FUNCTION OVERVIEW



GETTING STARTED

Power ON/OFF

Plug in the charger, Press and hold the power button for 3-5s to turn on your tablet. Select your language and set up your tablet following the start guide.

Press and hold the power button for 2s, then release it. It will show **Power off**, Restart on the screen. Tap **Power off** to turn

off the tablet.

Press and hold the power button for 7-8s to do a forced reboot when it's frozen.

BATTERY

A rechargeable Li-ion battery is installed in the tablet.

We suggest you drain the battery completely once a month if only use your tablet occasionally.

DO NOT dispose of tablet in a fire.

SLEEP MODE

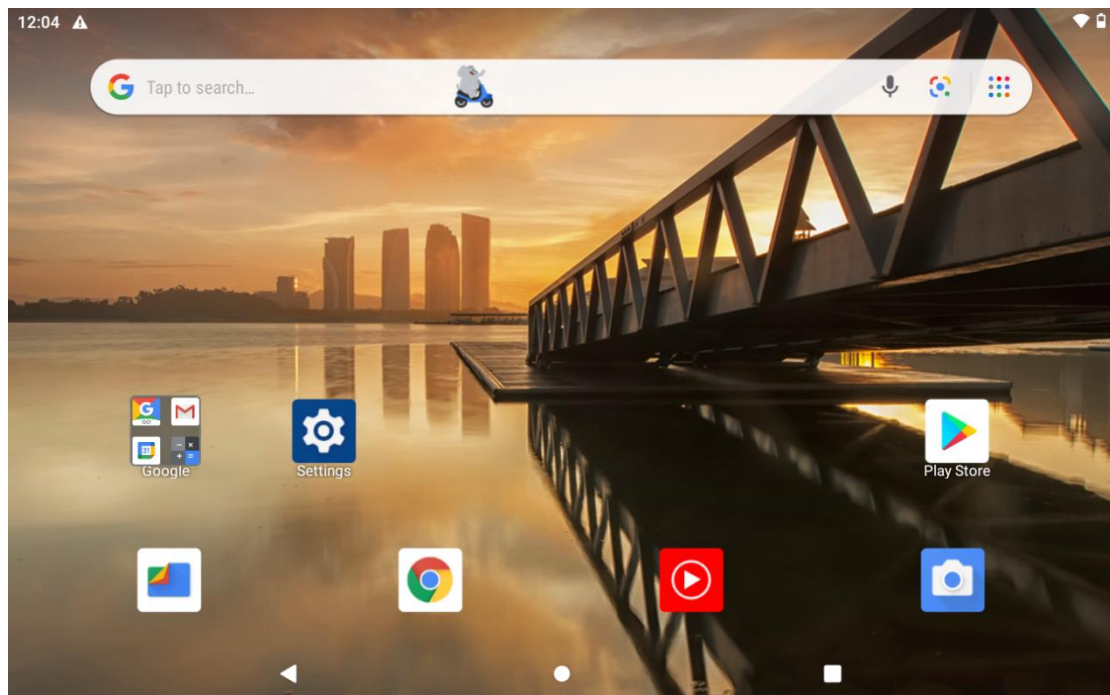
Simply press the power button once to switch the tablet to the **Sleep Mode** when the tablet is **ON**: Press again to wake it up.

Tip:

Go to Settings>Display>Advanced>Sleep to set the time of entering the sleep Mode.

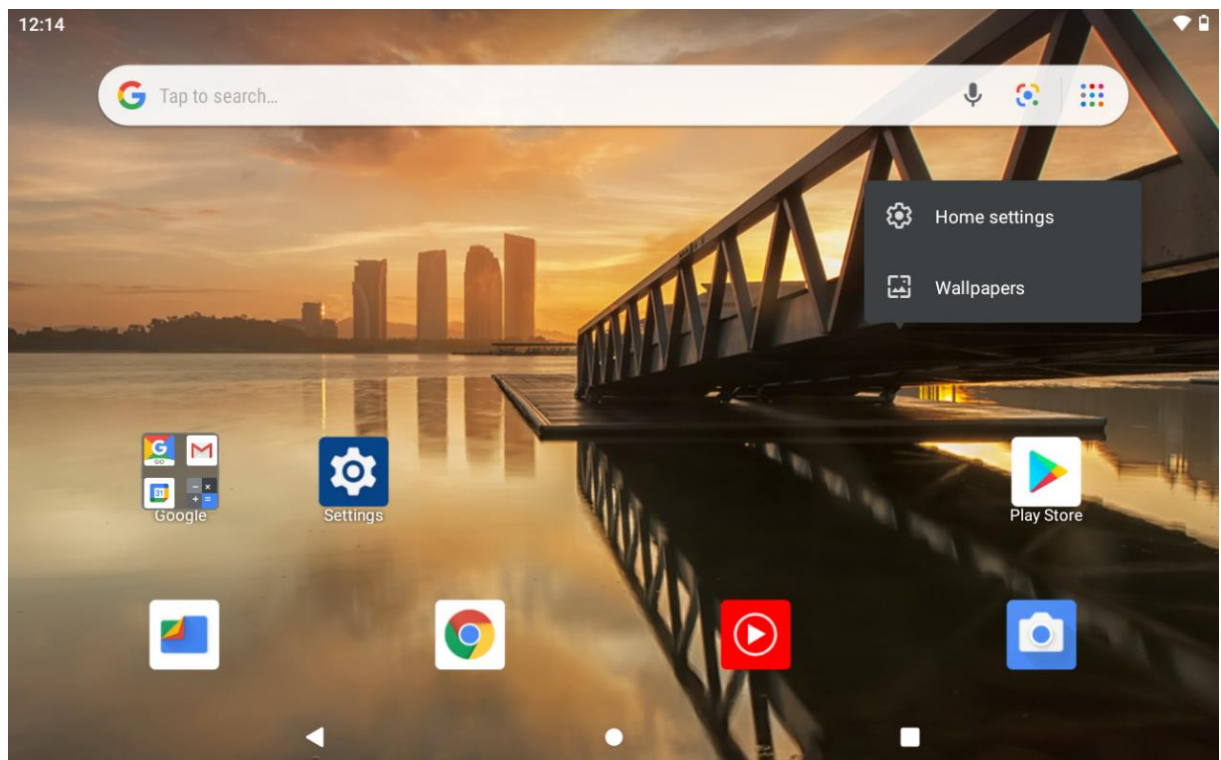

Home Settings, wallpapers



Tap and hold the empty section of a Home screen, **Home settings**, **Wallpapers** will be displayed.

Tap **Home settings** to enable/disable **Add icon to home screen**. This is applicable to the new Apps installed from **Play Store**. It

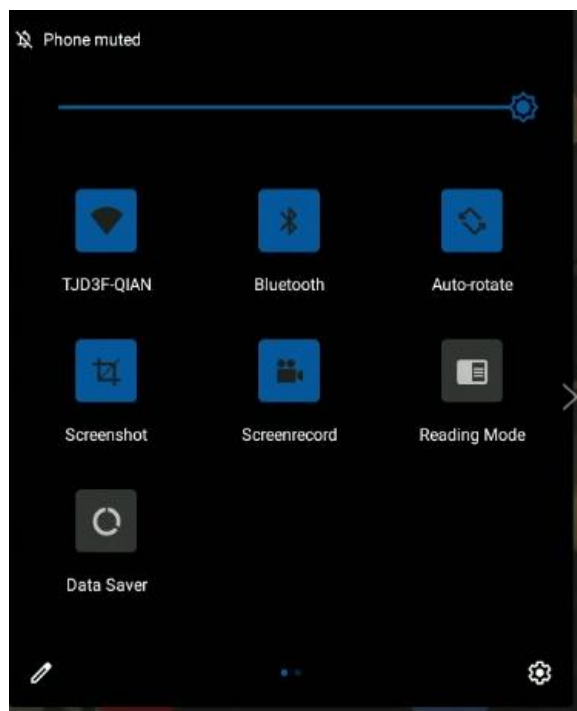
also provides the shortcut to enable/disable the notification dots. In addition, you can set the option for **Pull down action** on the screen and change **Home screen style**, and more.

Tap **Wallpapers** to change the current wallpaper of the tablet from the default wallpapers, liver Wallpapers or your photos.

SETTING BASICS

QUICK SETTINGS


Swipe down from the top of the screen to access Quick settings.




WIFI. Tap to connect/disconnect to a wireless network

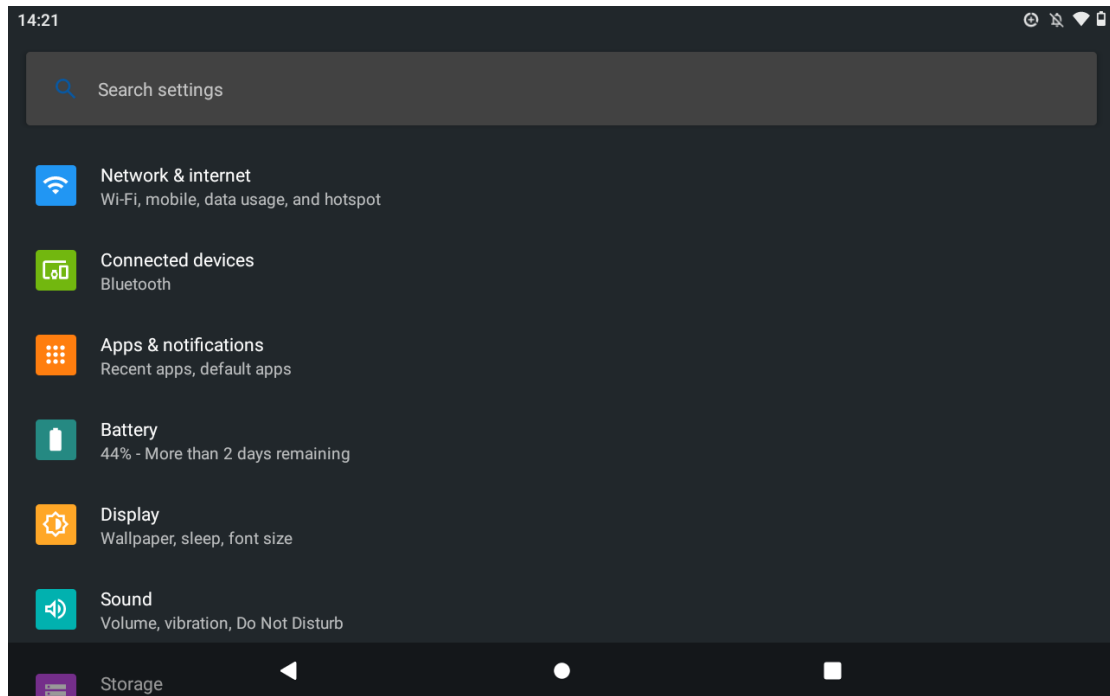
Bluetooth.Enable/disable the Bluetooth of the tablet

Display

Adjust the screen brightness.

Adjust **Color and Contrast** of display.

Set to check the notifications and other info. When you lift the tablet with screen locked and more.

Sound

Select audio profiles from General and Silent

Set the volumes for notifications, media and alarm.

Storage

View and manage your storage space.

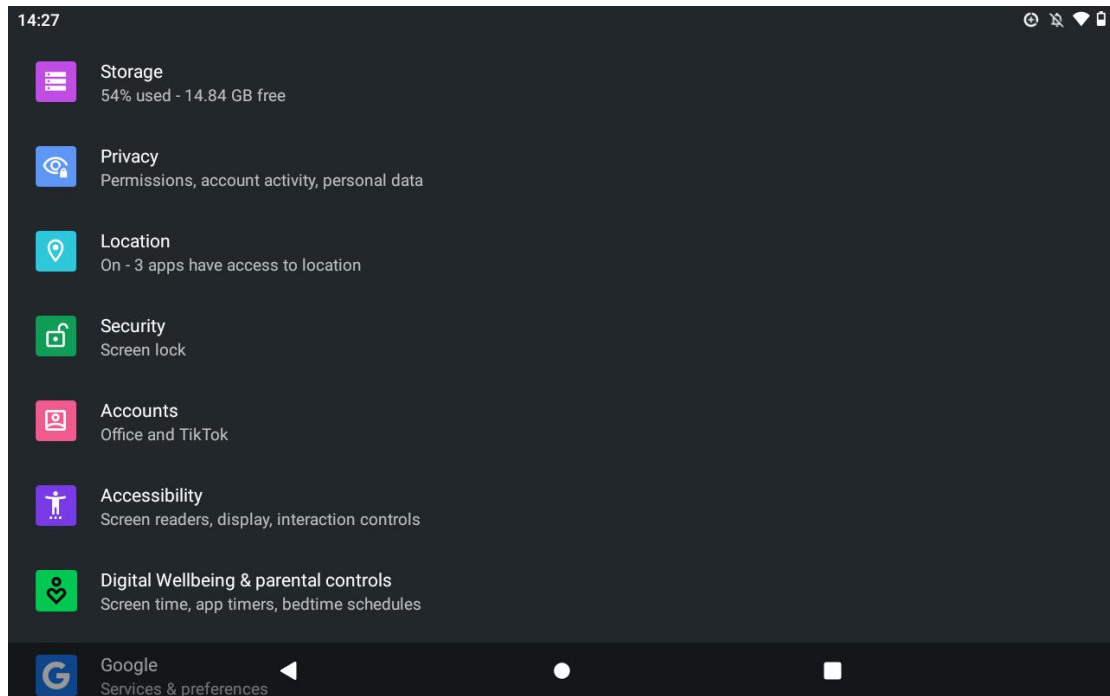
Privacy

View App permissions, account activity and personal data.

Location

Location may use sources like GPS, WiFi, and sensors to help estimate your devices locations.

Google may collect locations data periodically and use this data in an anonymous way to improve location accuracy and location-based services.



Security

Set screen lock pattern, e.g.Password.PIN,Swipe etc.

Enable/disable all the notifications while the screen is locked.

Turn on/off the location services for specific Apps

Set to show/hide the password when input a password and more.

Accounts

Add and manage the user accounts on you tablet.

Accessibility

For vision and hearing impaired users, manage settings for Screen readers, Display, **Interation Controls** and more.

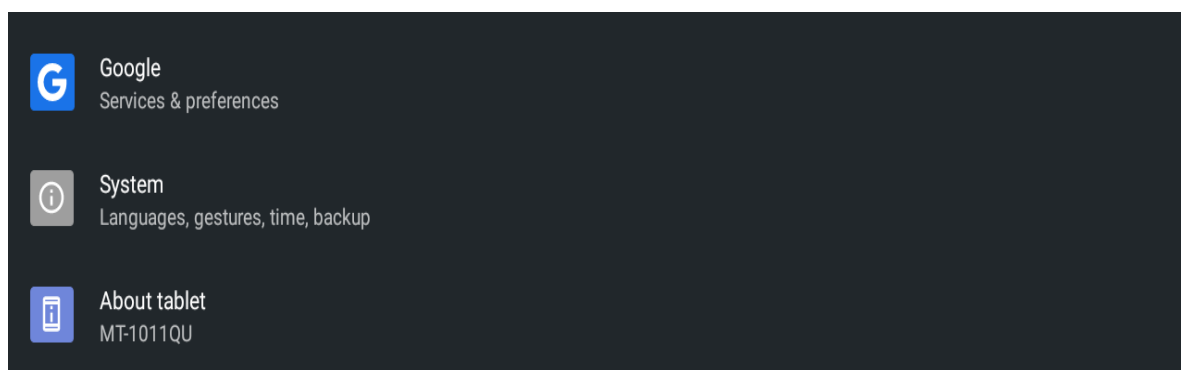
Digital Well being & parental controls

Check your app usage based on Screen time, Notifications received, or Times opened from Dashboard

Manage the related notifications settings to reduce interruptions.

Set up parental controls to help your kids balance their screen time and more.

Set the preferences for Google related services

Tap Language & Input>Languages>+Add a language to add your language. After adding, Hold and slide the ≡ to the top to

change the language

Restore factory setting.

Tap **Advanced**> **Reset options**>**Erase all data (factory rest)** to restore the factory setting.

To edit you device name to whatever you like.

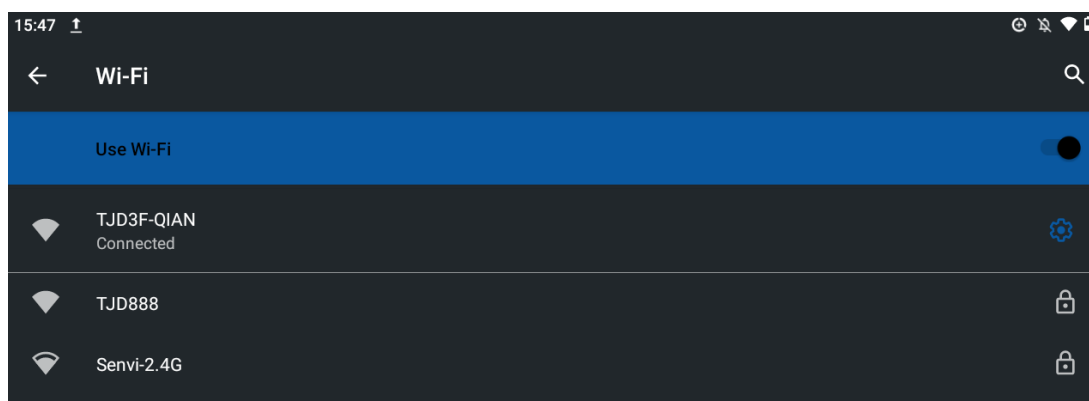
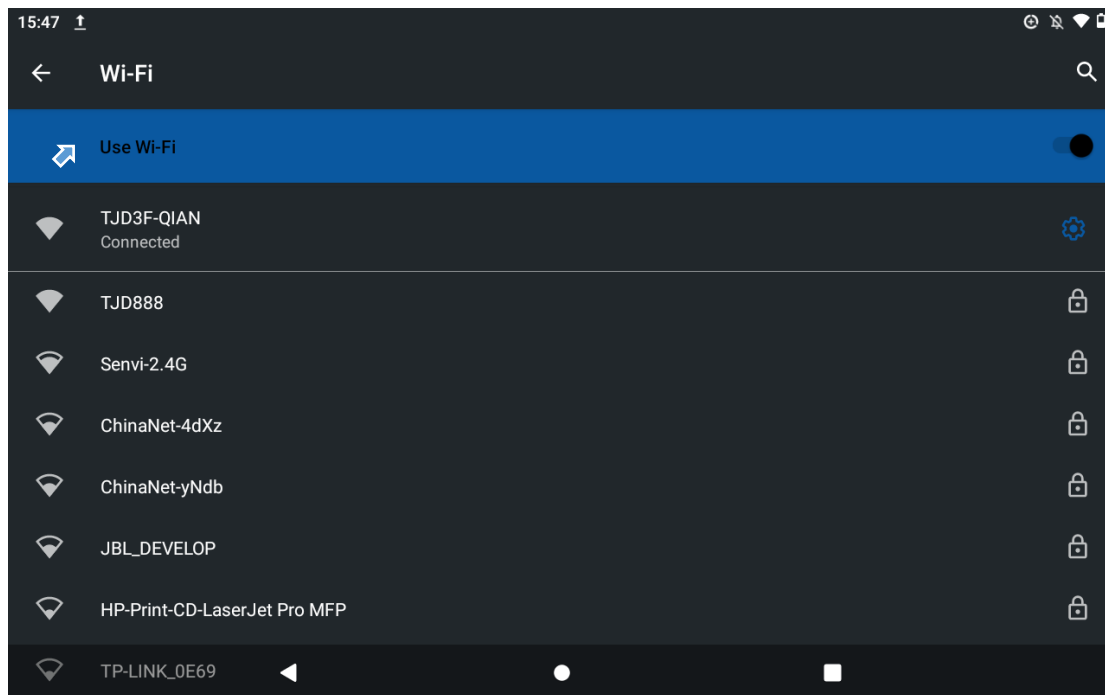
NETWORK CONNECTION

Go to network settings from the **Settings** App or by long pressing the WiFi/Bluetooth icon in **Quick Settings**.

WIFI CONNECTION

1. Tap **Network&internet** and turn on the WiFi. All the **Wifi** connections available will be listed.

2. Select your Wifi and input the correct password.



BLUETOOTH PAIRING

Please turn on the **Bluetooth** on you tablet and your Bluetooth

device.

1. Tap Connected devices.
2. Tap+pair new device to enter the scanning interface. Devices available will be displayed after a few seconds.
3. Tap the desired device to get a pairing code and click PARI on both devices. The automatic connection is applied to some devices.

APP MANAGEMENT

APP DOWNLOAD AND INSTALLATION

1. Tap and open **Play Store** on the Home screen.
2. Log into your google account, search and download the App you need.

APP MANAGEMENT


Move the App

Tap and hold the App, then slide it to a desired screen.

Remove the App from the Home Screen

Touch and hold the App, then slide to X Remove to remove it from your Home Screen.

Uninstall the App

Touch and hold the App, then slide to the  Uninstall to uninstall the App.

Clear the Cache of the App

1. Go to settings>Apps & notifications.
2. Select an App> Storage>CLEAR CACHE to clear the cache.

INTERNET NAVIGATION

Please make sure the tablet is connected to a working WiFi network before navigating the Internet.

You may use the pre-install Chrome browser or use another

browser downloaded from Play Store.

MULTIMEDIA

CONNECTING TO A COMPUTER

1. Connect your tablet to the computer with a USB cable.
2. Media device(MTP) is the default setting. Go to your computer and find your tablet HNS-T100 to transfer files between your tablet and computer.

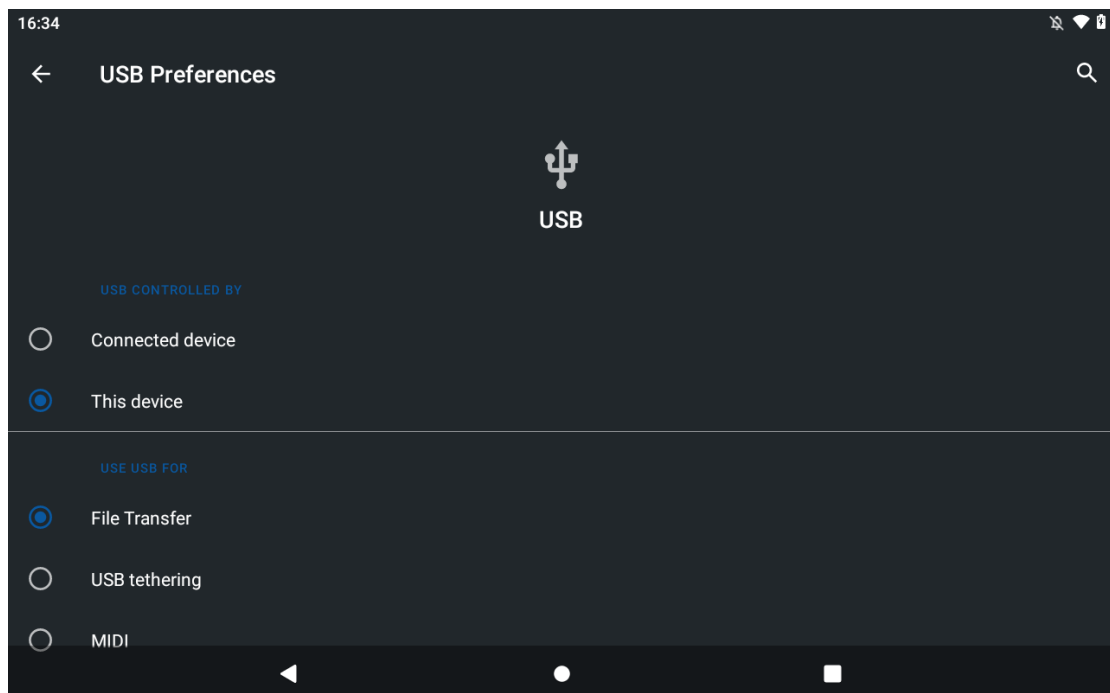
Tips:

Question&Answers :

Q1. The tablets does not charge.

Make sure the USB cable is properly plugged into the charging port.

Try another compatible USB cable and adapter.

Q2. Error message occurs during the operation

Uninstall the App with the error message, then download and install again.

Press the Rest button with a pin to reboot the tablet.

Q3. The tablet cannot connect to the WiFi.

Make sure the WiFi in your tablet is ON.

Make sure you input the correct password when connecting the WiFi.

Restart the router.

Make sure there is no filter setting or device connection limitation in the setting of the router.

Q4. The storage space of the tablet is not enough.

Delete the Apps you don't use.

Clear the cache of the Apps regularly.

Install a MicroSD card to expand the storage.

Q5. The screen is unresponsive

Check if the screen is dusty or greasy. If yes, Please gently wipe the screen with a cloth to clean it.
