Please use the provided Type-C Charging Cable to charge.

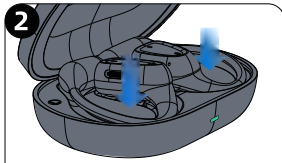

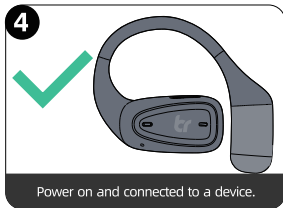
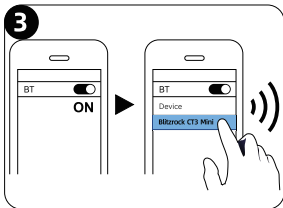
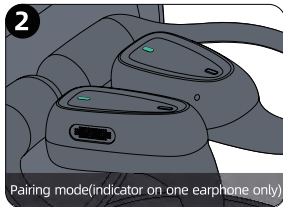
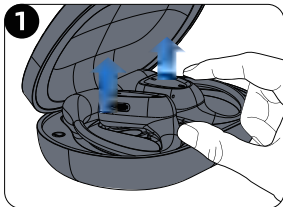
Please remove the insulating sheet and all protective stickers before the first use.

| Low volume or unclear sound | <p>1.The surrounding environment is too noisy.</p> <p>2.Incorrect Wearing</p> <p>3.Volume limit set on iPhone.</p> <p>4.Absolute volume off on Android(SYNC).</p> | <p>1.As open-ear headphones do not have noise -canceling function, please do not use them in noisy environments.</p> <p>2.Ensure that you wear them correctly, refer to the instruction manual for diagrams.</p> <p>3.For iPhone users:</p>  <p>Turn off the maximum volume limit.</p> <p>4.For Android users:</p>  <p>Turn on the Volume sync.</p> <p>*The SYNC setting method may vary for different Android models. | Headphones won't charge   | There is dirt or oil on the charging pin or charging contact sheet. | <p>Clean the charging pins and charging contacts with a clean paper towel or rag.
