
- 1. Take out the wireless remote control and turn the switch to ON to unlock. The LED indicator light flashes, indicating that the wireless Bluetooth of the selfie stick is turned on.
- 2.Turn on the Bluetooth of your phone to find or search the Bluetooth Selfie, and pair it with this Bluetooth connection. After the connection is successful, the LED light will stop flashing. After turning on the phone's camera, you can take a selfie. Every time you take a picture, the LED indicator light will flash once.
- 3. \top urn the switch of the wireless remote control to OFF. If the LED indicator light does not flash, turn off the wireless remote control.

Battery replacement manual

1. Loosen the screws and open the battery cover



2. Remove the original battery and replace it with a new one



3. Close the battery cover and lock the screws
