
## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

FUNCTION KEY

**\*IMPORTANT REMINDER:**  
Before installing the headset, please connect to your mobile phone according to the instructions in the quick user manual to test the sound effect and volume. If the sound effect and volume are significantly different after installing the helmet, please adjust the position of the speaker inside the helmet.

## BASIC FUNCTIONS

### START UP

Press and hold simultaneously Talkback and function keys  
(The blue light will stay on for 3 seconds and then go out. After powering on, the blue light will flash slowly and wait for the next operation)

### SHUT DOWN

Long press at the same time Talkback and function keys  
(The red light stays on for 3 seconds and then turns off)

### VOLUME KEY PLUS AND MINUS

Long press the "+" key increase volume  
 Long press "-" key reduce volume

### MOBILE PHONE PAIRING

Long press function key  
(The red and blue lights flash alternately)

### BATTERY POWER BROADCAST

In power on state  
Long press at the same time Function keys and "-" sign key

### SWITCH BETWEEN CHINESE AND ENGLISH

In shutdown state  
Long press at the same time Function keys and "+" sign key 6 seconds  
(The red light flashes 3 times and then goes out)

### VOICE ASSISTANT

Click the voice assistant key

### AUTOMATIC ANSWERING FUNCTION

In power on state  
Long press at the same time Intercom key and "-" sign key  
(The blue light stays on for three seconds when turned on. The red light stays on for three seconds when it is turned off)

## MUSIC FUNCTION

### PAUSE/PLAY MUSIC

(WHILE THE MUSIC IS PAUSED) PLAY  
 (WHILE MUSIC IS PLAYING) PAUSE

### SWITCH MUSIC

(WHILE MUSIC IS PLAYING) PREVIOUS SONG  
 (WHILE MUSIC IS PLAYING) NEXT SONG

### AUDIO SHARING

In intercom mode pairing, click the "+" key and the "-" key at the same time to turn on/off audio sharing.

## CALL FUNCTION

(INCOMING CALL) ANSWER THE CALL  
(10 SECONDS LATER)  
 (INCOMING CALL) ANSWER THE CALL  
 (INCOMING CALL) REJECT CALLS  
 (DURING A CALL) END THE CALL  
 (WHEN THERE IS NO INTERCOM) REDIAL LAST NUMBER  
 (WHEN MAKING AN OUTGOING CALL) CANCEL OUTGOING CALL

## BLUETOOTH INTERCOM FUNCTION

### TWO-PERSON INTERCOM MODE

1 LONG PRESS "WHEN PAIRING" INTERCOM INDICATOR LIGHT FLASHES SLOWLY  
2 CLICK "SEARCH FOR" INTERCOM INDICATOR LIGHT FLASHES QUICKLY  
3 "INTERCOM MODE CONNECTED" INTERCOM MODE INDICATOR IS ALWAYS ON  
4 DUO MODE  
(Both User 1 and User 2 need to follow process 1. Let one of the machines operate according to process 2)
