


INSTALLATION

Installation Way1:

- 1.First, tear off the double-sided tape on the upper half of the EVA.
- 2.The EVA paste is aligned on the back of the product.

Installation Wav2:

- Remove the shorter part of the Velcro tape and apply the Velcro Parallel to the back of the product.
 Apply the longer part of the Velcro to the back of the product, then peel off the tape and stick it to the wall together with the product.
