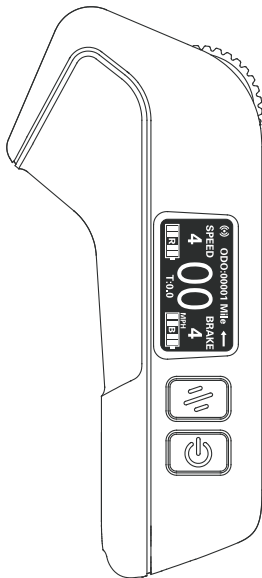

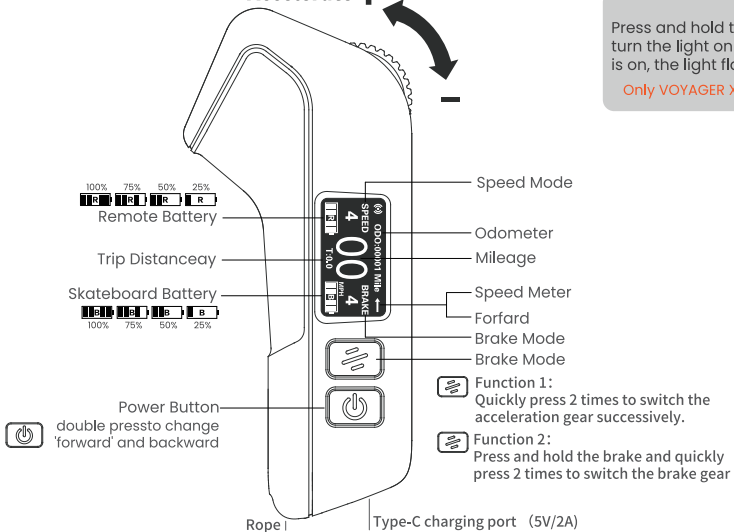

Ambient light mode

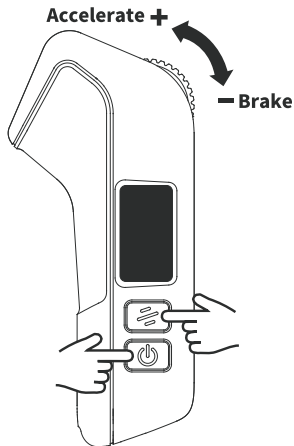
Accelerate +

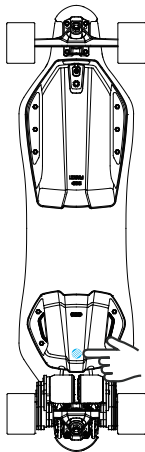

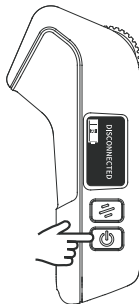
- Turn off the remote and long press "Function" with "power" to remote menu.

To Pair With Your Board



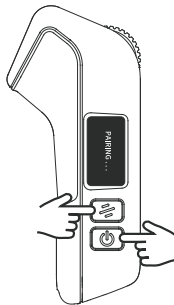
NO.1

Press "power button" to turn on your board, and then keep pressing for 7s until it is blinking.



NO.2

Press "power button" 3s to turn on your remote



NO.3

Hold the "FUNCTION" and "POWER" button of remote at the same time quickly (keep trying a few times if fail in the first time)
