### **FCC RF Exposure Information and Statement**

The SAR limit of USA (FCC) is 1.6 W/kg averaged over one gram of tissue. Device types: KING 9000 (FCC ID: 2BGA8-KING9000) has also been tested against this SAR limit. This device was tested for typical body-worn operations with the back of the handset kept 5mm from the body.
