* Main interface function introduction

Main interface: All games are displayed on this page. Use the "up and down keys" to select a game, the "left and right keys" or "L1/R1 keys" to switch emulators, and the "L2/R2 keys" to quickly turn pages. *Main interface function introduction

Press the "X key" to enter the quick search page.



* OPTION (SYSTEM CHANGE) function introduction

Press the "SELECT key" + "START key" at the same time. After entering OPTION (SYSTEM CHANGE), there are two options.EMULATOR VIDEO RATIO can switch the game display ratio.
, OPTIONS MORE allows you to switch game names in multiple languages and set game

* Introduction to the function of switching game screen ratio

Press "SELECT key" + "START key" at the same time to enter OPTION (SYSTEM CHANGE). Select EMULATOR VIDEO RATIO and press "A" to confirm entry. Then select GAME RATIO and press "A" to confirm entry.



After entering GAME RATIO, press the "A key" to confirm to switch various screen ratios.



* Introduction to multi-language switching function

Press "SELECT key" + "START key" at the same time to enter OPTION (SYSTEM CHANGE). Select OPTION MORE and press "A key" to confirm entering MAIN MENU.



After entering the MAIN MENU, select LANGUAGE SETTNGS and press "A" to confirm entering LANGUAGE.



After entering LANGUAGE, use the "up and down keys" to select the language, and then press the "A key" to confirm. You can set multiple languages at will.



* Introduction to button setting function

Press "SELECT key" + "START key" at the same time to enter OPTION (SYSTEM CHANGE).Select OPTION MORE and press "A key" to confirm entering MAIN MENU.Then select CONTROLLERS SETTINGS and press "A" to confirm entry.



After entering QUIT, Select RESTART SYSTEM to restart the system.

Select SHUTDOWN SYSTEM to shut down.



* Introduction to Game Menu Functions

While the game is running, press the "SELECT key" + "START key" at the same time to enter the game menu. The menu supports game pause, restart, exit, instant archiving, and file reading (999 slot archives are optional).



*N64 simulator real-time archiving and real-time file reading function introduction

While the N64 game is running, press the "SELECT key + L1 key" at the same time to save instantly. Press "SELECT key + R1 key" at the same time to read files instantly.
