The field strength is calculated by adding the Antenna Factor and Cable Factor and subtracting the Amplifier Gain and Duty Cycle Correction Factor (if any) from the measured reading. The basic equation with a sample calculation is as follows:

5.1. Antenna Requirement

Standard Applicable

FCC CFR Title 47 Part 15 Subpart C Section 15.203:

An intentional radiator shall be designed to ensure that no antenna other than that furnished by the response-ble party shall be used with the device. The use of a permanently attached antenna or of an antenna that uses a unique coupling to the intentional radiator, the manufacturer may design the unit so that a broken antenna can be replaced by the user, but the use of a standard antenna jack or electrical connector is prohibited.

FCC CFR Title 47 Part 15 Subpart C Section 15.247(c) (1) (I):

(i) Systems operating in the 2400-2483.5 MHz band that is used exclusively for fixed. Point-to-point operations may employ transmitting antennas with directional gain greater than 6dBi provided the maximum conducted output power of the intentional radiator is reduced by 1 dB for every 3 dB that the directional gain of the antenna exceeds 6dBi.



Test procedure:

- 1. The EUT was setup according to ANSI C63.10 requirements.
- The EUT was placed on a platform of nominal size, 1 m by 1.5 m, raised 80 cm above the conducting ground plane. The vertical conducting plane was located 40 cm to the rear of the EUT. All other surfaces of EUT were at least 80 cm from any other grounded conducting surface.
- 3. The EUT and simulators are connected to the main power through a line impedances stabilization network (LISN). The LISN provides a 50 ohm /50uH coupling impedance for the measuring equipment.
- 4. The peripheral devices are also connected to the main power through a LISN. (Refer to the block diagram of the test setup and photographs)
- 5. Each current-carrying conductor of the EUT power cord, except the ground (safety) conductor, was individually connected through a LISN to the input power source.
- 6. The excess length of the power cord between the EUT and the LISN receptacle were folded back and forth at the center of the lead to form a bundle not exceeding 40 cm in length.
- 7. Conducted emissions were investigated over the frequency range from 0.15MHz to 30MHz using a receiver bandwidth of 9 kHz.
- 8. During the above scans, the emissions were maximized by cable manipulation.


5.4. Radiated Band edge Emission

In any 100 kHz bandwidth outside the frequency band in which the spread spectrum or digitally modulated intentional radiator is operating, Radiated Emissions which fall in the restricted bands, as defined in §15.205(a), must also comply with the Radiated Emissions limits specified in §15.209(a) (see §15.205(c)).

Test configuration:



Test procedure:

- 1. The EUT was setup and tested according to ANSI C63.10.
- 2. The EUT is placed on a turn table which is 1.5 meter above ground. The turn table is rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the maximum emission level.
- 3. The EUT waspositioned such that the distance from antenna to the EUT was 3 meters.
- 4. The antenna is scanned from 1 meter to 4 meters to find out the maximum emission level. Thisis repeated for both horizontal and vertical polarization of the antenna. In order to find themaximum emission, all of the interface cables were manipulated according to ANSI C63.10 on radiated measurement.
- Use the following spectrum analyzer settings:
 - a) Span shall wide enough to fully capture the emission being measured
 - b) Set RBW=100kHz for <1GHz, VBW=3*RBW, Sweep time=auto, Detector=peak, Trace=max hold
 - c) Set RBW=1MHz, VBW=3MHz for >1GHz, Sweep time=auto, Detector=peak, Trace=max hold for Peak measurement If the emission level of the EUT measured by the peak detector is 3 dB lower than the applicable limit, the peak emission level will be reported. Otherwise, the emission measurement will be repeated using the quasi-peak detector and reported.







Test procedure:

- 1. The EUT was setup and tested according to ANSI C63.10.
- 2. The EUT is placed on a turn table which is 0.8 meter above ground for below 1 GHz, and 1.5 m for above 1 GHz. The turn table is rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the maximum emission level.
- 3. The EUT was set 3 meters from the receiving antenna, which was mounted on the top of a variable height antenna tower.
- 4. For each suspected emission, the EUT was arranged to its worst case and then tune the Antenna tower (from 1 m to 4 m) and turntable (from 0 degree to 360 degrees) to find the maximum reading. A pre-amp and a high pass filter are used for the test in order to get better signal level to comply with the guidelines.
- 5. Set to the maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.
- 6. Use the following spectrum analyzer settings
 - a) Span shall wide enough to fully capture the emission being measured;
 - b) Below 1 GHz:

RBW=120 kHz, VBW=300 kHz, Sweep=auto, Detector function=peak, Trace=max hold;

If the emission level of the EUT measured by the peak detector is 3 dB lower than the applicable limit, the peak emission level will be reported. Otherwise, the emission measurement will be repeated using the quasi-peak detector and reported.

c) Set RBW=1MHz, VBW=3MHz for >1GHz, Sweep time=auto, Detector=peak, Trace=max hold for Peak measurement If the emission level of the EUT measured by the peak detector is 3 dB lower than the applicable limit, the peak emission level will be

reported. Otherwise, the emission measurement will be repeated using the quasi-peak detector and reported.


