## Pairing New Remote method:

- 1.Press [Power] Key to turn on the [TV]
- 2.Press and Hold [VOL-] key and [ · ] key together for 3-5 seconds, the indicator light flashes and enters the pairing state. After the pairing is successful, the indicator light will go out.

#### Connected new remote with a Paired Remote:

- 1.Press the [Home] key, then select [Setting Remotes & accessories]
- 2.Select [Add accessory], then Press [OK] key to confirm to pair.
- 3.Press and Hold **[VOL-]** key and **[ •• ]** key together for 3-5 seconds, the indicator light flashes and enters the pairing state. After the pairing is successful, theindicator light will go out.
