

# Network Card

## Installation Steps

1. **Take out the USB WIFI adapter** from the package.
2. **Insert it into a USB port** on your computer firmly.
3. **Locate the new drive:** A new removable disk will show up. Double - click to open it and run the installation file following the wizard.
4. **Check in Device Manager:** Open Device Manager, expand "Network Adapters", and confirm "AIC8800 wifi6" is listed.
5. **Connect to WiFi:** Click the WiFi icon, choose your network, enter the password if needed, and start using the Internet.

## Precautions

- Check compatibility before installation.
- Don't remove the card during installation.
- Seek help on the official website or from customer support if there are issues.
