supply, the charging station, or the power socket is damaged.
- DO NOT charge the lawnmower when the temperature is above 40°C (104° F)or below4°C (39.2°F). The battery has built-in temperature protection and will not charge if the limit is exceeded.
- When there is an abnormal smell, sound or light display, stop charging immediately and contact after-sales service.
- Keep away from inflammable and explosive materials when charging.

Activate the lawnmower


1. Press the start button under the machine. Make sure the lawnmower activate.



Please wait about 1min until you hear "Beep!!".


2. Enable Mobile location, Bluetooth, 4G on your phone, log in to the app and follow the instructions to pair with the lawnmower.




- Tap your lawnmower to go to the device home page, and then the APP will start searching for lawnmower and automatically connect.
- When you see the Bluetooth logo at the top of the interface, it means that the device has been successfully connected.



2.4 Paired RTK signal beacon


Follow the instructions in the app and scan the QR code (or input the serial number) to connect the RTK beacon.



NOTE: You can find the QR code and serial number on the RTK signal beacon. Just go to iSward Settings>Beacon Paring, tap" Scan Barcode to Pair".



2.5 Set up the Work Area



Follow the instructions in the app and control the lawnmower to create the work area (referred to as the map in the manual). The lawnmower will intelligently decide its moving pattern within the map.

- The work area consists of Boundary, Off-limit Island and Channels.
- Boundaries delineate one single complete work area, Off-limit Islands delineate areas where the lawnmower is prohibited, and Channels are used to connect multiple work areas.
- Inside the Channel, the lawnmower will just pass through without cutting the grass.
- The charging station and the RTK signal beacon should be installed outside the work area. And the distance between the charging station and the nearest working area boundary should be about 1m. If the charging station is inside the work area, the changing station will be treated as off-limit island so that the lawnmower won't be able to go home and charge.

NOTES:

- If the location of the charging station or RTK signal beacon is changed, the existing map CANNOT be used anymore and you MUST create a new map.
- Make sure your phone and lawnmower are fully charged before mapping. Mapping will only start when the lawnmower battery power level is sufficient.

Step 1: Map out the boundary


1. Make sure the lawnmower is powered on. With Bluetooth connection, your phone will connect to the lawnmower automatically.

NOTE:


If the lawnmower is in lock status, you must enter the PIN code before operating the lawnmower. The default code is $\land \land \land \land$ and can be reset via the iSward app.

2. Just go to iSward Settings>Lawn Mapping , tap "+"in top right corner and name your lawn.


Then tap "+" in top right corner and tap "lawn" to Map out the boundary.




3. Find a proper starting point along the edge of your lawn (20 cm between the lawnmower's left side and the edge). Keep within 5m from the lawnmower during the mapping process.



- 4、Walk along the edge.
- Distance from the edge: always keep 20 cm.



• Slope: Even though the lawnmower can traverse slopes up to 57% within the lawn, make sure the slope along the edge does not exceed 10%



 $5\ensuremath{\,{\rm \circ}}$ Go back to the starting point to finish the boundary mapping.


NOTE:

- If there is a sudden interruption and failure, follow the instructions in the app to continue or restart.
- If you have multiple separate lawns, please repeat this step.
- The charging station should be located outside the boundary, but should be close to the boundary.

Step 2: Set up off-limit island

When the lawnmower sees a hard obstacle taller than 10 cm (such as big rocks or a tree trunk), it will change the direction automatically. However, you need to lay borders for objects that need protection or areas you don't want the lawnmower to enter, e.g., a flowerbed, small trees, lawn decorations, pond, sprinkler heads, emerged roots, etc. If you recently installed a trampoline or grill on the lawn, you can also set an off-limit island to protect it.

How: Just go to **iSward Settings>Lawn Mapping**, tap "+" in top right corner and name off-limit island. Then walk along the edge of the off-limit island.




• If you have multiple off-limit islands, please repeat this step.

When you need to cancel the area (like when you remove the trampoline from the lawn), just delete it via the app.


Make smooth turning angles when setting the islands. You also need to walk along the edge when setting the island.




Step 3: Create a channel to connect separate areas

Following the instructions in the app, create a channel between separate boundaries.

How: Just go to iSward Settings>Lawn Mapping, tap "+" in top right corner and name the channel.



Then Operate the lawnmower to walk from one lawn to another.




NOTE:

When creating a channel:

- Do not choose ground that is bumpy, muddy, or wet.
- The width of the channel needs to be greater than 1 m. In order to ensure smooth passage, when establishing the channel, please drive along the center line of the passable area. Being too close to the edge may scratch the lawnmower during work.
- The starting point and the end point should be set in the two map areas drawn respectively.
- The lawnmower cutter stops running and rises to the highest position.


Step 4: Set up the charging station



You should set up the charging station so that the lawnmower can automatically find the charging station to charge. How:

Just go to **iSward Settings>Lawn Mapping**, tap "+"in top right corner and tap "**the charging station**".

Then drive your lawnmower about 0.5 meter in front of the charging station.




Tap" Add dock point" add the charge location.

Note:

When your lawnmower is low on power or needs to return to the charging station, themachine will return to the docking point.

Your lawnmower will automatically identify and return to the charging station at thedocking point, and then charge back to the station.

2.6 Mowing setting



After saving the work area, tap the icon on top right corner in the app then you can set Grass cutting height, mowing speed, edge trimming and the angle of mowing.

NOTE:

When you first use this device, please set the grass cutting height to the highest. When the lawn has been mowed once, gradually lower the grass cutting height.

2.7 Start mowing

On the lawnmower, enter the PIN code to unlock the lawnmower. Then press **MOW** and then **OK** to start mowing.

You need to keep an eye on the satellite signals. How :

Tap "iSward Setting >Lawn Mapping", you can see a satellite icon at the top-left corner.




NOTE:

If the lawnmower goes beyond the boundary, make sure the satellite signal is strong at the problematic spot. The lawnmower and the RTK signal beacon need to see satellites to have accurate positioning. You can try to relocate the charging station, set the map again, and then test one more time. Get help from professional technicians when necessary. Contact your nearest dealer to solve problems. You can also send an email to our after-sales service.

3.1 Display and Control on the Lawnmower

The display shows various states of the lawnmower, and the control buttons can be used for the basic operations: start mowing, return to the charging station, enter the PIN code to unlock the machine, etc.

3.3 Mow

This part is mainly about how the lawnmower works, how to start and pause it during daily work, etc. Work settings related to mowing, such as: scheduled mowing, how to change cutting height, map management, etc.

How does iSward mow your lawn

Edge cut

Before mowing the work area, you can tap "Edge Trimming" to choose when or if you need to cut along the boundary.

Planned cut

Unlike most robotic lawnmowers, inside the work area, the lawnmower will mow the lawn along a planned path by an algorithm for maximum efficiency.


1. Before mowing for the first time, please cut your lawn to a height of no more than 6 cm.

2. During the working process, if the battery is low, the lawnmower will stop mowing and return to the charging station to charge. After fully charged, it will automatically return to the position where it previously stopped and continue mowing.

Start Mowing

There are two ways to start mowing:

- a) On the lawnmower, press **MOW** and then **OK** to start mowing.
- b) The lawnmower starts automatically according to the mowing schedule.









- 4. View and change lawnmower work settings (Mowing schedule, Cutting height, Map management)
- 5. View and change lawnmower security/function settings (PIN, Anti-theft lock, etc.)
- 6. Update firmware
- 7. Unbind and add devices
- 8. Get help information and after-sales support

To Use the iSward App

1. Register and log in to your account.

2. Turn on your phone's Bluetooth function and make sure your phone has a network signal.

NOTES:

1. If you cancel your iSward account, all data related to iSward will be deleted.

2. During use, the iSward app will ask you for Bluetooth (iOS/Android), location (iOS/Android), and Wi-Fi access (iOS/Android). To ensure normal use, please grant the above accesses.

Activate your lawnmower


After registration and login, you will come to Device Activation Guidance, which will guide you to install, connect and activate your iSward. Tap "Add device".



Create a map


Before mowing your lawn with iSward, you need to create a work area (map) using the iSward app. Go to **iSward Setting> Lawn Mapping**, and follow the instructions in the app.

You can tap and hold the appropriate button to edit the maps. Maps can be renamed or deleted on the settings page.

To check the signal distribution of the newly created map, you can view the signal icon at the top-left corner in the iSward app.





3.7 Settings (Lawnmower)

All lawnmower-related settings can be adjusted in the app. You can:

- 1. Change lawnmower work settings (mowing schedule, cutting height, map management, etc.)
- 2. Change lawnmower security settings and function settings (reset PIN code, etc.)

NOTE:

Setting adjustment requires the lawnmower to be online or connected to your phone via Bluetooth.

How to set mowing schedule


You can set the mowing schedule in the lawnmower settings. The lawnmower will work automatically according to the schedule.

The mowing schedule can be adjusted in **iSward setting > Schedule Setting**.

Choose a specific date and time period on the schedule page to set your mowing schedule:

Tap the Hour bar on the page to add or delete working hours in the pop-up page.

• Tap a day of the week to toggle the mowing schedule on/off for that day.



NOTE:

You need to set a time during the day to start mowing and multiple times when you can't mow.

During the mowing process, set up non-mowing periods for you to use the lawn.

How to change the cutting height



The cutting height can be adjusted in **Mowing Settings > height**, the adjustment range is $3\sim 6$ cm, and the minimum adjustable segment is 1mm.


How to set the edge trimming



The edge trimming can be set in **Mowing Settings > Edge Trimming**, you can choose "**Disable**", "**Before mowing**", or "**After mowing**".

How to edit the map

You can edit or delete the entire map in **iSward Settings>Lawn Mapping**. Make sure your phone is connected to the lawnmower via Bluetooth.



By tapping " **boundary**"," **off-limit island**", and "**channels**" you can: add or delete boundary, off-limit island, and channels.

NOTES:

1. When you delete a boundary, the element associated with the boundary (channel) is also deleted.

2. By tapping Delete you will delete the entire map. You need to create a new map before using the lawnmower.


Rain sensor

If it rains when mowing, the rain sensor will be triggered after receiving a certain amount of rainwater, and the lawnmower will automatically return to the charging station. After the water on the rain sensor dries, it will automatically resume the mowing task. Before the water dries, the lawnmower cannot be started via the buttons on the lawnmower. This is normal and not a malfunction of the lawnmower. NOTES:

- For the best mowing results, it is recommended to mow in dry weather. Mowing in the rain can make the grass stick on the wheel and the lawnmower may slip.
- DO NOT mow in bad weather, such as heavy rain, thunderstorms or snow.

Anti-theft

Your mower has an anti-theft feature and you can effectively prevent accidents such as mower theft. When moving out of a designated area, iSward will sound an alarm and you will receive a notification on the app simultaneously. At the same time, iSward team will send email alerts to your mailbox.




When you cannot find your mower, you can tap 'Find my mower' on the app to check the location of the mower on the map. Then tap 'Lock' to lock your mower.

NOTES:

1. If you want the Anti-theft unlock, you need to enter PIN on the APP.

2. Anti-theft is only available with 4G connection.

3.9 Obstacle Avoidance

Obstacle avoidance features are designed to increase the performance of your lawnmower and your safety.

Vision sensor

Vision sensor can significantly improve iSward's obstacle recognition and avoidance capability.

The Vision sensor is designed to achieve accurate obstacle avoidance by identifying grass and non-grass objects. Thanks to the advanced visual recognition algorithm, the sensor can identify obstacles and start avoiding obstacles when the lawnmower is about 0.3 m away from them. With the Vision sensor, the lawnmower can avoid some obstacles, such as trees and flowerpots, without setting them as off-limit islands. However, there is a certain probability that the Vision sensor will fail to recognize obstacles that are too small (less than 10 cm in length and width), too thin, tilted, dangling, or easily confused with lawn. For example, wire fences, moss, ornamental grass, bushes, dirt, roots, leaves, etc. Moreover, the vision sensor cannot recognize some pits, pools, pools, etc., and it is recommended that you set it as an off-limit island. When the signal is weak, the lawnmower can still avoid obstacles through visual recognition.

NOTES:

1. In the case of insufficient light, the headlight of the machine will be lit to provide light for the Vision sensor, which can better avoid obstacles.

2. Clean the lens of Vision sensor by spraying water regularly, avoiding the lens being obscured by stains or mud.

3. For the best obstacle avoidance effect, we recommend that obstacles larger than 1 m and smaller than 0.1 m in diameter should be set as off-limit islands.

Bumper sensor

When the enclosure bumps into an obstacle and triggers the sensor, the lawnmower will back away from obstacles.

NOTES:

Your iSward is able to avoid objects after bumping into them. However, it is still recommended to remove excess clutter before mowing.

4.Maintenance

To achieve better mowing results and increase the service life, be sure to keep the lawnmower clean and the blades in good condition. Inspection and maintenance should be carried out by an adult every week. Any damaged or worn parts should be replaced.

DO NOT perform maintenance when wearing open sandals or barefoot. Always wear long trousers and work shoes when servicing the lawnmower.

4.1 Cleaning

Use a soft brush or cloth to clean the exterior of the lawnmower thoroughly. DO NOT clean with alcohol, gasoline, acetone, or other corrosive/volatile solvents. These substances may damage the appearance and internal structure of your lawnmower. For proper docking, periodically inspect and clean the charging station from debris and mud. Make sure all connecting parts of the charging station, the extension cable, and the power supply are not blocked.

A. Chassis and blade disc

If the chassis and blade disc are dirty, use a brush or a water hose to clean. DO NOT use a high-pressure washer. At the same time, make sure that the blade disc rotates freely and the blades can pivot freely.

CAUTION: High-pressure water can leak into the sealings and damage electronic and mechanical parts.

B. Blade fender

Check the blade fender regularly. If mud, grass clippings or other objects gather on the blade fender, remove them with a dry brush or scraper.

C. Wheels

Grass on the wheels can affect how the lawnmower performs when climbing slopes. Remove mud or other objects stuck in between to ensure strong grip.

D. Front wheels (universal wheels)

Inspect and clean universal wheels regularly. If the wheels are stuck, clean off the debris and lubricate the wheels.

E. Rain sensor

Check the rain sensor regularly and make sure the rain sensor is not covered by mud, grass clippings or other objects. You can either wash it or clean it with a soft brush. After cleaning, dry the sensor area.

F. Vision sensor

Check the Vision sensor regularly and make sure the Vision sensor is not covered by mud, grass clippings or other objects. You can either wash it or clean it with a soft rag.

WARNING

- Before cleaning, make sure the lawnmower is powered off.
- When the lawnmower is upside down, it must be powered off.

4.2 Replace Blade assembly

If the lawnmower is used on a regular basis, it is recommended to replace the blade assembly and screws to ensure safety and better mowing results. Replace the blade assembly and the screws at the same time for a safe cutting system.

NOTE:


When a blade component replacement prompt is displayed on the APP page, you need to replace the blade assembly as prompted.

WARNING


- Wear heavy gloves when you inspect or service the blade assembly.
- Only use the right type of screws and original blade assembly as approved by iSward.
- DO NOT reuse the screws. Doing so can cause serious injury.

How to replace the blade assembly


- 1. Turn off the lawnmower.
- 2. To avoid scratching, place the lawnmower on a soft and clean surface in an upside-down position.
- 3. Use a cross-tip screwdriver to loosen the screws on both sides of the guard.



- 4. Set the removed shield aside
- 5. Use a cross-tip screwdriver to loosen the three screws.
- 6. Remove the screws and blade assembly.



7. Fasten the new blade assembly and screws (Torque: 1 N ⋅ m). Make sure the blade assembly can pivot freely.




8. Install the removed shield.

4.3 Transportation

To protect the lawnmower, use the original packaging for long-distance transportation. Before lifting, moving, or transporting the product, turn it off. Handle with care and avoid violent force, such as throwing and heavy pressure. Never pick up or carry the lawnmower while the motor is running.


How to move or lift properly

Carry the lawnmower by the handle, with the blade disc facing away from your body.



CAUTION:

To avoid damage to the lawnmower and/or the charging station, DO NOT lift the lawnmower by the handle when it's parked in the charging station. Remove the lawnmower from the charging station before lifting the lawnmower.



4.4 Battery

- Power off the lawnmower and keep the battery fully charged before storage to avoid over-discharge and damage to the electrical components. Charge the lawnmower every 120 days for long-time storage.
- Battery damage caused by over-discharge will not be covered by the Limited Warranty.
- DO NOT use the battery under extreme temperature conditions, i.e., above 60° C (140° F) or below -10° C (-4° F).
- DO NOT store the battery under extreme temperature conditions, i.e., above 30° C (86° F) or below -20° C (-4° F).
- Temperature protection will be activated at -10° C (14° F)/60° C (140° F), the battery won't be charged unless the temperature reaches 0° C (32° F) or reduces to 45° C (113° F) or below.


When the battery temperature is too high or too low, the lawnmower will not start mowing. You will also receive a push notification in the iSward app.

NOTE:

The battery life depends on how often the product is used and the total working hours. When the operation time is significantly shorter than usual per full charge or the lawn is not well-cut, consider replacing the battery.

How to replace the battery

- 1. Turn off the lawnmower.
- 2. Open the back cover of the lawnmower.
- 3. Turn the knobs on each side in the direction away from the center of the machine.
- 4. Take out the battery pack and replace it with the new one.
- 5. Pack the battery to the exact location and rotate the fixed button.
- 6. Close the back cover.



WARNING

Use only the original battery pack or that of the same model as specified by iSward. Each lawnmower contains one battery pack.

Do not use non-rechargeable batteries. For the purpose of recharging the battery, only use the detachable supply unit provided with this appliance.

DO NOT dismantle or puncture the battery casing. Keep away from metal objects to prevent short circuit. Keep away from fire, heat and direct sunlight.

For information about battery and electrical waste, please contact your household waste disposal service, your local or regional waste management office, or your point-of-sale.

The battery compartment is not supposed to be opened regularly. Only open the battery compartment when you need to change the battery.

The battery pack contains electrolytes. If the electrolyte leakage comes into contact with your skin, wash off

with soap and water immediately. Get medical help in case of eye contact and immediately flush the eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes without rubbing.

4.5 Power Supply

- Disconnect the power supply:
 - Before clearing a blockage;
 - Before checking, cleaning or working on the machine;
 - After striking a foreign object to inspect the machine for damage.
- Regularly examine the cord, plug, enclosure and other parts. If any damage or signs of aging are found, stop using immediately.

WARNING

- DO NOT operate a damaged power supply. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard. If the extension cable is defective, please replace it with the long cable as approved by iSward.
- DO NOT connect a damaged cord to the power supply or touch a damaged cord or extension cable before it is disconnected from the power socket. Damaged cords can lead to contact with live parts.
- DO NOT use the power supply with any other product or battery, otherwise there will be risks of personal injury, fire or electrical shock. Product safety cannot be guaranteed with other than original batteries.
- DO NOT charge when the battery is leaking.
- Keep the extension cable away from moving hazardous parts to avoid damage to the cords which can lead to contact with live parts.

4.6 Storage

- Before storage, power off the lawnmower and charge its battery full to avoid over-discharge, which will cause permanent damage.
- Store in a cool and dry place indoors. Exposure to sunlight and temperature extremes (both hot and cold) will accelerate the aging process of the components and may permanently damage the battery.
- Keep the lawnmower, charging station and power supply away from heat sources (such as stoves, radiators, etc.) or chemicals. Protect the power supply from moisture and keep it in a well-ventilated place.

WARNING

When there is a risk of a thunderstorm, unplug the power supply from the power socket. Disconnect all cables and wires connecting to the charging station. Reconnect when there is no longer a risk of thunder.

Extra requirements for winter storage

• The lawnmower

Clean the lawnmower thoroughly before storage. Check the components subject to wear such as the blades. Repair or replace them if they are in poor condition. Store the lawnmower in a dry and frost-free place, while standing on all wheels, preferably in the original packaging. • The charging station and RTK signal beacon

Unplug the power supply from the power socket and disconnect it from the charging station. Disconnect the RTK signal beacon from the charging station and take it down from the standing pole. Keep the charging station and RTK signal beacon indoors and out of direct sunlight.

4.7 Recycling and End-of-life Disposal

DO NOT treat this product as domestic waste. For recycling information, contact your domestic waste service, your municipality, or point of sale.

4.8 Others

- Keep all screws, nuts and bolts tight to ensure normal and safe operation.
- To ensure good grip of the tread, keep the drive wheels (rear wheels) clean by removing any mud with a brush.
- The removal of the housing must be opened and resealed by authorized service technicians ONLY. Servicing by yourself can void the Limited Warranty.
