## **Getting Started**


### STEP 1 Download Tapo

Get the **Tapo** app from the App Store or Google Play, and log in.



### STEP 2 Set Up


Tap the  $\oplus$  button in the app. Select **Plugs** and then your model. Follow the step-by-step app instructions to set up your smart power strip.



### **How to Wall-Mount Your Device**



- 1. Mark the screw hole locations on the wall, with a 26 cm spacing between the two screws.
- 2. Use a drill to insert the screws into the marked locations and securely attach the power strip.



For a smooth installation, use screws with a diameter range of 4-8 mm for the screw cap

(Screw 4# or 6# recommended).

Note: A < 2.5 mm B > 6 mm 2 mm < C < 3 mm 4 mm < D ≤ 6 mm





### **Button & Port**

On/Off Button	Turn on or off your Smart Power Strip.  * Your Smart Power Strip turns off automatically when it's overloaded in electricity.
Smart Outlet	Plug in your device and control it from your phone. Each outlet is independent.
Individual On/Off Buttons	Press the on/off button to turn on or off the corresponding outlet. Press and hold any on/off button for about 5 seconds to reset Wi-Fi while keeping previous settings. Press and hold any on/off button for 10 seconds to restore your Smart Power Strip to factory default settings.
USB Ports	Charge your tablet, phone or other devices. Output: 5V/2.4A each; 5V/2.4A total

#### Note:

- Power Adapters/USB Chargers rated under 75W do not support PFC (Power Factor Correction). PFC can reduce the inrush current generated when the relay is turned on. Therefore, using a 60-75W Power Adapter/USB Charger may damage the device due to inrush currents.
- Avoid plugging your appliances with a motor/compressor higher than 1HP, such as an air conditioner. Frequent on/off switching may damage the compressor. You can check the motor/compressor value listed on your appliances or consult their customer support.
- 3. EV charging is not supported as it demands higher power and a charging current that surpasses the plug's rated capacity.
