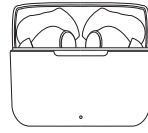
### Instructions for Use



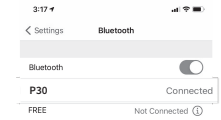
1.When using the earbuds for the first time, remove the insulating sticker from the earbuds and charge them fully.



3.The left and right earbuds are automatically paired when turned on.

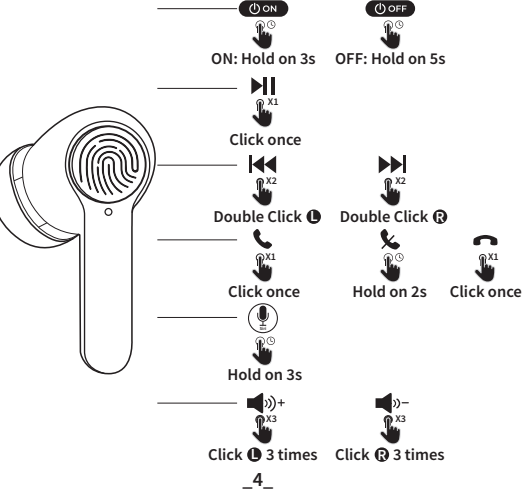


2.Take the earbuds out of the rechargeable charging case when fully charged.



4.Turn on your phone's Wireless, search for and connect the earbuds "P30".

### Basic Operation

1. Turn On
  - ①The earbuds will turn on automatically when you take out from the charging case after charged.
  - ②Press and hold for 3 seconds on the L or R earbud function touch key to turn on.
2. Turn Off
  - ①The earbuds will automatically switch off when placed in the charging case.
  - ③Press and hold for 5 seconds on the L or R earbud function touch key to turn off.
3. Play or pause: Click once on the L or R earbud function touch key.
4. Previous song: Click twice on the L earbud function touch key.

5. Next song: Click twice on the R earbud function touch key.
6. Volume +: Click 3 times on the L earbud function touch key.
7. Volume -: Click 3 times on the R earbud function touch key.
8. Answering calls: When a call comes in, click once on the L or R earbud function touch key.
9. Ending calls: Click once on the L or R earbud function touch key when during a call.
10. Refusing calls: Press and hold for 2 seconds on the L or R earbud function touch key when comes a call.
11. Turn on Voice Assistant: Press and hold for 3 seconds on the L or R earbud function touch key.

12. Auto shutdown: 3 minutes without connection will automatically shut down.
13. Memory function: the connection to the last connected device is made automatically after switching on.

### Earbuds Indicator

- 1.Turn on: red and blue light flashes.
- 2.Turn off: red light flashes.
- 3.Disconnected: red and blue light flashes in sequence.
- 4.Auto shutdown: red light flashes.

### Charging Case Indicator

- 1.Charging: red light flashes, after fully charged, the red light will always on.
- 2.Charging to the earbuds: blue light on.
